New Challenge For Labels: 'The Songs That Would Not Leave'

Think of them as crockpot records for a microwave world. With top 40 radio polarized between PDs who look for active records that ignite quickly, burn brightly, then burn out, and PDs who are still driven primarily by research, a growing number of records don't become hits on their initial release but—thanks to research—enjoy rich and rewarding afterlives, long after the mental chalk outline has been drawn around them.

Among the titles finding new or ongoing success at radio long after relatively unspectacular initial chart runs in Airplay Monitor are Los Del Rio's "Macarena," After 7's "Til You Do Me Right," the Backstreet Boys' "We've Got It Goin' On," Simply Red's "Fairground," and Chris Isaak's "Somebody's Cryin'." The continued endurance of those

records—and others that became chart hits but took forever to come home, such as Everything But The Girl's "Missing" or Diana King's "Shy Guy"—says a lot about how stations expect records to react and how labels are having to realign promotion schedules.

Michael Plen, Virgin Records senior VP of promotion, says such surprise successes are all about faith in a record and the lost art of patience. "'Til You Do Me Right" is a case in point. "It took a long time for people to believe in that record," Plen says. "All it had going for it was sales and some early belief from a few key programmers. It came onto the Monitor charts and then fell off, but that never deterred us. We made it a hit for four or five key players and then used that information to sell it to other people."

Plen admits that the length of time it



Kingston Exits Z100 For K-Rock PD Spot

Confirming weeks of speculation, Steve Kingston has exited his position as WHTZ (Z100) New York director of operations and programming after nine years and has been named PD of Infinity's modern rock outlet WXRK (K-Rock), Z100's crosstown rival. Kingston has been replaced by KRBE Houston PD Tom Coleman, who will arrive at Z100 in time to watch APD/MD Andy Shane cross the street to become MD at top 40/rhythm WKTU, reuniting Shane with former Z100 APD Frankie Blue.

Kingston signed a six-month noncompete clause with Z100, which WXRK GM Tom Chuisano says he intends to honor. No word

on how Kingston will spend the next six months, but current WXRK PD Andre Gardner will stay on for now, and Chuisano says Infinity hopes to find another place for him after Kingston becomes PD. K-Rock also officially announced that John "Whipping Boy" Wilbur would start as the station's night jock March 25.

Poleman, who has programmed Susquehanna's KRBE since 1993, previously worked at WKCI (KC101) New Haven, Conn., and WALK Long Island, N.Y. He becomes only the third PD of Z100 since its inception in 1983, following in the footsteps of Kingston and Scott Shannon.

Kvetching About Boss Old Morning Tradition

When Mancow Muller was guest-starring on WYNY New York, he spent most of his time attacking Howard Stern. Now that he's focusing on Chicago again, the WRCX (Rock 103.5) Chicago morning man has spent most of his time attacking his bosses on the air and getting suspended for it (Top 40 Airplay Monitor, March 15).

Assuming that Muller's problems are real—not a stunt—they're hardly novel. Attacking management on the air and being suspended for it is an exalted morning-show tradition. If you believe that the current crop of quasi-shock morning shows operates as its audience's emotional escape valve, then it follows that PDs and GMs should volunteer themselves to be abused on-air so that listeners get some relief from their lousy bosses.

The problem is that the tradition of joking about "the boss" on-air started at a time when DJs were, otherwise, relentlessly upbeat. Add it to today's morning-show tradition of beating up on everything else and you have our current series of high-profile morning men who start out being brash and funny and end up complaining that "Entertainment Tonight" is always shooting their bad side. "The boss" is just one more in a litany of decreasingly interesting complaints.

Besides, it would be nice if there was another way to manage talent that didn't involve morning shows and PDs being locked in an adversarial relationship over the length of breaks. Alliance, owner of the Young Country stations, has taken the opposite tack. Its PDs don't hold traditional aircheck sessions; one veteran air talent who works for Alliance told me it was the first time he'd ever been told to talk *more*.

But PDs shouldn't have to choose between "four breaks an hour" or the "glorious workers' paradise" when managing talent. So are there other options? One is to surround yourself with an air staff of former PDs, people who presumably understand the need to balance quality and quantity of content. This doesn't always work either. In my programming life, I have had four former PDs on the air. Many of them could listen to an aircheck and *volunteer* that they were talking too much. Being able to sense it while they were on the air was another matter. That being the case, one ends up taking the Alliance approach by default—giving up on the quantity of talk and working on quality in the hope that somebody's three-minute break will at least be gripping stuff.

It would be interesting to hear from anybody who has this one solved. Then we can move on to sales vs. programming, records vs. radio, and all the other stuff we'll still be arguing about in the rest home in 2017.

REWRITING HISTORY: Remember the

old KFY (Y94) Fresno, Calif. (now "Kiss Country" KSKS)? A former AC station, KFY went through several months of what is now believed to have been a smokescreen format—commercial-free rhythmic top 40—before switching to country in the early '90s. As memory serves, KSKS had a noncompete keeping it from going country for several months, and the apparent idea was to do as much damage to the market-leading dance stations as possible before going to the real format.

What was interesting about KSKS is that during its three-month lifespan, it claimed, like its competitors, to be rhythmic top 40, "top 40 for the market," etc. When it died, the publicity for the format change listed the old format as "urban." In the intervening years, I've seen this more than a couple of times, and not just with R&B stations that don't own up to playing R&B until it's a moot point. I've also seen it with stations that were hot AC that suddenly admitted to being top 40, right before changing to something else. It's happened again recently with a PD who told another trade publication that his new station wouldn't be as "urban" as the previous one. That station, of course, never considered itself "urban" at the time.

All of this tends to confirm the disingenuousness of those perpetrating the "top 40 for the market" argument. When there's no longer anything at stake, most GMs or PDs involved are more than willing to tell the truth. There's also something a little insidious about a successful station not wanting to be part of R&B or top 40 but a failed station having no qualms about trashing the reputation of the format it just left.

REPEATING HISTORY: So with WYNY New York gone, where have I been getting my country music fix? From a station 10 hours outside New York. WWKB Buffalo, N.Y.—the former WKBW—runs ABC's Real Country network and comes in great after sundown. The irony is that WKBW was one of the stations I used to DX as a teenager in Washington, D.C., when the station was a legendary top 40. The DX'ing of AM stations became relatively obsolete in the '80s, when most of the music AMs switched to news/talk of some sort. In recent months, I've noticed that I've had a few more excuses to go to AM for music: New York's WPAT-AM, doing an unusual soft AC blend until its sale closes and its switch to Spanish takes place; Jacor's WSAI Cincinnati, the country's most heavily produced big-band station; and WKBW, among them. There's also WJDM Elizabeth, N.J., which runs the Radio Aahs children's network on the new AM Expanded Band. There are, at any given time, a few small-market AMs doing top 40. So one wonders how long we have before somebody tries top 40 on a larger-market AM where a hole exists.

Entercom Buys WAXQ, Trades It To Viacom

In most other weeks, this would have been the biggest story out of New York: After months of speculation, GAF will sell album WAXQ (Q104) for \$90 million to Entercom, which will trade it to Viacom for that company's modern/oldies Seattle combo, KNDD/KBSC. Viacom is launching a format study for WAXQ.

In other sales this week, American Radio Systems buys KLUC/KXNO Las Vegas from Nationwide for a reported \$11 million. ARS has also revived its \$66.5 million deal to buy classical WFLN Philadelphia and WTMI Miami.

Heritage Media has agreed to trade its Seattle properties, KRPM/KCIN, to EZ Communications for WEZB (B97)/WRNO/WBYU New Orleans. Both companies begin immediate sales agreements with their prospective stations.

Finally, in this week's strangest megapolis story, album WRZK Tallahassee, Fla., has flipped to top 40 WWLD (Wild 106) in a duopoly with *three* different sets of owners in the market. WRZK was sold to a partnership of Timm, Catamont, and HVS Broadcasting—Tally Radio. HVS' Jon Hill will be GM of the new station. Orlando, from crosstown WXSR, joins as MD. No PD is named.

PROGRAMMING: KQI PLAYS THE HITS

With morning man Dick Purtan gone, AC WKQI (Q95.5) Detroit moves to adult top 40 as "Detroit's continuous hit music station." Kim Stevens joins for middays from jazz/AC WJZW Washington, D.C., replacing Tom Sommers. Night jock Tom Baker also exits. PD Tom O'Brien is accepting tapes and resumes. Here's an hour of the new station: Toad The Wet Sprocket, "All I Want"; Take That, "Back For Good"; Pat Benatar, "Hit Me With Your Best Shot"; TLC, "Waterfalls"; Blues Traveler, "Run-Around"; Steve Winwood, "The Finer Things"; Mariah Carey, "One Sweet Day"; Goo Goo Dolls, "Name"; Gin Blossoms, "Found Out About You"; Paula Abdul, "Cold Hearted"; U2, "I Still Haven't Found What I'm Looking For"; and Sophie B. Hawkins, "Only Love."

It took longer than we thought, but Jacor's KHTS (93.3) Tampa, Fla., which had been simulcasting sister station, soft AC WDUV, is now simul-blasting WFLZ Tampa, the radio home of "MJ & BJ" and evening maniac Bubba the Love Sponge, now heard at the tasteful drivetime hour of 4 p.m. PST. The change, which may be yet another stunt on the way to KHTS' intended format, coincided with Jacor's programming meetings in San Diego.

WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn., MD Tony Bristol has been named PD at WKCI (KC101) New Haven, Conn., replacing Steve Wilson.

Duff Lindsey, PD of R&B WJHM (102 Jamz) Orlando, Fla., signs a three-year deal to stay at WJHM under new owners OmniAmerica, owners of crosstown WXXL. Meanwhile, former WXXL GM Randy Rahe, who had gone to WJHM as NSM, exits following the sale.

B.K. Kirkland, PD of R&B WIKS New Bern, N.C., adds regional PD duties for Taylor Broadcasting, including AC WKQT, which will return to the air shortly as WMGV and carry WKZL Greensboro, N.C., morning man Jack Murphy.

AC WJQI Norfolk, Va., flips to a modern-

based top 40 adult format as WPTW (the Point) under OM Rich Hawkins. P.m. driver Peter Tripp and overnighter Brian Michel stay on. Hawkins is looking for a morning show.

With Western Cities Broadcasting resumes control of KQKS (KS104) Denver from Century Broadcasting April 1; management is asking for top 40 record service to be sent directly to KQKS, 9191 Sheridan Blvd., Suite 202, Westminster, Colo., 80030. Attn: Mark Stevens.

Cenla Radio Network's KLA Alexandria, La., flips from country to AC Pat Cloud, former PD (and current midday jock) at sister top 40 KQID moves over as PD . . . WHZR Logansport, Ind., flips from top 40 to country PD/mornings Jason Addams and most of the staff remain on board.

Two former employees have filed a petition to deny the license renewal of WSTR (Star 94) Atlanta. Former sales reps Henry Bruen and Arlecia Duke are alleging "discriminatory practices against blacks and other minorities in hiring, promotions, compensation, and recruitment."

PEOPLE: SEX WARS IN SAN DIEGO

KKLO (Q106) San Diego snags "The Love Doctor" from crosstown KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) for 8-10 p.m. Night jock Karen Kay moves to afternoons, replacing Jenna Foxx, who exits. KFMB PD Tracy Johnson wastes no time in inking Dr. Theresa L. Crenshaw, sex therapist and author of three books, including this week's release, "The Alchemy Of Love And Lust." The show will be called "Love Soup With Dr. TLC."

After weeks of loose talk, KGGI Riverside, Calif., PD Bob Lewis hires Michael Steele (ex-PD of KDGE Omaha, Neb.) as APD, with an air shift to be announced. KGGI still needs nights, overnights, and an MD.

Look for KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles to fill its long-vacant morning-show opening with ex-MTV jock Mark Goodman and Shirley the Stunt Girl from KIOI (K101) San Francisco. K101 also needs a production assistant and a producer for Don Bleu's morning show (Brian Holt exits to work for Joe Boxer). Also, Premiere Radio Network's Larry Morgan is now doing P/T at KYSR.

The stunting continues at WKTU New York this week, with Bill Lee doing mornings. Spotted in the hallways: Diane Pryor, who worked at the original WKTU.

KPWR (Power 106) L.A. stalwart Charlie Huero joins KFTM San Antonio, Texas, for afternoons . . . C.K. from KWIN Stockton, Calif., joins KYLD (Wild 107.7) San Francisco for P/T.

Here's the revised KUBE Seattle lineup: New APD/MD Lindsey Cipicic is in middays; Eric Powers moves from nights to afternoons, replacing Greg Valentine (206-526-7882); dance music coordinator Bobby O. is now doing 7-11 p.m.

After working P/T for ABC's hot AC format, veteran jock Gary Leigh is upped to afternoons for the format, replacing Michael Jason Taylor.

Former WXXL Orlando night jock Just Plain Mark (ex-KTBZ Houston) returns to the market for nights at Paxson rocker WJRR, teaming up with Zippy.

WDDJ Paducah, Ky., ups afternoon driver C.J. Steele to MD . . . Local college jock J. Pat Miller joins WBNQ Bloomington, Ill., for nights, replacing Gregg.

takes to get certain records to fly sometimes messes up the marketing of a follow-up single. "Our game plan is usually flexible, but still not to the point where it matches the schedule of radio," he says. "When we come with the next track, we always hear, 'I'm still breaking the last one.'"

Plen says it's easy to lose promotional momentum in such situations. "Our lifeblood is still retail," he says. "Where is the record positioned in the stores? Are there any returns? Our sales department can't wait around for seven months to follow up a record." For those long-term call-out monsters, by the time the active audience is finished buying the record, the passive audience is just beginning to react favorably.

GET OFF THIS (PLEASE)

Plen cites two situations involving slow-breaking records from last year: Cracker's "Low" took 11 months to play out, he says, causing the second single, "Get Off This," to be rereleased three times and ultimately implode, because "Low" continued to grow and pulsate

after the fact. Same with Shaggy's "Boombastic." "We released that record last March, and in December it was still a powerful recurrent," says Plen. During that time span, while "Boombastic" was enjoying success in many markets, the label attempted to release two follow-up singles, "In The Summertime" and "The Train Is Coming." According to Plen, neither one was taken seriously, as they had to live in the shadow of "Boombastic."

Jack Satter knows from patience. As senior VP of promotion for Jive Recordings, he's more than familiar with the Backstreet Boys record that was released Aug. 21, 1995, and is still generating more than 400 spins at pop radio. The reason the record is still breathing is the fragmented fashion in which it was played, according to Satter.

"It took a long time to develop at stations like KDWB Minneapolis, but thanks to their patience, it ended up being No. 1 for six weeks and still sits at 50 spins today," he says. "We've had over 100 pop stations playing it, but all at different times." He says the single has also become successful internationally. "If I had to do this all over again, I'd have broken it internationally first, then used that success story to break the record domestically on a much more productive schedule."

Satter was expecting a four-month run with the initial single and, in fact, had the follow-up record, "I'll Go Anywhere For You," ready to ship earlier this year. Because of the unforeseen prolonged life span of the first single, the second release date has been pushed back to April 29, leaving an eight-month gap between singles.

THE 'MISSING' LINK

Another record that should qualify for Medicare is "Missing" by Everything But The Girl, which broke out of South Florida early last year. KIOI (K101) San Francisco PD Casey Keating played it last April while programming WHYI (Y100) Miami. "[Y100 MD] Al Chio first heard it in the clubs, so we put it on the air and got instant reaction," Keating recalls. Atlantic

Records also exhibited patience when it worked the record several times in 1995. That patience has since been rewarded. "Missing" was the most-played record on the Top 40 Airplay Monitor Mainstream chart for the fourth straight week last week, making it one of the few records of this type with a successful chart run.

K101 also had beyond-the-grave success with the Pretenders' "I'll Stand By You." Keating says that although the station has played the song since last September, it remains a solid B. "It's a consistent top five tester with women 24-40, with no burn." Another K101 success story is "Somebody's Cryin'" by Chris Isaak, which the station started playing in May 1995. "It's also testing as a B-rotation record, and we can't get it to burn," Keating says. "It's been around longer than a lot of radio careers."

Reprise Records' VP of promotion Marc Ratner agrees. "Chris Isaak is the type of artist that drives promo people crazy," he says. "His stuff always seems to research a year later. The same situation happened with 'Wicked Game' a few years ago." It happened again recently with Isaak's "Go Walking Down There." About three weeks ago, WKTI Milwaukee PD Danny Clayton heard it on crosstown modern rocker WLUM and said, "We gotta be playing this." Although it was the single prior to the current "Graduation Day," Clayton says, "We think it's a wonderful song, and we've made a full commitment. It's a hallway fave, and it's already pulling curiosity calls."

MICROWAVE MENTALITY

Ratner, like his promotional counterparts at other labels, often sees that when a record or artist takes longer than four weeks to generate decent research, the "microwave mentality" of today's programmer tends to wish those records away, into the cornfield of stiff. Any forward momentum is lost before those artists that require special handling begin to connect with their intended audience. Reprise is lucky enough to have almost an entire roster devoted to just that type of artist, including Enya, whose "Anywhere Is" has inched along at various stations since late last year.

Ratner says the major markets use call-out as a major gauge of success, but often finds it's a Catch-22. "How do you justify hanging on to a record to find out how it's really doing? There's usually a big difference between initial familiarity and long-term familiarity," he says. "A lot of programmers just can't devote eight to 12 weeks to a record." Although the BoDeans' "Closer To Free" has quickly become a call-out record, that song already had outside familiarity because of its "Party Of Five" TV exposure. However, Ratner says Load The Wet Sprocket's "Good Intentions" from the "Friends" soundtrack took a long time to establish.

"Just by my own observations, I find it takes usually 200 spins per station until the real familiarity kicks in and you can get a realistic idea of a song's performance," says Ratner. "I've seen a lot of programmers make a decision about a song at the 60-70 spin level, and the results are like night and day."

The dilemma, according to Ratner, is, "How do you ask someone for a 200-spin commitment? Who gets to be that first guy, especially when it's someone whom people respect?" He says there are only a handful of stations that can actively influence other programmers. "That's the hardest job in promotion," he says. "It's easier to get the add than the necessary spins. The trick is to get a quality station to give us the 200 spins, because we find the call-out situation really changes." Many times, Ratner finds that when a record is tested after only 60 spins, it may test familiar with a chunk of dislike, but when tested after 200 spins, the call-out story changes drastically, and usually for the better.

"Records that test well at 50 spins are like doughnuts," says Ratner. "They might taste good, but they're just empty calories. It's those subtle foods that you learn to like as an adult that really matter. Those are the records that test late but end up lasting forever—the building blocks of your station's metabolism."

Michelle S. Reinvents KMEL For The Eclectic Bay Area Market

This is the job KMEL San Francisco PD Michelle Santosuoso has been training for her entire career. "This was the most natural move I've ever made," she says. Santosuoso has been a fan of KMEL since age 19, when she first heard the station at a convention. When she worked with Kevin Weatherly and Guy Zappone at the original KZZP Phoenix, she used to fly to the Bay Area on weekends just to listen to the station. "When I got this job," she recalls, "Guy called me and said, 'Well, you finally made it to KMEL.'"

Between KZZP and KMEL, Santosuoso worked with Weatherly at KKLQ (Q106) San Diego before moving to New York as director of crossover promotion for RCA Records. Later, she joined former KMEL PD Keith Naftaly as APD of KKBT (the Beat) Los Angeles. When KMEL PD Dave Shakes moved to sister station KIOI in October 1994, Santosuoso got the call.

In recent months, KMEL has been in a fluid state musically, moving from its longtime R&B slant back to dance and going head to head with rival KYLD (Wild 107.7). "As a heritage

show.

"None of these players had ever done morning drive before," she says. "We wanted it to be a direct reflection of the multicultural lifestyle of the Bay Area. Traditionally, when you change something as large as your morning show, you usually see a ratings dip before it catches on, but if the latest AccuRatings are any indication, we've actually grown from where we were."

KMEL features block programming beyond the standard mix-show fare, including shows devoted to reggae, house music, and oldies. Even the public-affairs talk show, "Street Soldiers," has musical content. "That's why our [Broadcast Data Systems] spins may appear lower than Wild 107, because of our commitment to these other important musical genres," says Santosuoso.

San Francisco has rarely adhered to the usual industry template for top 40. "Those standards might hold true in Montana," Santosuoso says, "but you can't fit this market into any neat category. The music scene here is original and innovative. It's always been eclectic, dating back to the '60s with Haight-Ashbury, the Grateful Dead, Jefferson Airplane, etc. It's always been explosive here, nothing is traditional. We are the contemporary music station for the Bay Area. Keith Naftaly said that for years, and nobody believed him."

Here's a 3 p.m. sample of KMEL: Total, "No One Else"; Bucketheads, "The Bomb! (These Sounds Fall Into My Mind)"; Fugees, "Killing Me Softly"; Mariah Carey, "Always Be My Baby"; KE, "Strange World"; Mary J. Blige, "Not Gon' Cry"; Ice Cube, "You Know How We Do It"; Sandy & Papo, "La Hora De Bailar"; D'Angelo, "Lady"; Brandy, "Sittin' Up In My Room"; and Debra Laws, "Very Special."

Santosuoso says MD Joey Arbagey "has great ears and always fights for the records he believes in. He's responsible for getting artists like D'Angelo and Xscape on the air here. He's the one who keeps the soulful edge to the station. He's grown a lot here in a short time."

She also praises marketing director Katie Eyerly as being "completely locked into every movie company, and [she] has great relationships with everyone from Great America to MTV." Besides coordinating the KMEL Summer Jam, celebrating its 10th anniversary in August, Eyerly is overseeing the KMEL World Wide Web site on the Internet. "It was designed by a guy who designs rave fliers," says Santosuoso. "It's brilliant." Given the proximity to Silicon Valley and such computer-heavy schools as Stanford and Berkeley, more than 50% of Bay Area households have access to a computer. "This is a forward-thinking market, so we have to do it right," she says.

The most important consideration when changing a heritage station, according to Santosuoso, is not to bend to outside influences. "When you change your station at all, the armchair quarterbacking starts immediately. You have to have a clear vision of what's real and what isn't," she says. One of the biggest boosts Santosuoso received was a phone call of support from Kevin Weatherly. "He told me to stick to what I know, stay close to my market and my station. He said only you and your staff need to know what's going on and why."

"This is not a dictatorship here. KMEL continues to evolve in a fluid process, based on many individual personalities," she says. "I know we're doing the right thing. I've studied this station for eight years." KEVIN CARTER


