## Major Markets See Higher Ratings

Seattle, Atlanta Shares Higher For Quarter, Year

Country outlets in major markets continued their upward climb with stations in such cities as Miami, Seattle, and Tampa, Fla., posting higher 12-plus ratings in the summer-fall Arbitron survey.

Some of the winners included KYCW Seattle, which posted a 1.6-3.3 share, putting it three-tenths of a point higher than one year ago, when it was rock-formatted KXRK. In the same market, KMPS-AM-FM also saw its ratings rise (7.9-8.5) during the same period. Year-on-year, country shares have risen 18% (13.1-15.5).

In Atlanta, the ABC/Cap Cities-owned country duopoly also turned in higher ratings for the summer-fall book. Younger-skewing WYAY had a 3.7-4.5 share, while mainstream partner WKHX had a 9.2-9.9. For the year, the combo is ahead 13.8-14.1, a 4% rise.

In Miami, a traditionally weak country market, WKIS saw its 12-plus numbers increase 3.7-4.6. Over in Tampa, WQYK-FM turned in a 9.8-9.0 book.

In the Phoenix market, KNIX

regained the 12-plus lead, rising 7.1-8.2, while KMLE slipped 7.6-6.6. During the summer-fall period, the two stations added one-tenth of a point to country's share of listening.

In Nashville, WSIX held on to the overall ratings lead, rising 14.8-15.9, while crosstown rival WSM-FM eased 12.2-10.2. Both are down from one year ago.

Other summer-fall ratings winners included KZDG Denver (1.9-2.9), WWYZ Hartford, Conn. (5.7-8.2), KTST Oklahoma City (4.0-5.2), and WOGY Memphis (4.2-5.2).

Year-on-year growth awards go to WCOL-FM Columbus, Ohio, which rose 4.0-7.6, as well as KCKI Tulsa, Okla. (2.1-3.1) and KTST (3.7-5.2).



## California Stations Duke It Out In Promo Bowl

### Charity The Winner In Radiothon Wager

No matter what the outcome of the California matchup in Super Bowl XXIX, St. Jude Children's Hospital will come out a winner, thanks to the side competition between country stations in San Francisco and San Diego.

As part of its Super Bowl promotion activities, KSON San Diego will sell for about \$5 a four-song cassette (featuring three parodies and one theme song), with proceeds earmarked for the St. Jude Radiothon. The morning teams at KSON and KSAN San Francisco also have a friendly wager on the game, with the loser donating \$1,000 to the other station's St. Jude Radiothon kitty.

Meanwhile, California stations are working overtime to get their promotions implemented and heard. Says KYCY San Francisco promotion director Krista Coutts, "The thing that's so

### Promotion To Be First Stand-Alone Unit At Arista's Unnamed New Label

For now, radio promotion will be the only autonomous division at Arista Records Nashville's as-yet-unnamed new label. Three regional managers have been hired, and another is expected this week.

Says VP of promotion and artist development Jack Weston, "The executive staff at Arista will service the new label . . . There's not going to be a separate label head."

Weston says as business picks up at the new label, other departments—such as publicity, media, and marketing—will be added.

Promotion is currently being overseen by director of national promotion Denise Nichols.

WKHX Atlanta has signed afternoon-drive personality Bill Cellar to a new five-year contract. He's been with the station eight years.

great about radio is that you can do things at a moment's notice. We originally had two other plans for our Super Bowl promotion, and we changed it because we wanted it to be as easy as possible for listeners to participate but still [have the promotion] sound really fun on the radio."

Adds Steve Sapp, promotion director at KSON, "The [San Diego] Padres in the World Series in '84 was big, and this has taken the whole city by storm, so we're trying to do something really big. But until [the Chargers] became AFC champions, they hadn't done anything they haven't done before. So our efforts really started after they won . . . against Pittsburgh."

Here's a brief look at some of the projects from three of the leading country stations in the San Francisco and San Diego markets:

#### KYCY San Francisco

- A "What Would You Do For Super Bowl Tickets" contest. The winner gets an all expense paid trip to the game.

- The station's name ("Young Country") has been changed to "Steve Young Country" in honor of the 49ers' quarterback: 10,000 posters have been printed promoting the change.

#### KSAN San Francisco

- An all expense paid trip for two to the game.
- A special party for 600 listeners at the Black Angus restaurant the day of the game.

#### KSON San Diego

- Airing parody songs all week, including versions of "Kick A Little," "Can't Keep A Good Team Down," and "Thunder Rolls Super Bowl." It's changing the lyrics and dropping in play-by-play from the Pittsburgh game.

- The station invited listeners to the studio to sing along during the recording of the station's fight song, "Nuts About The Bolts," written by local songwriter Steve Vaus.

- The morning team will do live remotes Wednesday (25) and Thursday (26) before the game tentatively slated to air from Jimmy Johnson's new sports bar in Miami.

## COUNTRY CONFIDENTIAL

### I

T'S BEEN SAID that the only thing constant is change. The success we've enjoyed as a radio format and at the retail level during the past five years is unequaled by any other "boom period" in our history. This success means both productive and problematic change for country music.

Recent Nashville media commentary, and a rather controversial national news feature on country music at the retail level, bore such dismal headlines as "Can Nashville Hang On To Restless Fans?" After allegations of inaccuracies in statistics and countless interpretations, the message appearing between the lines suggests that the spell we've cast on record buyers, radio listeners, and concertgoers has somehow been broken.

Perhaps the most unfortunate element of such commentary is the manner in which it tends to dishearten the industry from within, potentially sowing confusion and self-doubt. Industry insiders will no doubt agree that

historically our community tends to reprimand itself each time it experiences unusual success. Such a system of checks and balances is healthy. Country music is primarily an ethnic music with roots and traditions to observe and perpetuate. But our audience has grown tremendously, and the bigger it gets, the better the bottom line looks.

If country music is at any crossroads at all, it is where musical integrity and fiscal well-being intersect. This is an equally critical juncture for radio and the record community, coming at a time when we must renew our faith in ourselves and our various tasks and goals and make a renewed commitment to discredit the naysayers. It is not a time for conservative thinking in terms of creativity or for playlist shrinking and wholesale reactionary measures at radio. It is time to become better acquainted with consumers and also to reacquaint ourselves with the traditions and roots that brought us to the dance. We can celebrate our heritage and make money. There is no need to apologize for who we are or where we've been—that's why our consumer fell in love with us in the first place.

It's official: WNY New York has named Katherine Brown and David Temple as its new morning co-hosts. Brown just wrapped up a four-year stint as air personality on the Westwood One Radio Network. Temple also spent four years at Westwood One, where he anchored the hot country format.



## Alan Jackson Leads ACM Nominees; Named In 6 Hat Award Categories

Alan Jackson took honors as the most-nominated artist for the Academy of Country Music's 30th annual Hat Awards, scheduled for May 10. The superstar is up for six categories, including entertainer of the year and top male vocalist.

Vince Gill and Tim McGraw followed closely with five nominations each; Garth Brooks, Brooks & Dunn, Reba McEntire, Mary Chapin Carpenter, and John Michael Montgomery picked up four apiece.

The show will be broadcast live at the Universal Amphitheater in Los Angeles on NBC-TV by Dick Clark Productions Inc. There are provisions for write-in votes; all ballots are due Feb. 22. Here's the full list of nominees:

### James Can Talk The Talk Again

Conservative Music, DJ Longevity Key To KSCS Success

**K** SCS Dallas PD Dean James speaks with the subdued confidence of a market leader. Maybe it's the fact that KSCS returned to the top slot in the market after slipping from No. 1 in the summer; or maybe he knows that the market's changed significantly since the station's 10-share days and that it's best to tone down the rhetoric for the media.

Regardless, if James wanted to talk the talk he could, because KSCS just walked the walk in the fall '94 Arbitron survey. Mainstream KSCS' 12-plus share rose 5.9-6.9, ahead of crosstown competitors KPLX, unchanged at 4.1, and KYNG, which dropped 5.9-3.7. The station also dominated morning drive with a 7.2-7.8 share; that's over two times the ratings of its nearest country competitor.

"We're competing not just with country, but all formats; and there's some very strong competitors in the market, and not only in

country," says James, who celebrated his second anniversary with KSCS this month after spending several years programming KFKF Kansas City, Mo. "The bottom line is dollars. We're not looking for country dollars because you don't have to look for country dollars in Dallas, since it's the mainstream format. It's what AC is in other markets."

James says the summer ratings drop was a humbling experience, and, like many PDs, he used it to take a closer look at his operation. "We conducted a very serious self-check of what we were doing to see if we were on target, and then we did some housecleaning.

"One thing that honestly has been very beneficial to us is . . . good competition in this market. That makes you a better radio station. Are we the slickest, hottest, biggest-sounding station in America? I don't know and that's unimportant. The point is: Did we sound good to our listeners?"

One thing James has been blessed with is longevity regarding KSCS' on-air staff. Granted, in a market like Dallas stations can afford to pay top dollar for talented personalities; holding on to them is another story, and KSCS has been right on the mark for almost a decade.

"We're putting a promo on the air right

now that talks about the tradition this station has with its air staff. It hasn't changed since I've been here, and there probably have only been two changes in the air staff—the evening and the overnight show—in the past five to seven years. Our morning show personality has been with us for seven years. There's a lot of consistency there.

"Listeners could care less about voices or being smooth. On-air staffers are not jocks. They're people who are on the air. Jocks are a dime a dozen. I could get anybody with a big voice for half the money than what we're paying these guys, but it would mean absolutely nothing to us and our listeners."

One thing that does matter to the listeners is the music, and James and his staff so far have been on target, straddling the mainstream fence. "I think it was Michael Owens, the GM at KNIX Phoenix, who made a good point," says James. "He said that whatever you are, you might bob up and down like a buoy in the water, with a slight adjustment here and there. If 'there' happens to be dealing with a lot of really great new music, then we're not going to say, 'We only play so many new songs so we can't play those songs.' We'll probably make a slight adjustment, but overall the station is going to still be very consistent."

James admits KSCS is "very conservative" when it comes to playing records. "That's always what we've done in the past before me, but it has also been part of the success of the station," he says. "Other stations can break all the ground they want. Sometimes that can seem unfair to new artists who deserve some airplay, but the whole point is to find the balance between our recurrent and gold library and the new stuff. It's important for us to keep that balance."

James, however, cautions other programmers about viewing Dallas as a bellwether market for country, when it comes to competition and musical tastes. "Tastes are going to be different in every market, and there are some similarities between Dallas and other markets. I know a lot of people look to Dallas and Houston to see how things develop, but I don't necessarily believe that what's going to happen to Dallas and Houston is going to happen to somebody else's market."

Looking to the future, James says country could fragment, but only slightly. "I guess it's possible. I already see some real differences in test score songs; some test horribly with older folks, while the same songs will test fantastic with the younger side. If there's going to be more than one station, and in our case four, then there's going to be some fragmentation. Somebody is going to find a particular niche, whether it's skewing younger or older. Is there a country gold format? It depends on the market."

"Everybody's talking about fragmentation, and there's probably more [such talk] than there was a couple of years ago; but it's not a problem for a station to be mainstream, at least in this market."


