Top 40/Crossover Format At Crossroads?

Have the Rembrandts become a dance act? Are C&C Music Factory a core act for top 40/rhythm-crossover radio again? Is Bryan Adams?

Not quite. But as the format goes through its broadest phase in several years, top 40/rhythm-crossover stations, particularly the Hispanic-targeted West Coast outlets, are making some surprising musical choices.

• Adams' "Have You Ever Really Loved A Woman?" has become his first crossover chart record in several years, peaking at No. 29 on the Top 40/Rhythm-Crossover chart two weeks ago on the strength of heavy airplay at KGGI Riverside, Calif., WBBM (B96) Chicago, KBOS Fresno, Calif., and others.

• The Rembrandts' pop smash, "I'll Be There For You," has shown up on Top 40 Airplay Monitor's crossover Impact page with airplay at B96, KKXX Bakersfield, Calif., WOVV West Palm Beach, Fla., and others.

• C&C's "Robi-Rob's Boriqua Anthem" was last week's most-played song on KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles, which rarely breaks non-hip-hop product. Power also plays the Bucketheads' "The Bomb! (These Sounds Fall Into My Mind)," another house record that has attracted some unlikely stations and Selena's ballad "I Could Fall In Love."

• KMEL, San Francisco and rival KYLD (Wild 107) have both stretched their boundaries in recent weeks. Besides KMEL's much publicized adding of Green Day's "When I Come Around" earlier this year, both stations played Annie Lennox's "No More I Love You's." KMEL, which usually leans more R&B than KYLD, has also joined its rival in supporting Selena and the Bucketheads.

Some of the current broadening is reminiscent of 1993, when many of the same stations were part of the brief-lived "freestyle" renaissance, as PDs hailed records by Lil Suzy and

WZJM (Jammin' 92.3) Cleveland and WMQX Greensboro, N.C. Clark was best known at WHJX and WZJM for his modern rock/hip-hop/top 40 hybrid, the Channel X format.

Clark's wife, longtime WZJM promotion director Marie Griffin, will follow him to Pittsburgh, leaving that station with a promotion director opening.

Parker Joins KKFR; NYC Mod War Update

I just flew in from New York, and let me tell you, I'll never forget the sights, the smells, the vibrant colors—and that was just the stuff stuck to the bottom of my shoes after a week in Times Square. But I digress. Judging from the time on my official Bolex watch, purchased from one of the many helpful sales consultants I met in the city streets, it's Jan. 32, 1974, time for the latest news:

Don Parker was last the PD of modern rock KTBZ (the Buzz) Houston, but it was his "musical knowledge of a mainstream-leaning rhythmic format" that led Broadcast Group CEO Fred Weber to tap him as the new PD of KKFR (Power 92) Phoenix.

Curious about New York's modern rock war? Here are p.m. drive monitors of top 40 WHTZ (Z100), which has backed down considerably on dance product in recent weeks, and WNEW-FM, which debuted a new adult-leaning modern format last week. Z100: Pearl Jam, "Better Man"; Better Than Ezra, "Good"; R.E.M., "It's The End Of The World As We Know It"; Live, "All Over You"; Hootie & the Blowfish, "Let Her Cry"; Sponge, "Plowed"; Counting Crows, "Mr. Jones"; Bon Jovi, "This Ain't A Love Song"; and Meat Puppets, "Backwater." WNEW-FM: U2, "Desire"; Matthew Sweet, "Sick Of Myself"; Live, "I Alone"; the Rolling Stones, "Time Waits For No One"; Pearl Jam, "Alive"; Neil Young, "Downtown"; Stone Temple Pilots, "Dancing Days"; Cranberries, "Linger"; Foo Fighters, "This Is A Call."

In top 40/adult news: Look for Linda Silver from WRQX (Mix 107.3) Washington, D.C., to be the new MD at WMXV (Mix 105)

New York, replacing Mary Franco. Also, consultant Jack Taddeo adds WTMX (Mix 101.9) Chicago as a client. And at WZPK Portland, Maine, Louise Clark is the new PD and Stu Kenly, from AC WLNH Laconia, N.H., is the new MD/midday host.

Consultant Bill Richards adds WXXL (XL106.7) Orlando, Fla., as a client.

Ken Wall, most recently PD of country KMKV (the Maverick) Little Rock, Ark., returns to top 40 as PD of WZYP Huntsville, Ala., replacing Cat Thomas . . . PD Terry Simmons and MD Nikki Cruz are out at WPXR (Power 98.9) Davenport, Iowa, following that station's takeover by Segue Communications. Chuck O'Brien, from oldies rival KUUL, is the new PD/OM, as WPXR heads toward top 40/adult. Call Simmons at 319-359-7347.

Former KHQT (Hot 97.7) San Jose, Calif. morning team J.V. and Elvis Medina resurface at KYLD (Wild 107.7) San Francisco, replacing Frank Lozano . . . WNVZ (Z104) Norfolk, Va., moves Sean Sellers from afternoons to mornings, as John Trout returns to Indianapolis. Z104 also needs a news director.

At KXTZ Las Vegas, "Hitman" Haze joins for nights from WHJX Jacksonville, Fla. Mojo, last with WKCI (KC101) New Haven, Conn., was finishing up a deal to join KXTZ for afternoons at press time. KKXX Bakersfield, Calif., MD Kozman, who had initially accepted afternoons at KXTZ, is now headed to modern KDJK Modesto, Calif., as PD.

Former WIOQ (Q102) Philadelphia PD Jefferson Ward resurfaces in Philly radio this week as national sales manager of WPLY (Y100) . . . WHTZ night jock Freddie Vedder is filling in as the host of Westwood One's "Future Hits" replacing Joel Denver . . . "Banana" Joe Montione, last in radio as PD of WUSA Tampa, Fla., is the new morning man at '70s gold WMGK Philadelphia.

KTMT Medford, Ore., morning partner Dan Cheek resigns after 11 years with the station to pursue a career as a standup comic. Night guy Bryan O'Conner goes to mornings and overnighter Chris Adams to nights.

Monitor Offers Industry The Big Picture

In addition to our brand-new news section, this week Top 40 Airplay Monitor introduces a new chart, The Big Picture, on page 6. The Big Picture is a combined ranking of the most-listened-to records on all four radio formats included in Top 40 Airplay Monitor: mainstream, rhythm-crossover, adult, and modern rock. For the first time in Top 40 Airplay Monitor, The Big Picture ranks songs by the number of listeners, rather than just by the number of plays. Audience estimates for each song are computed by cross-referencing exact times of airplay as logged by Broadcast Data Systems with audience estimates for that time period supplied by Arbitron.

Specifically, the features contained in The Big Picture, starting at the left of the page, include rankings of the 40 most-listened-to songs with all four formats combined, for this week and last week. Bullets are awarded to songs that gained audience compared to last

week. No record shows more than eight weeks on the chart so far, because we started test charts eight weeks ago. The columns of data to the right of the song title and artist show the combined audience (in millions) and number of detections for this week and last. Also included are the detection rankings for comparison.

Finally, there are columns showing the individual audience and detection totals by format, so at a glance you can see not only the total airplay for a record, but what part of the airplay comes from each format. The rankings in the individual format breakdowns come from our existing detection charts printed this week in Top 40 Airplay Monitor, so records that have already gone to recurrent do not carry rankings, and records below No. 40 on the format charts also are not ranked.

As always, Top 40 Airplay Monitor is a work in progress, and we'd love to hear your opinions about The Big Picture. We hope it will prove a valuable addition to our package of airplay information.

What Happened To Small-Market Top 40?

RIGHT LIGHTS, BIG PITY:

These are the top 40 AMs I grew up listening to in the mid-'70s: CKLW Detroit, WLS Chicago, WKBW Buffalo, N.Y., WFIL Philadelphia, WRKO Boston, and WHVR Hanover, Pa.

You probably haven't heard many air checks of WHVR. I don't have any. Neither does the one former employee I've run across. Barely audible 90 miles away at my home in Washington, D.C., WHVR was, for a 14-year-old chart junkie, the place to hear songs before CKLW or WKBW, which were hardly lax on new music themselves. And WHVR never weeded its gold, meaning that in 1977, one could hear both "I Feel Love" by Donna Summer and "Mr. Lee" by the Bobbettes.

If I had air checks, I would probably discover that WHVR wasn't such a well-programmed station. It was still a significant part of my adolescence, along with WCDQ Hamden, Conn., WPRW Manassas, Va., and WCGY Lawrence, Mass.—other small-market or suburban top 40s at a time when such stations were plentiful and had a clear purpose in the industry: warming up new music for the medium markets so they in turn could warm it up for the big cities.

There are still promo people who remember spreading records from Bakersfield, Calif., to Fresno, Calif., to San Francisco, say, but theirs are distant memories now. Small-market "starter" stations and any sort of regionalism evaporated in the mid-'80s, a casualty of both MTV's ability to break records nationwide and, in particular, the promotion mentality that saw individual stations as only part of the boxcar number of new adds needed weekly.

Soon, small-market top 40 didn't just lose its individuality, it lost stations, too. Small markets didn't feel the effect of country in 1992. They've always felt it. And although small-market stations were the outlets with the fewest competitors and the most opportunity to be mass appeal, they also had the owners least likely to want to explain "Rump Shaker" to their Kiwanis buddies. And as small-market radio increasingly became satellite-delivered, operators could switch to oldies or Z-Rock or adult R&B—formats that had once been too exotic for small markets—but not a mainstream, full-time major network top 40 format on satellite. (The one such existing format had also gone hot AC by the early '90s.)

Satellite penetration also meant small-market top 40s were no longer serving their other purpose of developing talent for larger markets. Washington, D.C., had at least four suburban top 40 AMs in the mid-'70s—at least 30 people reading this column will have worked at one of them. While a lot of top 40 PDs may have begun their careers by playing country or AC or religious tapes, we're headed for a day when anybody lucky enough to find a first job will have to do so in another format.

There is fear that deregulation will lead to a further homogenization of radio, making the dial a strip mall of Gap stores, Starbucks,

and Outback Steakhouses. Actually there was always cloning of the top markets. It's just worse when there's less worth passing down. Hearing 1973 air checks of 37 different stations running the "Last Contest" is a lot more tolerable than hearing 37 different stations billing themselves as "Today's best music" and playing "Faithfully" by Journey.

As for what might be passed up to the larger markets by those small market top 40s that persevere, one must consider that long before there was a modern/top 40 hybrid format on WHTZ (Z100) New York, there were modern/top 40 hybrid formats on KFIZ Idaho Falls, Idaho, KIOC Beaumont, Texas, and the like. Five years ago, big-city PDs ignored those stations because they thought their markets were different. Now they have stations of their own market size to watch. Hot ACs have brought back '80s gold with much fanfare. Small-market top 40 never discarded it, meaning that many large-market stations' research has led them to sound like stations that aren't researched at all.

Collage as an antidote to what they then saw as too much hardcore rap. This broadening, coming when even some crossover outlets have downplayed rap, also suggests a vote of no confidence on available product by some PDs and/or an attempt by some to broaden their demos.

As one national director of crossover promotion puts it, crossover radio "is so fragmented now that it's not really a format. There are stations that lean dance. There are stations that lean R&B that do play rap. Some stations lean Hispanic but have more of a pop vibe. So how do you break a record?"

"There was a time when the crossover format was there because those stations were playing records that other people weren't playing. Now if you take rap out of the picture—and to a large extent, crossover stations have done that themselves—most of the crossover outlets are just top 40 stations. They're playing the same records that a KIIS Dallas or KIFI Austin, Texas, or WFHN New Bedford, Mass., would play."

Many crossover PDs have traditionally seen their stations as having a license to break format for the right record. Over the 10-year history of the format, such unlikely pop megahits as "I Touch Myself," "Kokomo," and Adams' own "Everything I Do (I Do It For You)" have been embraced, briefly, by some rhythmic top 40s.

As B96 PD Todd Cavanah notes, "Every now and then we get a 'Stay' by Lisa Loeb or 'The Power Of Love' by Celine Dion that just crosses all boundaries. Songs where we look like we're not the true hit station for the market if we don't play them." The Rembrandts and Adams hits, he notes, were already testing well at B96. "The Rembrandts record is just so big right now. I know it really stands out on the radio station, but I think it fits for what it is."

Power 106 MD Bruce St. James says the decisions to play C&C and the Bucketheads—which were already testing for his station—and Selena were not a deliberate change in musical strategy but "just happened to come at the same time. C&C and the Bucketheads were getting tremendous response from the mix show, and our DJs were telling us that these records really worked. . . We don't think the Selena is totally out of our realm either. It's almost like a Latina [version of] Brandy, a young, fresh voice singing about love."

So if the decision to expand reflects a larger number of usable records outside the format's recent boundaries, does it mean there are fewer hits from traditional sources? One indicator is that the bottom of Top 40 Airplay Monitor's Top 40/Rhythm-Crossover chart has been unusually soft recently, with four titles recharting last week.

Cavanah, whose station relies more on dance than hip-hop, is not feeling a product shortage. "Over the last six months, we've had weeks when we were digging for records. Now there's more available." But St. James sees "a little bit of a leveling out in hip-hop . . . Everything we see says that there's an appetite for hip-hop, but that the records aren't meeting our current expectations. Sometimes you have to look for something else."

Some of that, St. James says, stems from KPWR being a West Coast outlet at a time when "core West Coast [hip-hop] artists aren't making records. We haven't had a Snoop Doggy Dogg record in a year. We haven't had a Dr. Dre record, aside from the single from 'Friday.'"

St. James is quick to note that Power's broader music does not indicate a broader demographic target. "We've gotten burned a little in the past by

trying to be more than we are. We're . . . geared toward young Latinos. We can't try to be the black station and the pop station, too."

But Cavanah notes that there are ongoing discussions at B96 "about whether we're trying to please Hispanics or whites first." And other programmers, like XHTZ (Z90) San Diego OM Lisa Vazquez, do hope to expand their demos. "In markets like ours, where you can't be too urban but still have to be loyal to the 'hood,' she says, "we're finding out that with Seal's 'Kiss From A Rose' and Bryan Adams, for the few people we may [alienate], we're making 98% happy."

Bay Area crossover rivals KMEL and KYLD have emerged from their crossover experiments with different ideas about where the boundaries lie. PD Michelle Santosuosso is pleased with KMEL's forays toward the pop side. "We are a top 40 station, and it's important for us to be diverse," she says, noting that when KMEL tried Green Day and Seal, those songs were staged carefully on the air. "Once listeners take ownership of a record that's out of the format, then suddenly it's in their hands and out of yours."

By contrast, KYLD assistant PD/MD Michael Martin says his station tried the Annie Lennox record, but decided it wasn't compatible with the station. For the same reason, KYLD researched but never played Bryan Adams. "People who tuned in wanted Naughty By Nature, Notorious B.I.G., and TLC, and [Adams] wasn't why they came to the station." Martin remains a staunch supporter of non-R&B dance records, however.

Most of the East Coast's crossover outlets have actually gone less pop in recent months. WERQ (92Q) Baltimore PD tried Dionne Farris, Des'ree, and even "Can You Feel The Love Tonight" last winter but wasn't happy with the results. R&B WJHM Orlando, Fla., which has always played pop crossovers, also phased out Real McCoy, Corona, Stevie B., etc., following several bad Arbitrums. Of the crossover stations closest to R&B, only KBXX Houston has a pop title—"I Could Fall In Love"—in its top 40 most-played songs at the moment.

Crossover's changing posture means that its label reps are being pulled in different directions. RCA national pop/crossover promotion director Kim Hughes finds herself in the position of having records like LaBouche's "Fallin' In Love" considered "too pop" by some of her stations, and having big-selling rap records that aren't played beyond mix shows and the more hip-hop-driven East Coast stations. Besides WQHT (Hot 97) New York, she says, "most of these stations say they play hip-hop, and they do, but it's heavily dayparted. They're not stepping out on these records. They're playing them in the mix show for 4-6 weeks to see if there's any reaction, and then it's 'goodbye, record!'"

"Two years ago, Naughty By Nature's 'Feel Me Flow' would have been all over the map in a couple of weeks, but it's taken a minute this time," says Tommy Boy promotion director Mike Beccce. "Outlets are just disappearing. You turn around and there's no [WLUM] Milwaukee or [WIOQ] Philadelphia."

Island Records national director of crossover promotions Marthe Reynolds also goes through "more hoops" with an R&B or rap record now. MoKenStef's "He's Mine" went top five at crossover radio, she says, but not before proving that it sold, got requests, and researched. Dance records, by comparison, "have an easier time of it [now because] there are fewer out there."

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PROGRAMMER PROFILE**KIIS Confronts Its Identity Crisis, Adds Personality, Leads Dance Music Revival**

Identity crisis: Those two words have kept Steve Perun up nights since his arrival as PD of KIIS Los Angeles. For the last year, Perun has been refocusing what had been one of America's premier top 40 radio stations, helping the station move from a 3.7 12-plus share last winter to a 4.3—third in the market—in the second spring Arbitrend.

Perun was aware that the station's hit music image had eroded. "KIIS sounded almost hot AC for a while in reaction to [crosstown KYSR (Star 98.7)], which didn't work. Then it leaned alternative in a market where there's already a very strong alternative station." He adds, "KIIS had a hard time creating an identity for itself in a market that's largely Hispanic. In this market, rhythmic is what sells, requests, and researches."

For that reason, Perun says, "we started playing dance music again, because we need-

that perhaps have gotten jaded over the past year. It takes time and consistent focus . . . KIIS has always been known for contesting. What it needs to be known for now is the product. There is no such thing as buying a book with a contest anymore. Not in L.A. If you don't have the product, you're dead."

One of the most obvious changes in the sound of KIIS under Perun is the return of high-profile air personalities in dayparts, other than Rick Dees' morning show. Direct from that radio proving ground, Guam, comes the Nastyman, who has made some serious afternoon noise in the market. "In this market, you can't cut through with a piece of driftwood. You need a 2-by-4, and Nastyman definitely cuts through," says Perun. Night jock Domino (ex-KIIS Dallas) has also made a dent, up from a 3 share to a 5.3. "We now have a station again from 3 p.m.-midnight. We weren't even in the game a year ago, [and now] 3-7 p.m. and 7 p.m.-midnight have higher ratings than mornings."

Perun also oversees Gannett sister station KHKS Dallas. That market, he says, "is much more conservative than L.A. We can react to certain records a lot more quickly than they do in Dallas . . . Anything urban-sounding becomes much bigger [more quickly] here than in Dallas."

Perun also notes that Dallas is only 15% Hispanic where L.A. is 40% Hispanic and nearly 70% Hispanic 12-24. He says, "We've defined three different types of Hispanics: [The first is] Spanish-speaking, not well-versed in American culture. The second is . . . somewhat assimilated, still speaks Spanish at home, but lives the American culture. The other third is fully assimilated . . . In the past, KIIS has only appealed to the latter third. To be successful in L.A., you need to get the middle third and make whatever inroads you can into the third that's Spanish-speaking only."

Some other Perun comments:

- On dayparting: "There's a common thread throughout the day, but KIIS definitely changes from daypart to daypart. That's the only way we're going to make it work again. There's a fine line between doing what we're doing and sounding like seven different radio stations." Even an uptempo record like "I Know" by Dionne Farris may be mornings and middays only on KIIS. Even Rick Dees, Perun says, "is now more aware of the 18-24 audience, and we've made the morning music a little hotter than it was."

- On old school and why he plays "Got To Be Real" and "I Will Survive": "Most of these records tested better than any currents. But there's no way we could own the old-school image, because Power [106] had it already wrapped up."


- On MD Tracy Austin: "She has a different work ethic and attitude than most MDs. She understands the mission and goals of the station, and she's very serious and thorough."

As for final pieces of the KIIS puzzle, Perun says, "We have to continue to solidify the adult audience that we've grown in the last year. We also have to become more relevant to the younger audience. KIIS has been nowhere for those people for three to four years, while other stations have already been superserving them."

"We will execute month after month without changing every week," Perun says. "One trend in this market is meaningless because it can be 70% Spanish-speaking. If somebody has a bad trend and changes their whole station and the next trend goes up, they don't realize that trend reflects what they've already changed. They've just screwed it up again."




