Triple-A's Pioneering Artists: Where Would They Be Now?

Sarah McLachlan, Fiona Apple, Jewel—the Lilith Fair artists, if you will—are all enjoying great success these days, due in no small part to the success of modern adult radio and the surprise acceptance of singer/songwriter music at top 40. While Fiona and Jewel are riding debut sets to great heights, this is McLachlan's fourth outing with Arista. So how many other triple-A or modern rock mainstays of the late '80s/early '90s would be having multi-format hits if modern AC had been available to help spread them?

We canvassed triple-A PDs, who embraced McLachlan from the beginning and were first on the Apple and Jewel bandwagons, about the artists they wish could have another at-bat in the singer/songwriter friendly world of 1997. Names that came up nearly across the board were Kate Bush, Jonatha Brooke, and even Tori Amos, all of whom remain active artists.

Triple-A KGSR Austin, Texas, PD Jody Denberg says, "Kate Bush comes



to mind immediately. She would be mega. Ask Tori Amos and Fiona Apple." Bush's closest brush with multi-format stardom in the U.S. was 1985's "Running Up That Hill."

While he agrees with the Bush reference, Joan Armatrading is the first name that popped into Mercury triple-A domo Dave Einstein's mind. "[She] was one of those types of artists that was way ahead of her time," he notes.

Einstein's list is a mix of cult heroes and artists who did have commercial breakthroughs, ranging from Melissa Etheridge and Suzanne Vega (who scored two of the genre's rare crossover hits), Joni Mitchell, k.d. lang, Emmylou Harris, Mary Chapin Carpenter, Patti Smith, Rachel Sweet, and Chrissie Hynde. "Without 'Stop Your Sobbing,'" says Einstein, "I don't think Jewel could have gotten as far as she did with 'Who Will Save Your Soul.'"

Looking within his own roster, Einstein says that if the earlier Texas records had come out today, "it would have been a much different thing."

From his seat at the helm of triple-A flagship KBCO Denver, PD Dave Benson says, "A lot of us always looked at the BoDeans and said, 'If the Gin Bloss-



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World Radio History

Jacor Buys Nationwide For \$620 Mil.

Jacor has emerged the victor in the bidding war for Nationwide's broadcast properties. Its \$620 million offer will give Jacor another 17 stations in eight markets. The buy marks Jacor's entree into Dallas, Houston, Minneapolis, Phoenix, and Baltimore and expands its holdings in San Diego, Cleveland, and Columbus, Ohio. Jacor will probably have to divest outlets in San Diego. Gary Stevens & Co. brokered the deal. Rock stations included in the deal are album **KEGL** Dallas, modern **KTBS** Houston, classic hits **KXGL** San Diego, and album **WMMS** Cleveland. Also part of the Jacor buying spree this week is the purchase of classic rock **WQTL** Lima, Ohio, in a separate deal.

In other sales news, Triathlon Broadcasting has retained investment banker Goldman Sachs to look into a possible sale or merger of the company. And Regent Communications merges with Flint, Mich., station owner Faircom Inc.

In related business, Clear Channel merges with Universal Outdoor Holdings. The deal is structured as a stock exchange, with Clear Channel assuming roughly \$495 million in Universal Outdoor debt.

Former modern **WVIC** Lansing, Mich., PD **Todd Thomas** will program and do afternoons. **Kristin Burns**, another **WVIC** refugee, will be MD/middays, as she was at **WVIC**. **Carlito**, last in nights with **WVIC**, takes 4-8 p.m. at **WXVO**.

Sarah Connor moves from nights at triple-A **KZZE** Medford, Ore., to **WXVO** for nights.

Former album **WKQZ** Saginaw, Mich., PD **Rick Church** heads to mainstream rock **WRQK** Canton, Ohio, for the same duties.

Classic rock **WCIZ** Watertown, N.Y., PD **J.P. Hastings** heads to classic rocker **WOUR** Utica, N.Y., replacing OM **Tom Starr**.

Oldies **WMMA** Cincinnati evolves to classic hits under PD **Scott Carlisle** as **ARS** assumes control of the station. **Carlisle** moves from afternoons to the midday slot last held by a satellite feed. Morning man and former owner **Mike McMurray** exits, replaced by **D.D. Neumann**, last working for Metro Traffic. **Carlisle's** afternoon shifts goes to **Becky Prewitt**, who previously served as the station's afternoon news anchor. P/T **Steve Rhodus** takes nights.

Modern adult **KMXB** (Mix 94.1) Las Vegas PD **Mike Marino** is named PD of **SFX** Broadcasting's similarly formatted **KKPN** (the Planet) Houston, replacing **John Cook**. **KMXB** APD/MD **Kevin "Kozman" Koske** is interim PD.

Mark Adams, PD of rhythmic top 40 **KBOS** (B95) and sports **KCBL** (the Ball) Fresno, Calif., segues to Milwaukee as PD of modern adult

WXPT (the Point), replacing **Chris Kerr**.

Album **WIZN** Burlington, Vt., PD/morning man **Steve Cormier** exits.

Album **KCMQ** Columbia, Mo., PD/afternoon host **Debbie Wyld** exits. MD/middayer **Jim Hunter** is interim PD and handling afternoons.

Album **WYNF** Sarasota, Fla., PD/MD **Eric Stevens** exits the station.

Triple-A **KXST** (Sets-FM) San Diego has moved its antenna, allowing it to boost its transmitter to 14.5 kilowatts and increase its coverage.

Album **WWDC** (DC101) Washington, D.C., morning man **Will Pendarvis** signs with modern **KTBS** (the Buzz) Houston for wake-up duties,

paired with morning-show producer **Tony Angelo**, last at active **WTPT** Greenville, S.C. **Angelo** also spent time at top 40 **KRBE** in the market.

In other Nationwide morning-show news, classic hits **KXGL** San Diego forms the **Brink and Otis** show for mornings. **Scotty Brink**

most recently held an on-air shift at country **KYCW** Seattle, though he has a history in San Diego as PD/air talent for classic rock **KSDO-FM** from 1989 to '91. **Judd Otis** joins from the **Bob and Judd** morning show at AC **WUSA** Tampa, Fla. (now **WAKS**). The station's **Jane Asher** handles news and sports.

Classic rock **KSD** St. Louis PD **Steve Brill** has assembled an air staff chock-full of market rock radio veterans. Station veteran **Mark Klose** will join **J.C. Corcoran** in mornings and then stay on through middays. **Asher "Smash" Benrubi**—previously morning host of crosstown album **KSHE** and former **Corcoran** rival—takes afternoons, joined by sports director **Steve Schlanger** and traffic guy **Lance Hildebrand**. **Sam Prowler** serves as the bridge between **Klose** and **Smash**, from 1-3 p.m. He comes from nights at album **WFBQ** Indianapolis and also was part of **WFBQ's** syndicated **Bob and Tom** morning show. **Debbie Alexander** joins from classic rock **WCKG** Chicago for nights, and **Jonathan "J.B." Breier** is heard in overnights.

Album **WFBQ** Indianapolis MD **Ace Cosby** picks up the late-night shift.

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Black Lab Collaborates In The Laboratory

When a band's productivity stems from one person writing and singing the songs, it is not uncommon for that person to seek complete control in a solo situation. But **Black Lab** singer/songwriter/guitarist **Paul Durham** wanted "more of a collaboration with the guys." So he disbanded his acoustic-based **Durham**, which was starting to get attention from labels in the San Francisco area. In doing so, he ingratiated himself to a longtime but reluctant supporter, Geffen A&R rep **Jim Barber**, who had liked his songs but thought the previous group needed a bigger sound. When Durham phoned him with the news, Barber invited the songwriter down to Atlanta to cut some demos.

Durham returned to the Bay Area with a renewed sense of direction and a mission to find the ideal band, which for him meant an ensemble that wasn't merely content to take orders. He found accomplices in **Sleepers** and **Pieces Of Lisa**, two Bay Area bands—guitarist **Michael Belfer** and bass player **Geoff Stanfield**. Durham's tunes, which he describes as "basically folk songs that I write at home in my bedroom on acoustic guitar," were suddenly transformed into "whole other worlds." The merging of stark, obsessive love songs with a louder, mainstream rock sound led to a deal for **Black Lab** in November '95.

Hailing from Twin Falls, Idaho, Durham describes feeling like "an outsider" after his parents left the primary congregation of the Mormon-dominated town to seek other forms of enlightenment, eventually choosing Buddhism. Further isolating his son from the future farmers of America, Durham's father prohibited Paul from listening to rock-'n-roll, substituting Irish folk music and opera, though the **Waterboys** and **Van Morrison** managed to slip by.

However, it was an inevitability that he'd discover rock music—especially after getting a Walkman in the ninth grade. When he did, the music that best spoke to his left-of-center upbringing was punk and hardcore. While most of his class-


mates went for **Kiss** and **Def Leppard**, Durham dove right into the punk rock of **7 Seconds**, **Youth Brigade**, **Minor Threat**, and others, through friends who bought records directly from Discord Records, the Washington, D.C., punk label owned by **Fugazi's Ian MacKaye**. "There was with nothing else going on socially or musically; it really did save my life," he says. "It allowed me to unplug from the kind of social-climbing atmosphere and shallow-mindedness of my high school, which was just about kids getting drunk."

Though he eventually did branch out and became acquainted with "cool pop stuff," such as the **Psychedelic Furs**, and developed an affinity for **Bob Dylan**, who was his inspiration when he first picked up an acoustic guitar in high school, he was about as familiar with classic rock as the **Dalai Lama**. "We'll be listening to rock radio and something will come on and I'll go, 'What's this?' and they'll just go, 'It's **ZZ Top**. What the fuck do you mean, 'What's this?'" They think I'm a freak."

Ironically, **Black Lab** took its name from an early conversation among its members about the direction of the band being a cross between **Black Sabbath** and **Stereolab**, which, of course, "didn't really end up kind of being that way," he says with a laugh. But the name, however, took on another meaning during the period of rehearsals for the group's debut album, "Your Body Above Me." Apparently the studio it was housed in had a set of lights that would emit so much heat that the band often ended up rehearsing in the dark. "The studio had this very strong laboratory sense to it. We were doing a lot improvisation, playing for six hours at a time, and trying to grow the band with the songs and arrangements."

Durham's songs speak of jealousy, ambivalence, and yearning and are permeated by the ebb and flow of the band, even though the other group members were unfamiliar with the lyrics until Durham actually laid down the vocals for the album, bespeaking an intuition by the band to play to a vibe. "After sweating on some of these songs for almost a year, it was like, 'Oh, this is what he's saying.' They are total musicians; words are whatever," Durham says with a laugh.

soms could explode, why not BoDeans? Why not Del Amitri? Those are two bands that had a pretty good start before these other bands, but it's all timing." (Both acts have, in fact, ridden the recent pop/rock revolution to one top 40 hit apiece, but neither has yet parlayed that into multi-format superstardom.)

Speaking of timing, Benson sees a fatal flaw in early triple-A artist development. "The triple-A format had a somewhat negative tendency to just embrace artists and not look for the best songs," he says. "The format's come to the point where it's much more song aware, and it's much easier to launch an artist based on a song rather than an image."

Triple-A KTCZ Minneapolis PD Lauren MacLeash put her head together with MD Jane Fredericksen and came up with a list, starting with Vega. "She was before her time," says MacLeash.

"Lowen & Navarro," she adds. "If they got the right producer and the right record company, they might be able to produce something that could cross over from triple-A to modern adult."

MacLeash sees the likes of Amos, Chris Isaak, Michelle Shocked, and Bruce Cockburn as "artists who had a time when they really hit it, but then they wandered off into some conceptual direction or something" and since have not recourted radio with "friendly" music.

"Maybe another one who is set in her ways is Rickie Lee Jones," says MacLeash. "At one time with 'Magazine' [and albums of that era], she really had her heart in it. Since then [she] hasn't put out anything that I felt that she cared about."

Finally, observes MacLeash, "the common thread with Jewel, Fiona, and other Lilith Fair-esque acts is the songs are pretty mainstream. They're not too deep. They're not too folksy. They've got good production value. There were a lot of singer/songwriters in the beginning who were better writers than performers. What these women have going for them is that they're great performers."

BOWIE HAS BELIEVERS

Bruce Warren, MD for noncommercial triple-A WXPB Philadelphia and co-producer of the nationally syndicated "World Cafe," kicked things into a rock gear, mentioning two acts that rode the last modern-rock crossover boom for a while.

Citing David Bowie's early, less commercially successful collaborations with Brian Eno on "Low," "Lodger," and "Heroes," he says, "There's no difference between the electronica of Bowie's 'Heroes' and the new U2 album," which is hailed as a breakthrough. "[Eno and Bowie] were so ahead of their time . . . Those songs from Bowie work better now than they did back then."

In a similar vein, Warren eyes the Talking Heads. "If 'Remain In Light' came out today, it would be hailed as an ambient/electronica masterpiece," he says. "That record was definitely totally ahead of its time. It still is. There's nothing out in [the current crop of] electronica that comes close."

Warren adds, "The Pixies were totally underrated and didn't get their due, sonically, lyrically. The soft-loud distortion thing the

Pixies had down really well. Steve Albini worked with that band from the first day, and he went on to produce all those great albums."



alongside Goldfinger and whatever other ska band of the day is out."

Warren also cites the Story, the duo of Jonatha Brooke and Jennifer Kimball, as being "ahead of its time" on "Grace And Gravity" and "The Angel In The House."

Warren's list includes Jeff Buckley, Edie Brickell, Donald Fagen, Dream Academy, Prefab Sprout, John Wesley Harding, House Of Love, Darling Buds, and Ride. "Fucking Noel and Liam [Gallagher of Oasis] would be shit without Ride."

Triple-A WXLE Albany, N.Y., PD Neil Hunter agrees with MacLeash's take on Rickie Lee Jones. "I'm not sure she cut through well enough," he says. And he brings up the Story, which was the first time triple-A became acquainted with Jonatha Brooke, who is now set for her second solo album (her first without a reference to the Story), "10¢ Wings."

Andrea Karr had programmed SWE Cable Radio for years and is now doing promotions with Wind-Up. She picks up the Tori Amos thread, saying, "The song that specifically comes to mind is 'Cornflake Girl.' If that was a brand-new single, that would happen. I can't imagine that Fiona Apple didn't hear or wasn't influenced by Tori Amos."

She still calls Mark Lanegan's "Carnival" one of her favorite songs. She also felt strongly about the Jayhawks' "Blue," Massive Attack's "Protection," and "You Won't Fall" from Lori Carson's "Where It Goes" album."

Karr was one of those who cited Jonatha Brooke. "She has an exquisite voice and potential," says Karr. With her next effort slated for an early November release, "it will be interesting to see what happens with it."

Elektra's Lisa Michelson cited Brooke but proudly reported that Tracy Chapman and Natalie Merchant, both Elektra acts, had done a lot of the trailblazing and were happily still around today.

Up in Boston, triple-A WXRV PD Joanne Doody pointed to Clannad. "I loved them to death and never understood why they couldn't go anywhere," she says. "That music is so beautiful."

(In case you're wondering what thoughts swirled around here in-house: Airplay Monitor editor Sean Ross has, like many people, suggested publicly that Roxy Music offered the blueprint for much of today's modern adult music. And the inspiration for this story came when managing editor Marc Schiffman got the new Julia Fordham album and wondered what would have happened had her Virgin debut come out today.)

Todd Little Uses Jacor Synergy In San Diego To Keep Out KGB Wannabes

"I knew the legacy of KGB from afar, because it was so massive," says Todd Little, who took the PD seat at the San Diego classic rocker at the beginning of '97. "I knew the history of KGB back in Cincinnati when I was working nights [at Jacor sister WEBN]. It's been my job to fan those flames and bring back that mystique of KGB."

In the summer book, KGB pushed forward 3.6-3.8 12-plus and was the top rock station in one of the most rock-heavy markets in the country. "Top-of-mind awareness is probably the greatest thing that we've tried to do," says Little. "Out of sight, out of mind, is a real problem in radio. Unless you have billboards up and television and constantly remind people that we are the classic rock brand name in San Diego, they tend to wander and meander away."

Even at a classic rock station, Little says, fixing the music was Job One. "The only reason

hemian Rhapsody"; and Asia, "Only Time Will Tell."

If "World Class Rock" calls to mind triple-A KBCO Denver, there's good reason. Little spent a good five years in that market with Jacor, prior to its purchase of KBCO. "The cool thing about KBCO and . . . what we try to do with KGB as well is that KBCO eats, sleeps, and drinks Boulder, Colo.," Little says. "And KGB, hopefully, eats, sleeps, and drinks everything that's cool about San Diego, from surf reports to tourism stuff, sports, and certainly lifestyle."

Crucial in reclaiming KGB's heritage was to evaluate talent. "We brought back some of the veterans that had gotten away from KGB," says Little, who cites placing market veterans Coe Lewis in afternoons and John Leslie in nights as crucial. "Most important, Dave, Shelly, and Chainsaw, our morning show, have come back to KGB [from co-owned KIOZ]. The theory is that we want to make KGB comfortable to listen to again. If you've got an emotional attachment to KGB, we tried to fan those flames and to basically make it warm and fuzzy again."

As his alma mater WEBN did, KGB had relied on fireworks as a station benchmark for years. But under a previous owner it had "withered away to nothing," Little says. "We decided to take it back to its original form of fireworks with music. We promoted it earlier than normal. Historically, the radio station had only promoted the show 30 days out. We did it 3½ months out. We brought in a new producer to change the image of Sky Show, to bring it into the '90s. We added other features to make it more interesting, [like] a photography contest."

The Sky Show was designed to follow a Major League Baseball game. "We chose a date that we thought would be conducive to a huge attendance," says Little. And the station got more than anyone bargained for. "We broke an attendance record, not only in San Diego this year, but also in Major League Baseball—60,230."

And he used Jacor muscle, promoting the event among the 10-station cluster in the market. "There's a synergy in Jacor that we need to be pioneering in," Little says. "For example, it's World Series time, and our sportscaster in the morning says, 'You can watch the game tonight on channel 7 or hear it on [XETRA-AM] Xtra Sports 690.' If you've got 10 radio stations, there's a tremendous come in all 10 of those radio stations. If we keep them in the family, we're going to do OK . . . It's just a synergy that's no different from NBC using CNBC or MSNBC. It's just the way it's got to be in the future. And Jacor, being a pioneering company, believes that synergy is the answer. I'd much rather send my listeners to [N/T AM sister] KOGO, as opposed to CNN, when there's a major breaking news story."

Jacor can also flex its muscle when it comes to copping exclusivity at other events in the market. "That's where using the power of 10 Jacor stations often will prohibit a KGB-wannabe station to get in the door," says Little. Jacor can go to an event organizer and say, "Look, we'll give you an easy-listening station. We'll give you a news/talk station. We'll give you a rock'n'roll station. We'll give you a CHR.' Well, you've pretty well got it covered. You don't need anybody else. And that's been the synergy of the 10 radio stations. What we try to do is bring a lot to the table for clients, so they don't even have to think about going elsewhere."

KGB has wannabes in the market is because KGB let them be in the market," he says. "The previous management afforded an opportunity to [rival KPLN] the Planet and afforded an opportunity to KCLX years ago."

So Little tapped KGB's heritage. "We have a lot more room on the leash than most classic rock stations, because these records are not foreign to a KGB listener. When you've got a radio station that put Boston on the map, you can dig a little deeper in the library. Because of the heritage of the radio station, it gives us some license to play some different tracks, some slightly more rock-textured songs, but we don't go overboard. They come to hear great classic rock on KGB. We not only give them classic rock, we give them 'World Class Rock.' The cream of the crop. We're not afraid to play a spice track. We're not afraid to play a new track from a classic artist, like the Rolling Stones or John Mellencamp or Jackson Browne or something along those lines. Because if you liked Jackson Browne in 1972, you probably like him today in 1997."

Little is quick to add that when it comes to currents, "we don't have a power rotation. We don't add records, and we don't give them 30 spins a week. It's done usually as a then and now . . . There's a curiosity factor. It's basically a news item that the Stones have a new album out. Here's a little sample for you, just so you know that they're alive and well in 1997, just as KGB is alive and well in 1997. Music didn't stop in 1989."

Here's a sample hour on KGB: Pink Floyd, "Wish You Were Here"; Beatles, "Birthday"; Black Crowes, "Hard To Handle"; Rolling Stones, "Beast Of Burden"; Journey, "Any Way You Want It"; Foreigner, "Long, Long Way From Home"; Van Halen, "Right Now"; Who, "I'm Free"; Elton John, "Levon"; Edgar Winter Group, "Frankenstein"; Queen, "Bo-

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
