## Modern Adult Grows Up Quickly As Wallflowers Top First Monitor Chart

Almost a year after Airplay Monitor assembled the industry's first chart measuring modern adult radio, the Modern Adult chart becomes a regular part of Top 40 and Rock Airplay Monitor this week. The 30-position chart can be found on page 26.

The modern adult panel, which currently numbers 28 reporters, includes stations from adult top 40, mainstream top 40, triple-A, and modern. Those stations will continue to report to their primary charts.

Modern Adult will be the first in a series of planned BDS custom charts that represent either a subset of an existing format or, in this case, various subsets of several formats. Since last July, the Modern Adult chart has been available to BDS subscribers

and can still be found via BDS online.

While modern adult stations can vary from each other in many ways, the 28 stations used as modern adult panelists share an emphasis on music from the modern rock universe, or music that is compatible with it, without a significant amount of harder modern rock. Usually, the stations target an audience that grew up with the modern rock of the '80s, but that may have been disenfranchised by the modern rock format's harder, post-Nirvana skew.

When Top 40 and Rock Airplay Monitor ran the first Modern Adult chart on July 12, 1996, there were 14 available reporters, also assembled from multiple formats. There is now twice that number of stations, and other similarly formatted outlets are

## RADI ACTIVE BY KEVIN CARTER

### Alleged Murderess Pleads To Lesser Charge

**S**uzette McClure, the woman accused of murdering promotion executive **Charlie Minor** in March 1995, has reportedly agreed to a plea bargain and will plead guilty to the lesser charge of second-degree murder. McClure will be sentenced to life in prison but will be eligible for parole in 17 years.

**KZZU** Spokane, Wash., has been targeted by a radio pirate. On May 5, the station began receiving phone calls from different parts of town complaining about profane messages, specifically mentioning the **KZZU** call letters, that break into the station's programming. Because of the random locations of the incidents, authorities believe the pirate may be mobile. While the station has been receiving extensive TV and newspaper coverage, PD **Ken Hopkins** is hoping for a quick end to these incidents. Management is offering a \$5,000 reward leading to the arrest and conviction of the pirate.

It's getting hotter in San Diego as we speak: As of May 12, the morning team of **Jeff and Jer** hit the air, as scheduled, at their new home, **KFMB** (Star 100.7). Across the street, **Dave Smiley** showed up on **KKLQ** (Q106), allegedly in violation of his contract, according to **KFMB** OM **Tracy Johnson**, who says Smiley's contract forbids him from cracking the mike until July 18. Asked what recourse **KFMB** plans to take, Johnson said, "We're examining our options."

#### FORMATS: MILWAUKEE GETS POINT

Saga's **WFMI** Milwaukee flips from jazz to modern adult as **WXPT** (the Point). **Dave Beasing** of Jacobs Media is consulting. The new format signed on with **Sheryl Crow's** "A Change Will Do You Good." **Chris Kerr**, most recently PD of modern **WWDX** Lansing, Mich., is the new PD. Kerr is no stranger to the market, having previously spent four years at **WLUM** (Hot 102).

Former **KZFM** Corpus Christi, Texas, PD **Charlie Maxx** (now based in New Jersey) and New World Communications' **Mark Shands** are now serving as co-PDs for a new Web site radio station, **allradio.com**.

Rhythmic top 40 **KPTY** (Party 103.9) Phoenix has upgraded its signal by erecting a new 640-foot tower on a site 10 miles closer to the metro. The station also changes its city of license from Coolidge, Ariz., to Gilbert, Ariz., according to **CE Ray Baca**.

ABC Radio Networks, which rolled out its Radio Disney kids' network last fall, has now officially gone national with the service.

#### SUITS: TURK TAKES IT HOME

**WNOE** New Orleans GSM **Richard Turkheimer** is upped to station manager and will oversee **KHOM** as well as its modern and country sister, replacing **Tom Kennedy**. **Ernest James**, GM of **KHOM's** R&B sister outlets, becomes VP/market manager for all Clear Channel New Orleans properties, including **KHOM**.

Jacor names **Kevin McCarthy** VP/GM and co-market manager for its San Diego AMs **KOGO/XTRA/KPOP/KSDO**. McCarthy joins from the VP/GM slot at **Trumper's KQQL/WBOB** Minneapolis. **Mike Glickenhau** will manage Jacor's FM properties in the market, including top 40s **KKLQ** (Q106) and **KHTS** (Channel 933).

**WRZE** (the Rose) Cape Cod, Mass., PD

**Steve McVie** exits after four years to become APD at Nassau Broadcasting's adult top 40 **WJLK** (the Point) Monmouth, N.J.

Veteran programmer **Ron Jacobs** was, at press time, still in negotiations to become PD for new oldies outlet **KGMZ** Honolulu.

#### PROMO HONCHOS IN FLUX

**KHKS** (106.1 Kiss FM) Dallas marketing director **Julia Atherton** is crossing the street for the same spot at ABC Radio Networks. GM **Brenda Adriance** needs a replacement. And check out these other major market promotions gigs available now: **WHYI** (Y100)/**WBGG** Miami needs a marketing director to replace **Julie Wilson**, who is promoted to VP of marketing for Clear Results Marketing, a new, in-house marketing subsidiary of parent Clear Channel Communications, serving its 107 stations (as of press time). Clear Results will be based in Miami. **Kevin Cerenzia** and **Tammy Moye** continue as Y100 and **WBGG** promotions directors, respectively. Also, **WDRQ** Detroit still seeks a marketing director to replace **Sue Jansik**.

### Others Sowed The Seeds For Modern AC

**W**hen **KYSR** (Star 98.7) Los Angeles became the first modern AC station in fall 1995, modern rock was cutting the new format a pretty wide swath. Modern rival **KROQ** was at its crunchiest and most guitar-driven; around the time that **KYSR** flipped, **KROQ** went looking for another cut from **Alanis Morissette** and came up with "All I Really Want," the hardest song on the album. And after 10-15 years of indiscriminately holding on to the same core artists, modern was starting to purge those artists just as indiscriminately. I recall one station in 1995 that wanted to be classified as top 40 pointing out, "But we play **Annie Lennox** and **the Human League**, so we can't be modern."

No sooner did modern rock finish sowing the seeds of adult modern than top 40 helped. After two years of overdosing on modern, it went almost as far in the other direction, penalizing records—no matter how poppy—if they'd started at modern. People who wanted to hear the modern hits had to go somewhere else for them, and at that moment modern was too hard for many pop fans.

It's clear that modern and top 40 PDs realize what they've done by now. Modern, in the last couple of weeks, has made a point of going back for the **Duncan Sheiks** and **Jewels**. Album rock's response to modern was to try to pre-empt it, and modern is now responding in kind to modern AC. As for top 40 PDs, they still chafe initially at anything they consider too modern, but not to the point where it's stopped them from playing **White Town** or **Paula Cole** or **the Wallflowers** or **the Verve Pipe**. And if those records are actually top 40 records disguised as modern rock, well, you can say the same thing about the first five years of

**Rick Carroll's** pioneering **KROQ** Los Angeles.

Many adult top 40 stations looked, for a while, as if they would become modern ACs. Eventually, like their top 40 brethren, they realized that their format depended on variety—being able to play records without modern credentials, whether they were **Bob Carlisle** or **En Vogue**. Yet modern remains a noticeable flavor for adult top 40, also.

As other formats try to narrow the gap, modern AC stations have narrowed the gap between themselves and other formats, too. After initially looking only at music already broken by top 40, modern AC has gone looking for a lot more of its own music. Many of its most adventurous stations don't look very different anymore from the **KXXPK** Denvers of the world—stations that were serving disenfranchised former modern listeners but from a more alternative point of view.

Like triple-A and modern before it, modern AC has seen its pioneering spirit rewarded by spurring a large number of stations in other formats to try to steal its music. Its defense arsenal includes its ability to play 20 years of modern rock gold at some time other than the "Retro Lunch" and the ability to cherry-pick from modern, top 40, and triple-A. Those are tools that one hopes it won't hand back too quickly.

The fact that other formats are now gunning for modern AC means that modern AC must be doing something right. We're proud that we were the first to recognize that, unveiling the first modern adult chart last July. Now, we're proud to make that chart a regular part of Top 40 (and Rock) Airplay Monitor. What the format looks like is still largely being determined; now, it will always have a place to see its reflection.

### Moving Forward With Airplay Monitor

**W**hen this column debuted in Airplay Monitor, nobody, including myself, would have predicted that its author would one day be the editor in chief for all four Airplay Monitors. slated for BDS monitoring over the next few weeks. Even with a smaller panel, there was already a cohesiveness among modern adult stations and a strong number of consensus hits shared throughout the format, particularly compared to mainstream top 40 at that time.

Among the companies that have been most active in pursuing the adult modern format is American Radio Systems, whose modern AC outlets include flagship WBMX (Mix 98.5) Boston; KMXB (Mix 94.3) Las Vegas; WAQB Rochester, N.Y.; WLCE (Alice 92.9) Buffalo, N.Y.; KFSR (Star 101) Fresno, Calif.; and KAMX (Mix 94.1) Austin, Texas, under consultant Randy Lane.

WBMX PD Greg Strassell, who also advises ARS' other modern ACs, has seen the demand for the format "in market after market, with research project after research project using different companies. The growth opportunity for this format is very real."

As for the addition of the BDS Modern Adult chart to Airplay Monitor, KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles acting PD Angela Perelli notes, "It was getting a little complicated every week opening up Monitor to look for the playlists that most resemble mine. I used to have to skip around from adult top 40 to AC to triple-A to modern rock in order to locate the stations that I most respect. Now that there are enough stations to fill a panel, it's great to be able to see them all on one page."

Newly named Capitol VP of promotion Justin Fontaine sees the power of modern adult in his current position at the Work Group. "Fiona Apple had airplay at triple-A and modern rock, and modern adult is now the next logical step before going to mainstream top 40, which might also be playing dance and urban records," he says. "It's the

bridge to the masses."

"I'll definitely use this new chart," says Lane. As a consultant who specializes in this format, I find this information very useful, and it does help give this new format an extra dose of added legitimacy.

"I believe that modern adult as a format has legs. It's powered by singer/songwriters performing real music with meaningful lyrics." Although the music texture at the heart of this format may eventually change, he adds, "there will always be a large group of people who will gravitate toward rock-based, nonrhythmic hit music."

A list of modern adult reporting stations follows. Playlists for the adult top 40 stations that also report to modern adult have been moved from the adult top 40 Power Playlists section to the Modern Adult page in order to allow us to expand the number of adult top 40 stations represented in the Power Playlists. Top 40/mainstream reporters to the Modern Adult chart continue to be shown on the Top 40/Mainstream Power Playlist page.

Adult top 40 and AC chart manager Steve Graybow will serve as chart manager for the Modern Adult chart and can be reached at 212-536-5361. Airpower criteria for the new chart is 400 detections. The "weeks on chart" history for records currently on the Modern Adult chart is based on their number of weeks on the previous Adult Top 40 chart.

Because of the still-evolving nature of modern adult radio, the parameters for reporting stations are also evolving. ### Kapugi Earns His Stripes, Closes In On Double Digits at Jacor's WFLZ Tampa

**C**aptain. I can't stop it. The damn thing keeps goin' up!"  
Scotty himself couldn't have described the situation more accurately. Jacor's WFLZ Tampa, Fla., with recently installed PD Jeff "Booger" Kapugi at the helm, has managed to navigate to a 9.5 share 12-plus this winter, easily within striking distance of the double-digit stratosphere it inhabited in 1989, when the debut of the Power Pig propelled WFLZ from 2.6 to 11.6.

Kapugi was hired in February 1989 for week-ends at what was then an oldies station. That August, he was upped to MD, "mostly because I was the only one besides the PD who knew anything about Selector. My only guidelines were to avoid scheduling two Motowns or Beatles songs back to back." In six weeks, WFLZ went top 40: "It was like throwing a brick on the gas pedal," he says.

WFLZ was always known for having a deep bench. OM Marc Chase and PD B.J. Harris were known to make decisions on the fly ("It wasn't unusual for Marc to run out of the bathroom with a great idea," Kapugi says), while Kapugi, "the organized one," served primarily as the sole conduit of sanity as "Pig-Mania" reigned outside.

"Everyone would say, 'Give it to Booger; he'll write it down somewhere.'"

"Things didn't work out exactly the way I had planned. I had set some goals early in my career; one of which was to become a PD before I turned 30. I was 22 when I started here, and I figured by 27 or 28 I'd be a PD somewhere."

Kapugi was finally upped to PD in December after warming up as PD of easy-listening sister WDUV while retaining WFLZ duties. In typical Jacor seat-of-the-pants fashion, he was at home sick when Harris called. "B.J. said, 'Hey, we're gonna make you the PD, OK?,' and I said, 'Cool! It's about damn time,'" Kapugi recalls. Those famous Jacor layers of management are firmly in place to this day, only now on a national level. Harris was recently upped to director of top 40

programming; he's still morning co-host. Chase and San Diego-based Jack Evans also received national programming duties. Along with a creative brain trust of Harris and morning co-host M.J. Kelli, Kapugi credits creative director Eric Chase: "He has an ability to take our rough ideas and polish them into amazing promos. Our ideas can come from anywhere or else we'll just rip off [an] idea and take it one or two steps further."

Kapugi's "welcome aboard" party consisted of replacing notorious night jock Bubba the Love Sponge, now in mornings at sister WXTB (98 Rock), and MD/late nights Tom Steele. "Bubba is a one-of-a-kind personality. He carried the radio station for quite some time, but we couldn't move him to mornings on WFLZ, given the success of MJ and BJ," says Kapugi. "The acquisition of 98 Rock made him a perfect fit for mornings there." Bubba was replaced by Kramer from WZYP Huntsville, Ala. "We finally convinced him that he didn't have to fill Bubba's shoes; he just had to be Kramer... Bubba was shooting in the low 20s 18-34, and Kramer has managed to meet those numbers in the winter book," he adds.

Steele recently became morning co-host at WFBC-FM Greenville, S.C., joining a couple of other Pig alumni, PD Rob Wagman and co-host Hawk Harrison. Replacing Steele is Domino, who returns from a stint as OM of WILN Panama City. Middays is split by Dave Mann and Jennifer Jordan, while afternoons are anchored by three-year vet Jeff Thomas, formerly with WQHT (Hot 97) New York.

Although the station tends to favor the rhythmic side, on paper it resembles a textbook top 40 station. "We've just taken advantage of what the market has given us," Kapugi says. "We're lucky that we have no alternative in the market, no FM urban, and no direct top 40 competition."

Here's a recent 5 p.m. hour on WFLZ: OMC, "How Bizarre"; Babyface, "Everytime I Close My Eyes"; Collage, "I'll Be Loving You"; Savage Garden, "I Want You"; Wallflowers, "One Headlight"; En Vogue, "Don't Let Go (Love)"; Real McCoy, "Run Away"; Spice Girls, "Say You'll Be There"; Paula Cole, "Where Have All The Cowboys Gone"; Duncan Sheik, "Barely Breathing"; and Fun Factory, "Take Your Chance."

Even with all the elements in place, Kapugi is convinced some intangible magic is at play that makes it all work. "That magic was created on day one of the Power Pig and never wore off," he says. "We've always worked and played hard together, [in] brainstorming sessions, an impromptu three-on-three basketball game [there's a court in the building], or golfing. This staff has made it more like a family and less like a job."

"This station was successful before it was good," Kapugi adds. "Thankfully, things have settled down, and now, along with our success, we've also gotten pretty good." **KEVIN CARTER**

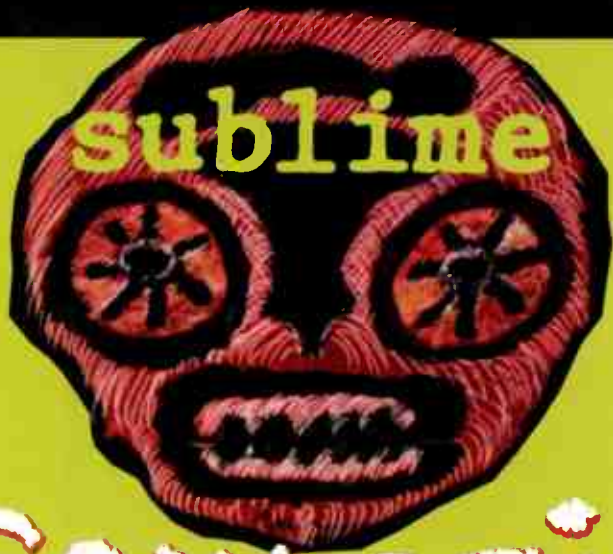

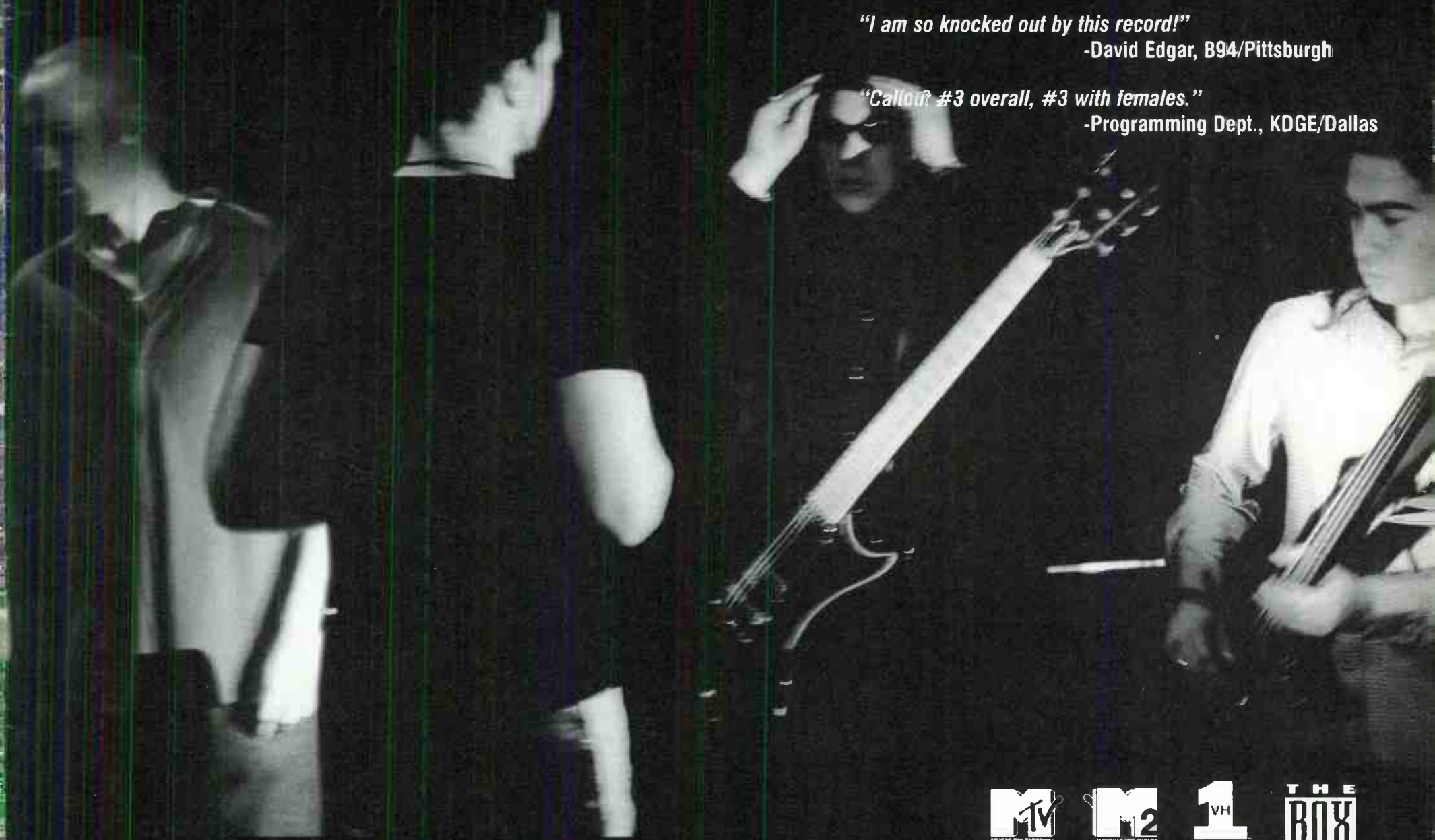
