Sexual Harassment Still A Live Issue On Music Day, Say Female Label Reps

Sexual harassment of female record reps at the radio level may not be as blatant as it was a decade ago, but it still exists as more than an isolated problem, according to a survey of female local and national promoters.

Awareness of sexual harassment has been in the foreground since the early '90s. It has become a hot topic again this week following reports that the recent firings of two station personnel may have stemmed from sexual harassment allegations by a local rep. Neither the station nor the label reportedly involved will comment on the issue. Neither the rep allegedly involved nor one of the radio people contacted would return phone calls. But many female reps in all the Airplay Monitor formats—while insisting on

anonymity—had plenty to say on the overall issue.

The consensus is that "ever since Anita Hill, it's gone underground," as one regional puts it, but harassment has hardly gone away, even if it's only a matter of being constantly propositioned by PDs and MDs. "The situation still goes on. I find the attitude toward women in this industry is still very old school," adds a counterpart.

Sometimes the harassment is blatant. "I had one particular programmer who always came on too strong and was always offensive to me," says one pop regional rep. "I told him to stop, but he just kept it up, so I told my superiors I couldn't deal with it anymore. No add is worth dealing with that situation."

"It's deep," says one R&B regional. "When I first started, there was one programmer who never took my

Nationwide Communications has announced a slew of promotions following the recent death of NCI president Mickey Franko.

WNCI Columbus, Ohio, PD/group PD Dave Robbins is upped to GM, replacing Dan Morris, a 35-year veteran of Columbus radio, who is promoted to Nationwide VP/radio, responsible for all company properties east of the Mississippi.

The Format's Mid-'80s Heritage Lives On!

Heritage top 40.

The phrase seems like an oxymoron these days. When it is used, it's often a way of describing a station that's switching to country or hot AC or anything else. Until recently, top 40 has increasingly been the province of class-A FMs that were not part of the market 10 years ago. The sounds of the glory days of 1983-86 seem like the most distant of echoes.

There are still heritage top 40s changing format. KOHT Grand Forks, N.D., is in the process of doing so. WEZB (B97) New Orleans just made the transition to talk. But there's little comfort in knowing that one has time to count format changes today, as opposed to two years ago, when changes came so rapidly that there was no time to reflect on one heritage top 40's demise before the next was rumored.

Although M Street Journal shows that two-thirds of the format have bailed since 1989, most of the stations now in the format are genuine heritage top 40s.

Of the 112 top 40/mainstream and top 40/rhythm reporters represented in Top 40 Airplay Monitor, 58 stations, or about 60%, were top 40 with the same call letters on this day in 1985. Another 16 were either top 40 with different calls or have been in and out of the format since 1985. Only 38—a little more than one-third—were something different.

Who was top 40 10 years ago? WHTZ (Z100) New York; KIIS Los Angeles; WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago; WXKS-FM (Kiss 108) Boston; WBZZ (B94) Pittsburgh; WKQK (Q102) Cincinnati; KUBE Seattle; KMEL San Francisco; KSFM (FM102) Sacramento, Calif.; KKRZ (Z100) Portland, Ore.; WPRO-FM Providence, R.I.; WZPL Indianapolis; WKSE (Kiss 98.5) Buffalo, N.Y.; WKSS and WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn.; WPXY Rochester, N.Y.; KJYO (KJ103) Oklahoma City; WRVQ (Q94) Richmond, Va.; WKRZ Wilkes-Barre, Pa.; and KQKQ (Sweet 98) Omaha, Neb. And that's just a few of the stations with continuous service in the format.

KHKS (Kiss 106.1) Dallas; WSTR (Star 94) Atlanta; WXXX (XL106.7) Orlando, Fla.; and WMXQ (Mix 94.5) Birmingham, Ala., were all top 40 10 years ago, although you knew them as KTKS, WQXI-FM (94Q), WHLY (Y106), and WAPI-FM (I95), respectively.

WNCI Columbus, Ohio; WSSX (95SX) Charleston, S.C.; and WHOT Youngstown, Ohio, were also top 40 a decade ago. They were heritage stations at the time, so their subsequent brief stints in AC (WNCI and WSSX) and rock (WHOT) seem long forgotten. KRBE Houston was in the format 10 years ago. It could claim a 20-year top 40 legacy, except that in 1985 it had just returned to top 40 after a three-year dalliance with AC.

Some entrenched top 40s feel like they've

been around for a decade but haven't. KKLQ (Q106) San Diego featured classic hits 10 years ago. WFLZ Tampa, Fla., was going through a rapid succession of formats, including AC, when it was known, ironically, as "OJ93"—it probably should have fought O.J. Simpson's lawyers to keep those O.J. billboards up. KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles will celebrate its 10th anniversary in January, but in November 1985, it was hot AC KMGG (Magic 106).

Then there are the stations that were very different 10 years ago. KJMZ Las Vegas was easy listening. WIOQ (Q102) Philadelphia was triple-A before triple-A was recognized as a format. KBXX (the Box) Houston was KFMK, a '70s oldies station, before anybody recognized that as a format. WERQ (92Q) Baltimore was AC WYST-FM (92 Star). WQHT (Hot 97) New York was AC WYNY. (The station that would come to be known as "Hot 103.5" before swapping frequencies with WYNY was the then-rockin' WAPP.) WWCK Flint, Mich., was a rock station; it became one of the last stations to see such promise in top 40 that it gave up strong 12-plus numbers in another format to make the switch.

KXXX Bakersfield, Calif., existed 10 years ago, but it was on the frequency of what is now country KUZZ. In 1985, KUZZ dominated its market as a country AM. It became one of the first stations to see the country franchise as so promising that it gave up strong 12-plus numbers as a top 40. WKBQ (Q104) St. Louis just misses the heritage label, even if you don't count its frequency flip. Ten years ago, it was at 106.5 and known as KWK.

It feels like more, but only 18 of the 57 stations now in the format were once heritage top 40s, although their numbers include such heavyweights as WPLJ New York; WRQX Washington, D.C. (then Q107); WTKI Milwaukee; WMJQ Buffalo; KSTZ Des Moines, Iowa (née KRNQ); WBLI Long Island, N.Y.; and WMC-FM (FM100) Memphis. (In fairness, it should be pointed out that WBLI, FM100, and even WTKI were very much adult top 40 stations at the time.)

One of the reasons that there are more heritage top 40s than you might think is that the really frightening shrinkage took place in smaller markets, often affecting stations that were unknown to most of us. Losing two-thirds of a format may not be good news, but more of top 40's mid-'80s heritage exists than one might think. Utilizing this heritage for the future is the hard part.

STATION LOG: With the departure of WEZB New Orleans and the return of KDLE Wichita, Kan., to R&B, the count of top 40/rhythm and top 40/mainstream reporters goes to 80 and 32, respectively. New to the modern rock panel this week are KEZE Spokane, Wash.; WVGO Richmond, Va.; and KCXX San Bernardino, Calif., bringing the panel to 69 stations.

Big Week For Big Groups; New Fox Laffer

W

hat a week it was on the corporate level: After CBS stockholders approved the \$5.4 billion purchase by Group W, it was announced that the combined group would be known as CBS Radio, not Group W. SFX Broadcasting bought Liberty Broadcasting for \$223 million. SFX's Providence, R.I., Hartford, Conn., Richmond, Va., and Albany, N.Y., stations go to Multi-Market Radio. Also, the merger between Citicasters and OmniAmerica has collapsed.

Looking for some national exposure for a promotion or morning-show bit? Fox-TV will launch "What's So Funny," a digest of the week in comedy, next year. The show will air Sundays at 9:30 p.m. ET. The show's John Taylor wants to include bits and stunts from local radio; he can be reached at 818-763-2862.

What kind of bits? Well, at KTFM San Antonio, Texas, what was billed as a Macarena look-a-like contest at a local nightclub has resulted in a lawsuit by a disgruntled listener. KTFM PD the Janitor says the club handed out bananas, culminating in a nonwinning contestant filing a lawsuit alleging mental anguish for being asked to do the "banana dance." We hear Zucchini Night has been postponed.

Following word that WLS-FM Chicago is dropping its news/talk simulcast before the new year, the station has begun stunting for a change to take place between now and year's end, according to The Chicago Sun-Times.

KISF (Kiss 107.3) Kansas City PD Chuck Geiger exits. MD Booker Madison, who had left for WNRQ Pittsburgh, may now stay.

Former WXXL (XL106.7) Orlando, Fla., GM Randy Rahe is the new national sales manager at R&B rival WJHM (102 Jamz).

PD Clarke Ingram is upped to OM at top 40 WPXY Rochester, N.Y., and sister AC WVOR following the exit of WVOR PD C.C. Matthews for the PD slot at top 40 WDIX Louisville, Ky. Matthews worked at WDIX when it was top 40/album rock WKJJ (KJ100). MD J.J. Rice adds APD stripes at WPXY. APD Dave LeFrois is upped to PD at WVOR.

KDON Salinas, Calif., GM/group VP of programming Jeff Salgo transfers to Henry Broadcasting's new property, AC KYMX Sacramento, Calif. KHQT (Hot 97.7) San Jose GM Dayton Phillips segues to KDON.

Album WAPL Green Bay, Wis., flips its new duopoly partner, country WJLW, to modern-

leaning top 40 as WKSZ (Kiss 95.9) under OM Garrett Hart. WAPI p.m. driver Miles Ryker will be APD/MD. Keith Kelly from WMXP (Mix 93.3) Peoria, Ill., is the new morning host. Ace Adams from WLET Gainesville, Ga., is the new night jock. Michael T., formerly PD of crosstown AC WQLH, is GSM. Meanwhile, WQLH becomes "Mix 98.5" under new PD John Thomas from sports WMVP Chicago.

Former WKDY Utica, N.Y., PD Wally McCarthy resurfaces as OM at sports/country combo WHEN-AM-FM Syracuse, N.Y.

KSTZ Des Moines, Iowa OM Kipper McGee exits for the PD slot at oldies KBZT (K-Best 95) San Diego. KSTZ segues from AC to a rock-based top 40/adult approach.

At press time, Greg Williams was still the PD, at least in name, at KDLE (Power 93.9) Wichita, Kan. Chance Logan is named OM.

Suburban Columbus, Ga., top 40 WKZJ has been LMA'd to Davis Broadcasting's WFXE Columbus and will switch to R&B. PD James Steele is looking; call 334-480-8571.

WNCI Columbus, Ohio, ups five-year Morning Zoo "Street Stunts" guy Jimmy Jamm to morning partner, replacing Dave Calin, now bound for WBZZ Pittsburgh.

WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago MD Erik Bradley signs a new two-year contract this week. Look for an announcement where acting night jock Brian Middleton and acting late-nighter Julian "Jumpin'" Perez become permanent by this time next week.

WIVY (Coast 102.9) Jacksonville, Fla., moves from top 40/adult to rock-based AC. APD/MD/midday host Jeff Donovan goes to mornings. Also, production director John Daniel exits for WROQ Greenville, S.C.

New top 40 WAKX (Mix 96) Grand Rapids, Mich., taps WAYV Atlantic City, N.J., PD Mark Hunter for nights. Kim St. James from WKPK Gaylord, Mich., joins for middays. New PD Jay Towers is doing afternoons.







calls. Then, when he did, he would shout to his MD, 'Has anybody seen [what she looks like?]' Then, when we met, he said, 'Oh, you're cute! We'll be fine then.' Not a thing about whether you have hit records or whether you're doing your job.

"He was all right with me for a while, then he treated me bad. He wouldn't add a record, and I kept calling him. He said, 'If you're going to call me and talk about . . . business all the time, then don't call me.' I said, 'Look, last time I checked, your job was to program the station, and until I get what I want, I'll continue to call.' This record was top 10 sales in his [city], and he was being an asshole. Now he wants to hug on me all the time."

A TOTAL PERVERT

"I have one PD who is a total pervert," says the same rep. "He tells me what they do at strip clubs. He tells disgusting stories. Do I want to hear it? No. But I have to, because I would be excluding myself if I stop him. He told me he was looking forward to one of my female artists coming into the market; he told me she was a real 'lap spinner.' But at least he's upfront about it. He's disgusting, and that's his whole vibe."

"I was talking to a guy this morning who's taken a liking to me," says one promoter who is in the process of switching jobs. "I took him out to dinner once, and he kept asking me to come back to his hotel room. This morning he said, 'I really hate that you're leaving without us having gotten married or having [had] sex.'

"I've had programmers make reference to when I come visit, wanting me to bring sexy lingerie, and other programmers ask me to send them photographs, [and] I don't think they mean pictures of me baking cookies," says a country regional. "There's a lot of innuendo about wanting to know each other better, or 'my wife's out of town' . . . It's tough to know how to handle it."

"I definitely think it's out there," says another country regional. "There are a lot of guys in my region, and they definitely don't care what they say as far as treating us regionals like ladies . . . When you say, 'Is there anything I can do for you this week,' they'll go into [something] sexual."

IT SHOULD HAVE BEEN MY BABY

"I've had some PDs say things about my pregnancies," says an R&B regional. "One said, 'It should have been my baby, if I had known you were f-ing around.' The same regional tells another story of a PD who wouldn't take her calls, so she began working another person at the station. Then the same PD called her, accused her of sleeping with that employee, and refused to play her records for that reason. 'Regardless of if it was true, and it wasn't, what has that got to do with taking care of business?' she asks.

"I get so tired of people telling me how good I look when I'm trying to get an add," says one R&B regional. "Do I get insulted if someone calls me attractive? No, but now let's talk about my record," says a pop counterpart.

Not surprisingly, regional reps tended to have more stories than nationals, since they have more day-to-day contact. "The single local female reps are the ones constantly under the gun," says one rep. Another pop national says the further women rise up the ladder, the more seriously they're taken. And one pop local says that many of the worst problems take place in smaller markets, because new PDs and MDs "are like kids in a candy store. Everything is new and available to them."

One R&B regional feels that "a man gets a certain amount of equitable respect just by being a man . . . When I bring a record to a PD, if I don't bring a softer attitude or a smile, I don't stand out. I'm more playful and friendly, but I keep it from going too far. A man going in could talk about baseball or a [strip] bar; they can bond, and he might get priority over me because he's a man, but I'm just another piece of a—to the PD. That in itself is another degree of sexual harassment."

THEY ARE ALL GENTLEMEN

It's important to note there were several reps contacted by Airplay Monitor who felt they had never encountered harassment. Or that the situ-

ation had dissipated over the last 10 years. One country regional worked top 40 in the '80s and says a PD called her boss and told him she was a bad rep after she refused his suggestion that "I would get a lot further if I pulled my skirt up a little higher."

But, she says, "in country, I can honestly say that, to a man, in the Southeast region, they are all gentlemen. Maybe it's because a lot of them are older. I think there is a more professional air, and I haven't encountered anything like that."

Another country regional adds, "In all honesty, I haven't experienced anything but respect, not only for my position but the fact that I'm a woman. I think a lot of people go the extra distance to make sure there is nothing but respect."

One former country regional, now at a national level, says, "I've been doing promotion for 15 years . . . It has always amazed me how well behaved [PDs are]." But she says that she has gotten one or two complaints from her female regionals. And, she adds, "there have been suggestive people, but I have found that in very short order those MDs and PDs are out, because their management finds out. If they're doing it to the regionals, they're doing it at the station, too."

"I don't feel I've ever been discriminated against, never had a feeling I had to give out any favors," says one pop promoter. "Sure, I've heard comments from some programmers, but if I took to heart every comment that had a sexual connotation to it, I'd be suing the world."

LIKE A KID SISTER

Most reps felt they were able to avoid trouble by setting the proper tone early on. "I position myself as their little sister, so they watch over me," says one R&B regional. "If the guy is a little older, then I'm your daughter. I make a joke of it that way, so if something happens, it's like they're respecting their own family."

"It's all a matter of how you carry yourself," says the pop rep who stopped calling a station because of a PD. "Personally, I just don't allow it. I refuse to put myself in that environment. If a problem happens, I choose to deal with it right then and there."

Female reps also say they try to avoid situations where there's drinking. "Alcohol lowers people's inhibitions, and their guard comes down. It's always tough dealing with the infamous convention mentality, where everyone seems to have this need to get drunk and get laid," says one pop rep.

"I don't drink or do drugs myself, and I don't put myself in those social settings. I will not stay out until 3-4 a.m. alone with a PD. If I am out late, I always make sure somebody else is with me, so I don't leave myself open to any problems."

SUPPORTED OR EXPLOITED?

Most reps felt that if they did encounter problems, they would have the support of their home office. "My company would back me up 100%," says a country regional. "My bosses ask me when we do reviews if anybody has made sexual remarks to me, so it's out in the open."

"They are not oblivious to what happens," says another regional, who notes that when one programmer propositioned her, "I think he was talked to, and the next week it was not as bad."

A country national says that if a female rep came to her with a problem, "If I felt that we couldn't handle it together—because I wouldn't have any problems confronting someone—I'm sure our legal department would be on the phone in a minute. Not one of my people would have to put up with this for a minute."

But another regional complains that her bosses "believe that if you're an attractive woman, you can get more records played. That's why you're hired . . . If you start complaining about getting hit on, the VPs say, 'What are you complaining about? That's why you have that job!'"

And another female promoter says women who complain about being harassed at a particular station are often told not to go back to that station. Other times, she says, "women who go to the human resources department and complain about something like this are marked. They'll move you somewhere, and within a year, you're out of the company."

PROGRAMMER PROFILE

KJ103's McCoy Achieves Double-Digit Bond With Oklahoma City Listeners

Focus groups have shown that listeners perceive this station as having huge promotions and giving away the biggest prizes," says Mike McCoy, six-year PD of top 40 KJYO (KJ103) Oklahoma City, as well as PD of country sister station KEBC. "In fact, I'm willing to bet that we have the smallest promotion budget of any of the top 10 stations in the city."

So how does Clear Channel's KJ103, which was up 10.1-10.3 12-plus in the first fall Arbitron, enforce that image? With a lot of touchy-feely promotion, McCoy says. "The term 'forced listening' just doesn't apply here. What other stations accomplish by buying the audience, we continue to accomplish through emotion."

Nowhere was that more clear than immediately after the bombing of the Murrah Federal Building this spring. Although most stations have emergency plans for tornadoes, earthquakes, and the like, "we never dreamed we'd

have to go through what we did," says McCoy. "We ascertained where our listeners were, and it became evident that almost everybody who called us knew someone in the building."

"People just wanted to talk, so we let them express their emotions. When we later went through the diaries from the spring book, there were so many comments from listeners who were grateful to us. It really built an emotional bond, and now we are a friend forever," he says. "It was surprising how many stations were afraid to break format during the spring book. Letting people vent was part of the healing process. Playing a hit song just didn't relate."

This summer, to help the city's healing process, all three Clear Channel outlets (KJ103, KEBC, and news/talk KTOK) staged the Heartland concert, with Tony Bennett, the Rembrandts, Collective Soul, 4 P.M., Sophie B. Hawkins, and a number of country acts. McCoy credits Mike Wahl, OM of both stations, as largely responsible for the concert's success. Wahl serves primarily as liaison between sales and programming, but is also KJ103's "street warfare" guy and, McCoy says, its "secret weapon."

McCoy also works closely with consultant Jim Sumpter, whom he first worked for at the late WCKS (CK101) Cocoa Beach, Fla., in 1979. "Jim is right there with me every day, fighting in the trenches," says McCoy. "I've worked with consultants who spend most of their time trying to find blame. It's one thing to be a problem solver; it's another entirely to be a problem preventer, and that's Jim."

KJ103 was always in double digits, and was one of the last top 40s to be found there, but started slipping several years ago, especially when the market again had access to an R&B station. When McCoy examined the situation from the listeners' standpoint, he decided to broaden the music. "They still want to hear the occasional Aretha Franklin or Foreigner,

and they wanted lots of '80s stuff, I think to make up for a lot of the disposable artists we were playing in the early '90s." That's why McCoy started experimenting with Garth Brooks, Bonnie Raitt, Melissa Etheridge, etc. "That was considered a [risky] move back then, but we were able to expand and immediately saw our cumulus start growing by leaps and bounds."

The top 40 tastes in Oklahoma City are unique, McCoy says. "We play everything from Counting Crows to Aretha Franklin's 'Respect.'" In its ongoing quest to expose new acts, the station instituted a new music hour every night at 11 p.m., and it is generating positive feedback in focus groups. "We don't hype new music as fresh and new," says McCoy. "We prefer to sell it creatively, give the artist information, and let the listeners decide how hot it really is. It's easy to get caught up in the label game."

Here's a recent 4 p.m. hour of music: Blues Traveler, "Run-Around"; Coolio, "Gangsta's Paradise"; Martin Page, "In The House Of Stone And Light"; Hootie & the Blowfish, "Only Wanna Be With You"; Natural Selection, "Do Anything"; Deep Blue Something, "Breakfast At Tiffany's"; Duran Duran, "Ordinary World"; Mariah Carey, "Fantasy"; Collective Soul, "Shine"; TLC, "Waterfalls"; and Journey, "Don't Stop Believing."

The KJ103 morning show features Bob and Josh, formerly of WCSR Charleston, W.Va. "I knew them before they were hired, and they had a real feel for this station." Midday DJ Joe Friday was upped from weekends and was awarded MD stripes when Billy the Kid left five months ago. "Joe has that natural curiosity I like to surround myself with," says McCoy. (Billy the Kid is now out of the radio business and living in Albuquerque, N.M.) Afternoons/API is market vet Ronnie Rocket. "He knows this market and reflects it and is consistently No. 1 or 2."

KJ103 currently has a night opening, as Dylan recently exited. Overnights is being handled by Brian Kelly, "a 21-year-old, and you know how young bucks are. We're trying to break him in." Teresa Maxwell is doing morning and afternoon traffic, as well as weekends, and the most recent hire is production director Craig Buffington from KHTT Tulsa, Okla. Running more than one radio station leaves McCoy little time to sit behind a desk. "Most of our best aircheck sessions have taken place in the hallway. There's too much pressure and not enough time for a formal session."

Although McCoy has been sitting relatively still for six years at KJ103, his career has taken him through the doors of such legendary stations as WBZ (B94) Pittsburgh, WNCI Columbus, Ohio, and KIUC Las Vegas, and he's had programming stints at KNMQ (Q106) Albuquerque and WMGZ (Z96) Youngstown, Ohio.

McCoy oversees two full-time air staffs and two separate sales departments. This is his first time programming a country station, which has borrowed many top 40 formatics, including hotter clocks, foreground jocks, and jingles, which KJ103 doesn't use. In McCoy's opinion, "KEBC now sounds more like a traditional top 40 station than KJ does."

KJ103 recently issued "Listener Club" cards, designed to reward listeners with deals at local sponsors. "These cards are a real hot item, and I expect them to fuel tremendous growth for us in 1996," says McCoy. "It's easier to get someone who already likes you to love you, rather than attempting to build a new relationship from scratch. They end up listening longer, and it makes this station a bigger part of their lives. No matter where our listeners go, they know there's going to be a benefit."
