What Would A Modern/AC Chart Look Like? Monitor Finds Out

Modern/adult: It's definitely the flavor of the fortnight. But is it a format?

A lot of industry types have asked that question. Airplay Monitor wondered, too. So we commissioned a special 40-position sample chart from Broadcast Data Systems this week, made up of the 14 monitored stations that best fit that description. (The first chart can be found on page 5; in subsequent weeks, it will be available exclusively to on-line BDS subscribers. The stations used in the sample chart will continue to report to their current formats.) And we found that, even with the presentational and philosophical differences among stations, there is a surprising amount of consensus.

• Even as the modern/adult format defines its ground rules, there are already a lot more records that its relatively small universe of stations can agree on than there are records that mainstream top 40 or top 40 adult stations can agree on.

• Modern/adult stations are distinguished from top 40/adult and traditional modern stations more in terms

of what they won't play than what they do play. While there are only one or two titles at most that can really be said to be indigenous to the modern/adult format—most have already developed a story at top 40, AC, modern, or all of the above—there are recent No. 1 records from the top 40/adult and modern rock side in which the new format shows little or no interest.

• In terms of the artists it plays, modern/adult stations usually look for artists who have credibility in the modern rock format, although there are one or two notable exceptions. But in most other matters—especially the issue of when they play songs—modern adult stations tend to resemble top 40/adult stations more than their modern counterparts, with a higher correspondence to the former chart than the latter.

• Although the modern/adult format is, in many ways, the '90s equivalent of the '70s soft rock format, it is not based as heavily in singer/songwriters as one might think. Female singer/songwriters who would have been comfortable on a '70s soft rock station, from Jann Arden to Tracy Chapman to Na-



TOP 40 TOPICS BY SEAN ROSS

Where The Holes Are, Part Deux

For hardcore radio junkies—those of us who use our vacations and weekend getaways as an excuse to listen to radio, not to escape it—there are always one or two heavily played songs by which you remember any trip. For several years, one sign of top 40's decline was that the song you remembered from button punching wasn't likely to be a top 40 hit anymore. It was more likely to be country. Or an oldie. Or classic rock. (Or, for the rest of you who matured normally, a story from "All Things Considered," perhaps.)

I still make trips like those on occasion. With no mainstream top 40 in Baltimore or Washington, D.C., the records by which I'll remember the last Bobby Poe convention are "Blue" by LeAnn Rimes and "If I Ruled The World" by Nas. But things are getting better. I drove a New York-Wilkes-Barre, Pa.-Binghamton, N.Y.-Elmira, N.Y.-Rochester, N.Y.-Syracuse, N.Y.-Albany, N.Y.-New York circle this weekend, and I'm proud to report that even if I did hear "Anyway You Want It" by Journey more than once, it was no longer the most-played song of the trip. (Honors on that score go to "You Learn," which, since that's the No. 1 mainstream record, is how it should be, with runners-up including "Macarena," "Champagne Supernova," "Killing Me Softly," and "Counting Blue Cars.")

This is one more indicator that the top 40 holes are being filled in. Unlike the New York-D.C. trip, there wasn't one market on this route without a top 40. But there are still cities where top 40 is MIA. So here's part two of this column's analysis on where the holes are (or are not) in descending order of market size.

Sacramento, Calif. (market No. 29)—Even before "Ironic" and "Because You Loved Me" became rhythm-crossover mainstays, KSFM was one of those top 40s that would at least spike the biggest pop records, once those songs reached critical mass, "One Of Us" being the most recent example. It may surprise everybody to read this here, but as long as the crossover outlets are willing to cover their bases on some pop titles, it would be hard to do mainstream top 40 here or in Fresno, Calif., Monterey, Calif., San Jose, Calif., Albuquerque, N.M., or San Bernardino, Calif. Seeing it work again in San Francisco would be the acid test—although that particular term does have a different meaning in San Francisco.

Salt Lake City (No. 35)—KUTQ (Q99) is starting to act more like a top 40 station than a modern rocker. So any opportunity that exists here again depends on where new PD Ken Carr and company end up. Even with Q99, top 40/adult KBEE (B98.7), KQMB, top 40/rhythm KZHT (Hot 49.9), several moderns, and three countries fragmenting the young-adult audience, I say there's room here for a larger-than-life, mass-appeal top 40 along the lines of the old KCPX until one of the borderline players commits. And this being America's most over-radioed market, the minute somebody did that, three other stations would join 'em.

Memphis (No. 43)—Through the '80s, a few folks took a run at adult-leaning WMC-FM (FM100) with hot-rocking, flame-throwing top 40 and didn't understand why they couldn't dent FM100 when that station was still playing Alabama oldies. At the time, FM100 was sufficiently well-entrenched and just close enough to top 40 to own that image. And those top 40 partisans that weren't controlled by FM100 were listening to the R&B stations, WHRK (K97) and KJMS (Majic 101), both of which could throw in a Bryan Adams or Gloria Estefan record when they felt like it. But that was 10 years ago. Today's 22-year-old doesn't have the same perception of K97 or FM100 as a top 40

station. And some of the stations that should be getting the top 40 audience by default—specifically, the young-end rocker, the modern rocker, and the young-end country—are not, at the moment, pulling boxcar numbers, suggesting an opportunity for somebody. With nearby Little Rock, Ark., now out of the picture, the cradle of rock'n'roll may be the biggest top 40 hole in the country right now.

Worcester, Mass. (No. 106)—Because of its proximity to a half-dozen other Southern New England markets, this is one city that has never had its own top 40 on FM, at least in recent memory. Instead, it has two mainstream ACs, an album rocker that now targets Boston, and a suburban hot AC. Top 40 isn't the only hole in this market. There's not a major country outlet. There's not a mainstream R&B FM anywhere in Southern New England. But there's at least room for one more big player to own the hometown station and entertainment station positions—so why not do top 40?

Jackson, Miss. (No. 118)—The last top 40 in this market went through several call-letter changes and permutations of the format before going young country; it didn't leave much of a legacy, which may say something about why nobody seemed eager to replace it. Right now, the market is divided between WJMI—one of the best R&B stations anywhere—two well-programmed country outlets, and hot AC WJDX, which owns the heritage top 40 calls in the market and which has evolved from mainstream to hot AC lately but seems to have no plans to go further. WJDX is, in addition, the duopoly partner of the two country stations, which means that it might be hard for any new player to make a dent saleswise. But from a programming standpoint, the hole is there.

Portland, Maine (No. 162)—It's not that you can't hear top 40 in this market. WMME Augusta, Maine, comes in fine here. So does suburban WRER (R96). So does New Hampshire's top 40/adult WZPK (Peak FM). The latter two stations made a quick pass at being Portland stations when the market's previous top 40s went away, without much success. And, again, this is a market in which both stations left on bad terms, after a particularly ugly late-'80s battle. For top 40 to work here, it would have to be local. It would have to be well-financed. And it would have to ingratiate its way into the community very quickly.

Where else? Savannah, Ga., is almost identical to Jackson in terms of the existing players, and it's been without top 40 for a longer time, so there might not be as much baggage to overcome. Topeka, Kan., Shreveport, La., Fayetteville, N.C., and Columbus, Ga., have also been without top 40 for a while. Montgomery, Ala., just lost its last top 40 this year. At the moment, market observers are eyeing both the third country station and the hot AC warily to see who wants to be first.

The problem in most of the aforementioned markets is that nobody wants to be first. The problem in the remaining markets is that nobody minds being second. Meaning that we could see too many players swarm into the format in some markets, keep one station from developing a legitimate success story, and discourage anybody from filling some of the remaining holes that exist. We're already starting to hear on-air sniping between competing top 40s again, one of the things that probably hurt the format last time.

So far, we've gotten relatively lucky in the past few months—people have wanted to fill some top 40 holes without waiting to see a lot of success stories. Ultimately, however, it's going to take actual successes to rebuild the format. And it's going to take success stories that can withstand top 40's tendency to self-destruct.

Wyatt Returns To Crossover Radio

Veteran Los Angeles radio figure Jeff Wyatt (KIIS, KPWR) has been named GM of L.A.'s new top 40/dance outlet, KACD/KBCD (Groove Radio.) No air staff has been named yet, but Joe "Boomer" Servantes and China Smith have been retained from the station's AC format, and word is that Jim "Poorman" Trenton will sign on. Groove Radio also hires Peter Nichols from rival KROQ as graphic designer.

KBZR (103.1) Phoenix, which had been running R&B oldies since its sign-on, kicked off 24-hour-a-day live mixers July 3. No jocks yet.

WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago expands its weekend "Private Lives" sex talk show to morning drive. The show, hosted by Kelly Johnson and Karen Hand, is now heard 8-10 a.m. and will still play six songs an hour, according to MD Erik Bradley. Morning team George McFly and Frankie "Hollywood" Rodriguez now broadcast 5-8 a.m. The Chicago Sun-Times reports that SJS Entertainment is picking up the Sunday night version of "Private Lives" for national syndication. The Sun-Times also reports that Evergreen is in the process of buying top 40/adult WPNT (FM100).

WPST Trenton, N.J., APD/M1 Dave McKay is upped to PD as VP of programming. Michelle Stevens drops the daily reins to oversee programming for Nassau Broadcasting's 12 stations, including recently acquired AC WOBM AM-FM Ocean County, N.J.

KWMX (Mix 107.5) Denver's morning team of Eric Ferguson and newscaster Robbyn Hart have exited in preparation for the arrival of Rick Stacy. KWMX production director Dirk Steele and morning producer Larry Ulibarri are currently filling in on mornings.

Simulcast top 40 AM KCBQ San Diego flips to N/T . . . Former WCOD Cape Cod, Mass., GM Bill Files is named GM at hot AC WFKS (Kiss 99.9) Daytona Beach, Fla., replacing Mike Loures. Look for Kiss to move to a hotter top

40/adult approach.

Top 40/adult WAEV (Mix 97.3) Savannah, Ga., and gospel/R&B adult sister combo, WSOK/WLVH, have been sold to Patterson Broadcasting, owner of AC/country WYKZ/WCHY.

Top 40/adult WEZB (B97) New Orleans raids rival KHOM (Mix 104.1) night jock Skid Marxx for afternoons. He'll be known as David Marxx. B97 taps Kim Carson, last heard in mornings at country rival WNOE, for middays.

Billy Burke exits afternoons at KSFM Sacramento, Calif. Will he resurface shortly in some capacity at KIIS Los Angeles? Meanwhile, KSFM taps Randi from WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., for nights, replacing Naughty Boy . . . KJMZ (Mix 94.5) Las Vegas, which recently flipped to top 40/adult, gets new calls KMXB.

WHTZ (Z100) New York overnighter Jeremy the Phone Guy segues to crosstown WXRK (K-Rock) for swing . . . Top 40/rhythm CIDC Toronto morning man Jesse Dylan returns to crosstown rocker CILQ (Q107), where he's re-united with Gene Vilitis.

AC WMAS Springfield, Mass., promotion director Karen Ann McCarthy crosses to rival WHYN-FM, replacing Kevin Matthews, now with WFHN (Fun 107) New Bedford, Mass.



Dance Revival, Modern AC Panels On Tap

The dance boom and the growth of the modern/adult format are among the hot topics to be discussed at the upcoming Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards, scheduled for Sept. 5-7 at the New York Sheraton.

Top 40-specific sessions include "The Dance Revival: Does It Feel Mighty Real?" With the meteoric rise of WKTU New York

you meet them at your next staff meeting.

Another session, "Four Stations, One PD, And A Telecom Bill: So Who's Listening To The Music?", will attempt to answer the question of what happens in this post-Telecom Act era of consolidation, in which one PD makes music decisions for multiple stations. Programmers in all formats who oversee more than one station will discuss the challenges.

DAB, hard-drive automation, digital downloading of music, and the Internet will be among the subjects tackled at the session "Technology Isn't Just For Techno-Geeks Anymore." Find out how these high-profile technical issues will affect radio and its relationship with labels.

Another new session this year will be "The All-Format Market Leaders Panel," during which PDs of the leading stations in major markets will talk about the issues they have in common that transcend format boundaries.

Returning this year will be the "Air Personality Supergroup" session, in which top jocks from all formats compare war stories and discuss what it takes to be a successful entertainer today. Also returning is the popular "Music Trivia Contest And Game Show"—hosted by Airplay Monitor editor Sean Ross, "Radio's Rainman"—as trivia geeks gather under one roof to show off their heads full of obscure facts and compete for semi-valuable prizes.

Other related seminar activities include opening night festivities Sept. 5, breakfast at the Hard Rock Cafe the next morning, and a cocktail party Friday evening. The seminar culminates with the annual Radio Awards dinner and ceremony Sept. 7.

talie Merchant, are a major part of the format. But so are bands who broke through a more conventional modern rock route: Smashing Pumpkins, Foo Fighters, Oasis, etc.

At press time, there were 18 large- and medium-market stations that could reasonably be said to be modern/adult outlets. Those included stations that were taking a more top 40 or AC approach to the format, most notably the much-copied KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles and KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego, and those that operate as part of the modern rock community, specifically such "rock alternative" outlets as KXPK Denver and KAEP Spokane, Wash. What we felt all those stations had in common—even before looking at a chart—is that they chose primarily from modern's musical universe, that their target was older than a conventional modern station, and that they played much of the gold that had been exiled to special programming at most moderns.

Of the 18 stations now closest to the adult modern format, 14 were available through BDS. For the purposes of our custom chart only, we took five modern rock stations—KAEP, KXPK, WLJR Long Island, N.Y.; KZON Phoenix; and WWCD Columbus, Ohio—and four stations from the top 40/adult panel: KFMB, KYSR, WSHF Miami and WTMX Chicago. We also included KQPT Sacramento, Calif. (currently a triple-A reporter), WDLZ Orlando, Fla., and KRRK Omaha, Neb. (two stations that just switched from mainstream and modern rock, respectively), and two mainstream top 40 reporters, WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn., and KALC (Alice 106) Denver. BDS is currently working to monitor three of the format's remaining outlets—WPTE Norfolk, Va., KZZP Phoenix, and KRQR (Alice 97.3) San Francisco; the remaining one, KKNB Lincoln, Neb., is in a nonmonitored market.

Many of those stations might think of themselves as having little in common. But we found a surprising amount of consensus. Within the top 30 most-played titles, 10 songs—or one-third—are on all 14 stations. Another five songs are on 13 of the 14 stations.

By comparison, only four songs ("You Learn," "Give Me One Reason," "Ironic," and "Who Will Save Your Soul") were on all 82 mainstream top 40 stations for a comparable period. Only "Give Me One Reason" is on all 47 top 40/adult reporters.

What don't modern/adult stations play? They differ from the top 40/adult panelists by not play-

ing that chart's current hits by Celine Dion, Tony Rich, the Fugees, George Michael, Robert Miles, or Los Del Rio, some of which made it on to one or two of the stations on our custom panel, but none of which were in modern/adult's 40 most-played songs. They differ considerably from conventional modern rock. On the June 28 modern chart, at least six of the top 10 were records that didn't make the modern/adult chart, songs from the Butthole Surfers, Stone Temple Pilots, No Doubt, Soundgarden, Tracy Bonham, Garbage, and Porno For Pyros that are either too hard or too new for many modern/adult outlets. By having sat out, in most cases, "Because You Loved Me" and, thus far, "Pepper," modern/adult stations have passed on records that were No. 1 in the top 40/adult and modern formats.

Despite this, modern/adult stations will occasionally make exceptions for nonmodern-image artists that modern rock stations cannot. Eric Clapton's "Change The World" is a top 10 modern/adult record with airplay on about 60% of our custom panel. Jann Arden's "Insensitive" is top 15. Donna Lewis' "I Love You Always Forever" cracks the top 40 this week.

Modern/adult stations tend not to play records that haven't already been broken by other formats. The closest thing to an indigenous modern/adult record is Radiohead's "High And Dry," which received airplay at top 40 and modern but never became a "Run-Around" or "1979" in either format. Another possible exception is Why Store's "Lack Of Water," which charts here largely, although not exclusively, on the strength of airplay at the panel's modern and triple-A reporters.

The chart you see below covers the period from June 25 to July 1, a time frame roughly comparable with the charts in last week's Airplay Monitors. If you want to see what the chart will look like this week, it's available to BDS subscribers who call up the "charts" menu, then select the "adult modern" chart. (If you don't subscribe to BDS, call 800-688-4634 for more info.)

At the present, we're merely making this chart available in this issue and through BDS as a service to the industry. With the jury still out on whether modern/adult is an enduring format, we won't make this a regular Airplay Monitor chart, yet. MONITOR PROFILE**PD Background Gives Gehron A Unique Perspective In Today's Marketplace**

John Gehron doesn't fit the profile of your typical corporate bean-counter. As co-COO (with David Pearlman) of Boston-based American Radio Systems, he is one of the growing number of broadcasting execs who broke out of the programming ranks, most notably at WLS Chicago.

"The industry has never experienced what we're going through today," Gehron says, in a massive understatement. "This is how we now define the future."

In a post-Telecom Act world, where corporations swap stations like so many trading cards, ARS continues to seek active growth opportunities. And unlike other broadcast giants, it isn't limiting acquisitions to the top 10 or even top 20 markets. "We prefer to concentrate on growth markets," Gehron says. "Markets that aren't over-radioed, where we can become one of the key players, or the key player. That's our goal—to control the radio dollars and dollars from other media." That's why ARS is operating in markets where it has the ability to direct the business, says Gehron, such as Las Vegas, San Jose, Calif., Austin, Texas, West Palm

stand-alones will be able to rise with the tide," he says. "I'm not convinced that an owner who's left with a single station can't be successful, as long as they're running that station well and providing a product the listener wants."

"Radio won't grow by taking money from small operators," Gehron continues. "As big as ARS might get, we can never own enough stations in a market to cover every niche format possible. The beauty of radio is you can change it overnight simply by bringing in a stack of new records, and if you play them in a better order than the other guys, you'll win."

"Look how quickly a single station can become successful. In the country's largest, most competitive market, WK TU went from nothing to No. 1 in less than 90 days. Anybody could have done that if they were smart. A stand-alone went against the big guys and beat everybody . . . The listener doesn't care who owns the radio station, whether it's Evergreen, ARS, or Joe and Mary Smith."

Having a former DJ end up co-COO of ARS is akin to the PD beating out the sales manager for the GM's job. Ten years ago that was a rarity. Today, more programmers are successfully making the transition to the corporate suite. Gehron recently moderated a panel for the Broadcast Ad Club, and among the owners and managers in attendance were Tribune's Wayne Vriesman, who started as a news writer; Viacom's Bill Figenshu, who started as a DJ; and CBS honcho Dan Mason, another former PD.

"The job description of today's PD has changed," Gehron says. "They used to be concerned only with playing records, but today, because of deregulation, a PD has become much more well-rounded, more business-oriented, more capable."

Gehron programmed the legendary WLS before being promoted to GM in 1983. He later ran WODS Boston for CBS, until Pyramid brought him back to Chicago as GM of jazz/AC WNUA. He returned to Boston with ARS in '94, six months after Steve Dodge formed the company, which, at the time, consisted of the former Atlantic Radio, Stoner, and Pearlman's Multi-Market properties.


Gehron sees another advantage to owning more than one property per market: One-stop shopping for labels. Recording artist Meat Loaf recently visited WBMM Boston and ended up visiting four ARS stations, including all-sports WEEI and N/T WRKO. "Labels can now work with groups of stations in a market instead of worrying about two top 40s fighting each other," he says. "It takes the pressure off the labels over playing favorites. Now, the owner can decide where the artist will appear, not the label."

"My primary job is to act as a resource. I can offer my expertise in marketing and programming and can make our stations aware of trends in other markets. Hopefully, I have more time for strategic thinking because I'm not on the firing line every day."

For the future, look for ARS to slow down its expansion into new markets, says Gehron, in favor of beefing up its rosters in existing markets. ARS recently upped its critical mass in Rochester, N.Y., Buffalo, N.Y., Dayton, Ohio, Hartford, Conn., and Boston.

"ARS is a people-oriented company whose goal is to grow people faster than assets," he says. Gehron and Pearlman each oversee seven markets: Pearlman covers the East Coast; Gehron, the West Coast.

"It's our goal to keep that human element alive," says Gehron. CEO Steve Dodge "sets the tone, along with [CFO] Joe Winn. One of the reasons I went to work for ARS in the first place is our values are similar." KEVIN CARTER

Beach, Fla., Portland, Ore.—"the markets of tomorrow," he says.

In this new environment, Gehron says, "there are now three or four strong operators in a market, and that's become the way to go after business we couldn't attract before. We can now go to an advertiser with an impressive portfolio of stations and nail down a \$50,000 or \$100,000 buy, rather than fighting over a \$2,000 order. Before, we didn't have the clout or critical mass to pull off that kind of deal."

Until recently, radio was forced to play by agency rules. "They would hold a radio cattle call and let stations beat each other up for the few dollars that were on the table," Gehron says. "Thanks to the sheer tonnage of operating more than one station in a growth market, we now operate on a level playing field." Where many agency budgets were determined behind closed doors and later doled out with a spoon, "with our added clout, we have the opportunity to get in on the planning stage before those budgets are even put on paper," he says.

Radio's increased powerbase has helped it reclaim ad dollars previously spent on newspapers, which Gehron compares to "miniature, niched radio stations," with many sub-formats: news, sports, weather, business, food, etc.

What about the cumulative effect on mom-and-pop operators? "There will always be opportunity for individual operators," Gehron says. Like many megopoly proponents, he says diversity allows for more formative experimentation and less clustering around mainstream formats in order to make money. "We'll be able to bring more money into the radio arena, which is good news for all operators. Even the
