Marriage And Morning Shows Mix Well For Some On-Air Duos

They're both hard work: successful marriages and successful on-air partnerships. Perhaps that's why only a handful of brave couples are willing to tackle both challenges, and their attendant tensions, at once.

Around the country, across all formats, Monitor found only a handful of husband-and-wife duos, evenly divided over current music formats, including news/talk. "We're kind of a close-knit fraternity," says Chuck Johnson, half of Johnson and Johnson, who does mornings with wife Debbie at country WKXC Augusta, Ga. "We always run into other couples at conventions, and we look at each with this sort of knowing look in our eyes."

"At [the annual morning-show] boot camp [convention]," he adds with a laugh, "we listen to radio duos complain and say, 'Well, you don't have to live with it. Your problems could be worse, pal.'"

Among most couples surveyed, radio came before romance, leaving a budding affair to open up in front of the microphone.

For Jagger and Kristi, who handle afternoon drive for modern adult KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego, the tingle began after she had been doing traffic for Jagger's show for about a year. "We got a crush on each other," Jagger says, as he began to pull her more into the show as an integral element. Months later, they revealed to listeners that they had become a couple, thanks to a Valentine's Day promotion for which they pretended to get married.

"We weren't sure how listeners would accept it, but they seem to like the fact that we're a couple. I think they sense some kind of sexual tension," says Kristi.

"We worked together for seven or eight months before anything remotely started happening," says Debbie of Johnson and Johnson. The pair began working together in mid-'92 at a station in Waco, Texas.

Sinclair Gets A Classic Rock/Hits Combo

In a big week for format changes, Sinclair's former adult R&B outlet KXOK St. Louis dropped its simulcast of modern sister KPNT and re-launched as "The Rock—classic rock that really rocks," along the lines of WNRQ Nashville. This gives Sinclair both classic rock and classic hits outlets in the same market, since crosstown KIHT just shifted its on-air imaging from "the '70s station" to "classic hits." (The two stations are operated separately.) KPNT APD/imaging director Marty Linck is named PD of the new station.

KXOK's launch tapped into the **Mark McGwire** hysteria. It started stunting Sept. 25, alternating McGwire's theme song, "Welcome To The Jungle" by Guns N' Roses, with the phrase, "If you build it, he will come," from the film "Field Of Dreams." At the St. Louis Cardinals' final game of the season, the station flew planes around the stadium towing signs proclaiming the new station. In the ninth inning, KXOK flew a plane with a sign thanking McGwire for his 70 home runs. It's now airing 7,000 songs in a row, 100 for each 1998 home run McGwire hit.

In other format changes this week, KMJZ Minneapolis drops jazz for modern AC as the Point under new owner CBS. Overseeing KMJZ for the past week has been KAMX (Mix 94.7) Austin, Texas, PD **Dusty Hayes**. Elsewhere on the modern adult front, soft AC WXRM Fort Myers, Fla., is now Star 100, patterned on sister WSSR (Star 95.7) Tampa, Fla. Jim Radford remains PD.


KLZK Lubbock, Texas, flips from classic rock to rhythmic top 40 as Kiss 104.4 under PD Ram Rodrigues. The second Texas rocker in two weeks to become its market's second top 40, following last week's flip of album KBAT Odessa, KLZK is balanced somewhat by classic rock KHKS Abilene, Texas, which assumes the frequency of top 40 KFQX. KFQX resurfaces on KHIX frequency as an AC outlet.

Classic rock WMQC Morgantown, W.Va., flips to Jones Satellite Networks' AC feed.

Veteran Texas rock GM **Pat Fant** exits KTXQ (Q102) Dallas in the wake of that station's flip to R&B oldies. Fant is replaced by **Brian Bieler**, former president of Viacom Radio Group.

The Department of Justice has thwarted the sale of album WQWK State College, Pa.'s adult top 40 sister WIKN and two AMs from Citadel to Talleyrand, owner of crosstown AC WZWW.

Northern Indiana Broadcasting sells album WZOW South Bend, Ind., to Van Hawke-Johnson Communications.

Westwood One will launch a youth-targeted network, Source MAX, in January. Affiliates will include moderns WXRK New York, KROQ L.A., and album WYSP Philadelphia.

Album WBAB Long Island, N.Y., taps GSM **Joel Simon** from LSM at AC WLTW New York.

Classic rock KRKQ Des Moines, Iowa, PD/p.m. driver **Dan McClellan** exits.

PEOPLE: COW V. BEAR CONTINUES

The Illinois Supreme Court is hearing an appeal in the case of former Chicago Bear lineman **Keith Van Horne** vs. **Matthew "Mancow" Muller** et al. Muller's attorney **Steve Baron** claims the case could have a chilling effect on broadcasting. Van Horne claims that Muller's previous station, album WRX Chicago and then parent Evergreen Media (now Chancellor) were negligent in hiring Mancow. The case stems from a November 1994 confrontation between Muller and Van Horne. At the time, Van Horne was broadcasting his own show for the company and had a run-in with Muller in the hall. Muller claimed on the air that Van Horne had threatened his life. Van Horne initially sued for defamation but amended it to include negligence on the station's part for hiring Mancow. Although initially dismissed, an Illinois First District Appellate Court reinstated the case upon appeal. Muller's team is now appealing that decision. Baron claims that the case threatens to set a "dangerous precedent" and instill "a severe chilling effect" that would dissuade broadcasters from hiring controversial talent.

Former KITS (Live 105) San Francisco APD/middays **Roland West** is Geffen's new S.F. regional, replacing **Scott Perlowitz**, now with Reprise.

Classic rock KLRZ New Orleans welcomes market vet **Cadillac Jack** back on-air in mornings with PD **Jeff Boggs**. Local TV vet **Tom Gregory** picks up afternoons.

Album KRXQ Sacramento, Calif.'s **Justin Case** exits "The Rise Guys" morning show. Creative services director/late nights **Chris Rice** replaces him as co-host. Reach Case at 916-922-9607.

Detroit veteran **Bob Bauer** returns to radio on classic rock WWBR as **Ted Nugent's** morning co-host. He replaces the exited **Jaz McKay**.

In other Detroit-related news, former classic rock WCSX p.m. driver **Carl Coffee**, now in mornings at album WWGZ Flint, Mich., is replaced by **Steve Cooper**, from nights at classic rock KRXQ Denver; Cooper was also in mornings on Jones Satellite Network's classic rock feed.

Back at KRXQ, Cooper's long-vacant slot is filled by album KIOZ San Diego p.m. driver **Brian Christopher**, who isn't leaving San Diego but is doing the KRXQ night shift via ISDN.

Alanis Has Highest Modern Adult Debut

Alanis Morissette's "Thank U" (Maverick) makes the highest debut ever on the modern adult chart. It enters at No. 7 with Airpower honors, garnering 1,316 detections.

Since the triple-A chart was first published in Monitor in February 1996, 33 songs have hit No. 1. This issue, with "My Favorite Mistake" (A&M) topping the chart, Sheryl Crow becomes the first solo artist to hit No. 1 three times. Crow spent one week at No. 1 in October 1996 with "If It Makes You Happy" and six weeks at No. 1 during the summer of 1997 with "A Change Would Do You Good," both from her second, self-titled album. Monitor had not yet published a triple-A chart when Crow released her debut album, "Tuesday Night Music Club." The Dave Matthews Band is the only other act to get a triple-A No. 1 hat trick; "Too Much," "Don't Drink The Water," and "Stay (Wasting Time)" all hit No. 1. The group's latest, "Crush" (RCA), rises 18-13 and marks its ninth appearance on the chart.

Two of this week's modern rock entries come from artists who have left successful group situations for solo careers. Former House Of Pain rapper Everlast debuts at No. 36, and Rob Zombie, whose band White Zombie recently announced its dissolution, debuts at No. 40.

Caribou/Hawaii OM Jeff Blazy picks up mornings at the cluster's modern KPOI Honolulu.

Omnipoint Communications consumer marketing manager Roger Tashjian joins album WNEW New York as promotion director. Heading slightly east, WLIR Long Island, N.Y., promotion manager Susan Krick is upped to promotion director at that station.



Marriage And Morning Shows Mix Well For A Few On-Air Duos

and "we kept it secret there, though it was hard to keep it under wraps because we were always together. We thought that management would ultimately frown upon it."

Not so now, however; most married duos allow last night's pork chops to become part of the banter if it fits in. "I think most stations view a married couple as an inviting concept," says Davin of rhythmic top 40 KKXX (X96.5) Bakersfield, Calif., morning team Davin and Ana Fesmire. "You don't have to hope that a duo will develop good chemistry—it's already there."

"Of course, if your partner sucks," he adds, "you're both out of a job."

"People really seem to love it," says Stephanie Porter of the duo Billy Dee and Stephanie Porter at R&B WAGH Columbus, Ga. "They love to see the positive family image, especially in the black community, where there's so much talk of the disarray of the family. They can see where a man loves his wife and she loves him."

They also offer a program feature called "Dear Stephanie," where listeners call in with personal and marital problems. "We'll talk about things that work or don't work for us, things that parents face, things we love," says Porter. "They call us on the air and off. We love to share our experiences where it could help somebody else."

AGAINST THE GRAIN

In the modern rock arena, the concept of a married couple on-air might appear to go against the determinedly cynical nature of the format. Not so, according to Ernie and Jane Mills of "The Morning Edge" at KMYZ (Z104.5) Tulsa, Okla.

"We weren't sure what to expect with the modern rock format. Would I be less appealing because I wasn't a single chick anymore?" says Jane. "But the audience has embraced the whole situation. It's kind of blown us away."

"It's been like a coming of age for all of us," Ernie says. "We came up with the angst-ridden generation, and now we're getting on with life. The generation is growing up."

Their audience has also seen the couple through the birth of their first child, Fritz, and, in fact, Ernie now works from the studio, while Jane co-hosts over ISDN lines from home.

"People have embraced the whole situation. They've heard about Fritz since he was a bean," Ernie says. "Fritz said his first words over the air during our shift; he said, 'Mommy and Daddy.'"

While Eric Ferguson, half of the morning duo at modern adult WTMX (101.9, the Mix) Chicago, doesn't share mornings with fiancée Dr. Jennifer Moran, a local dentist, his relationship with her has been a regular topic of discussion with his a.m. partner on the "Eric And Kathy Show" for two years. Again, listeners have grown to care about the couple and their business.

"On the first date, I ended up kissing Jen at the end of the night," says Ferguson. The next morning on the air, he expressed second thoughts about the kiss to the Greater Chica-

go area. "I said, 'She's gotta hate me,'" says Ferguson, "and then she called in and said, 'No, it wasn't bad.'"

Ferguson's romance soon became a stock subject on the morning show. "It's nothing that's contrived to appeal to the [station's 18-34 target] demo," says Ferguson. "But since Jen and I are both in the demo, our listeners are living the same circumstances that we are. We're just living our life in a public forum."



A record that has been on the chart for more than 20 weeks will not receive a bullet, even if it registers an increase in detections. Airpower awarded to those records that attain 400 detections for the first time. If two records are tied in number of plays, the record being played on more stations is placed first. Records below the top 20 are removed from the chart after 26 weeks.




