Hot AC's Spring TV Spots Provide Dramatic Proof Of Format Overhaul

In the not-too-distant past, AC radio was distinctly artist-driven, built on a foundation of Neil Diamond, Barbra Streisand, and Lionel Richie. And AC's TV spots reflected that, even when Streisand and Diamond stopped dominating current music, PDs would take advantage of their name recognition.

Cut to 1996 and hot AC/adult top 40's spring book TV campaigns: Streisand and Diamond are long gone. So, in most cases, are their successors—Phil Collins, Amy Grant, and Michael Bolton. Representing the format instead are Hootie & the Blowfish, Alanis Morissette, the Goo Goo Dolls, the Foo Fighters, Smashing Pumpkins, and Deep Blue Something.

That hot AC and adult top 40 stations would now be imaging around artists who, in many cases, have had only one or two hits at the format, isn't just another indicator of the massive programming overhaul of recent months but an indication that PDs are using music in their TV spots for different reasons than they once did. And it's further proof that a format that had been artist-driven is "not only song-driven, it's now more sound-driven, mood-driven, and attitude-driven," as KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego PD Tracy Johnson says. KFMB's forthcoming TV spot features the hooks of "1979" by Smashing Pumpkins and "Big Me" by the Foo Fighters. Not your mother's AC station.

Why Modern AC Worked In San Diego

Two years ago, most of the format changes that took place when the winter Arbitrums came back were to '70s oldies. Many of those stations are gone (or significantly modified) already.

Last year, most of the post-winter-book format changes were to modern rock. Most of those have lasted, so far.

So how about modern-flavored hot AC? It's the new format of choice in Norfolk, Va., Phoenix, Miami, and, probably by the time you read this, Long Island, N.Y. Several months ago, when we first discussed modern AC, I mentioned that there was a lot of cloning taking place without a success story. Now, the winter book is back, and KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego is up 3.2-4.6 12-plus. So the die is cast.

Will modern AC work everywhere? KFMB-FM has a couple of things going for it that don't exist in every market. One is that there's no mainstream top 40 in San Diego, unless you count Jacor's simulcast of WFLZ Tampa, Fla. KKLQ (Q106) was in a period of transition from top 40 to hot AC this winter. Rhythm/crossover XHTZ (Z90) occupies the other end of the spectrum. That gave Star 100.7 room to maneuver through several potential audiences.

Beyond that, KFMB-FM's greatest advantage is San Diego's modern rock heritage. XETRA-FM (91X) switched to modern rock during the first modern rock boom and was one of the rare KROQ Los Angeles clones that lived to see the next modern rock revolution. XHRM (the Flash) was, by most accounts, the first "adult modern" station. Before vacating that position, it proved a gold-based modern station could get some attention, and that was before most of the '80s gold disappeared from modern rock.

Having an audience that grew up with modern rock makes a big difference for both modern AC stations and adult modern outlets along the lines of KXPK Denver. It gives Star 100.7 a larger pool of available music and a larger base of listeners who remember those songs. Anybody who grew up with top 40 or MTV in the '80s was exposed to some modern rock, of course, but a lot of those songs—"Who Can It Be Now?", "Hold Me Now," "Need You Tonight"—are often burned to a crackly crisp. There's a second set of oldies that '80s modern rock fans hold dear, but that never crossed over: "How Soon Is Now?" by the Smiths, "Forever Young" by Alphaville, "Route 66" by Depeche Mode, etc. Those are hot-button titles for the folks who remember them. Problem is that there aren't enough folks who remember those songs for a modern AC station to reach critical mass outside a handful of cities.

Relying so much on modern gold has a few other drawbacks, too. One is that even in markets in which there was a modern outlet in the late '80s or early '90s, those stations often cycled through songs so quickly that even the hits didn't have a chance to take hold. "I Don't Know Why I Love You" by House Of Love and "Sonnic Boom Boy" by Westworld were both powers on WDRE Long Island. They're both great pop songs that, in a different environment, should have been top 40 hits. But they're both distant memories now, and no matter how much I'd enjoy hearing them again, the possibility of finding a quorum of similarly minded listeners seems really unlikely. Even finding a quorum of industry types reading this column who remember those songs seems really unlikely.

Then there's the issue of depending on "oh wow" gold in general. If R&B adult outlet WRKS New York—a station built on "Reasons" by Earth, Wind & Fire and "Let's Stay Together" by Al Green and some of the greatest songs of all time—leveled off eventually, it's hard to

imagine that a station built on "Safety Dance" won't lose its "oh wow" factor eventually. While I, as a 33-year-old, haven't enjoyed modern rock nearly as much since the format threw out most of its gold, I have to admit that enough modern rock stations have done enough research to know if those songs are valuable. A lot of those songs went away for a reason and not just because they don't sound good next to the Nixons.

Building a modern AC format presents many of the same challenges as building a country oldies format. As recently as five years ago, most country PDs believed that there were no listeners who had grown up with country, and no disenfranchised upper demos who didn't also like today's hot country. Actually, it was always true that such cities as Houston, Dallas, Phoenix, and other "country lifestyle" markets did have country teens, even before Garth Brooks. And country radio's research is finally showing some disenfranchised upper demos who would like to hear Mel McDaniels again. But it's not showing enough for more than a handful of operators to take the chance.

Modern AC is to the '90s what the "soft rock" stations were to the '70s. In a world where Carly Simon, James Taylor and Joni Mitchell were, until 1979-80, considered part of the same rock format as Led Zeppelin and the Doors, it made sense to build the softer half of the format into something unto itself. Eventually, though, when album rock hardened up, the softer stuff didn't become its own format but was used to build the AC format into what it was for much of the '80s.

Now, of course, modern rock is being used to radically redefine AC and adult top 40 themselves. Hot AC has already claimed ownership of Melissa Etheridge and seems quite willing to battle for Hootie & the Blowfish, Alanis Morissette, and the Gin Blossoms. That prompts the question of whether the new crop of modern ACs will have enough turf of their own. WDRE, which is expected to reclaim its WLIR call letters and go modern AC by the time you read this, may have a rich legacy. It also has WPLJ and WMXV New York playing a lot of modern pop/rock in its backyard. (WPLJ has "Solsbury Hill" by Peter Gabriel in its power recurrants at the moment.) And aren't those songs by Morissette, the Gin Blossoms, and the BoDeans in AC rival WBLI's powers this week? Even with AC, WDRE could be driven into a narrow niche as it was as a modern rock station by WHTZ (Z100).

(Whether it's good for AC and adult top 40 to reinvent themselves so radically is up for discussion. To some extent, they don't have much choice. Hot AC has always depended on the music that top 40 passes down to it. Since top 40 doesn't set the agenda for the entire country these days, only triple-A or modern-to-top 40 crossovers have been heard by enough people to be usable at hot AC.)

So how can the new modern ACs set themselves apart? They can take a small amount of the noncrossover modern gold and bang it until it's comfortable with the secondary audience, thus giving themselves a little "oh wow," but not too much. They can market themselves as heavily as their top 40/adult rivals and try to own some of the artists. They can leave themselves enough room to play some nonmodern titles, thus evolving into the hot AC stations for their markets, which will probably happen for some stations. They should not allow themselves to be pushed into the insularity and unfamiliarity of some of modern rock's earliest stations, most of which were unable to hold the position when new competition came along. What these stations won't have are shortcuts to success, which, unfortunately, are what most operators chasing the spring's hot format usually want.

Cox Gets NewCity; KSFM Job Goes West



In this week's mega-sale news, Cox Communications has acquired NewCity for a reported \$250 million. NewCity's Dick Ferguson will join Cox. In addition, Clear Channel has acquired Radio Equity Partners for \$235 million; Clear Channel has also promoted Austin, Texas, GM Stan Webb to senior VP/operations for the group. And Saga picks up WDBR Springfield, Ill., as part of a four-station purchase to add to its existing two.

Veteran programmer Bob West has been named PD of KSFM/KMJI Sacramento, Calif., replacing Rick Thomas, who's headed to Phoenix to program Jerry Clifton's KBZR (the New 103.9). West formerly programmed crosstown KROY during its top 40 heyday. West will continue to operate his New West Communications, which consults Spanish KXYZ Houston. KJMJ Las Vegas MD/night jock Kid Stevenz also heads to KBZR for nights. KJMJ PD Mike Marino needs an MD and a bunch of other people for his new hot AC outlet.

WTIC-AM-FM Hartford, Conn., GM Gary Zenobi exits for a TV job in Fort Lauderdale, Fla.

Nice to be able to report on some new top 40s for a change. KEYW (the Key) Tri Cities, Wash., segues from hot AC to top 40, following the flip of crosstown KIOK (OK95) to country. Paul Drake remains GM/PD and teams with KIOK's Jeff Turnbo in mornings. Jonathan Walker remains in middays. Also from KIOK are Bob Bishop in afternoons and Michael Dean as MD/nights.

Then there's country KLTX Killeen, Texas, which segues to modern-leaning top 40 as KNRV (the Nerve) under Gulfstar group PD Larry Kent and new PD/p.m. driver Joey Armstrong from KPER Hobbs, N.M. Jeff "Cornbread" Law from KKIS Concord, Calif., will do mornings. Jessica Wooland from WSKS Utica, N.Y., is the new midday host. Ray Garza from country KILT Houston will do nights.

KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles PD Michelle Mercer reports that after sitting out for more than a week, morning team Tha Baka Boyz have ironed out their differences with management and were back on the air May 8.

While the hunt for Patty Steele's replacement at WHTZ (Z100) New York gets underway, PD Tom Poleman fires up the revolving wheel of

celebrity news anchors. This week: Maty Monfort from ABC's "Mike & Maty Show."

AC KRTR (Crater 96) Honolulu PD Kimo Akane crosses the island to Japanese KORL. KRTR owner Austin Vali is now handling the programming, along with MD Amie Manown and consultant Jerry Clifton. Elsewhere in the building, morning guy Michael Qseng is replaced by Kari Steele and Kimo Kahoano.

KHTO Springfield, Mo., OM Dave Alexander adds OM stripes for co-owned modern rocker KTOZ amid a format flip that sees KTOZ's old frequency being sold and its format moving to KHTO's former triple-A sister station KZBE.

WPLY Philadelphia morning sidekick Chad Brueske signs on as Detroit local for EMI Records.

KWTX Waco, Texas, is looking for nights to replace Flyin' Brian. T&R to PD Tom Martens.

WZNY Augusta, Ga., p.m. driver Ron Roberts moves to mornings, replacing Mark Summers, now at crosstown country WKBG. PD Bruce Stevens hires WSB-FM (B98.5) Atlanta P/T McKenzie Clarke for afternoons as Michael Chase moves back to nights.

Soft AC KOIT San Francisco PD Allan Hotten transfers back into a GM slot at co-owned WXTR Washington, D.C., and its duopoly partners, replacing Jack Alix. Former KOIT PD Suzy Mayzel returns to the station as acting PD.

Modern AC WPTE Norfolk, Va., unveils its on-air lineup. Peter Tripp from co-owned soft AC WFOG will do middays. Donna McCoy from jazz/AC WXTC Charleston, S.C., will be MD/p.m. drive. Brian Michel, the overnighter at WPTE's predecessor, WJQI, will do nights.

Rhythmic AC KBKS (Kiss 106) Seattle taps Dana Darden, the morning-show producer at rival KUBE, for mornings.

Arbitron has announced plans to reissue the Pensacola, Fla., book following the realization that five diaries went to a household connected with a radio station.

KIIS Los Angeles announces "KIIS and Unite 11," scheduled for June 8 at Irvine Meadows. The artist lineup includes Cher, La Bouche, 3T, Kool & the Gang, 2 Unlimited, Color Me Badd, Tony Rich Project, SWV, Billy Ray Martin, Sophie B. Hawkins, with more to come. The festivities will include a 38-hour radiothon and celebrity memorabilia auction.

WQHT (Hot 97) New York's "Summer Jam," to be held June 20 in the Meadowlands will feature L.L. Cool J, Mary J. Blige, Fugees, Total, Busta Rhymes, Lost Boyz, and Monica.

KHTT Tulsa, Okla., kicked the rumor mill into overdrive last week by running promos saying "the end is near" and promoting a "major announcement" last Friday. Turned out it was a set-up for a station-sponsored party for the season finale of "The X-Files."





Hot AC's Spring TV Campaigns Provide Proof Of Format's Overhaul

WKQI (Q95) Detroit used Jon Secada, Rod Stewart, and Billy Joel in last year's TV spot. "Then we got ballsy and threw in Sheryl Crow," says PD Tom O'Brien. The station's current TV spot features video images of Hootie & the Blowfish, Blues Traveler, Des'ree, the Gin Blossoms, and Seal, as well as the musical hook from the Spin Doctors' "Two Princes."

Like Johnson, O'Brien cites the more song-driven nature of the format: "Hot AC is now becoming top 40 in that regard," he says. "Two years ago, we sat around hoping that Michael Bolton, Rod Stewart, and Gloria Estefan would release a new album in order to refill the format, but today, we welcome music from many new and exciting artists. We're no longer worried about having to fall back on being a library-based radio station if certain artists don't have new product."

WOMX (Mix 105.1) Orlando, Fla., uses clips of the Spin Doctors, Hootie & the Blowfish, Blues Traveler, and Crow in its TV spots. The only major holdover from two years ago is Grant. "When you consider the changes this format has undergone lately, it seems like 100 years," says PD David Isreal, who was previously MD at WMXV (Mix 105) New York. Isreal recalls feeling strange when he finally pushed the envelope and added a Spin Doctors single that was already a recurrent nationally. "It was like starting the format all over again," he says.

In a bold image statement, WMXV itself actually uses the hook of the unknown-until-recently Deep Blue Something in its TV spots. Like Isreal, PD Steve Weed says the spots were designed to sell the musical essence of the station, rather than ride the coattails of the individual artists. "We wanted to showcase the music, which when you think about it, was from relatively unfamiliar artists," he says. "We used the videoclips as a visual reference, and ID'd each performer on-screen. The purpose was not to sell the artists you will now hear, but the overall music style you can expect when you listen to Mix 105."

After all, there's no sense in trying to claim ownership of image artists when the format seems to have few image artists. The closest thing to an image artist hot AC has now is Hootie, says WKQI's O'Brien, who adds, "One day Hootie will probably put out a record that won't go top 10. It will have nothing to do with artist, only the song's merit." Playing an artist or using that artist in a spot is "not a blanket endorsement of the artist."

WRQX (Mix 107.3) Washington, D.C., also employs Deep Blue Something in its TV spots, along with Del Amitri and the Goo Goo Dolls. It's all about playing to expectation, says OM/PD Randy James. "The audience expects to hear an uptempo hit record, not an uptempo hit artist."

Modern AC KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles uses Joan Osborne, Hootie, Seal, and U2 in its current TV spot. "The main reason we showcase the artists and song hooks is to clarify an overall image of the station, rather than an attempt to own an artist," says PD Dave Beasing. "In the old days, we would have probably tried to claim ownership of an artist by saying, 'We're the Deep Blue Something station,'" he says.

Beasing has been careful to position the spots to let audience members in on the new music revolution happening around them. The spokesmodel in the spot says, "Music has changed," thus repositioning the station without saying the station has changed.

WANE, WANE, GO AWAY

Like most PDs explaining hot AC's mega-changes, WMXV's Weed cites music test scores that showed a markedly decreasing passion for the format's previous core artists

at the same time this new music revolution was on the rise with such artists as Hootie & the Blowfish. "The challenge we were faced with was acknowledging our audience had moved on musically. The paradigm has shifted, and we had to respond."

KFMB's Johnson says his research found his audience hadn't really tired of certain traditional AC artists. "It's just they were no longer relevant to today's 25-34 females," Johnson says. "They don't dislike them; they just don't mean anything to them. They're dispassionate about them."

WRQX's James notes that the change is not only significant, but retroactive. In previous auditorium tests, Tracy Chapman's "Fast Car" never performed, "but now that the acoustic sound about angst and broken relationships is hip, 'Fast Car' is now a top 10 tester."

WBMX (Mix 98.5) Boston uses Hootie, Melissa Etheridge, Seal, Natalie Merchant, and the Gin Blossoms in its latest spots. Like Johnson, PD Greg Strassell found his audience getting bored with traditional AC artists. "The success of the newer pop/alternative artists have shown how compelled and attracted to those new artists our listeners are," he says.

Johnson feels many artists became generic in image based on the years of sharing by so many stations and formats. "It became impossible to carve out an image or position that's uniquely yours based on those artists," he says. "Billy Joel: Is he a top 40, AC, classic rock, or oldies artist? Same with Elton John. 'Your Song' was released in [1970], and much of my audience wasn't born then. Elton is to many of them what Chubby Checker is to my generation—they find him interesting, but they're not passionate about him," Johnson says.

STEAL THIS SONG

WKZL Greensboro, N.C., PD Jeff McHugh admits to borrowing many of his new image artists from neighboring stations. His TV spots feature Hootie, Ace Of Base, and Mariah Carey, as well as relative format newcomers Collective Soul, the BoDeans, Jann Arden, and Del Amitri.

Like his peers, McHugh's research has indicated gradual erosion in traditional AC artists, while showing increased familiarity and subsequent sales on newer artists. Much of his favorable data is based on exposure from nearby top 40 WDCG (G105) Raleigh, N.C., and modern rock WEND (the End) Charlotte, N.C. "This stuff is selling like crazy, plus it's influenced by MTV penetration and the other stations," McHugh says. "We've always had a hard time starting music on our own."

Because WKDD Akron, Ohio, PD Chuck Collins programs in the shadow of Cleveland, he does no TV. "The Cleveland rates are too prohibitive, and we'd be throwing away 80% of those impressions to an audience we don't affect." Collins rotates up to eight hook promos instead. Unlike many of his peers, Collins finds his audience still wants a dose of Stewart, Grant, and Phil Collins (no relation) mixed in with Deep Blue Something. WKDD's No. 1 testing song in two auditorium tests done a year apart is "In The Air Tonight" by Phil Collins. Another example of adult radio becoming more song-driven, in Collins' opinion: WKDD's continued success with a hearty side dish of '80s one-hit wonders.

A PLACE FOR MICHAEL?

So is there still a place for traditional core artists in hot AC's imaging? It may not be what those artists have in mind. In an attempt to pull a 180 on its previous AC posture, KYSR runs the following promo: "Six months, eight days, two hours, and 18 minutes, and not a single note of Michael Bolton . . . there is a God."

MONITOR PROFILE

Who's Doing Top 40 With A Twist In Denver? Go Ask Alice When She's 5,280 Feet Tall.

What's going on in Denver these days? It used to be such a nice, stable town. Not lately. KWMX (Mix 107.5) PD John Peake is off to KRBE Houston, the KQKS (KS104) staff has moved down the dial to KJMN (Jam'n 92.1), and KS104 is running jockless. Seems like Jacor bought almost everybody; Chancellor bought everybody else.

During this turbulence in the Mile High City, KALC (Alice 106) has stuck to its game plan. The only question within the industry has been what the game plan was, since its creators have made a point of "not putting a label on the station."

PD Gregg Cassidy has been Alice's only husband since April 1994, coming off two tours of duty at WLUM (Hot 102) Milwaukee and a side trip to Hell (ABC's short-lived WYTZ [Hell Radio] Chicago). Two other programmers helped give birth: Jim Lawson (ex-WVIC Lansing, Mich., and Hot 102) and Chris Davis, who had crossed the street from the PD chair at KS104. (Davis recently left to design World Wide Web sites on the Internet, but retains Alice as a client.)

So what exactly is Alice? Former owner Frank Wood came up with the name. Otherwise, since KALC's inception, the most the station has said, as Lawson does, is that "Alice is about entertaining 25-34 females with whatever they want. Actually,


side world." Cassidy says, "During the winter book, we had no promotions going on, so with every record, [the DJs] had to have a game plan. That's tough when you work without a net, but we have the people who can pull it off."

The morning show of Frosty, Jamie, and Frank has quickly generated a loyal fan base. Frosty is another vet of WLUM, Jamie White hails from XHTZ (Z90) San Diego, and Frank Mershon was a college student from Indianapolis who fell into radio.

"Their show kind of feels like 'Friends'-meets-'Seinfeld' to discuss the topics of 'Oprah,'" says Cassidy. So, basically, it's an overly caffeinated radio show about nothing? "Yes, and it's winning," Lawson says. Cassidy adds, "They all share the same objective, and that's to win. They're able to put everything else aside to do that, although they don't always agree exactly how to do it." According to Lawson, Frosty, Jamie, and Frank manage to spin three records an hour; if they're lucky, "Usually their favorites," Cassidy adds.

Middays are handled by Mary "Cha Cha" Chavez, a veteran of KS104. Another local guy, Paul Vincent, does afternoons, followed by Jojo Turnbaugh. Another local character, Tree King, handles overnights.

Right now, Alice is testing the waters with soon-



we don't program to a specific demo; we just play to adults and take what we get on both sides."

Beyond that, it's easiest to say that Alice has, through its several-year history, played more gold than a mainstream top 40 with more texture than most hot ACs. It also played modern rock oldies long before those became the flavor of the month at hot AC.

Here's a recent 1 p.m. hour: U2, "I Still Haven't Found What I'm Looking For"; Jann Arden, "Insensitive"; Real Life, "Send Me An Angel"; Peter Gabriel, "In Your Eyes"; Natalie Merchant, "Wonder"; John Cougar Mellencamp, "Small Town"; Edwin McCain, "Sacrifice"; BoDeans, "Closer To Free"; Dave Matthews Band, "Too Much"; Enigma, "Sadeness Part I"; Counting Crows, "Mr. Crow"; and the Clash, "Should I Stay Or Should I Go?"

Cassidy acknowledges the fact that Denver now has several stations (adult modern KXPK, top 40 rival KWMX) playing similar music. "Hey, we're just darn glad they're out there," he says. "It certainly keeps us on our toes, and the fact that the market is constantly changing makes Alice look almost like a lifer."

The difference between Alice and the others, Cassidy says, is that "they can't get a handle on the fun factor, and that's something you just can't force," adding that some otherwise good air talent hasn't been able to make the cut at KALC.

The personalities who inhabit Alice are faced with circumstances similar to those faced by early top 40 jocks, according to Cassidy. "We basically give 'em a stack of records and a microphone and make 'em entertain," he says. "We don't put much in their mouths," referring to the deliberate absence of liner cards in the studio. Lawson adds, "Our jocks have to be aware of the station and what's happening in the out-

to-be-owners Chancellor Broadcasting, which runs the station through an LMA. It also owns oldies KXKL, classical KVOD, and '70s gold KIMN. Cassidy and crew dubbed the new company "Richie Rich Broadcasting" in promos. The first day of the new regime, they ran IDs calling the company "John Chancellor Broadcasting," played the "NBC Nightly News" theme every hour, and encouraged listeners to "tip your waitresses." "So far, they're amused," Cassidy says.

Alice's new GM is Skip Weller, who succeeds Gayle Shaw, whom Cassidy credits with teaching him about the female mindset. "She really allowed the inmates to run the asylum," he recalls. "She was a great GM who balanced the testosterone level here and gave us the female perspective we need to succeed."

"A lot of stations talk about it, but this is the first time I've really seen the team concept work," says Lawson. This crew goes camping, drinking, skiing, does everything together." In an effort to cultivate a perspective outside the business, everyone at Alice is encouraged to find an outside buddy, says Cassidy: "Over and above spouses, they're allowed to bring that person to any of our events, which the station will pay for."

Chief engineer Jeff Garrett doubles as Alice's voice and has become a star for his "Motel 6"-like promos. Production director Kelly Michaels "never sleeps," says Lawson. "He's the guy who puts the icing on the cake."

After two years, Cassidy and Lawson admit the station has taken on a life of its own. "Sometimes we feel like Alice is a person and we work for her," says Lawson.

Alice in a nutshell, according to Cassidy: "The music attracts the audience, and our job is to keep them hanging around for more abuse."
