New Jacks Want To Go Back To Old School

Since radio's mid-'90s consolidation, an entire new generation of personalities and programmers has entered radio. These new players have come into the business at a time when radio is run by publicly traded mega-corporations with six to eight stations in a single market.

It's a generation of personalities and programmers that has grown up listening to hip-hop exclusively, that thinks of syndicated mornings as the norm, and that sees its future as either a national programmer, a voice-tracking jock, a syndicated morning personality, or maybe a hip-hop star.

This is the generation that will define the future of radio. But when *R&B Airplay Monitor* asked some of them how they hope to change and shape the radio of the future, many expressed a surprising desire for the radio of old.

Shannon "Trey" Brazier of the Choklit Jox at WPWX (Power 92) Chicago has been in radio for six years. He grew up listening to that market's WGCI-FM and WBMX and cites Tom Joyner, Doug Banks, and "Crazy" Howard McGee—with whom he started as a morning producer—as the personalities he most admires.

"Radio is not at all what I thought it would be," Brazier says. "Politics are so much more a part of the workplace. From how you get jobs to how you get records played... It's a little disappointing, but if you want to be in radio bad enough, you have to learn to deal with it."

Talus Knight, middayer at WCDX Richmond, Va., has been in commercial radio for slightly more than three years. He was raised in Raleigh, N.C., listening to WQQK, and says that "radio is vastly different than what I expected and what I heard growing up." He agrees that "the control over music and how it gets played is much more about corporate business than it is about the love of the music."

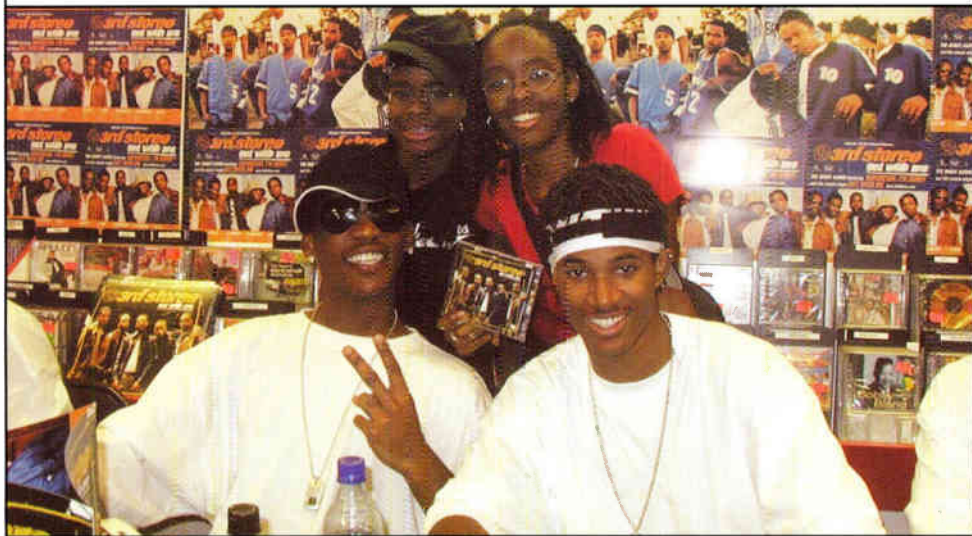

Recent Violence Draws Feds' Attention

New York native Jason "Jam Master Jay" Mizell was remembered by one of his town's R&B outlets, as well as N/T WNEW, after he was shot and killed Oct. 30. At press time, the *New York Post* reported that investigators were looking at a videotape from a security camera on the premises of the recording studio where Mizell was shot. It also reported that federal investigators are looking at several murders, assaults, and extortion attempts in the hip-hop world that may be related, including Mizell's death and that of a rap promoter Kenneth Walker, who was killed several days later. The *Post* cited a source as saying, "The U.S. Attorney's Office in Manhattan has been weighing possible criminal-conspiracy charges against unnamed targets in the rap world for more than a year."

In an unrelated incident, WAJZ Albany, N.Y., night jock DJ Biz is recuperating after being shot four times and slashed in the face by a rival club jock. Biz, aka Irving Bynum, was leaving the station at midnight after his shift when the accused assailant, Aristelle Thomas, called out his name. According to a story in the *Times Union*, Bynum and Thomas had a clash earlier in the year at a nightclub, when a friend of Bynum's, David Hayes, allegedly slashed Thomas with a box cutter. Hayes was arrested a week before the Bynum shooting.

MANAGEMENT: NASH LEAVES RADIO

Radio One/Boston president/GM Bernadine Nash has resigned. She oversaw WBOT (Hot 97.9) and heritage R&B oldies WILD. Also, Hot 97.9 hires Rocsi for middays from P/T at sister KBFB (the Beat). She replaces Reggie B, who returns to producer for the Russ Parr morning show.

At adult R&B KRPW (Power 97.5) Houston, market manager Tim Davies and marketing director Kristy Power exit. The Cumulus market manager for nearby Beaumont, Texas, Mike Knar, moves to Houston to take over for Davies.

WZHT Montgomery, Ala., GM Ron Eubanks will exit the Clear Channel cluster later this month.

SHEIST SPOTS NOW HEARD ON KPWR

Several weeks ago, the *Los Angeles Times* reported that KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles agreed to disclose the connection between Emmis, APD Damien Young, and MCA rapper Shade Sheist. Young produced Sheist's current project on the Baby Ree imprint, in which Emmis has an interest. While VP of programming Jimmy Steal emphasizes that Young had actually been on the air even before the project was released and

well before the *Times* article to talk about his connection to Sheist, the station has now started running spots for the album that feature the language, "Baby Ree is a division of Emmis Radio, and Shade Sheist is a Baby Ree artist." The ads are heard in regular stopsets and are run-of-schedule, meaning that they aren't heard a set number of times. This week, Steal reports, Sheist's "Wake Up" is No. 3 in callout and No. 1 with PIs.

WJLB 'FINDS ITSELF' IN EMINEM FILM

When Eminem's major-film debut *8 Mile* opens this weekend, you'll see both WJLB Detroit and night jock Bushman represented. *The Detroit Free-Press* says the film's portrayal of airplay on WJLB as the holy grail for local rappers goes back to the result of a seven-year relationship between Eminem and the station that began when the then-unknown rapper really did come to Bushman looking for airplay. A similar quest for airplay on WQHT (Hot 97) New York figures in to the new hip-hop-themed film *Brown Sugar*.

At adult R&B sister WMXD, PD Janet G. exits. Night jock O'Neil is interim PD, while WJLB PD K.J. Holiday will oversee programming of both stations.

PROGRAMMING: CC NAMES ANOTHER VP

Clear Channel/Charleston, S.C., OM Jon Robbins is upped to regional VP of programming. Robbins oversaw WSSP (the Beat) and was PD of top 40 AC WABC.

WTMP-AM-FM Tampa, Fla., PD Brian Castle exits, as does consultant Harry Lyles. Interim PD is morning man Bobby Holiday.

Longtime country outlet KIKK Houston flips to smooth jazz as "the Wave."

PEOPLE: WELCOME TO ATLANTA

Producer/artist Jermaine Dupri crosses over to radio as the host of his own weekly Saturday-night show, *So So Def Radio*, on WVEE (V103) Atlanta. The one-hour show will air at 9 p.m.

WQHT (Hot 97) New York fills its long-vacant MD position with KXJM Portland, Ore., morning man Ibrahim "E-Bro" Jamile Darden.

Former WQHT morning co-host missjones will be the anchor of the new morning show on WPHI Philadelphia. She replaces former PD Anthony "Luscious Ice" Harris. Morning co-host Kim Kane moves to middays, while new WPHI PD Colby Colb will handle afternoons, replacing Papi, who exits. Michael Shawn remains in nights,

Three-Month Reign Comes To An Endz

After three months atop the adult R&B chart with "Someone to Love You" (Epic), Ruff Endz loses the No. 1 position to Gerald Levert's "Funny" (Elektra/EEG), despite increasing in spins. The duo's 12-week run atop that chart is the longest span so far this year, beating out Luther Vandross' "I'd Rather" and its nine weeks. "Someone to Love You" is tied with Barry White's "Practice What You Preach" for the sixth-longest run on top. It is the first No. 1 for Levert in the Nielsen BDS era, although he made it as close as No. 2 five other times, with "Answering Service," "Already Missing You," "Thinkin' Bout It," "Mr. Too Damn Good," and most recently "Made to Love Ya." Elektra and Missy "Misdemeanor" Elliott also reclaim the No. 1 spot on the R&B/hip-hop chart, as LL Cool J's "Luv U Better" (Def Jam/IDJMG) gains spins but falls to No. 2.

ArtistDirect charts its first single on the R&B/hip-hop chart with "Tell Me (What's Goin' On)" by Smilez & Southstar. ArtistDirect has had three songs on *R&B Airplay Monitor's* rap chart: "Ballin' Boy" by No Good, followed by Smilez & Southstar's first single, "Who Wants This?," and "Tell Me," up 23-20 this issue.

A NEWLY FORMED coalition of friends, fans, and supporters has come together to support the family of the late Jam Master Jay, né Jason Mizell, of Run-D.M.C. Reverend Joseph "Run" Simmons and Darryl "D.M.C." McDaniels, along with Mayor Michael Bloomberg, the New York City Police Department, acts Jay-Z, Aerosmith, Kid Rock, Ja Rule, Ashanti, and Irv Gotti, Def Jam co-founder and chairman of the Hip-Hop Summit Action Network Russell Simmons, Island Def Jam chairman/CEO Lyor Cohen, and Def Jam president Kevin Liles, have already pledged contributions to a fund in support of the Mizell family—to provide for its home mortgage and education costs for Mizell's three children—and the criminal investigation. Separately, the coalition confirmed that \$50,000 has already been earmarked as a reward for the arrest and conviction of those responsible for Mizell's death. In lieu of flowers, the family has asked for donations to the Mizell Children's Fund, c/o Terri Corley-Mizell, Box 3497, New Hyde Park, N.Y., 11040.

Recently arrived morning man Big Moon now adds MD stripes at WKPO (Hot 105.9) Madison, Wis.

Look for rhythmic top 40 KUBE Seattle to promote Karen Wild from music coordinator to MD by the time you read this. She replaces Julie Pilat, now winging her way down to KIIS Los Angeles.

K.J. Carson is named promotions director for adult R&B KMJK Kansas City. He was last morning anchor at crosstown KPRS.

WJMZ (107.3 Jamz) Greenville, S.C., loses middayer A.J. Glover. PD Doug Davis is accepting T&Rs.

KSFM Sacramento, Calif., morning sidekick Ms. Freska exits.

Rhythmic top 40 KDON Monterey, Calif., p.m. driver Chubby Lopez exits. MD/late-nighter Alex the Boy Wonder moves to afternoons until a replacement is found.

SMOOTH FOR A GOOD CAUSE

Jazz WQCD (CD 101.9) New York has released a charity compilation CD, *New York's Smooth Jazz, Volume 1*, to benefit the station's Brian Marks Scholarship Fund. Marks was director of music and marketing for Emmis/New York until his death earlier this year. The foundation raises funds for various area charities supporting the education of young people who want to be in the music industry.

HOME OFFICE NOW SUPPLYING MORE THAN TOP 10 LIST

On Nov. 11, 15 Infinity stations will begin simulcasting sister CBS-TV's *Late Show With David Letterman*. While some of the stations with which Letterman is making his return to radio are N/T outlets, including WNEW New York, they also include top 40, adult top 40, and rock stations.

"I grew up listening to radio in Washington, D.C.," says Lamar "LBD" Robinson, APD/MD/afternoon host at WBOT Boston. "Stations like WKYS, WHUR, and WPGC." Now that he has been in radio for almost eight years, he says, "I still love radio, but I don't think there is as much passion about the music as I thought there would be." He adds that "growing up, my family and I would go on road trips to the Carolinas or Georgia, and all along the way we would listen to the different radio stations, and they would actually be different, playing some songs I had never heard before."

Brian Paiz, APD/MD/night host at WMNX Wilmington, N.C., says radio has become "more like a factory, like building a car." Paiz, a native of Salisbury, N.C., has been in radio for four years and grew up listening to "[WJMH] 102 Jamz in Greensboro and [WPEG] Power 98 in Charlotte. Once I finally got a job there, we had three to four owners in under two years. Most of my generation in radio has experienced this kind of scenario, so we are more adaptable to it. But we also look at how we will move up in the industry differently. For me, it makes more sense to try and stay with one company and move up through the ranks."

AN UPHILL BATTLE

As aspiring PDs formulate their own ideas about radio, it's interesting to see how they hope to borrow from radio of the past but still take a contemporary approach. Unfortunately, many feel they face an uphill battle because of the choices being made by today's research-driven, cost-efficient corporations.

Knight observes, "I don't think the younger generation listens to radio the way they used to. I think it's more a background noise for kids. You can cut off the radio for a couple of hours, knowing that when you turn it back on, you haven't missed anything. I remember radio being more compelling. You didn't want to miss anything the jock said or might play. Now you can pretty much expect that this hour you'll hear Ja Rule and you'll hear it two hours from now."

Knight believes "spontaneity is what gets listeners excited. That's why when a new station signs on, so many people go over to check it out. But then after the freshness wears off, they find that the new station is just playing the same records as the old station was."

He continues, "I also think local artists have been lost in the shuffle. I don't believe that being community-oriented is relegated to doing just charity events. I think radio's role should also be about supporting the local music scene. That's part of what keeps you in the streets."

Robinson feels more younger listeners may be "tuning out radio because it's less about personality and making a real personal connection with the listener. Look at how many stations use voice-tracking. I don't think those jocks are bad; in fact, they are quite good. But how can they connect with the listeners in Boston if they're based in Los Angeles? They can't go out in the neighborhoods or be at the clubs. I came up listening to Donnie Simpson, knowing that every weekend I could see him at some community event happening."

Brazier's ultimate goal is to do mornings one day. "[But] for my generation, it has to be to aspire to be a syndicated morning person, because that may be the only opportunity available for me in the future." He also says he only sees "things getting more budget-conscious and tighter. If you can't handle doing more than one market, especially at a company like Clear Channel, you may not have the opportunity to move up. So that discourages new jocks [from getting] into the business."

One of the biggest challenges Paiz sees facing future programmers in hip-hop and R&B is competition. "Now you have all these rhythmic top 40 stations playing almost all hip-hop, and even the top 40 mainstreams will play Cam'ron, even during middays. The days of having a 15 share in your market are basically over, because we share too much of our music with other formats. As programmers, we're going to have to figure out how to handle that."

MONITOR PROFILE

92Q Uses A Squeeze To Once Again Please Its Adult R&B Audience

Like many heritage mainstream R&B outlets that came to prominence in the early '80s, WQQK (92Q) Nashville was designed to be all things to all demos. And it did very well that way for many years, leading the market in the 12-plus, 18-34, and 25-54 demos. But like many other heritage stations before it, when WQQK faced a more younger-targeted, hip-hop-focused competitor, its numbers were cut almost in half—from a 9.2 in summer 2001, before Clear Channel-owned WUBT (the Beat) signed on, to a low of 5.2 in spring.

Instead of going head to head with the Beat on WQQK, parent Cumulus Media decided to squeeze the new station by flipping sister WNPL to hip-hop as Blazin' 106.7 in June. Then WQQK gradually segued to a more adult stance. In the recently released Arbitron summer ratings, WQQK rose to a 5.3 and WNPL grew 2.0-2.9, while WUBT dropped 7.4-5.0.

PD Derrick "D.C." Corbett joined WQQK in August, as the station began its evolution into adult R&B. "The initial changeover was more gradual," he says, "to kind of put the spotlight on WNPL as the new player in town."

As the changes started to take place, Corbett says, "the first thing we had to do was to make sure we had the right music in place on 92Q. After looking at the research, we felt there was a lot of room to grow in terms of the gold. We expanded the library by 400 titles"—although, he adds, "we are still a current-driven radio station."

"In terms of currents, we scaled down our categories to five power records, seven medium-rotation songs, and six records in the new category," Corbett continues. "[In terms of sharing artists], WNPL is playing very little R&B, so we don't share a lot, anyway. They do play [songs like] 'Stingy' by Ginuwine or the Floetry record, but usually only after they've had a certain amount of requests and demand for the R&B tracks."

What about hip-hop or younger-ended R&B on 92Q? Corbett says, "I don't have a problem putting on, say, the new record from Dru Hill, because they are a core gold artist for us, and the new track is good. In regular rotation, we don't play the new Floetry, but we might play one of their album cuts, like 'Miss Stressed' or 'Say Yes,' on our neo-soul show that airs on Sunday nights. The show is locally based, from 9 p.m. to midnight. The first hour is a neo-soul mix, done by mixers Stacy Blackmon and DJ G Spot. After the mix, you hear a variety of artists, like D.J. Rodgers Jr., India.Arie, the new Glenn Lewis & Amel Larrieux—"What's Come Over Me?"—Mike Phillips, or this new group Kindred on Hidden Beach. We'll also spotlight local artists that fit into the R&B/neo-soul genre. It's kind of an extension of our weeknight Quiet Storm show, only a little more progressive and current-driven."

BRING THE OLD SCHOOL BACK

How will these future PDs change radio? While they know the bottom line will always be about being profitable, they hope they can bring back some of the "old-school" ways.

Knight says, "I understand the financial reasons behind voice-tracking, but I'd like my generation to bring it back to being local and being about personality. My generation is about being the individual, standing out in a crowd, and being a star. Hell, just look at the egos in our business. That can work to your advantage sometimes. Just look at an icon like Puffy. We look at him and say, 'If he can do it, so can I.' But with things like voice-tracking and syndication, all you get is the same—at every station across the country."

Knight adds that he hopes more jocks will go through the process of paying their dues. "I've worked in small markets, learned the ropes on-air, in promotion, production, etc. But today, so many jocks now get their start in a major market.

Corbett also "expanded the Quiet Storm category in the music library. Before, there might have been 35-40 gold records exclusive to the Quiet Storm; now, there are almost 150. I want the show to sound unique and different from the rest of the station. I don't want it to just be all the current slow jams, yet we do still play the current hit ballads during the show."

He also relies more heavily on deep cuts for the Quiet Storm. "Instead of only hearing Teddy Pendergrass' 'Turn Off the Lights,' you'll also hear 'The Whole Town's Laughing at Me' or the Average White Band's 'A Love of Your Own' and the Whispers' 'Say Yes.'" Corbett adds that the Quiet Storm category is freshened every three to four months "so that you're not hearing the same record over and over, making them lose that sentimental appeal."

As the host of the Quiet Storm (Corbett voice-tracks the show during the day), he says, "I feel closest to this style of music—it's like coming home for me. It's the format I got my start in." Corbett was hired by Michael Saunders at WPEG Charlotte, N.C., to host that station's Quiet Storm from 1993 to 1997, after spending his first year in radio at WQMG Greensboro, N.C. In '97, he moved over

to WPEG sister WBAV when that station went adult R&B under PD Andre Carson. Corbett remained at WBAV until he took his first programming job at adult R&B WVKL Norfolk, Va., in December 2001.

With WQQK's transition to adult R&B, the decision was made to move the Quiet Storm's start time up, from 10 p.m. to 7 p.m. Corbett says, "It just further set us apart from the rest of the market." And luckily, he adds, "the majority of the staff was able to stay in place on WQQK."

"We had Yolanda Nealy in middays, who has been doing radio for 20 years. She has worked at major stations like WHQT Miami, and she fits right in the demo," Corbett continues. "Our afternoon jock, Derrick Mason, is more of a hip-hop cat in musical taste, but he's good for us in afternoons, because he keeps us from sounding sleepy—he has so much energy."

As one of the early affiliates of ABC's syndicated Tom Joyner morning show, WQQK already had a very strong adult morning show in place. "Tom has been on WQQK and leading this market for years," Corbett says. "He fit right into what we wanted the station to evolve into. It was more of the station changing to fit what he was doing."

Corbett adds that while the programming side of WQQK is now all in line with the adult listener, it has been a little more of a challenge getting the sales side in line on the new product. "We are not the old WQQK, and while the salespeople understand that, some of the advertisers may not be as aware. We have to sell them a whole new image, new events—events that are at the next level. We can't necessarily go back to the same old clubs we used to go to, because our listeners are older and a little more upscale."

Some of those events include "the Tom Joyner Sky Show, which we are setting up for next March," Corbett says. "Then we have our annual Come Together Day, in either April or May. This is our big family day that we have every year, and we plan to add more of a gospel element [next] year." The other big annual event that WQQK had in the past was Slamma Jamma, which WNPL will now take on as its own.

"The first event we are doing is our recurring 92Q Old School Party, every Friday night after work. We're also planning the Up Close and Personal events that will happen once a month... We hope to make it a whole night of music. First, a local band would perform, then we would like to have a national act do a track date—artists like Jaheim, Heather Headley, or Dave Hollister. Then, after that, we'll have a DJ spin to really kick up the party. I really want to make these events something the listener feels comfortable at. When a listener comes out to a 92Q event, they can expect it to be classy, and they will be partying with folks their own age." **DANA HALL**

While I don't want to hate on them for that, it can also be a disadvantage, because then you have people in those big markets who may not know as much about radio."

Brazier wants to hear more hip-hop and R&B personalities "pushing the envelope and maybe crossing the line. We as black folks get so sensitive whenever anything a little risqué or controversial is said on-air. But why not? Isn't that how you start people talking about important issues? And isn't that how you get more listeners to tune in? Maybe we should try to have more people of other [races] listening to us, to hear what we are talking about and our concerns."

He adds, "The biggest thing I hear from people who listen to the radio is they want more variety in the music. I know about research, and I understand you have to play the hits, but please... repetition will be the death of radio for my generation. Of course you have to play Jay-Z and Ja Rule—but what about Mos Def, Common, or

the Roots? Everyone complains about the violence and misogyny in rap, yet they never play the positive rap. Because these acts don't get played on the radio, our listeners have to go to the Internet or satellite radio to hear them instead."

On the business side, Paiz would like to "change the indie system. It just doesn't seem right, and sometimes it can make it difficult for a programmer to do what is best for their market musically. I came up through the mix shows and always felt that was the best place to find your next hit. But if a company has a list you have to follow, and your big mix-show hit isn't on that list, then your listeners are the ones missing out."

Robinson says he would like to bring more "creativity back to radio. When radio was less corporate-driven, I think there was more creativity flowing. The bottom line is still to make money, but when the drive to make more money gets in your way of actually accomplishing that, then we have a major problem."
