WRCX Tops In Mainstream Rock With 5 Major-Market Radio Awards

Perennial mainstream rock victor WRCX (Rock 103.5) Chicago rolled through the 1997 Billboard/ Airplay Monitor Radio Awards as the high



achiever in its class, sweeping the major-market mainstream rock category with five trophies for station, PD, MD, local air personality, and marketing director of the year.

Two radio stations—also repeat winners from 1996—took home trophies in four categories: adult top 40 WPLJ New York and crosstown

rhythmic top 40 WKTU, including top prizes for major-market station of the year and PD. In all, an unprecedented 46 out of 94 winners at the ceremony, held Oct. 18 at the Orlando Renaissance Resort, made command-performance trips to the stage from last year's awards show.

Rock 103.5's award recipients were PD Dave Richards, MD Jo Robinson, local air personality Mancow Muller, and marketing director Natalie DiPietro, all repeat winners.

Unlike WRCX's mainstream rock sweep, there was no consensus in the genre's medium-market categories: Station of the year was WEBN Cincinnati. PD of the year was Keith Hastings of WLZR (Lazer 103) Milwaukee, and the winning MD was Sharon Schifino of WHJY Providence, R.I.

Other top award winners in the major-market category included modern rock triple-crown winner KROQ Los Angeles, which took hon-

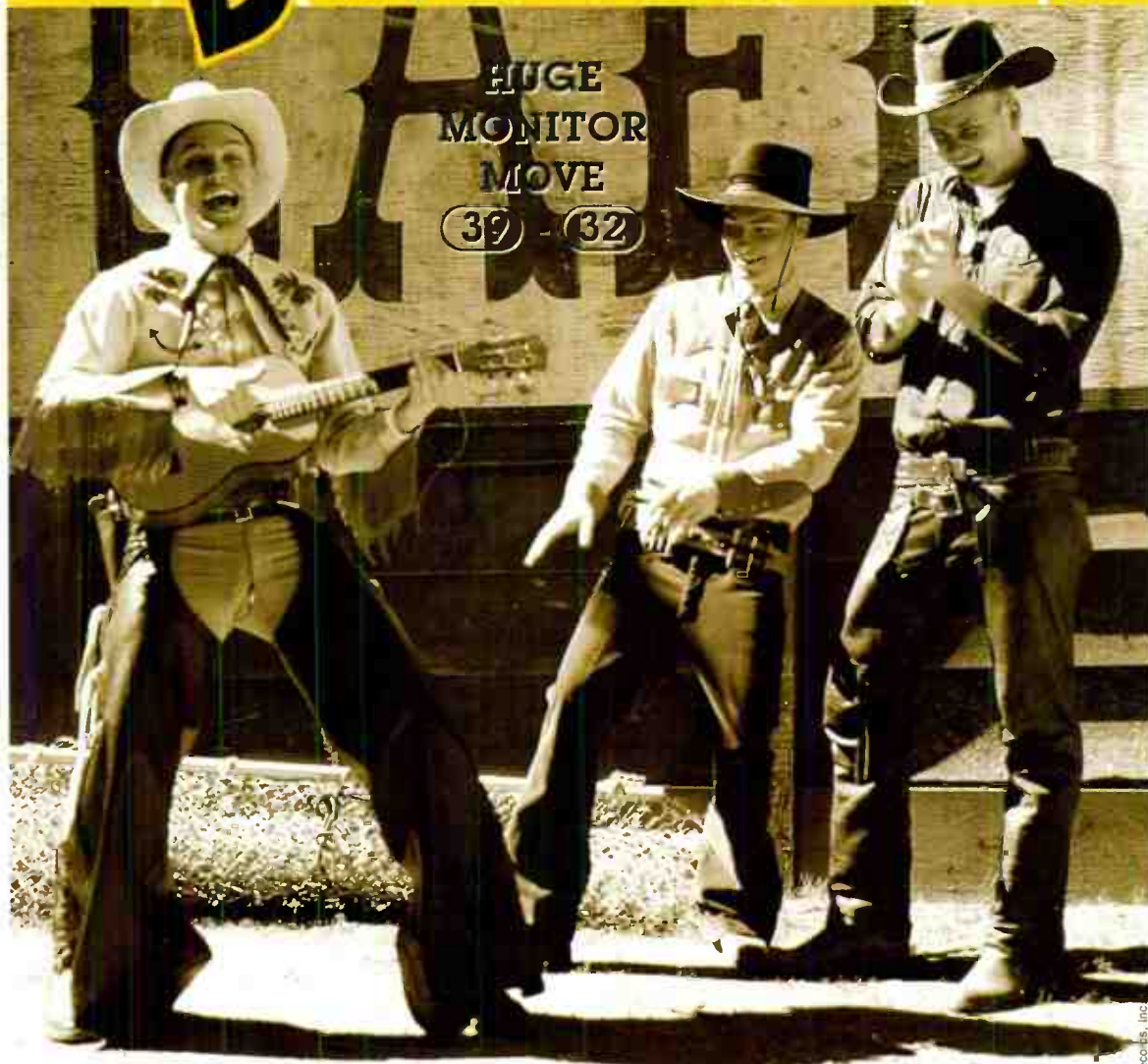

KLZX Salt Lake City drops satellite-fed classic rock for live album rock under the brain trust that brought the market KRKR (K-Rock). PD/MD/p.m. driver **Gary Michaels**, midlayer **Mark Erickson**, and night jock **Casey Baird** return. **Jack Daniels**, fresh out of college, takes mornings.

Classic hits WZZU Raleigh, N.C., will flip to satellite gospel by the time you read this. Morning hosts **Kevin Silva** and **Mike Wheelis**, p.m. driver **Brian McFadden**, and night jock **Don Brookshire** all exit as a result.

Album WJXQ Lansing, Mich., is rocking harder says APD/MD **Bob Olson**, now handling

programming. Gone are **Heart**, **John Mellencamp**, **Bob Seger**, etc.; a higher dose of **Ozzy Osbourne**, **AC/DC**, **Led Zeppelin**, and **Ted Nugent** is in. **Kevin Conrad** exits 1-3 p.m. for production; p.m. driver **Olson** takes the shift. Nights **Bill Crooks** gets afternoons; P/T **Sue** takes nights. **Duran Martinez**, last in mornings, takes 10 a.m.-1 p.m.; **Bob** and **Tom** are now in mornings.

Album WHJY/AC WSNE Providence, R.I., PD **Bill Weston** joins classic hits WAXQ (Q104.3) New York as PD. Across the hall, Chancellor's WNSR New York (formerly modern AC the Buzz) has returned, at least temporarily, to hot AC as "FM105.1."

Former modern AC WPLL Miami PD **Dave Stewart** resurfaces in New Orleans as OM of modern KKND (the End) and top 40

KHOM.

Classic rock KVFX Modesto, Calif., flips to country as Froggy 96.7.

PEOPLE: EDGE PEERLESS

Modern KDGE (the Edge) Dallas MD **Mike Peer** becomes modern WXRK (K-Rock) New York MD. **Booker Madison** remains music coordinator and resumes his 10 p.m.-2 a.m. air shift. Look for **Julie Slater** to take on middays, where she's been filling in. Afternoons remain open.

Triple-A WBOS morning man and market vet **Ken Shelton** exits.

Active WTKX Mobile, Ala., drops the syndicated **Ron and Ron** show, moving PD **Joel Sampson** to mornings with former classic rock WSRR Memphis PD **Dana Daniels** as co-host.

Country WEXT Kenosha, Wis., PD/morning man **Phil Enzinga** crosses the hall to classic rock WIIL for mornings.

Veteran WRCX Chicago personality **Bob Barnes Watts** exits to return home to England.

WIFR-TV sports director **Robert Lanigan** joins album WXRK Rockford, Ill., for mornings. Local waitress **Amy Cusimano** is co-host.

Modern KAEP Spokane, Wash., overnights **Jeff Downz** takes over production duties for Citadel's Spokane radio cluster.

Album KOZZ Reno, Nev., moves P/T **Casey Titus** into overnights, replacing **Jay Slater**.

Modern WPLT (the Planet) Detroit has added a Sunday morning contemporary Christian music show.

Panels: 'Rock Wall,' Modern Adult Fears

Consolidation, modern adult radio, and music sharing were the major issues at the rock panels during this year's Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar, held Oct. 16-18 in Orlando, Fla.

This year's mainstream rock panel focused on the post-consolidation phenomenon of programmers working as a part of a "rock wall" in some markets. Modern XETRA-FM (91X) San Diego PD **Bryan Schock** noted that while he and **Tim Dukes**, PD of album sister KIOZ, have some history in the market, they're not as steeped in the battle that their two stations have been in for years. Although the two PDs get along fine, some of the stations' staffers, **Schock** said, "still want to kill each other on the street. There are still feelings of animosity between the two stations behind closed doors. You spend your time getting your people to go out and kill, and now you're telling them, 'Go easy. They're on our side.'"

That rivalry can get exacerbated, said **Schock**, "when you're a radio station as part of a group and you're watching your brothers get vehicles and funding, and you can't complain because we're all supposed to be part of the same team."

There are even musical rivalries to attend to. **Schock** said, "I recently caught our modern AC station [top 40 KKLQ] playing **Nine Inch Nails**, and I called to ask, 'Where are the boundaries here?'"

Musically, **Elektra** VP of rock promotion **George Cappellini** noted a new wrinkle in the formula. When he approached **Jacor's** upper echelon about a song, he was eventually told that the song would be tested on KIOZ and then might be picked up by the rest of the chain. In the days before this level of consolidation, he'd never have gotten that song on KIOZ, he said. "It's opened new avenues to get records played."

Addressing the way labels and owners can now interact as well as quell internal rivalries, **Clear Channel** director of programming for **Miami** **Gregg Steele** suggested, "The label should go to our corporate group with tickets and promotions and let them decide which stations will get it."

Referring to **Jacor's** hold on San Diego rock, **Schock** said, "We have two modern ACs in our market, one we own. We have two alternatives, one we own. And we own one rock station. I want to work with record companies in making things work with acts that cross over to our stations. I'm seeing resistance from the record people, who say, 'Oh, I don't want to upset [your competition]. I say, 'You're not going to need them anyway, so why not sit down with me? Here's a great opportunity for you to give me a show—I'll buy tickets and split it with KIOZ, and we'll make it a **Jacor** thing. Why wouldn't you do something like that?'"

A&M's **Mike Rittberg** asked what would happen when the next act comes down the pike and 91X doesn't want it. He's going to

need to maintain that relationship with crosstown modern XHRM (the Flash) so that next artist at least has a chance in the market.

What's more, another audience member noted, given the still-unstable world of consolidation, at some point a particular aggregate of stations might break up and then the stranglehold is no longer there for one owner, and the record rep will have to go back to working with that crosstown rival.

Album **WJRR** Orlando PD **Dick Sheetz** bemoaned the new phenomenon of modern adult sister **WSHE** in the market playing his music. "I find 'em, they grind 'em," he said. He added later, "We try to maintain synergy

because that is a corporate mandate, but there's hot spots. I'd been spinning **Third Eye Blind** for weeks, when suddenly our modern AC jumped

on it. Then there are questions, like when the show comes to town, who will get that? Who owns the band? We have to come up with what we think is a reasonable sharing process, because ownership of bands is important."

Modern adult loomed large on the modern rock panel's radar screen as well. **WMRQ** Hartford, Conn., PD **Jay Beau Jones** was one of several PDs sounding a battle cry. "We may be at a point now when we can't let modern adult [stations] take that music anymore," he said.

That led **Coleman Research's** **Warren Kurtzman** to note, "Whether the modern adult hurts a station is completely based on how good the alternative station in the market is." To which **WRZX** Indianapolis PD **Scott Jameson** added, "Stations have always been squeezed. You just have to make the station more exciting."

When one audience member characterized the creation of modern adult as coming from some back-room cabal of consultants, **Kurtzman** retorted that when he was working on an early modern adult station, modern didn't even enter into the picture. "We designed this thing to take out the hot AC in a market," he said. "After it took off, we found that the alternative sucked and we could do better in that direction as well, so we went after both sides."

Noting the poppier side of modern these days, **Kurtzman** referred to a recent perceptual study that showed that the dark, grunge era was largely over. One respondent said something to the effect of, "You can just be depressed and down for so long. You either have to kill yourself or move on." With a lot of the grunge fans graduating college and finding good job prospects, a rising stock market, and a healthy economy, there's less they can relate to in songs that are so down.

When asked what the format would look like a year from now, **WPLA** Jacksonville, Fla., PD **Jim Randall** stated simply, "I live in fear of a modern adult [coming to town]."

ors for PD Kevin Weatherly and air personality Jed the Fish. Another CBS outlet, WBCN Boston, won major-market awards for MD Carter Alan and marketing director Larry "Chachi" Loprete.



Yet another CBS station, modern KOME San Jose, Calif., led medium-market stations, picking up two nods, for station and OM Ron Nenni. Modern KROX Austin, Texas, bested the small-market pack with three awards: small-market

modern rock station and a double nod for PD and local air personality Sara Trexler. Sister album KLBJ took home two trophies: small-market mainstream rock station and small-market mainstream rock PD for Jeff Carrol.

Finally, WXRT Chicago repeated its 1996 achievements by taking home all three awards in the triple-A category: station, PD Norm Winer, and MD Patty Martin.



Jacobs Media dominated the rock end of the consultant awards once again this year. Fred Jacobs earned mainstream rock radio consultant of the year, with his co-worker Tom Calderone getting the honors for modern rock consultant. Guy Zapoleon of Zapoleon Media Strategies again won for both top 40 and adult.

In syndicated programming, Global Satellite Networks walked away with two awards. Its

"Modern Rock Live" triumphed in the modern rock network syndicated program category, while "Rockline" topped the mainstream rock tally. And, as usual, CBS Radio's Howard Stern won as nationally syndicated air personality. Stern, who usually sends one of his morning-team members to accept, this time sent a female recipient who flashed her breasts at the crowd, accompanied by an E! Entertainment camera crew. But she was upstaged by top 40 WFLZ Tampa, Fla., which sent heavyset morning stunt guy Uncle Fester, who charged the podium, clad only in his underwear and a necktie, prompting presenter Paul Carrack to shriek and leap off the stage.

The ceremony also included a new accolade, the Alison Steele Lifetime Achievement Award. The first trophy went to broadcast legend Casey Kasem from Westwood One.

In adult top 40, WDBZ (the Buzz) New York MD Linda Silver received the one major-market award that WPLJ didn't; ironically, Silver was one of those exiting in a mass layoff at the station last week. The station, now WNSR, has since dropped its modern adult format for a more conventional hot AC format, at least for now. Silver's win elicited the loudest applause of the evening.

The Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Awards are given annually in seven format categories. The Radio Awards are voted on by the readers of Billboard and the Airplay Monitor publications. A total of 94 awards were given to 470 nominees this year. The awards ceremony was hosted by Westwood One's Kasem. Musicians LL Cool J and Paul Carrack were co-presenters at the show, which attracted a record crowd of more than 1,100.

Space Monkeys Keep Manchester Grooving

Space Monkeys are another in a long line of British bands that aren't content to simply write a classic pop song without then affixing it to a club groove, a formula that can be traced back 10 years to the Manchester, England, club scene. And while a dance element has been one of the more exciting aspects of Britpop, bands with it still face an uphill climb in America.

Hailing from Manchester, Space Monkeys' blend of club and rock culture was derived "from watching the Charlatans and the Stone Roses," says lead singer/guitarist and songwriter Richard McNevin-Duff, who took in the scene as a teenager. The group was signed in November '95 to Factory Records in the U.K., the label responsible for Joy Division, Happy Mondays, and OMD. Three months ago, label head Tony Wilson played a recording by the band, which has already had four British singles, for the former U.S. manager of New Order, Tom Atencio, who manages No Doubt. Atencio signed the group to his own Chingon label and brought it to Interscope, which will release the band's U.S. debut, "The Daddy Of Them All," Nov. 4.

Though officially formed in 1994, the Space Monkeys' origins can be traced to 1989, when McNevin-Duff, who was working in a record store, met DJ/sampler Tony Pipes. Initially, the two couldn't have had more disparate tastes, but, McNevin-Duff says, "we got a flat together, and he turned me on to stuff like Eric B. & Rakim, Public Enemy, and Digital Underground, and I turned him on to the stuff I was into," including the Stooges, Doors, and Bob Dylan.

The pair cast the band's mold in their respective influences by combining a traditional three-piece lineup of guitars, bass, and drums with a live DJ scratching records and firing samples. As a live unit, the group is "loud and punky," says McNevin-Duff, and has been described as "the Sex Pistols with poppier tunes and a DJ."

Given the album's melodic pop feel, it comes as no surprise that McNevin-Duff writes mostly on an acoustic guitar. As for his biggest songwriting influence, he says, "I'm a Dylan freak. He's the one in my mind when I write. I probably have a sweeter voice, but I try and fuck my voice

up to sound like the guy." Besides, he adds, there are sociological parallels. "To me, hip-hop is like folk music. The thing that turns me on about hip-hop is the freedom in the way you can write lyrics and let them flow within the song. You're not stuck to the chord structure," referring specifically to the single "Sugar Cane."

While that hip-hop-flavored pop confection, which has an antecedent in Grandmaster Flash, is an obvious reference to drugs, McNevin maintains that the song is neither a condemnation nor a condoning of those party people "popping pills like Pacman." It's more of an observation, he contends, but adds that people need to be careful. "Everybody I know has been through the same sort of experiences. You know, people should do what they want, as long as you're not hurting anybody else."

Although intended as a response to the whole Britpop movement, the urgency and brashness of the album opener, "Acid House Killed Rock & Roll," summarizes the band's answer to critics of the rock/pop/dance collision. "I've got respect for the Beatles, but at the end of the day it's 1997, and in two years' time we're going to be taking part in the biggest fucking party that this planet has ever seen. We just want to sort of make the soundtrack for the party."

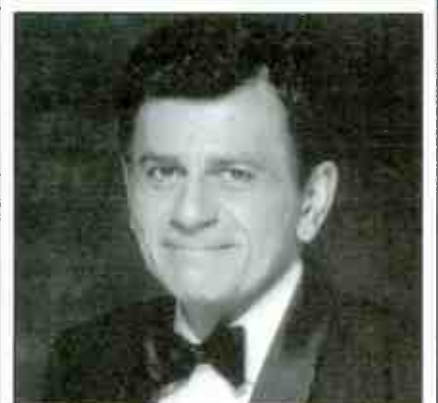
