Rap No Dilemma For Some Adult R&B PDs

Each year, adult R&B PDs wonder if it's finally time to acknowledge that even listeners in their early 40s grew up with hip-hop. While some adult R&Bs already play some classic rap, especially in weekend old-school shows, that's as far as most have gone. Until now. For the week ending Oct. 27, "Dilemma" by Nelly Featuring Kelly Rowland had risen to No. 19 on the adult R&B chart, increasing by 42 spins.

It's not the first time a rap artist has charted. Erick Sermon's "Music" peaked at No. 5 on the chart last year, albeit with a non-rap version that featured only Marvin Gaye's vocals. And from 1992-94, when *Airplay Monitor* organized its panels differently, some adult-leaning mainstream outlets reported to the adult chart, allowing Heavy D, Salt-N-Pepa, Warren G & Nate Dogg, Ini Kamoze, and Shabba Ranks to make the adult R&B chart.


Of the 41 stations on the *Airplay Monitor* adult R&B chart, eight are playing "Dilemma" in significant rotation, while two others have played it sporadically. Of those eight stations, six are Clear Channel outlets. In fact, for KJMS (V101.1) Memphis and KHHT (Hot 92.3 Jamz) Los Angeles, it's the No. 1 record, getting 71 and 39 spins, respectively. At the other Clear Channel adult R&B outlets that are playing it, the song ranks in the top 10.

"It's a power for us at WSVY [Norfolk, Va.]," says OM Daisy Davis, who also oversees WOWL. "It tested really well—in fact, it came back No. 2 with the demo, behind 'The Battle Is the Lord's' by Yolanda Adams . . . We all put it in our callout, and the stations that got back the best response started to roll with it. I think the reason it does so well is because it's not only a really big hit among the masses, but it's also a familiar hook to the older listeners, using the Patti LaBelle melody [from "Love, Need, and



Emmis/NYC Vet Ellis To Exit In 2003

Emmis Communications/New York senior VP/market manager Judy Ellis has overseen WQHT (Hot 97) New York as long as Emmis has owned that station. Ellis joined in August 1986, when WQHT was launched as dance-driven rhythmic outlet Hot 103.5. After overseeing the station's transition to an influential R&B/hip-hop outlet and sister WRKS' transition to adult R&B, Ellis will not renew her contract, which expires Feb. 28, 2003.

In other news from Emmis/New York, Hot 97 p.m. driver/Elektra artist Angie Martinez becomes the fourth judge for the upcoming *American Idol* competition, set to air in January 2003. She joins returning judges Paula Abdul, Randy Jackson, and Simon Cowell.

KVGS (V108) Las Vegas shifts to adult R&B as "today's R&B and old school." PD Vic Clemmons remains, along with most of the airstaff, but mix-show coordinator Pretty Boy A.D. exits.

Rhythmic top 40 WJFX Fort Wayne, Ind., taps Beau Derek from WNDV (U93) South Bend, Ind., as PD, replacing Phil Becker, now the PD of CKEY (Wild 101) Buffalo, N.Y.

American Urban Radio Networks is launching the American Smooth Jazz Network in January. Veteran New York personality Ken "Spider" Webb will host the program *Jazz Masters* on the

network, while former BET news correspondent and current WQCD New York personality Angela Stribling will host *Jazz Notes*.

Syndication veteran Walt "Baby" Love extends his deal with Excelsior Radio Networks through 2009, covering *The Countdown*, *Urban AC Countdown*, *Gospel Traxx*, and a new prep service to launch in 2003.

Badu Represents R&B With 'Hip-Hop'

For those who've been wondering if there's still room for an R&B artist on the R&B/hip-hop chart, there's good news this week, as neo-soul pioneer Erykah Badu earns her sixth top 10 on that chart. Then again, it's with a song called "Love of My Life (An Ode to Hip-Hop)" (Fox/MCA) and the help of rapper Common. Badu's last appearance in the top 10 was in September 2000, when "Bag Lady" peaked at No. 2. Her only No. 1 was 1997's "Tyrone." Badu was also featured on the remix of "The Light" by Common, which peaked at No. 5. The un-Common rapless version of "Love of My Life" moves 14-12 on the adult R&B chart.

Earning its second consecutive top 10, *Clipse* moves 11-9 on both the R&B/hip-hop and rap charts with "When the Last Time" (Star Trak/Arista). This eclipses the duo's previous single, "Grindin'," which peaked at No. 10 in August.

AS REPORTED IN *Billboard Bulletin*, MTV will air a 90-minute, commercial-free concert on World AIDS Day, Dec. 1. The special will feature footage from two concerts: a Nov. 7 show in Seattle with Missy "Missdeemeanor" Elliott and others and a Nov. 23 concert in Capetown, South Africa, with Alicia Keys, P. Diddy, and local artists. The concert footage will be intertwined with AIDS/HIV-awareness PSAs. The MTV special will be offered rights-free to broadcasters worldwide and distributed via Westwood One's MTV Radio Network.



Want You"]]. And even though we are geared toward the older demo, there will always be some younger-ended music that appeals to that demo."

Eileen Collier, APD of KJMS and mainstream sister WHRK, says, "We started playing it a couple of weeks ago, and the research went through the roof immediately with the 25-34 demo. The song is very melodic, and he's such a likable artist that it's not a negative to play the song. I even have some ministers who call to request it."

There's also the question of whether Nelly's sing-song vocal would even be considered rap if it was coming from another non-rap-imaged artist. Chuck Atkins, VP of operations for Clear Channel in Nelly's hometown of St. Louis, says, "It's not just that Nelly is from here. You can clearly see in the callout that the adults, even the upper end of our demo, are passionate for this song. Even though it has rap in it, Kelly Rowland's singing softens it considerably. I don't know if I would even consider it rap."

Mike James, PD of WFLM Port St. Lucie, Fla., one of the few non-Clear Channel stations playing "Dilemma," says, "To me, it has always been an adult record because of the hook and because it's so mass appeal. It's not hard rap; in fact, I feel it's more of a Kelly Rowland record than it is a Nelly record. He just happens to have the bigger name right now." But James admits he was hesitant to play it, "until I started to get a great deal of requests. Adult stations don't generally get a lot of requests to begin with, so when you start to see calls, you should pay attention." James also played Mary J. Blige Featuring Ja Rule's "Rainy Dayz," which he calls "a similar type of record."

But only three other non-Clear Channel stations at press time were playing "Dilemma," and only Emmis' WRKS New York was doing so significantly, with 22 spins during a seven-day period. Almost all the other programmers we spoke with are not now considering "Dilemma."

Ken Johnson, Cumulus director of urban programming, says, "I consider it to be a hip-hop record but not necessarily a rap record, because the sound is pretty soft. But that being said, I don't think it's a record my adult listeners expect to hear on adult radio stations." He adds that he hasn't yet put it into callout, because "I haven't seen any requests on it at the adult stations, like I saw when Erick Sermon had 'Music' out, which we did play. It's just a different scenario."

Derrick Brown, PD of Cox-owned WHQT (Hot 105) Miami, says that while "the research on the record shows a decent number, I still would not play it on Hot, because I don't need to. The fact is I have a mainstream R&B sister, WEDR, which is a hip-hop station. They are in a battle with another station, [WPOW] Power 96, as well as a top 40 that plays hip-hop. They're all playing 'Dilemma' heavily. Why would I play it as well? I would also be concerned about the burn factor of the record in the market, because of that exposure on the other stations."

Brown admits, however, that "I don't really consider it a rap record. If it weren't so overexposed, I might be looking at it now. When you have three or four other stations playing it literally every hour, then I need to be the alternative."

Jay Dixon, PD of Cox's WBHK (98.7 Kiss FM) Birmingham, Ala., asks, "If that's what your listeners want, then you should play it. But is it really what they want? I recently played Mario's 'Braid My Hair' to see if listeners would respond. One caller in particular stands out in my mind. She said, 'Sure, I like the song, but I expect to hear that on [sister station] WBHJ, not on Kiss.'"

Dixon continues, "The problem is, if you look at the adult R&B chart today, you see a lot of records that aren't really hits. That's why you have a record like Ruff Endz's 'Someone to Love You' or Maxwell's 'Lifetime' stay at No. 1 forever, because they are so good. But a lot of those other records in the top 10, it's as if programmers are just grasping for records to

move up, to freshen up their sound. And in the process they are moving up mediocre records or records that don't really fit the demo, like 'Dilemma.'

"You have to be careful in research as well," Dixon adds. "There are some gospel records that research very well—but does their sound fit your station? It's like going to McDonald's today and you see pizza on the menu."

READY FOR A CHANGE?

But is it time for a menu change at a format whose target demo now includes people who weren't even listening to radio yet when "Rapper's Delight" came out in 1979? Clear Channel/New Orleans OM Carla Boatner believes so. "The adult R&B format is changing," she says. "It's not just an artist-driven format anymore." She too is considering adding "Dilemma" at WYLD-FM.

Davis agrees that what is happening with Nelly "could be a very good indication that things are ready to change. It's really about the song now and not who the artist is. I consider Nelly to be a rap artist, but this song is not a rap record. And honestly, it's not something I would normally seek out to play on WSVY. But maybe we need to look at things with a new perspective."

Davis adds that "things have changed so much in the past year or two. There are core adult R&B artists who can't even get airplay at the format now. Unfortunately, there is something that happens in R&B that once an artist reaches a certain age, it's very hard for them to still be accepted. I don't think they are producing music of a lesser quality, it's more of a stigma that the industry puts on them."

Another industry professional remarked that he feels adult R&B stations are playing more current artist like Nelly because "there is just less hit adult R&B music to play overall. Labels are releasing less of that type of music, so programmers have to turn to the mainstream artists—either that or they go more gold."

Atkins adds, "A couple of years ago, if Luther Vandross or Michael Jackson put out a record to adult radio, it was an automatic add. Today, you can't do that. It's not about the name value of the artist—it has to be about whether or not the song is a hit. And if the hits come in the form of Nelly's 'Dilemma,' that's what you play."

He continues, "Our format needs new blood. The heritage artists only put out so much material; that's why we are looking to the Musiqs and Jill Scotts to be the next generation of adult artists."

Collier agrees. "I see the doors opening up for rap acts like LL Cool J and others—who this demo has grown up listening to—to have current music heard on adult R&B radio. You've also got artists like Will Smith or Common who might have different nuances of rap that could appeal to adults."

And James adds that "the demo that is accepting of rap has grown older. They are 35-40 now. They are not turned off by rap, as maybe the 40-plus listeners are. So you can definitely play the classic hip-hop and the softer stuff like 'Dilemma.' It makes sense."

Even those who aren't playing the St. Louis rapper say the format will continue to evolve. Johnson says the format "should first embrace more of the old-school hip-hop, like Sugar Hill Gang, Heavy D, and LL Cool J, because a lot of that stuff is being ignored by R&B and hip-hop stations anyway. It still keeps you in your niche."

And Dixon says, "Rap will eventually make it onto adult R&B if your station is branded in the right way and that's what your listeners expect. There is room for a hot adult R&B AC format in many markets—like Atlanta, Chicago, or New York—but it may not be right for every market. If people want to hear smooth R&B and oldies, that's all they want. They don't want all that other mess, especially if they can already get it somewhere else."

OM Boatner Boosts Morale, Momentum, And Imaging In New Orleans

As one of the few female OMs in R&B radio, Carla Boatner oversees four stations for Clear Channel's New Orleans urban cluster—WQUE (Q93), adult R&B WYLD-FM, gospel WYLD-AM, and blues WODT. Within Clear Channel, she's among a growing number of female programmers who are taking center stage as the leaders in some of the company's most competitive markets.

Boatner's journey in radio began in 1990 as the morning producer for then-mainstream R&B KMJQ Houston. Her responsibilities grew to include promotions, and she eventually became APD/MD. Boatner was also part of the team headed by PD Carl Connor and then-GM Ernest Jackson when the station segued to adult

I] worked really hard at redefining the station by changing the image." Boatner uses Dr. Dave Ferguson as voice talent for WQUE and Jim Snowden on WYLD.

"The biggest problem with being No. 1," Boatner says, "is growing complacent, comfortable, and cocky in your position. But with new competition in the market in recent years, that has kept WQUE and WYLD on point."

She continues, "WYLD has a formidable competitor in KMEZ, so we have to watch that race closely. They are all old-school, whereas WYLD plays currents, but they still share a great deal of artists. We are still ahead of them 25-54." In fact, WYLD is ranked second in 25-54, KMEZ is third, and WQUE is first.

R&B. In 2001, Clear Channel called her home to Chicago, as APD/MD of WGCI-AM-FM and adult R&B sister WVAZ (V103), under OM Elroy Smith. In June, Clear Channel VP of urban programming Doc Wynter, along with newly appointed New Orleans GM Muriel Funches, brought her on board to head the team there.

Boatner says, "When I first arrived, what I noticed immediately was the longevity of the talent on our stations. Many had been there for five, 10, or even more years. Also, the heritage value of the call letters for both WQUE and WYLD meant a lot to the New Orleans listener."

While both WQUE and WYLD-FM had long-standing personalities on-air, the two stations had been through several transitions on the programming and management side during the past two years. Boatner observes that "the morale of the staff was affected during that time. It's normal for people to feel uneasy when upper management is going through changes. You must wonder about your job security, and things might get a little uncomfortable, especially when they hadn't had changes before that for a number of years. So Muriel and I made sure we sat down with everyone to spell out our plans."

The greater challenge for Boatner was how to keep the momentum of her stations while not losing ground to new competitors. She concedes, "WQUE is the No. 1 station, and WYLD is right behind it. You have to ask yourself, 'If it ain't broke, why try to fix it?' But that being said, I knew I wanted to do some things to raise the bar and to grow in areas we never had to before. I did that by reworking the imaging. I wanted the image on WQUE to be a little more hip, more contemporary. We made it more aggressive to fit the hip-hop format. On WQUE, we are 'No. 1 for hip-hop and R&B,' and the secondary statement is 'nothing but jamz.' For WYLD, it's 'the best from back in the day and today.'"

Boatner explains, "I'm an imaging nut—I like to come up with creative names for contests and events. I want to make sure the personalities are always selling the image and product that is the radio station. A big part of that is selling the music and artists. That's what I helped to do in Chicago at WGCI. [Elroy and

"It's not really a concern for me," Boatner adds. "In fact, it's a good problem to have and one that I dealt with before in Chicago at WVAZ where [sister] WGCI led in the 25-54 demo. Our goal is to get WYLD to the top [of] 25-54 but at the same time not lose any headway for WQUE [in] 12-plus or 18-34."

Boatner explains that "[what] I have noticed about the music here is that it doesn't burn as fast as it did in Chicago." With regard to musical style, she also notes that "we have more in common with Houston in terms of having a distinct local sound and a bigger local hip-hop scene. Artists like the 504 Boyz, Master P, Cash Money Crew, and unsigned acts like Choppa are all huge here and might get more play than in other markets. But overall, the big hits in Chicago or New York or D.C., like 'Baby' by Ashanti or 'Dilemma' by Nelly, are also the biggest hits here."

On the adult side, Boatner adds that "WYLD plays a little more jazz than maybe other adult stations, but hey, this is New Orleans after all. We spotlight it in our *Mellow Moods* show at night, and we have a jazz show on Sunday mornings." Blues, on the other hand, will air on sister WODT, while the majority of gospel is heard on WYLD-AM. "But we do share some songs and artists across all the stations."

With the many annual activities in New Orleans—such as the Essence Music Festival, Mardi Gras, and the Bayou Classic—Boatner says there is always a concert, after-party, or community function that keeps the stations busy in promotions. "We also have signature events that have been going on for 10 and 20 years. WQUE has its annual Teen Summit that is both a concert as well as a forum for teens to talk about issues that affect them, like drugs, sex, education, and peer pressure. And WYLD has been holding its annual talent contest for over 20 years. The PDs at each of my stations—Angela Watson at WQUE, A.J. Appleberry at WYLD, and Chris McCoy at WYLD-AM—help me a great deal in making everything come together. They are great because they don't have these big egos. This is totally a team effort."
