



Who are the soul singers? Where do they come from, are they all negro? What were their musical influences?

LITTLE ANTHONY

One story helps to stress the question, "What do you mean by soul anyway?" About a year ago, Little Anthony and the Imperials were playago, Little Anthony and the Imperials were playing to a predominately negro audience at Los Angeles, "Whisky A Go Go". They'd not had a hit for well over a year and were doing straight pop on stage, that is, until a group of colored girls came down to the stage and started singing "Just Sing It Soul, Brother And Little Anthony sang it soul. The numbers were still the same numbers but they breathed

love and fire.

If you've ere heard the women they now call "Lady Soul", Aretha Franklin, sing the old standard "You Are My Sunshine" (It's on the Atlantic LP, Aretha Artives), you'll know where soul comes from. It comes from the old blues, from the Mississippi Delta. It comes from the

rrom the subsassippi detta. It comes from the unbelievable gospel singing in the Negro churches. It comes from jazz.
It's a modern fusion of all these elements.
Ray Charles, blind blues singer, says "it's from the heart". Scotty Reagan from the Four Tops shouts out "just all start lovin" each other

BEFORE ROCK

Soul is strongly sound to the Negro community. In a way it's their music. The concerts at the Apollo Theatre in Harlem and the antique Fox Theatre in Detroit were moving to soul music well before Bill Haley's brand of rock was coming in with the white kids.

And then soul caught on with non-Negrot.

And then sout caught on with non-negros-Everyone began to groove with Wilson Pickett, James Brown, Joe Tex. Many of them, Ike and Tine Turner and James Brown for example made smash hit tours of the U.K. Mick Jagger

When Otis Redding died in December last year, there was a genuine feeling of loss and misery in the Negro areas where he started singing. With Otis in the plane crash were the Bar-Kays, Jimmie King. 18, Ron Caldwell, 19. Carl Cunningham, 18; and Phalin Jones, 18. His last release "Dock of the Bay" illustrates what I mean about soul. It's sad and lonely but you have to move with it, because the vital element of drive and blues rhythm is still there.

What makes the words of soul songs so good: With the singers it's a voice that's played like an instrument. Voices that scream like Sam and Dave and growl like Wilson Pickett

At Christmas every year Tamla produces the Motown Review in Detroit's Fox Theatre It lasts for ten days and includes every Motown artist. 
