Modern, Mainstream Rock Return To Their Corners, Stop Sharing So Much

In a recent Rock Airplay Monitor profile, WRCX (Rock 103.5) Chicago APD/MD Jo Robinson estimated that WRCX and modern rival WKQX shared as much as 80% of their music a year ago but were now down to overlapping a mere 10%-15% of each other's lists.

Well, a recent comparison of the Broadcast Data Systems Mainstream and Modern Rock charts in Rock Airplay Monitor from today and a year ago doesn't show anything that pronounced. But modern and mainstream did return to their corners and at least stopped biting each other quite as often. The two formats went from about 50% sharing a year ago to only about a third shared music today. The charts also confirmed that modern rock is now somewhat more British and considerably less edgy than it was a year ago, with ska and dance pop supplanting some of the grunge or active-to-modern crossovers that were a significant part of the format last summer.

And based, at least, on a comparison of the June 27, 1997, and June 28, 1996, charts, it appears that mainstream rock is spinning its biggest currents slightly slower than a year ago, while modern rock gave its No. 1 record a few more weekly spins than last year.

On last year's mainstream panel, consisting of 103 stations, the No. 1 track, Metallica's "Until It Sleeps," had 2,204 spins in its fifth week in that spot, an average of 21 spins per station. The 1997 version saw 102 mainstream reporters giving Tonic's "If You Could Only See" 1,854 spins, an average of 18 per station. At the bottom of the chart, however, both last year's No. 40 (Alanis Morissette's "You Learn," with 441 spins) and this year's clean-up hitter, (Sugartooth's "Booty Street," with 422) averaged about four plays per station per week.

Over in modern, where 1996's panel comprised 76 signals vs. today's 80, Butthole Surfers' "Pepper" had just topped the chart at

Evergreen Closes On Viacom Stations

Evergreen and Chancellor finally closed on the embattled Viacom stations, with the two companies now poised to complete their merger next month. Evergreen now owns WAXQ/WLTW New York and WBZS/WZHF/WJZW/WMZQ Washington, D.C., while Chancellor has possession of WDRQ Detroit and WLIT Chicago, as well as KYSR (Star 98.7) and KIBB (B100) Los Angeles. In addition, Evergreen's KYLD (Wild 107.7) San Francisco made its move July 3 to 94.9 FM, the frequency of former country outlet KSAN. As of July 7, Susquehanna's new KSAN on 107.7 was running a tape loop promoting "classic rock'n'roll oldies," essentially a classic hits format. KFFG/KFOG GM Dwight Walker adds VP stripes and will oversee the new KSAN, while Tony Salvatore, VP/GM of Susquehanna's KNBR, is named market manager. Elsewhere in the market, KLLC (Alice @ 97.3) GSM Tim Roessler and LSM Sue Schuler have exited.

In other Susquehanna news, Dan Halyburton is upped from VP/GM of triple-A KKZN (the Zone) and country KPLX Dallas to market manager for Susquehanna's four Dallas stations. He retains his previous duties.

SFX LMAs WRFX Charlotte, N.C., in a deal with ARS pending its previously announced purchase of the station for \$20 million and country WDSY Pittsburgh. The deal also includes the John Boy & Billy Network.

Modern WWBX Bangor, Maine, trades from Bangor Radio Corp. to Gopher Hill Communications for \$950,000. Format/programming staff remain. And HVS Partners deals album WXQR New Bern, N.C., to Cumulus Media. Cumulus also picks up triple-A WXKR Toledo, Ohio.

MANAGEMENT: REICH RISES

Veteran top 40 manager Bob Reich is upped from COO for Cromwell Group/Nashville, owner of top 40 WQZQ (the Party), to COO for the whole group. Nashville director of programming Brian Krysz gets similar chainwide stripes.

With Tele-Media's sale to Citadel, Phil Urso, owner of modern WDGE (the Edge) and rhythmic top 40 WDFG (the Beat) Providence, R.I., is

now GM at crosstown WPRO-AM-FM, WWLI-AM-FM, and WLKW. Citadel has not yet closed on its planned purchase of WDFG/WDFE.

Former album KBPI Denver PD Bill Betts becomes GM at top 40 WBHT (Hot 97/AC WMGS Wilkes-Barre, Pa., replacing Tom Shealy.

Now that 62nd Street Media has closed on its Saginaw, Mich., stations, hot AC WIOG GM Nancy Dymond adds those duties for new sister rock outlets WKQZ and WMJK.

Community Service Radio is selling its stake in album WTAO Carbondale, Ill., to the newly merged Clearly Superior Radio and its six-out-

let aggregate. WTAO VP/GM Chris Gullett exits, with Jerry Crouse becoming market manager for all six outlets. Top 40 KHTQ Spokane, Wash., morning man Kit Mann joins WTAO as PD, replacing Aaron Roberts.

With Heritage closing on album KQRC Kansas City as part of a swap with Journal

Broadcast, new PD Greg Stevens is now aboard. Jim Bone moves from P/T and assistant morning producer to nights, filling the slot vacated by Traci Wilde.

Album KFMW Waterloo, Iowa, names former top 40 KLSS Mason City, Iowa, GM Tim Mathews to its GM slot, replacing Don Moorehead.

PROGRAMMING: MEMPHIS MOVE

Dana Daniels exits the PD slot at classic rock WSRR (Star 98) Memphis.

Album KKEG Fayetteville, Ark., PD/middayer Dave Jackson is off the air to concentrate on his newly expanded duties as group PD of KKEG and country sister KFAY-FM and N/T KFAY-AM. First order of business is to get a midday person for KKEG and a morning show for KFAY-FM.

Modern adult WSHE Orlando, Fla., MD Rich Bryan joins the Jones Radio Network's classic rock feed, JRN Rock Classics, as operations manager. He'll also hold the midday shift. Mornings will be held by Denver rock radio vet Steve Cooper; afternoons goes to Robert "Shark" Sharkey, last with classic rock KRFX Denver. Laurie Cobb shifts from the JRN Soft Hits format to nights on the Rock Classics feed. Tom Collins, another Denver vet, picks up overnights.

Modern rock WXPS Burlington, Vt., is dark and will flip to N/T by the end of this week. PD Wally McCarthy stays on for now, while staffers Victoria St. John (afternoons), Jason McGahey (P/T), and Jennifer Casey (nights) exit. Casey heads to top 40 rival WXXX for P/T, while McCarthy can be reached at 802-863-1013.

With Saga LMA'ing triple-A WOXM Manchester, N.H., PD/MD Keith Murray exits. Promotion director Mike Hatch will also exit soon.

Classic rock WING-FM Dayton, Ohio, night jock Bradley Olson drops his shift, becoming program coordinator. Overnighter Campy gets nights, and Brian Rose slips from P/T at news/talk sister WING-AM to overnights.

Radio One's New Rock Alternative feed adds two affiliates. KLHI Maui, Hawaii, flips from the Jones Radio Network alternative feed. KZCY Cheyenne, Wyo., had been dark.

Syracuse (N.Y.) University's modern WJPZ returns to its longtime rhythmic top 40 format.

PEOPLE: HOLDING THE FORT

Triple-A WJBX Fort Myers, Fla., P/T Rachel moves into the morning co-host slot; former intern Cat takes overnights and hosts the weekly new-music show "Virgin Vault."

Elektra's Joey Vendetta returns to Toronto radio. He'll do mornings at top 40 CIDC (Hot 103).

Modern KGDE Omaha, Neb., midday host Nikki Boulay adds APD stripes, while morning co-host Justin Cooper moves to weekends, and P/T Scott Voorhees slides into the morning show.

Jere Crosby, last promo director with classic rock KZOZ San Luis Obispo, Calif., joins album KUPD Phoenix as promo coordinator.

Pollack To V2? Sub Pop Ups Meyer

Expect Matt Pollack, Elektra VP of alternative promotion, to join V2 as head of radio promotion by mid-August. Sub Pop promotes national director of video promoting and commissioning/new media Kristen Meyer to a less unwieldy title—national director of promotion. A&M Atlanta local Gina Suarez is upped to national director of rock promotion; Minneapolis local Karl Bader shifts to Atlanta.

John Corabi, who sang on Mötley Crüe's eponymous 1994 album, is filing suit against the band and Elektra Entertainment, according to Billboard Bulletin. Corabi claims that he was not paid the full amount owed to him per his contract with the band and was not compensated for songs that appear on the band's new album, "Generation Swine." Corabi, who exited the band upon the return of original front man Vince Neil, also alleges that the band slandered him by falsely stating that he voluntarily withdrew from the band due to pressure.



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Smash Mouth Have Fun On The Gridiron

You don't call your band **Smash Mouth** if your goal is to raise consciousness about Greenpeace or welfare reform. But it's a fitting moniker for a group that just wants to uncork the party bottle.

On most of its debut set, "Fush Yu Mang," which hits stores this week, Smash Mouth revs up a sprightly punk/ska/metal mixture with a comical tone that's calibrated for the full-contact festivities of the mosh pit. Perhaps that is why the band lifted its name from a phrase used by football aficionados to describe a dominant team's particularly aggressive style of play.

The group's style of play, meanwhile, can best be summed up in the title of one of its songs, "Let's Rock." "These poor kids are sitting around in their rooms listening to CDs with their headphones on just hating their parents, bummed out about everything," says guitarist/songwriter **Greg Camp** half-facetiously. "We just want to cheer kids up that are depressed."

Smash Mouth was formed in San Jose, Calif., in 1994 by two pairs of friends. Singer **Steve Harwell**, who had a short-lived stint as a **House Of Pain**-style rapper in a Tommy Boy group called **E.O.S.**, started the band with childhood friend and drummer **Kevin Coleman**, with whom he'd played "back in the AC/DC days." Through his manager, Harwell was introduced to Camp, who had been playing in various cover bands. Camp then recruited friend and former bass player **Paul De Lisle**, and the band embarked on its throw-everything-in-the-blender approach. A self-proclaimed "true rocker" and **Elvis** devotee, rapper Harwell also has a soft spot for **Van Halen** and **Ratt**.

Camp's musical upbringing is even more unwieldy. Besides having been weaned on **Santana** and **the Doors**, he was turned onto R&B by an older sister, got into punk and reggae with his school friends, and, at the home of his

best friend's Italian family, developed a love for **Frank Sinatra**, **Louis Prima**, and Italian jazz. And of course, like Harwell, he was a major **Van Halen** fan and speaks in no uncertain terms about the impact **Eddie Van Halen's** guitar playing had on him. "I was a drummer first. But when he came out, I threw those drums away," declares Camp, who also claims **the Buzzcocks** as a major influence.

Smash Mouth's determination to write "radio-friendly" pop songs started paying off last year. After recording some demos in Camp's bedroom, the band members came in contact with **Third Eye Blind** producer **Eric Valentine**, who recorded a couple of tracks with them in his studio. One of the tracks, "Nervous In The Alley," began to get substantial airplay at local modern outlet **KOME**. The band reconvened with Valentine; by the time it was signed, it had a completely finished first record to its credit.

The biggest surprise on the album occurs when the band members momentarily depart from the frantic punk/ska/metal thrust for the single "Walkin' On The Sun." A sort of **Doors'** "Moonlight Drive" meets **the Zombies'** "She's Not There," the track conjures images of teenagers doing the frug at a beach party or a "Shindig" episode. The song was actually written four years ago by Camp as an attempt at **Esquivel**-type lounge music and was lying dormant on an 8-track demo when Coleman suggested the band add it to its repertoire. "The best thing we could have done was to do that song, because that kind of opened up the doors for other stuff," says Harwell. Conspicuous in the song and on most of the album, however, is the way Harwell occasionally alters his standard middle American-sounding drawl to sing in a subtle British accent strangely not so unlike the way other regional neopunkers **Green Day** and **Rancid** have incorporated similar working-class accents. "Maybe it comes out from our influences when we were younger, like **the Clash** type of stuff. The fact that we were into that, maybe it just kind of bleeds over into your current writing," he says.

The band just shot the video for "Walkin' On the Sun," which is based on the drag-racing scene in the film "Grease." "It's going to be 'Gidget' meets 'Grease' meets 'The Fifth Element,'" says Harwell, who will be racing a hot rod against Camp.

With songs like "Beer Goggles," "Heave-Ho," and "The Fonz," one won't misconstrue Smash Mouth's flippant and irreverent tunes for anything too serious. According to Harwell, it's not a complicated prospect. "Music's supposed to feel good. It's just supposed to be fun," he says. "We just write about what we see. We're not worried about the news every day."

1,995 spins last year, an average of 26 plays per station. This year, Third Eye Blind's "Semi-Charmed Life" got 2,473 spins, meaning the average spin count went from 26 to 30 plays since last year. Then again, last year's No. 40 song, Alice In Chains' "Again," was averaging eight spins a week vs. this year's No. 40 song, Cowboy Mouth's "Jenny Says," with 7.4 spins.

So how about that downturn in sharing? Well, last year the two formats shared more than half their music (52.5% to be exact). In 1997, that has dropped to 35%. Of '96's shared material, 10 bands (Metallica, Stone Temple Pilots, Alice In Chains, Bush, Goo Goo

Dolls, Refreshments, Dave Matthews Band, Soundgarden [with "Burden In My Hand"], Sponge, and Nixons) were doing better on mainstream than modern. Smashing Pumpkins, Tracy Bonham, Butthole Surfers, the Verve Pipe, Green Day, Screaming Trees, Gravity Kills, and Alanis Morissette (with "You Learn") were the eight acts doing better at modern than mainstream.

Today, six shared bands (Tonic, Wallflowers, Collective Soul, Offspring, Blues Traveler, and Veruca Salt) are enjoying greater mainstream than modern success, while the same number (Smashing Pumpkins, Toad The Wet Sprocket, Verve Pipe, Blur, Third Eye Blind, and U2) have reversed that equation.

MORE STORIES ABOUT SHARING

While Veruca Salt's mainstream chart number may be slightly ahead of its modern rock counterpart, that's probably due more to modern rock burning through records faster and finishing up with the band before mainstream. But Wallflowers and Collective Soul, which both started in the modern rock camp, were mainstream exclusives this time last year, and this year are still enjoying a great success with "The Difference" (No. 3 at mainstream vs. No. 6 at modern) and "Listen" (No. 4 at mainstream vs. No. 18 at modern), respectively, indicating that these bands have truly crossed into mainstream stardom as modern continues to experiment with new genres. Blues Traveler, one of the '90s reconstructionist hippie-culture jam-bands (a la Phish, Sister Hazel, et al.), also seems to be making that transition, finding a warmer embrace at mainstream, charting No. 8, than at modern, where it placed at No. 30.

Last year, 35% of the music on the modern chart was from debut albums, while 30% of the mainstream chart were freshman releases. This year, the split is far wider, as modern tries to reclaim its mantle as the new-music capital of the world. While debut music has dropped from 35% to 30% at modern, it's been nearly cut in half at mainstream, which now draws only 17.5% of its music from debut releases.

Modern is still the format where the girls are: 20% of the music on last year's chart featured female vocals. While that's the same this year, mainstream's percentage of the same has dropped from 5% to 2.5%.

KICK OFF THE JAMS

It's probably no surprise when we tell you that the distorto-guitar-grunge genre has far less impact at modern this year than last. That lack of singular focus has seemingly opened the doors to a wider variety of music.

Witness the shortage of harder acts from to-

day's modern chart compared with last year, when Metallica, the Nixons, Soundgarden, Rage Against The Machine, Gravity Kills, and Solution A.D. were all happening at modern. While some of this phenomenon can safely be laid at the feet of release schedules, at least Metallica and the Nixons are currently enjoying mainstream success. Faith No More, another early modern favorite, is nowhere to be found on the modern chart, while its "Last Cup Of Sorrow" enjoyed a 24-21 rise on this year's mainstream chart.

Those spaces these days seem to be taken up by bands that are less guitar driven. By breaking down the chart in purely subjective terms to guitar-based and non-guitar-based, 82.5% of last year's modern chart was powered by Marshall stacks. This year, that's down to 70%. And while ska-tinged music made up but 5% of last year's modern chart, it's now up to 10%. Likewise, music from the synth/dance/non-guitar realm has nearly doubled from 12.5% to 20%. So the grunge era acts have been supplanted by the likes of Mighty Mighty Bosstones, Squirrel Nut Zippers, and White Town, all of whom have helped return a wider variety of genres to the format.

Perhaps the above-mentioned slight decrease in new acts embraced by modern has been replaced by musical history lessons. While the Cure led the '80s wing of the 1996 modern chart (which was then 7.5%), today the return of Depeche Mode and Echo & the Bunnymen along with the latest U2 release means a slightly richer 10% composition.

Both Soundgarden and the Cranberries were members of the modern overachievers club last year, co-opting four slots or 10% of the chart. Today, those daily-double awards go to Smashing Pumpkins (cementing the argument for the band as modern poster child) and Sublime.

There's more overseas fare in today's modern chart than last year (25% vs. 15%). Some may see that as the coming to fruition of Brit-

pop, and while Blur is among those British exports, the above-mentioned return of the '80s core groups cannot be discounted—they're all Brit acts, too. And the chart in question predated the debut of the new Oasis single.

The heritage-dominant flavor of this year's mainstream chart vs. that of a year ago skews more to domestic product. While 15% of last year's mainstream charters were from outside the U.S., this time around it's off at 12.5%.

THE BIG '80S

Not only has mainstream backed off the newer acts, but it seems to be reinvestigating those success stories of the '80s and earlier. Only 10% of last year's mainstream chart were B.N. (Before '90s or Before Nirvana). On today's chart, that's blossomed to 35%, including the likes of Sammy Hagar, Aerosmith, Motley, Cure, Metallica, John Fogerty, Paul McCartney, Queensryche, and U2.

Many of those flashback bands are responsible for multiple tracks on the chart. In all, 32.5% of the chart goes to repeat offenders Collective Soul, Live, Metallica, Queensryche, U2, and Aerosmith—the last of which has three tracks on the chart. Last year, five acts (Everclear, Spacehog, Soundgarden, Stone Temple Pilots, and Metallica) had two concurrent charting songs, accounting for 25% of the chart.

MONITOR PROFILE

Dan Howard Draws Them To Triple-A In Chattanooga With Right Attitude

Triple-A stations seem to come in a wide array of market-specific flavors. But in Chattanooga, Tenn., country-to-triple-A convert WDOD (the Mountain) is breaking ground, even for this venerably wide format.

Only two months after its flip, OM Dan Howard (known on-air as Skyler McKenzie) has seen his station's 12-plus numbers rise from a winter share of 3.1 to a 5.2 share in the second spring Arbitrend.

More surprising, even to Howard, is WDOD's 18-34 success story. "After two trends, we have an 8 share 18-34. I was hoping this book maybe we could debut with a 5. I had no anticipation that it was going to be this quick," he says.

Then again, even the format hole was a surprise to WDOD. "When we first went into our research on the station," he says, "our first thought was some type of rock, and we thought it could be classic with a few features [spotlighting] some of newer rock . . . I guess we under-

estimated the market a bit, because it came back overwhelmingly that, yes, they like some of the older facets of the good old classic rock from the '70s and a lot of the AOR of the '80s, but they wanted a healthy dose of today's rock. And they wanted it all mixed together. So, variety came into play when we started doing the research."

That variety can mean anything from Jewel to Lynyrd Skynyrd, Bon Jovi to Talking Heads. But that doesn't mean WDOD isn't triple-A. "I've listened to triple-A stations across the country in the past few months, and rarely do you find two of them that are alike," Howard says. "They may share 50%-60% of the library, but then the other 40% is markedly different. And that's the same way here."

Howard admits that when industry folk visit the market and hear WDOD spiking in some '80s Bon Jovi, they'll say, "Man, this is really not alternative." And I go, "I know it's not alternative, but we're an adult rock [station] that plays some alternative records."

"One of the reasons for our early success has been the mixture of familiarity. I know a lot of alternative listeners and programmers may not relate to that, but in this market, I think familiarity has helped us. There's songs that were not represented here for a long time. They were hits, or at least [listeners] had heard them, whether it was on other stations that are now defunct or MTV, VHI, or traveling out of town . . . So a lot of the music, while somewhat familiar, had not been burned out. And so we didn't take on a lot of high burn. We didn't pick up where a station had been plugging these songs for five years unsuccessfully to the same market.

"On the Mountain, we've tried to maintain a level of mass appeal while going deep enough on the album to sound different. We try not to just completely sell out to all the mass-appeal hits. We try to go pretty deep, or as deep as we can with songs that fit from artists that make sense, like a Springsteen. We'll [play] a 'Pink

Cadillac,' which isn't considered deep in this format, but for this market, it's considered deep."

Here's a sample hour on WDOD: Collective Soul, "Gel"; Third Eye Blind, "Semi-Charmed Life"; Chris Isaak, "Wicked Game"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Dancing Days"; EMF, "Unbelievable"; Van Halen, "And The Cradle Will Rock"; Dave Matthews Band, "Tripping Billies"; Joan Osborne, "One Of Us"; Bruce Springsteen, "Pink Cadillac"; Vigilantes Of Love, "Love Cocoon"; Loverboy, "Lovin' Every Minute Of It"; No Doubt, "Just A Girl"; Aerosmith, "Hole In My Soul"; and U2, "Pride (In The Name of Love)."

WDOD's closest musical competitors are top 40 WZST, which has a heavy modern lean, and classic rock WSKZ, which, Howard claims, is tossing in some currents after first training its guns on WDOD's AC sister WDEF (Sunny 92.3).

So why jump into the triple-A breach when modern adult seems to be all the rage? Howard, who is also WDEF OM, says, "It was economics. We felt that the modern AC end could possibly jeopardize Sunny 92.3, which is our main bread and butter." After toiling away in the shadow of country monster WUSY, ownership concluded, "It was going to be a strong uphill battle by continuing country, whereas we could see some immediate results in this format . . . with a moderate amount of expenditure, as opposed to spending tons and tons of money to hopefully break through that country barrier."

Between the two stations, "we're always going to share, maybe, a few titles, but I'd say at this point, we may share 10 to 20 records at any given time," says Howard. Jewel's "You Were Meant For Me" is one example. Though other triple-A's have had success with it, on the Mountain, "we have played it, but sparingly. I don't see that record being a power for the Mountain, whereas it would be a power for Sunny."

Probably the biggest difference between WDOD and its sister, as well as most every other triple-A, is attitudinal presentation. That was key in drawing attention to WDOD. As Howard sees it, "This market has not had a lot of attitude and . . . indignant, defiant radio. So, we've come on the air with a pretty healthy dose of 'screw you.' I think that's helped. I think it's caused a lot of word-of-mouth. We haven't gone too far, because this market's not going to [accept that]. I can't see a Howard Stern in this market at this point, not that we're going to pay him that much money to be in here anyhow."

Liners and drop-ins that present theater-of-the-mind beatings of such AC icons as Barry Manilow, Michael Bolton, and Michael Jackson are not uncommon. One typical new music billboard: "This one's straight from our new music garden. It just popped its little head up. We yanked it out of the ground, chopped it up into pieces, and boiled it just for you."

While the on-air Bolton-bashing was a little hard for Howard to take at first, given his AC background, the latest trial has been grooming an air staff that's not anchored to liner cards and wire copy. "We want the jocks to sound at ease, shoot from the hip, and [sound] unrestricted. . . [But] I keep wanting to put the belt to them some days. I'm thinking, 'Oh, they're running their mouths. Shut up and play a record.'"

It's OK for some of the drop-ins to be acerbic, but Howard strives to keep the jocks from going quite that far. "We've smacked around the competition and ridiculed them a bit on-air, but I'm not a big fan of trash-mouthing the competition over and over. We can do that on some cute little liners [for] three weeks, have some laughs, and get over it. I'm not into the personal-attack mode. I've had to pull a couple of jocks back on that."

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


TENDERLOIN
