PDs Say Radio's Next Generation Is MIA Because Pizza Hut Pays More

"Where the hell do I find a decent part-timer or intern?" That question is being asked by PDs in all formats these days. They are concerned with a general shortage of upcoming air talent and an overall lack of commitment on the part of prospective part-timers and college interns.

Joe Dawson, PD of top 40/rhythm WVKX (Kix 106) Providence, R.I., sparked debate on this subject recently in an America Online posting. When Dawson programmed KLYV Dubuque, Iowa, he says, there was almost no student interest in part-time work, let alone unpaid internships.

"Through outreach programs, we tried to recruit students, and their first question was always, 'How much does it pay?'" says Dawson.

That question speaks volumes about a potential candidate. "When your small-market station is paying \$5 an hour, they cease to be interested, because Pizza Hut pays \$7," he

adds. "It becomes obvious that the student is just looking for a job and not the opportunity to build a career."

Now that Dawson is in a top 30 market, he is gratified to have a larger pool of interns. "Although we have four top 40s and a large college population, we still run across those \$7-an-hour people," says Dawson, who adds that while there are "those who tell you they love your station and are willing to do anything," others who claim they're interested will lay down ground rules: They can't work weekends, overnights, or Fridays; they can only work days because they work nights making \$8 an hour, etc.

"Finding good part-timers and interns is the hardest job a PD has to deal with," says KLUZ Las Vegas PD Jerry Dean. Like Dawson, he says, "The first question is always, 'How much does it pay?'"

Many colleges offering radio and TV courses usually find students leaning toward the higher-profile

ARS, Henry Merge; Sebastian Exits Rock

American Radio Systems and Henry Broadcasting have announced plans to merge, giving Boston-based ARS nine stations, including mainstream/modern combo **KUFO/KBBT** Portland, Ore. No format changes are planned at the new acquisitions, says ARS' **Bruce Danziger**, who wants "to help them grow." ARS owns 24 stations, including mainstream **WCMF** Rochester, N.Y., and **WTUE** Dayton, Ohio. The company is in a JSA with modern **WNVE** (the Nerve) Rochester and is acting on options to buy moderns **WXEG** (the Edge) Dayton and **WPBZ** West Palm Beach, Fla.

WHYT (the Planet) Detroit PD **Garret Michaels** says **WHYT** will debut "a new planetary lineup" April 1 and stay modern but be more hit-driven. Out are **Vertical**, **Man At Large**, **Mikey Mike**, **Jade**, and **Greg St. James**. P.m. driver **Dave Fogel** and APD/MD **Alex Tear** stay on.

Modern **XHRM** (the Flash) San Diego PD/middayer **Kelli Kluque** exits; **OM Bryan Jones** assumes programming duties. Night jock **Kristi Knight** takes middays; P/T **Robert O'Quinn** fills the evening shift. Look for the station to take a more musically aggressive posture.

Classic rock **KSLX** Phoenix PD **John Sebastian** becomes PD of country **KZLA** Los Angeles.

AC **CKDX** (the Phoenix) Toronto has evolved into rock AC as "the X." PD **Gary Gamble** says the station will be similar to '80s-driven ACs, such as **KYSR** (Star 98.5) Los Angeles.

L.A.'s R&B/sports **KMAX** has begun two weeks of stunting in preparation for what is expected to be a switch to rock under new owner **Odyssey Broadcasting**. Same goes for simulcast partners in **Oxnard, Calif.**, and suburban **San Diego**.

Country **KHIT** Reno, Nev., flips to mainstream rock as "Rock 104.5" under new PD/morning man/market vet **Steve Funk**, formerly PD of crosstown **KZAK**. Current PD **Rob Williams** becomes OM/p.m. driver. **Tony Shavietello** from sister **KLPX** Tucson, Ariz., is now GM for both **KHIT** and classic rock duopoly sister **KOZZ**.

KEZE, the former call letters of adult modern **KAEP** (the Peak) Spokane, Wash., return to the market on **Rook Broadcasting's** new 96.9 FM.

The new **KEZE** carries ABC's classic rock format 24 hours a day with no plans to hire a local air staff. Religious **KSPO**, which had been on 96.9, has moved to owner **Read Broadcasting's** 106.5 signal, which had been running easy listening.

CKIK Calgary, Alberta, segues from classic rock to an '80s- and '90s-based mainstream approach as "Rock 107." **Roger Rhodes** from crosstown **CJAY** and **Spyder O'Neil** from crosstown modern rock **CFCN** are the new morning team. They replace **Paul Boucher**, who goes to middays, and **Tim Kilpatrick**, who will do morning sports, as well as teaming with **CILQ** (Q107) Toronto's **Carter Brown** in afternoons.

Benchmark's top 40 **WOSC** (Coast 95.9) Ocean City, Md., finishes its segue to modern rock, going against **WRXS**. **Bob Maxwell** remains PD. Elsewhere in the market, album **WZBH** picks up the syndicated **John Boy** and **Billy** morning show, replacing **Joker** and **Ace**.

WLLR/KCQQ Davenport, Iowa, GM **Larry Rosmilso** is now overseeing six other stations, including top 40 **WHTS** and oldies **KUUL**, as part of a now-closed deal that puts **Sconnix's** Mississippi Valley Broadcasting in ownership of six stations and in JSAs with two others.

Modern **WGRD** Grand Rapids, Mich., adds local band member **Andy Holtgrieve** to its air staff.

At **KYSR**, **Mark Goodman** (ex-MTV) and **Shirley the Stungirl** (from **KIOI** San Francisco) are now official in mornings; former morning-show fill-in **Gary Thompson** moves to middays, replacing **Paul Freeman**.

Modern **KEGE** (the Edge) Minneapolis ups late-nighter **Peter Johns** to promotion director, replacing **Scott Leif**.

Modern **WMMS** Cleveland names sales promotion manager **Susan Kay** as promotion manager, replacing **Heidi Kramer**, now promotions director at mainstream **WRIF** Detroit.

Mainstream **KRCH** Rochester, Minn., has a new lineup: PD **Jack Hicks** adds a.m. drive duties, and P/T **Sue Moore** joins as co-host; night jock **Stu Reed** adds APD stripes and moves to p.m. drive; overnighter **Jim Martin** moves to evenings with P/T **Nate Porter** on the all-night show.

Other additions to the Zoo team are **Jeff Dodes** as senior director/marketing and A&R, **H.M. Wollman** as manager/marketing and artist development, **Michael Rich** as marketing/A&R representative, and **Stephanie Pensyl** as Midwest regional promotion manager.

Roadrunner Records taps **Sean Knight** to handle modern rock and triple-A promotion duties. Knight was previously at **Immortal Records** and is slated to start April 8.

Look for onetime **WKDF** Nashville MD **John Nagarya** to segue to **Geffen** sometime in April as Dallas local promotion rep. **Nagarya** had been **Virgin's** Denver rep.

If you've noticed a change in the name of this column, it's because some folks have suggested that we shouldn't refer to our record brethren as weasels. Shocking Jocks Push Limits of Good Taste

The recent antics of **WFAN** New York's **Don Imus** and **KBPI** Denver's morning show raise serious questions about the line between satire and disrespect.

Imus, speaking at the annual **Radio and Television Correspondent's** dinner in Washington, D.C., made several off-color remarks about **President Clinton** and the first lady. That's nothing new for the seminal shock jock who cracks about **Clinton** on his morning show, except this time the president was there in person.

KBPI's morning show elected to send a staffer and a listener into a **Denver mosque**, where **Mahmoud Abdul-Rauf** of the **Denver Nuggets** worships. **Abdul-Rauf** recently was the focus of national attention when he refused to stand for the national anthem before **NBA** games, citing his religious beliefs. The staffer and listener attempted to play the national anthem in the mosque and later tried to put headphones on one person, allegedly to interview him on air. Staffers involved were put on unpaid leave by **KBPI**.

What both parties seemed to forget is that there is a difference between real life and being on the radio. While **Imus'** situation is just a matter of tastelessness, the **KBPI** morning show incident was far more hateful and potentially destructive.

The fact that **Abdul-Rauf** refused to stand for the national anthem because of his religion was criticized by many Islamic scholars. Therefore,

Abdul-Rauf alone was responsible for his choice. To disrupt religious services and penalize innocent bystanders because of the actions of one person is the ultimate act of disrespect.

When **Sandy Koufax** of the **Los Angeles Dodgers** refused to pitch in the **World Series** 30 years ago on **Yom Kippur**, did a wacky morning show burst into a synagogue singing "Take Me Out To The Ballgame?" And let's face it, this whole controversy revolves around basketball. If basketball were to stop tomorrow and never be played again, it's doubtful that the history of the world would change. However, if Americans were not free to worship without fear of ridicule, we all will be in big trouble.

Hearing about the two recent incidents made most of us cringe. While **Imus** just ended up looking lame, the **KBPI** incident has implications that reach far beyond goofy radio stunts. Political satire among adults is perfectly all right. **Imus** has every right to jab the president, **Bob Dole**, **Newt Gingrich**, or anyone else. The line he stepped over was the "don't do it to their face" rule. That's a far smaller infraction than the "religious persecution is wrong" rule.

Also re-added to the mainstream rock panel, after an absence due to technical difficulties, is WONE Akron, Ohio. There are now 102 mainstream rock reporters.

Upright (Everything's Alright) With Bonham

Tracy Bonham's demo tape was so good that it inspired Island's A&R people to drive to Boston to see her perform the day they received it. She was offered a contract that night.

Listening to Bonham's brash, pop-inflected music, it may come as a surprise to hear that she only recently began listening to rock. A violin student since the age of 9, Bonham earned a full music scholarship to the University of Southern California to study violin, then transferred to Boston's Berklee School of Music to concentrate on singing.

Living in Boston exposed Bonham to the vibrant independent rock scene, and she wound up settling in the city. To support herself there, she sang jingles for car companies and took other music-related jobs.



Around 1992, Bonham began listening more to the Buzzcocks and the Pixies than Debussy and Ravel. Bonham picked up the guitar but didn't give up violin, which she plays on the album and as part of her live performances. To perform her songs in clubs, Bonham enlisted various local musicians to back her. Some of her earliest live dates were performed as a trio.

An EP, "The Liverpool Sessions," was released on Cherrydisc in 1994. Recent dates have included stints with Spacelag, the Rentals, and Loud Lucy; a club tour begins in April. Her major-label debut, "The Burdens Of Being Upright," recorded last year at Fort Apache, was released March 19.

Maggie May Howl For Ex-Mobster

Harold Chichester is embarking on a new phase of his career. Once the bass player for Columbus, Ohio's Royal Crescent Mob (which released six albums), Chichester has a new band, Howlin' Maggie, which will release its debut set, "Honeysuckle Strange," April 9. Royal Crescent Mob achieved notoriety with its funk-rock blend, but Chichester began to sense the band's lessened commitment in spring '93. He decided to refocus musically and start writing songs for a new band.

Songwriting brought a change in instrument for Chichester, who switched to guitar. In 1994, Howlin' Maggie's lineup was solidified when some of Chichester's old friends came aboard.



In the early '80s, Chichester, nicknamed "Happy," developed a rapport with Jerome Dillon, a young music fan, while working at Dillon's father's steakhouse. About the same time, bassist Jim Rico became Chichester's jamming partner at Ohio University. Rico and Chichester played guitar and listened to music during all-nighters. After the old friends reunited to form Howlin' Maggie, guitarist Andy Harrison dropped by to add some guitar to a demo tape and wound up joining the band.

Three "Honeysuckle Strange" cuts, including "Alcohol," were first recorded by Howlin' Maggie as demos in Columbus. The rest of the set was recorded in North Carolina. Before this album, the band contributed a track, "Easy To Be Stupid," to the "Beautiful Girls" soundtrack, which was co-produced by Afghan Whigs vocalist Greg Dulli. Chichester played keyboards on the Cincinnati-based Whigs' latest album. A video for "Easy To Be Stupid" was shot by Larry Carroll, art director for Sam Beyer, who made Verve Pipe's "Photograph" video. Tour dates begin April 30.

Releases And Notes

This month's Oasis shows in the Northeast weren't without incident. In Providence, R.I., guitarist Noel Gallagher was hit by a shoe during the solo acoustic portion of the show as he sang the first verse of "Wonderwall." He abruptly left the stage, prompting brother Liam to berate the crowd. Liam then announced the rest of the set list, which he told the audience Oasis wouldn't be playing, then played "I Am The Walrus" before exiting. In New York, Richard Ashcroft, former lead singer of the Verve, opened the Oasis show with a surprise acoustic set. The headliners then played a full show without incident.

Reportedly, after seeing the Rolling Stones' "Gimme Shelter" film, DIR Broadcasting's Bob Meyrowitz came up with the idea of bringing live concerts to the consumer via radio broadcast. Hence the debut of "King Biscuit Flower Hour" Feb. 18, 1973, with a triple bill of Mahavishnu Orchestra; Blood, Sweat & Tears; and a young unknown, Bruce Springsteen. Featuring 24-track recordings mixed by the day's top engineers, the weekly series quickly grew from 44 stations at the end of '73 to between 250 and 300 stations during its peak years, 1975-85. Some of the more than 700 concerts taped are being made available for the first time through the King Biscuit Flower Hour label, which is distributed by BMG. The first 12 albums include 10CC from 1975, Kingfish featuring Bob Weir from 1976, Deep Purple from 1976, and the Fixx from 1982. The label hopes to release 24 concerts a year.

"Queensryche's Promised Land" was just released by EMI as a two-disc spinoff from its 1994 platinum album. The CD-ROM includes two discs, a "Promised Land" game disc and "Big Log," which explores the log-cabin studio in which the band lived and worked during the recording session of "Promised Land." The band wrote and performed the ambient soundtrack for the CD-ROM.

The speculation on the Kiss tour is that it will run from summer to fall and be international in scope. It's not expected that the band will include any "unplugged" performances, despite the band's recent MTV appearance and new album... The Love & Rockets tour is underway and will hit 21 cities in 30 days... Metallica has been at Right Track Studios in New York mixing its new album, which will be called "Load." The release date for the set, the band's first since 1991's "Metallica," is June 4. The band is scheduled to headline this year's Lollapalooza show. Other acts confirmed are Soundgarden, Rancid, and the Ramones.

PDs Say Radio's Next Generation Is MIA Because Pizza Hut Pays More

TV world, which carries a larger show-biz factor and the promise of a bigger paycheck. "Radio doesn't get the respect in college that TV does," says Dean. "If you want to be a performer on local TV, your options are limited to anchorperson, weather, or sports. I feel radio offers many more creative outlets than TV."

SUPPORT STAFF SPARKLES MORE?

Being in a college town helps R&B adult WILD Boston find interns, but APD/MD Dana Hall agrees that young people don't have the desire to commit to radio. "We get a few really good interns, but most of them lose interest. They don't have the commitment," says Hall. "We get lots of people from Boston University and Northeastern. Then there's Northeast Broadcast school. But those people want to do production and promotion, not on-air. I haven't had an intern in music programming for about a year."

That may surprise PDs who remember when many aspiring broadcasters wanted to work only on-air. Now, Chris Baker, OM/PD of album rock KATT Oklahoma City, sees more interns interested in nonmusic areas. "I'm surprised by the number of them who want to go into sales or a different part of the job, not programming."

THE GLAMOUR BOYS

Top 40 KKRZ (Z100) Portland, Ore., PD Ken Benson says, "The trick is finding talented, committed people with a good work ethic. I see a lot of potential interns who are looking for glamour and don't want to put in the time to pay their dues."

"What I've found . . . is that interns don't seem to be as serious as they used to be," confirms Monica Starr, PD of hip-hop WEJM (106 Jams) Chicago. "You get a good candidate and find out all they want to do is hang out with the stars."

Doug Clifton, PD of adult modern KXPK (the Peak) Denver, agrees with Benson and Starr that getting warm bodies isn't the problem. "Once they get here, they find the job could be a little mundane," he says. "It sounds pretty glamorous to be an intern at a radio station, but if there's not a true interest in getting into broadcasting, you find that after their internship, they're pretty bored and aren't showing up much."

Early in his career, KKRZ's Benson worked summers at album rock WBAB Long Island, N.Y., which had an extensive internship program. He estimates that WBAB had about 25 applicants for intern positions at any time, giving the station the luxury of a large talent pool and a rigorous prescreening and selection process.

KKRZ carries no interns in the programming department but places them in promotions for college credit. Compared to his days at WBAB, Benson says, "It's amazing how many stations have to be proactive and actually go to the schools and beat the bushes for interns."

INTERNS WHO HATE YOUR FORMAT

WILD's Hall often speaks to students at her alma mater, Emerson College, and finds attitudes toward commercial radio discouraging. "The kids want to come out and change everything and be about what they're doing," she says. "I tell them [they] can't go out there and say, 'Commercial radio sucks!' You've got to get in the door and learn from these people. It's very different from college radio—different goals, different arena. Honestly, I don't know where the next generation of radio people is going to come from."

The good news for frustrated programmers is that "for every 10 interns . . . there might be one who has a true interest in broadcasting and will devote time to help in any area that they can," says KXPK's Clifton. And that one good intern can be like the Energizer Bunny, says Vycki Buchanon, PD of R&B WTLC Indianapolis. "They stay and stay," she says, not-

ing that a former intern worked her way up to be WTLC MD.

At mainstream rocker KISW Seattle, PD Steve Young says, "One [former intern] is doing overnights and another is producing the morning show." At KAIT, where interns are rotated through all departments, OM/PD Baker says the promotion director was an intern three years ago.

According to Randy Scovil, PD of album rock WXRA Greensboro, N.C., candidates who say, "I really like radio, but I'm not sure [in what area]," are the best, as they're willing to try any task.

CARE AND FEEDING OF INTERNS

The key to having good interns is motivating them, say most PDs. "Once you find someone who has potential, it's important to make them feel a part of the station," KLUC's Dean says. "Invite them to staff and promotion meetings, station events and parties, [and] get 'em the same station clothing the full-timers have."

KATT's Baker says, "I have my own requirements. I make sure [their credit] hours are spent inside the station. I make them put a paper together for me at the end of the semester telling me what they've learned [and their] likes and dislikes of the job. It helps me, too."

Most stations express a preference for college interns who are working for credit. KISW's Young sees a steady stream of interns through arrangements with several local colleges. Because "they get graded on it," interns usually give the station a "pretty good effort," says Young.

The best interns are those with a love for radio. "A couple of guys interning for us now . . . have the bug and the desire [for radio]," says Baker. "Those are the guys who are here not only during their hours, but late at night, hanging out in the production room or coming to promotions and being active and involved in the station."

CARE AND FEEDING OF PART-TIMERS

When hiring part-time help, KLUC's Dean advises, one should ideally try to find someone good enough to be a full-timer. But, says WTLC's Buchanon, most experienced jocks who may be out of work won't relocate for two shifts a week. And the lower pay and inexperienced people keep the pool of good part-timers small, say PDs.

"Part-time—it's hard," says Buchanon. "Everybody wants to get in radio, yet they have no experience. It's hard for your club jocks to get the mentality, because it's not 'Hey! Ho! Throw your hands up in the air!' It's serious, and you have to be a serious communicator. Often you need a part-timer real quick, so you have to train someone, and who has the time?"

The faster pace of life for today's duopolized PD might be a factor in the failure to cultivate talent. "A lot of us are too pressed for time to develop an adequate talent program," Dean says. "We have to remember that we got help along the way in our careers, and it's more important than ever for us to make time for the next generation."

WHEN I WAS YOUR AGE . . .

At the risk of sounding like his parents, KKRZ's Benson offers an old radio war story: "When I started out, I did anything it took, worked any shift, commuted any distance. I was afraid to screw up, because I wanted to succeed."

When Benson attended college in Plattsburgh, N.Y., he took the ferry across Lake Champlain to Burlington, Vt., to work part time at WXXX. "If I missed the ferry, it was a two-hour drive around the lake," he says.

"Maybe people are brought up differently today," says KLUC's Dean, whose first unpaid on-air job was at the University of Iowa's KICR. "Even though it was minus 20 degrees outside, and the shift was 4 to 6 a.m., I jumped at the chance," he says.

ROCK GODZ

Secret PD Romano Responds To Challenge Of Modern Warfare In Steel City

Gene Romano, OM/PD of Secret Communications' WDVE Pittsburgh and duopoly partner WXDX (the X), had one of the most stable situations in rock radio since his arrival at WDVE in 1988. But late last year, suburban modern rocker WWKX made inroads in the Steel City, and shortly thereafter, Entercom's crosstown country outlet flipped to modern, becoming WNRQ (the Revolution). WDVE was quick to respond by buying WWKX and changing its calls to WXDX.

The Revolution debuted in the fall '95 book with a 3.4 share 12-plus. WDVE dipped 11.0-8.4, and the X fell to 1.6. With the Revolution's superior signal, it looked as if the X would be relegated to the role of WDVE's flanker. However, the addition of Howard Stern to the X and the announcement last month that the sta-

tion would flip to the stronger 105.9 frequency of R&B WAMO have upped the stakes in Pittsburgh's modern rock war.

"It's an exciting year for us," Romano says. "The synergy between WDVE and the X is going to be very special. It will ultimately enable us to make it difficult [over the] long-term for competitors to infiltrate our rock position."

So far, Romano says, "the X has been severely hampered by [its] signal disadvantage. We had a game plan early on, realizing that the X is going to be able to accomplish a few things [with an inferior signal]. It was going to get us in the game, which meant instead of trying to start from scratch when the other guys had a 5.5 share, and we had a zero, we could start with a 2 share, while the other guys have a 4. That's a big difference."

To further establish WXDX, Romano's team has "aggressively marketed the X for the last six months, enabling us to earn a place in the listener's mind," Romano says. "Clearly, the other guys are the dominant alternative station today in this market. However, in 1996 that's a fragile position. In a market the size of Pittsburgh, a 2-share lead is not very large. The other thing the inferior signal gave us was a delivery system for Howard Stern to get him established in November. Along with Howard, we have a lethal marketing budget that will make things interesting."

And while it might seem that Stern and WDVE morning team Paulsen and Krenn make strange bedfellows, Romano says, "it was a no-brainer decision to put Howard on the X. [He's] going to enable the X to win in this market against a direct alternative competitor. The name of the game in this business is to have the best morning show around. We're able to have under the same roof two pretty extraordinary morning shows."

With the X's format flip, Romano says, some lineup changes will come that "will energize the

personality of the radio station." Combined with Stern and the syndicated "Love Phones," Romano thinks "the X is ready to explode, now that we can be on equal footing [with the Revolution]. As a matter of fact, the frequency will be better [than the Revolution's]."

Here's a sample 1 p.m. hour of WXDX: Green Day, "Longview"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Big Bang Baby"; Spacehog, "In The Meantime"; Live, "I Alone"; Ammonia, "Drugs"; R.E.M., "Orange Crush"; Bush, "Machine Head"; Elastica, "Connection"; Smashing Pumpkins, "Bullet With Butterfly Wings"; Seven Mary Three, "Water's Edge"; Beck, "Loser"; Stabbing Westward, "What Do I Have To Do"; and Offspring, "Come Out And Play."

As for WDVE, Romano says, "what we've seen over the last few years are old heritage mainstream stations making a decision to go one way or another. Stations like WBCN Boston and KLOS Los Angeles and a few others decided to go pure alternative or a more focused 18-34 approach, whereas other mainstream stations—like KQRS Minneapolis, WFBQ Indianapolis, and WDVE—concentrate more as an adult mainstream, continuing to play selective new product, [with] some being more aggressive than others." Romano says WDVE probably plays more new music than most other adult mainstream stations.

Programming to adults is a tightrope act, Romano says. "It is difficult to please the 35-40 cell and the 25-29 cell. Those targets are very different. When you're trying to superserve 35- to 40-year-olds, you need to play the appropriate classic depth. [But] that material will kill you [with] 27-year-olds. It's become increasingly difficult [to serve both demos] as a mainstream radio station."

Here's a sample 3 p.m. hour of WDVE: Tom Petty, "You Wreck Me"; Rolling Stones, "Tumbling Dice"; Everclear, "Santa Monica (Watch The World Die)"; Stevie Ray Vaughan, "Little Sister"; Blues Traveler, "Hook"; Pink Floyd, "Run Like Hell"; Cult, "Fire Woman"; Warren Zevon, "Lawyers, Guns, And Money"; Dishwalla, "Counting Blue Cars"; Led Zepelin, "Babe I'm Gonna Leave You"; and Neil Young, "Downtown."

What about those who, despite a surge in interest in mainstream acts, say mainstream is dead? Romano says, "I believe mainstream is alive and well on two different fronts. One is as an 18-34-focused mainstream that can get into different textured songs and artists than a pure alternative. [The other is] the more adult mainstream that can cherry-pick new songs from what can be considered pure alternative artists. For example, on WDVE the best-testing song last week with upper demos was Everclear's 'Santa Monica.' It's not an alternative song; it's just a good rock song. In our particular case, our upper demos have always expected us to give them different types of new music. It's an important part of our personality."

Will WDVE play less new music once the X gets a full signal? Romano says, "We have cheated, and we have used WDVE offensively and in collusion with the X" to establish new songs and artists, but WDVE will continue to play new music that "feels like it belongs on our radio station. There will be many acts and many songs that we will stay away from that maybe a year ago we would have dealt with. However, new music will continue to be an important part of [WDVE]."

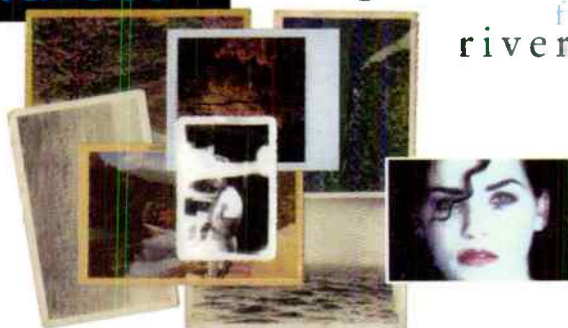

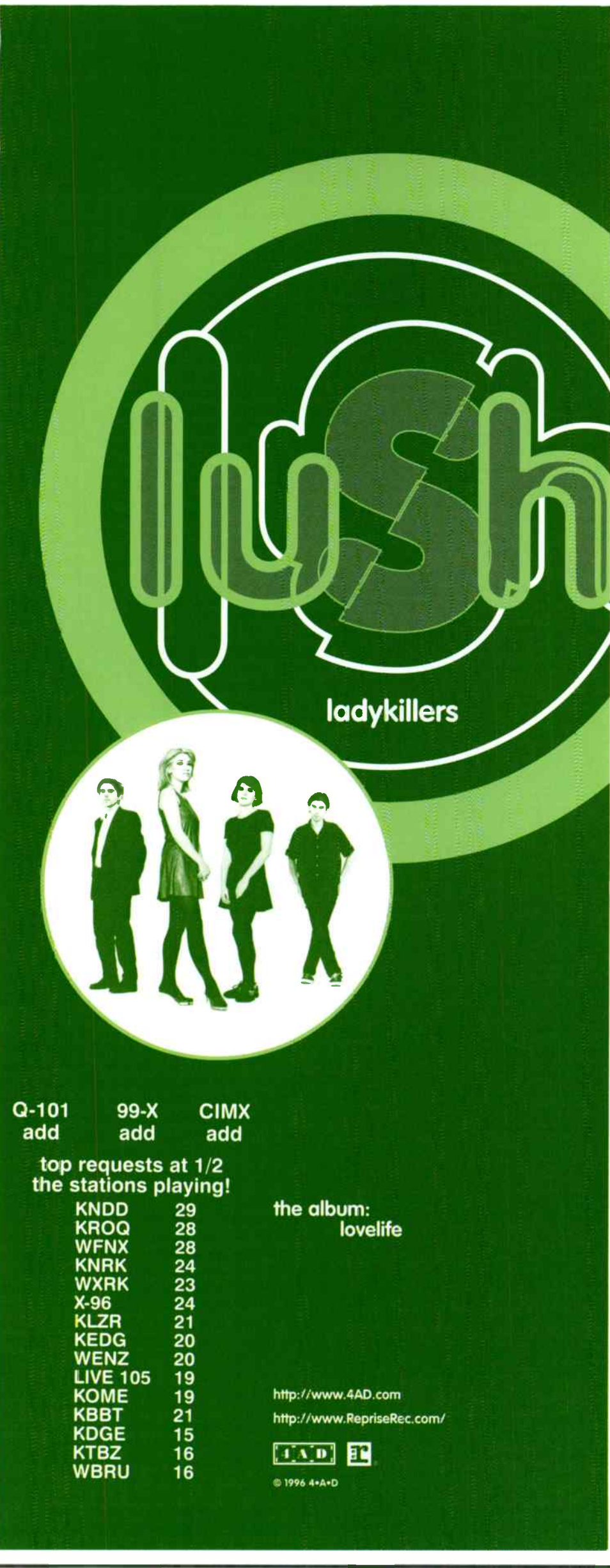

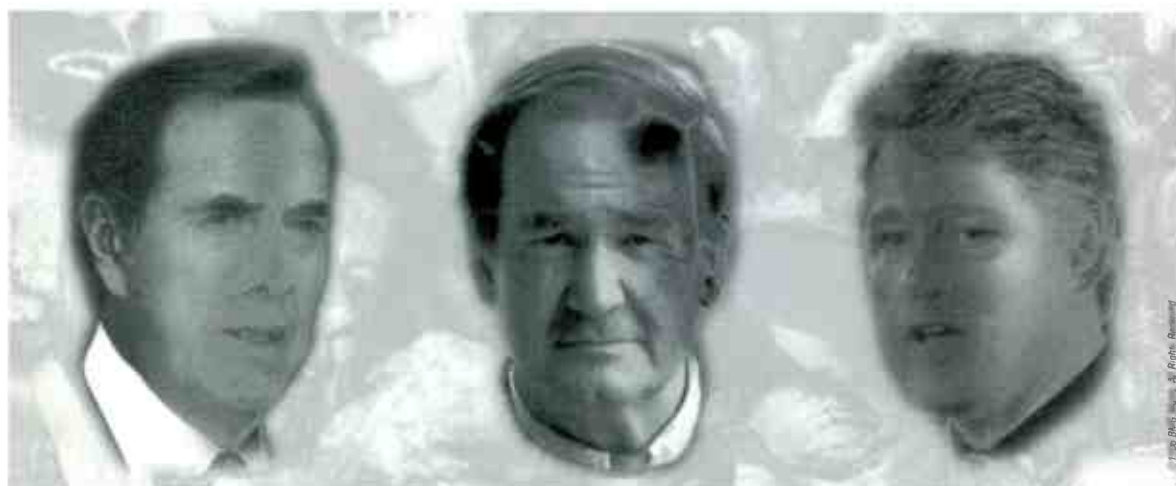
