Shortage Of Female Talent Widens Radio's Gender Gap

Programmers in all formats who have open air shifts that they are hoping to fill with a female jock are reporting an alarming shortage of female applicants. Although males in radio have always considerably outnumbered females, some PDs see that gap widening even further.

Country WJJY Des Moines, Iowa, PD Beverlee Brannigan says she gets 20 tapes from men for every one she gets from a woman and is among those who believe the problem is escalating. "There have never been as many female applicants as males, but it does seem worse to me in the last 18 months to two years," she says.

Country WQKQ Dover, N.H., PD Mark Ericson says the ratio of male to female tapes he gets for job openings is closer to 10 to 1, but, he says, "that's still way out of whack."

"When I first came to Fort Myers [Fla.], I really wanted a good female to do nights," says WWGR PD Chris O'Kelley. "I ran many ads. Not one tape came in from a female. Then I ran the same ad for

a female to do afternoons and, again, not one tape from a female came in."

"I currently have a position open for evenings and about two months ago [had] an opening for afternoons," echoes WTMF Milwaukee OM Kerry Wolfe. "Of all the tapes I received, zero were from women. I certainly wish there were more. Pickings are slim."

"Most of the tapes and résumés I have received in the past six months have overwhelmingly been from men," adds WGRX Baltimore PD Jim West. "I would certainly welcome more female air talent applicants."

In fact, of all the programmers contacted for this story, only one, WGRL Indianapolis PD John Q. Morris, says he gets enough female applicants. "During my most recent search this summer, I received enough tapes from talented females to field an entirely female lineup," he says.

NOT CRAZY ENOUGH?

For nearly everyone else, the shortage is a problem. And while

Jacor, Clear Channel Have Urge To Merge

Clear Channel Communications and Jacor Communications have announced a merger that will create the second-largest radio company in the U.S. in station count and third largest ranked by radio revenue, with 454 stations in 101 markets. The deal, valued at \$4.4 billion, awaits government and stockholder approval. There's relatively little overlap of the two entities, but there will likely be some stations spun in Jacksonville, Fla.; Houston; Tampa, Fla.; Louisville, Ky.; and Cleveland to align the deal with ownership caps. The two companies expect to close the deal Sept. 30, 1999. Jacor will continue to operate as a separate unit of Clear Channel with Randy Michaels maintaining his role as Jacor's CEO and Bobby Lawrence as its president.

BUSINESS: NEW CHANCELLOR EXECS

Marcus Cable executive VP/CFO Thomas McMillin joins Chancellor as senior VP. Marcus senior VP/general counsel Richard Gleiner joins Chancellor for the same.

Sports WFAN New York VP/GM Joel Hollander is named Westwood One president/CEO. That's the role Mel Karmazin had been handling. Karmazin maintains his position as CBS Corp. president/COO and continues to have an active role with Westwood One. One of Hollander's first orders of business was announcing Westwood One's deal with Fox News, creating a new network offering news, business, sports, features, and entertainment updates to affiliates.

In other Westwood One news, the company has renewed its MTV Radio Network joint venture.

A special tip of the entrepreneurial hat goes to Ken Roberts. In 1972, he invested \$500,000 for a 25% stake in what would soon become KROQ Los Angeles. Another half-mil or so later, he assumed total control of the station until he sold it to Infinity for more than \$42 million. He then used a very small piece of that to purchase a couple of weak signals in L.A., KACD/KBCD, and sign on techno "Mars FM." The simulcast would eventually transform into the \$67 million property Groove Radio, which Jacor closed on this week. The former dance outlets are now simulcasting top 40 KIIS in anticipation of a new format soon.

Citadel picks up 62nd Street's Saginaw, Mich., combo, including album WKQZ and classic hits WMJA and WMJK, for \$35 million. In other station sales, New Wave Broadcasting buys Caribou's four Honolulu stations, including album KPOI. And Hochman spins six Fayetteville, Ark., stations to Cumulus in a \$6.5 million deal, including modern KBRS.

Billboard Bulletin's Mike McGeever reports that London modern outlet Xfm has been fined 4,000 pounds (\$6,700) by the U.K. Radio Authority for failing to comply with its Promise of Performance to the regulator. The RA has received hundreds of complaints from listeners charging that the station has become too mainstream. Among other violations, Xfm was cited for a failure to broadcast live artist sessions. And you think your focus groups are tough?

FMTS: PEAK PACKS MORE PUNCH

Triple-A outlet KXPK (the Peak) Denver has switched focus from 25-34 adults to 18-34 males, now calling itself "The Rockies' new rock." The station is playing less Natalie Merchant and more Beastie Boys, with a lot of matchbox 20 and Dave Matthews Band still in there, according to SBR Creative Media, the station's consultant, whose Scott Strong is overseeing programming for now.

As rumored, Clear Channel launched its new Louisville modern adult, WQSH (She 93), at 5 p.m. Oct. 12. Market OM Michael Lee oversees the station. Karen Rite returns to the market as PD, joining from AC WMXB Richmond, Va. Lee calls WQSH a "very current-intensive" out-

let. The station is running 10,000 songs in a row commercial-free and jockless. And Lee is still looking for a new promotion director at album WTXF.

Classic hits outlet WZMX Hartford, Conn., reimages itself as the Point under new PD Jon Robbins.

PROGRAMMING

Consultant Dave Lange joins Capstar as VP of programming for its Midwest region. Lange joins Capstar regional VPs of programming Alan Furst (mid-South), Buddy Scott (mid-Atlantic), Dave Dillon (Southeast), and Harve Alain (Northeast).

Country WDD-FM Carbondale, Ill., PD/MD Tracy McSherry adds OM duties for Cumulus' Southern Illinois group, which includes album WTAO and classic rock WQUL.

Classic rock KRCH Rochester, Minn., OM Jack Hicks becomes PD of classic rock WOZZ Appleton, Wis.

Jones Radio Network adds three of the operations managers of its satellite networks to its consulting team, including classic rock OM Rich Bryan.

CD Radio unveils its programming department: Music Choice head of programming operations Jim Kessler becomes director of programming operations. Cindy Sivak, veteran of the launch of the MTV Radio Network, joins as director of industry and talent affairs. And Maria Carchidi, last manager of all music formats at Music Choice, becomes CD Radio director of music programming. On the format-specific front, Pat St. John, former PD/morning man of album WNEW New York, heads rock, with syndicated radio veteran Don Kaye. Prime 66 Partners L.P. buys a \$100 million interest in CD Radio, making it a 20% shareholder.

CD Radio rival, American Mobile Radio Corp., is now known as XM Satellite Radio and announces a number of deals with third-party program providers, including Heftel, which will contribute five Spanish-language channels.

Modern KROX Austin, Texas, MD/afternoon host Lloyd Hocutt and midday host Rachel exit.

Album KAZR Des Moines, Iowa, PD Sean Elliott comes off the air. Ryan Castle, who had split afternoons with Elliott, gets the whole shift. Jolene Michaels joins for middays from album KATS Yakima, Wash., and Jeff "Clutch" Kelly joins for nights from P/T at album WRQC Minneapolis. Across the street, modern KKDM production director Danny Bishop takes middays, as night guy Jamie Marchiori picks up production. Audrey Phillips moves from overnights to afternoons.

Blair Schultze, last with classic hits KXGL San Diego, joins oldies KBG Seattle's creative department.

Hole Digs In At No. 1 On Modern Chart

If Hole's "Celebrity Skin" (DGC/Geffen) can hold onto the No.1 spot at modern rock for one more week, Courtney Love's latest single will have tied her late husband Kurt Cobain's longest chart-topping single, "Heart-Shaped Box," which Nirvana kept at the top for three weeks in October 1993. "Celebrity Skin" (DGC/Geffen) is Love's first No. 1 at modern rock. Nirvana had four No. 1 modern tracks, but only "Heart-Shaped Box" and "All Apologies" held the top position for more than one week.

U2 hits the mainstream rock chart for the 39th time with "Sweetest Thing" (Island). The foursome has had 18 top 10 tracks, including seven No. 1 songs. Meanwhile, R.E.M. makes its 33rd mainstream rock appearance with "Daysleeper" (Warner Bros.), the lead track from "Up," which hits stores Oct. 27. The Athens, Ga.-based band has had 14 top 10 hits at mainstream rock, including three No. 1 tracks. "Daysleeper" debuts at triple-A this week, claiming Airpower status at No. 6. "Bittersweet Me," the third of three chart hits from "New Adventures In Hi-Fi," spent four weeks atop the triple-A chart in November 1996.

Jewel's "Hands" (Atlantic) is her first appearance at modern adult since "Foolish Games," which debuted at No. 22 on July 26, 1997. "Games" peaked at No. 6 two months later.

MUSICAL CHAIRS: Atlantic's Andrea Ganis is upped to executive VP . . . Island associate director of Midwest promotion Jeff Davis is named associate director of CHR promotion. Davis will remain in Chicago, while New York-based promotion assistant Joe Daddio will relocate to Chicago for regional responsibilities.

Former Interscope head of alternative promotion Lynn McDonnell joins Time Bomb Recordings, based in Laguna Beach, Calif. Kurt Steffek, former MTV director of programming, joins the label, based in New York . . . Mercury national manager of modern rock promotion Christine Chiappetta is upped to national director of modern rock promotion, West Coast . . . Elektra ups Midwest alternative promotion director John Stewart to national director of alternative promotion, East Coast. Stewart will be based in New York, using his given name, John Biondillo.

MONITOR PROFILE

Frisina Finds Experience Creative Freedom By Staying Put At 95X

Dave Frisina is one of those radio anomalies who found a job with a station in 1978 and is still working there 20 years later. Frisina was there when album WAQX (95X) Syracuse, N.Y., launched under PD Ted Utz. Today, several owners and several PDs later, Frisina is the station's APD and part of a heritage air staff, still in the same midday shift he's had for about a decade, though he now follows the syndicated Howard Stern show. "Some people have to move around to a dozen stations to work for half a dozen good programmers. I just had to stay here for 20 years to work for half a dozen good programmers," Frisina says.

In 1978, he says, "we were the first rock station in town. There have been a bunch that have come and gone since then. We've seen two or three classic rockers come and go. We've had to bend and lean one way or the other strategically, but we're basically still an AOR rock station."

Because of its demographic mix, he says, "Syracuse is one of the bigger test markets." Musically, it is "a classic-leaning, guitar-based,

going to play the better bands that they can play also, except that we're mixing in Monster Magnet and the Tragically Hip and the Goos and Semisonic and Second Coming with Led Zeppelin and Pink Floyd and Metallica and the Stones. And there are enough people in this area that want to hear rock as they define rock, as Pearl Jam and Led Zeppelin. If you leave out one of those elements, people will go somewhere where they can find both."

Although it's both his and the station's 20th anniversary this year, Frisina says that 95X "had to tread lightly on [its heritage], because we didn't want to get to the point where you go on the air and you're constantly patting yourself on the back, reminding people of how long the station's been around. We're still one foot in the '90s." He points to the station's 20th birthday concert, which featured Kenny Wayne Shepherd and Van Halen. It was, he says, "a perfect mix of a kid who's 20 or 21 years old and a band that's been around for 20 or 21 years... That was a good reflection of the kind of radio station we are."

Following Stern in middays, Frisina concentrates on getting 95X back into music. "We basically follow him up with music right up through noon, and then I come in and do a lot of features and things at noon to get back on track with what the rest of the radio station is," says Frisina.

To add continuity, "we're constantly cross-promoting during his show," he says. "All of the jocks have drop-ins that go through the show that pre-promote things that are coming up later on in the day, so that it's not just two separate radio stations. Luckily, Paul Turner was our outside station voice prior to us even getting Howard, and he does Howard's show too. So there's a continuity there."

After 20 years of different jobs at 95X, Frisina says his overnight gig was the most memorable. "I had no playlist to work with whatsoever. I could do whatever I wanted to do. I could make any kind of long-distance phone calls and put them on the air," Frisina says. "The freedom that I had then was unbelievable. That part of it is something that I'll never get back because it was just totally off the top of my head."

"I just decided to make the most of it. I was going to make sure that everybody knew what I was doing. I called it 'Dave Radio' and made up my own T-shirts. I was doing a morning show from midnight to 6, and I was promoting the hell out of myself. Instead of just going, 'Well, I'm just going in to do my shift until I get a better one,' I just said, 'Screw that. I'm going to be the best overnight guy in the city.' I still have people coming up now going, 'Oh man, Dave Radio. I used to listen to you when I was working the graveyard shift'... Unfortunately, people don't get a chance to do that anymore because overnights are being automated or it's hard to get in at that level."

With Virtual Radio and automation taking that training ground away, Frisina says that college radio should take on the talent development role. "Unfortunately, you see college stations wanting to emulate the big leagues and tighten down and making it harder for people to break in. I don't think I would have made it into radio coming out of college now like I did because I knew next to nothing."

He further questions if as many people are drawn to radio as in the past. "It's just not an easy gig where you walk in for four hours like it used to be. And it's tougher to get people interested in radio because now there are so many other [entertainment] choices," he says. "So you've really got to take those people under your wing if you can find them and give them as much as they can handle."
