Shortage Of Female Talent Widens Radio's Gender Gap

Programmers in all formats who have open air shifts that they are hoping to fill with a female jock are reporting an alarming shortage of female applicants. Although males in radio have always considerably outnumbered females, some PDs see that gap widening even further.

Country KJJY Des Moines, Iowa, PD Beverlee Brannigan says she gets 20 tapes from men for every one she gets from a woman and is among those who believe the problem is escalating. "There have never been as many female applicants as males, but it does seem worse to me in the last 18 months to two years," she says.

Country WOKQ Dover, N.H., PD Mark Ericson says the ratio of male to female tapes he gets for job openings is closer to 10 to 1, but, he says, "that's still way out of whack."

"When I first came to Fort Myers [Fla.], I really wanted a good female to do nights," says WWGR PD Chris O'Kelley. "I ran many ads. Not one

tape came in from a female. Then I ran the same ad for a female to do afternoons and, again, not one tape from a female came in."

"I currently have a position open for evenings and about two months ago [had] an opening for afternoons," echoes WMIL Milwaukee OM Kerry Wolfe. "Of all the tapes I received, zero were from women. I certainly wish there were more. Pickings are slim."


"Most of the tapes and résumés I have received in the past six months have overwhelmingly been from men," adds WGRX Baltimore PD Jim West. "I would certainly welcome more female air talent applicants."

In fact, of all the programmers contacted for this story, only one, WGRL Indianapolis PD John Q. Morris, says he gets enough female applicants. "During my most recent search this summer, I received enough tapes from talented females to field an entirely female lineup," he says.

Jacor To Merge With Clear Channel

After months of speculation, Jacor Communications has chosen to merge with Clear Channel Communications, creating the third, and quite possibly last, corporate radio superpower, joining Chancellor/Capstar and CBS/Infinity.

The \$4.4 billion merger creates a company that will own and/or operate 454 radio stations in 101 American markets. It is the second-largest conglomerate by station count and third largest ranked by radio revenue. The deal must now pass muster with government agencies and stockholders.

Considering the size of the merger, there's little overlap of the two entities. Only five markets have stations that must be divested: Cleveland; Jacksonville, Fla.; Louisville, Ky.; Houston; and Tampa, Fla. The latter market poses the biggest challenge, as several of the 15 stations will have

to be spun off. Currently, in Tampa Jacor and Clear Channel own modern AC WSSR, triple-A WHPT, adult top 40 WAKS, mainstream top 40 WFLZ, adult R&B WRBQ-AM, R&B oldies WILV, easy listening WDUV, album rock WXTB, classic rock WTB, jazz WSJT, country WRBQ, N/Ts WHNZ and WFLA, and sports WZTM and WDAE.

The two companies expect to close the deal Sept. 30, 1999. Jacor will continue to operate as a separate entity of Clear Channel, with Randy Michaels maintaining his role as Jacor's CEO and Bobby Lawrence as its president.

Aside from its radio holdings, Clear Channel owns billboards in 33 markets and TV stations in 11 markets. Jacor owns one TV station in Cincinnati and runs Premiere Radio Networks, home to syndicated talents Rush Limbaugh and Dr. Laura Schlessinger.

KIIS Gets Into The Groove For Now

Following last week's \$67 million purchase by Jacor, KACD/KBCD (Groove Radio) Los Angeles dropped its club-leaning rhythmic top 40 format Oct. 12 to simulcast top 40 sister KIIS, which has been heard throwing in the slogan "Groove 102.7." It's widely expected that the Groove duo will adopt a new format. However, KIIS' influence continues to grow in the high desert of the Antelope Valley, northeast of Los Angeles, as its broadcast is now also being heard on former moderns KAVS and KYHT Lancaster, Calif.

A special tip of the entrepreneurial hat goes to Ken Roberts. In 1972, he invested \$500,000 for a 25% stake in what would soon become KROQ Los Angeles. Another half-mil or so later, he assumed total control of the station until he sold it to Infinity for more than \$42 million. He then used a very small piece of that to purchase a couple of weak signals and sign on techno "Mars FM." The simulcast would eventually transform into \$67 million property Groove Radio.

Meanwhile, former Groove Radio PD Swedish Egil joins digital satellite broadcaster CD Radio as head of its dance/reggae division. He'll report to newly named director of programming operations Jim Kressler, most recently with cable music service Music Choice.

BUSINESS: MORE SALES

The M Street Journal reports that Citadel picks up 62nd Street's Saginaw, Mich., combo, adult top 40 WIOG and soft AC WGER, for \$35 million.

In other station sales, New Wave Broadcasting buys Caribou's four Honolulu stations, including top 40 KQMQ-AM-FM.

PROGRAMMING: RANDY RAMBLES

Randy James, most recently PD of WMVX (Mix 106.5) Cleveland, is the new PD of KHX (Mix 96.5) Houston. He replaces Lorri Palagi, who left to join Guy Zapoleon's consultancy.

Consultant Dave Lange joins Capstar as VP of programming for its Midwest region, which consists of the group's Central Star stations, as well as selected other Capstar outlets. Lange joins Capstar's other regional VPs of programming Alan Furst (mid-South), Buddy Scott (mid-Atlantic), Dave Dillon (Southeast), and Harve Allan (Northeast).

As rumored, Clear Channel launched a new modern adult, WQSH (She 93) Louisville, Ky., at 5 p.m. Oct. 12. Market OM Michael Lee oversees the station. Karen Rite returns to the market as PD. She joins from AC WMXB Richmond, Va., and she previously worked at top 40 WDJX in Louisville. The "very current-intensive" outlet launched with 10,000 songs in a row. Here's the first hour: Meredith Brooks,

"Bitch"; Goo Goo Dolls, "Iris"; Smash mouth, "Walkin' On The Sun"; Alanis Morissette, "Head Over Feet"; matchbox 20, "Real World"; Gin Blossoms, "Found Out About You"; Brian Setzer Orchestra, "Jump Jive An' Wail"; Jewel, "Foolish Games"; Sarah McLachlan, "Adia"; Everything, "Hooch"; D.N.A. Featuring Suzanne Vega, "Tom's Diner"; Hootie & the Blowfish, "I Go Blind"; Eagle-Eye Cherry, "Save Tonight"; 4 Non Blondes, "What's Up"; Natalie Merchant, "Kind & Generous"; and Dave Matthews Band, "Ants Marching."

Former WBIX (Big 105) New York interim PD Anthony Iannini is the new PD at AC WAFL (Eagle 97.7) Dover, Del., replacing Dan Gaffney. That station will retool and become a mainstream top 40 targeted to Ocean City, Md., by Nov. 1. Iannini is also the OM for Spanish AM WYUS.

Former WSSX Charleston, S.C., PD Calvin Hicks exits his new PD gig at WVB (the Vibe) Daytona Beach, Fla. APD Fargo is promoted to replace him. Also at the

Vibe, Tim Tuttle returns to do mornings with co-host Michelle Fox, who previously was an intern at Clear Channel's Orlando, Fla., cluster. Fresh out of school for her first radio gig is Amy, who nabs the midday shift, with P/T Stephanie, who has radio experience in Cleveland and Charleston, W.Va., in for nights.

KGLI Sioux City, Iowa, PD Mark Hahn leaves his PD gig to go into the sales department and concentrate on mornings. MD/afternoons Bart McCoy is bumped up to PD. He'll be hiring his replacement as MD within two weeks.

Jones Radio Networks gives Rick Brady, OM of its soft AC format, Rich Bryan, OM of its classic rock format, and oldies OM (and top 40 veteran) Jon Holiday associate consultant stripes with Jones Radio's consulting and programming division.

Bowdoin College outlet WBOR Brunswick, Maine, flips to rhythmic top 40—at least for 12 hours a week—as Power 91. KYLD San Francisco's Geoff St. John is doing the voicers.

KXXM (Mix 96) San Antonio PD Krash Kelly is starting to fill in his air staff. Nina Cardona joins for late nights from Aggravated Records in Houston. Before that, Cardona did nights at the former KRTX Houston. Co-hosting mornings will be Deb Ireland, morning co-host at WJET (Jet 102) Erie, Pa., for several years. She starts in November; her co-host is being sought.

'Hands' Grabs High Chart Rungs In Debut

CHART MONITOR: Following the recent pattern of high debuts (à la *Hootie & the Blowfish* and *Alanis Morissette*), Jewel's "Hands" (Atlantic) bows on the adult top 40 and modern adult charts at Nos. 22 and 19, respectively. "Hands" also debuts at No. 38 on the mainstream top 40 chart. Last issue, "Hands" had leaked to enough stations to appear as a Greatest Gainer on both the adult top 40 and modern adult charts and show up as Chart Bound on the mainstream top 40 Impact page, with 173 spins from 17 stations. Look for Jewel to grace the cover of *Vogue's* January issue and *Rolling Stone's* year-end issue. She'll also be making the late-night circuit: "Saturday Night Live," Nov. 14; "The Tonight Show With Jay Leno," Nov. 19; and "Late Show With David Letterman," Nov. 26.

LIVE LONG AND PROSPER: After 55 weeks on the AC chart, Paula Cole's "I Don't Want To Wait" (Imago/Warner Bros.) finally falls below the top 20 and is retired from the chart. That gives Cole the seventh-longest AC chart run, behind Eric Clapton's "Change The World" (81 weeks), Sophie B. Hawkins' "As I Lay Me Down" (67 weeks), Take That's "Back For Good" (66 weeks), LeAnn Rimes' "How Do I Live" (65 weeks), Elton John's "Something About The Way You Look Tonight" (58 weeks), and Celine Dion's "Because You Love Me" (56 weeks).

MUSICAL CHAIR: Atlantic's Andrea Ganis is promoted to executive VP... Island associate director of Midwest regional promotion Jeff Davis is upped to associate director of top 40 promotion. Davis will remain in Chicago, while New York-based promotion assistant Joe Daddio will relocate to Chicago for regional promotion duties. Former WWKX Providence, R.I., MD Becky Ianone joins the label to replace Daddio in New York.

Virgin's national director of promotion Mike Easterlin relocates from New York to the label's home office in Los Angeles. Easterlin can now be reached at 310-288-2726... Look for 550 Music senior VP of artist development Vince Bannon to add that title for Epic Records. In an unrelated move, Epic ups Chris Poppe from senior director of marketing to VP of marketing.

FOR THE RECORD: Effective immediately, WJD Jackson, Miss., is removed from the adult contemporary panel due to a format change. There are now 64 AC reporters.

ARTIST MONITOR: Did you know that Eve 6 originally went by the name *ElevenTeen*, but the group switched to Eve 6 after viewing the "X-Files" episode that featured nine clones named Eve? Incidentally, the sixth Eve clone was confined to a mental hospital... Did you know that the guitar sampled in Stardust's "Music Sounds Better With You" is from Chaka Khan's "Fate"?

MONITOR PROFILE

Longtime Radio Veteran Larry Kent 'Goes With The Flow' As Gulfstar Regional PD

Having spent almost 40 years in radio, including a stint with the legendary Gordon McLendon, Larry Kent had to be persuaded to return to the radio business in 1989. Yet when he accepted Don Chaney's offer to program KKYL Texarkana, Texas, little did he know that he'd be at the forefront of high-tech programming.

To be sure, he still knew how to program when he came back. Kent flipped KKYL, which had a 0.03 share, from hot AC to country, and in one book, he led the station to a 36 share 12-plus. He eventually was promoted to corporate PD for Chaney's Stellar Communications, then stayed on when Chaney sold out to Gulfstar, now under the Capstar umbrella.

Currently, Kent is East Texas regional director of programming. Under his domain are 10 stations in three markets: top 40 KISX (Mix 107.3), country KNUE, AC KTYL, and classic rock KTX (96X) in Tyler; KKYL, top 40 KPWW (Power 95.9), and classic rock KYGL in Texarkana; and top 40 KAFA (the

purpose is to give smaller markets access to better-sounding air talent. Granted, we may save a little on talent, but these stations get to use larger-market air talent [that] they couldn't normally afford to get."

Many people believe syndications like the Star System drain radio of a vital breeding ground for the superstar jocks of the future. "I understand their concern," Kent says. "But that's not solely the fault of the Star System. Mom-and-pop stations, which have traditionally been that training ground, are disappearing in the recent consolidation. The bottom line is people who really want to make a career in radio will find a way, be it as an intern at a larger station. The true talents in our business always find a way to make themselves known."

Kent's music stations are programmed individually, even during Star System broadcasts. "We also do our own music in-house, generate the music logs here, and then send it to them. All they do is add the voice. In each market, I do what all good programmers do and just play the hits. There may be a slight variance in what the hits are between Texarkana, Tyler, and Lufkin, but the goal is basically the same."

Here's a sample hour on KPWW: Bare-naked Ladies, "One Week"; Savage Garden, "Truly Madly Deeply"; Le Click, "Tonight Is The Night"; Alanis Morissette, "Thank U"; Duncan Sheik, "Barely Breathing"; Soul II Soul, "Back To Life"; Natalie Merchant, "Wonder"; Jennifer Paige, "Crush"; Brian McKnight, "Anytime"; Montell Jordan, "This Is How We Do It"; Blind Melon, "No Rain"; All Saints, "Never Ever"; Natalie Imbruglia, "Torn"; and US3, "Cantaloop."

In comparison, KISX's sample hour leans a little more rhythmic but also has Peter Gabriel's "In Your Eyes" and Ace Of Base's "The Sign" as gold. KAFA's hour shows more female product from Fiona Apple, Paula Cole, and Sarah McLachlan.

Kent also notes that each station runs its own promotions and call-in contests, with callers automatically routed to Austin during Star System shifts. "It's pretty impressive," he says. "You can't tell that they're talking to someone 300 miles away."

"We have a full-time promotion director in Tyler who oversees all four [top 40] stations," he continues. "Promotional funding is fairly equitably divided. One station may need it more during one book than others, so we'll adjust."

Ironically, in Texarkana, Kent's cluster was recently forced to divest itself of LMA'd AC KIWN, which has since become a direct rival by simulcasting top 40 KHTF (K-Hits) Little Rock, Ark. As fate would have it, Kent is trumpeting Power's local angle. "They're simulcasting all dayparts, including stop-sets and commercials," he says. "Simulcasting is a wild card; we're just going to keep on playing the hits."

Kent has seen top 40 grow from its infancy, through the ups and downs, to what it is today, yet he refuses to wax nostalgic about the "good old days." "I was there at the birth of top 40 and have seen everything come and go," he says. "But I'm not surprised at where we are today. The biggest change in radio is technology. People are still the same; they still want the hits. Now, it's just a matter of using technology to your advantage."

"If you told me 15 years ago that you could put all your music on a computer hard drive, I'd think you were crazy," he concludes. "The same goes for broadcasting a radio show from 300 miles away. So nothing surprises me anymore. I just go with the flow."



Shortage Of Female Talent Widens Radio's Gender Gap

NOT CRAZY ENOUGH?

For nearly everyone else, there is a problem. And while no one is exactly sure why there are few female applicants, programmers offer numerous theories ranging from women being more attracted to TV to women being less likely to switch markets.

Album rock WNOR Norfolk, Va., PD Harvey Kojan, who just filled an open shift with a female jock, says that "only a tiny handful" of the tapes he received were from women. But, he says, "it's always been that way because women aren't crazy enough to get into this business. Often, being a [DJ] is a job where you have to work strange hours. Obviously, it's a business with minimal security. It's a tough business. You end up working six days a week and making personal appearances." That makes being a DJ a tough career choice for women, he says, because "in most instances, women are still the primary caregiver for children."

"We're still a very male-dominated industry," says "Hurricane" Dave Smith, PD of R&B WHBX Tallahassee, Fla. "Women have less of a networking pool to work with . . . and networking is crucial in finding out about jobs, as well as letting people know about your specific talents."

"I have always maintained that female jocks simply have never had enough role models," says Ericson. "Every male jock can point to a couple of idols from their youth, and these are almost always male jocks. Based on the number of female personalities, or lack thereof, women have always had less of a standard to judge themselves by."

WCTQ Sarasota, Fla., PD Rob Carpenter says, "The talent is there, but many of the women in the business seem to be much more reluctant to relocate for a job. I also think that cable TV has opened up so many more TV opportunities that a lot of women see better career advancement and a better salary in [TV]."

WBCT/WCUZ Grand Rapids, Mich., OM Doug Montgomery says, "My theory is that many of the outstanding women have been pigeonholed into being news or sidekick types only and have been discouraged and left for TV."

STAYING PUT

Others say that since talented, experienced female jocks are so hard to come by, those stations fortunate enough to have them on staff are making sure they stay put.

"Where have all the good female talents gone? I don't think they went anywhere," says WWGR's O'Kelley. "If you are lucky enough to find a good female, you hang onto her. I don't think there is a shortage of females. I think that the good females who have jobs are being well taken care of because they are hard to find."

KJY's Brannigan agrees. "Perhaps the women that are working in broadcasting and are good at it have employers who recognize what they have and reward them, so they're not moving around as much," she says.

"I find that most of the real good female talent whom you hear about from other programmers or who have made a name for themselves are already working, and it's hard to steal them away from their station," says Smith at WHBX.

Top 40 KLUC Las Vegas PD Cat Thomas says he doesn't have as much trouble finding female talent because he actively recruits people who are already employed rather than waiting for T&Rs, but he agrees that there are "very few female jocks." He recently promoted a talent he "hand-raised," Jenna Wilde, from P/I to overnights and says developing his own female air personalities is another way to solve the shortage problem. Thomas says that he told Wilde if she is successful, she "may have an easier time getting into the big time than someone like me because there are not as many [female jocks] to choose from."

ARE THEY DISCOURAGED?

She's always felt supported by employers, but, Brannigan says, "at seminars and conferences I do occasionally hear from women who say they feel discouraged and don't feel they can advance. It makes me look at myself and say, 'Am I doing enough to encourage and help other women?'"

WESC-AM-FM Greenville, S.C. OM Ron Brooks says, "Has the industry discouraged women in any way? Only if you consider being

limited to morning-show giggle-girl roles and non-drive air shifts and making two-thirds [or less] the salary of many males in comparable shifts as discouraging. I know we would all like to think that the business is more enlightened than this, but on the whole it isn't. This has been going on for years. It shouldn't be surprising that the number of women staying in the business is decreasing."

Adult R&B WFLM West Palm Beach, Fla., VP/GM Barbara Marshall notes that "there are just not as many women in the business as there are men. But also, men are promoted more frequently than women. A solution might be to have more women mentor young women in the business. That's the only way we're going to see nurturing and women exploring other opportunities at companies. If we're consistently seeing women not moving up, then why should we want to stay in this career?"

"The other problem is consolidation at radio," continues Marshall. "There are just [fewer] jobs, so with more men competing than women, the odds are that more men will get those positions. Many women probably think, 'Why bother to apply?' The industry overall is harder on women, and I think that discourages women to a degree."

"I have an on-air staff of all men, all very experienced in radio," adds Marshall. "I'm looking for a female air talent and possibly one who has the potential to program. But she has to be able to lead this group of men, and I just can't seem to find anyone who has the experience to do so. I've tried to find [female candidates] through word-of-mouth, advertising, and a number of different ways, but they're not responding. I've also found some women who feel safe where they [are] and won't try to move up to program or even move into more prominent air shifts."

THE OTHER SIDE

On the flip side, one female air talent who has worked in New York for the past 10 years and is now looking to move to a new opportunity says the female jocks are the ones not getting the response from programmers, not the other way round. The jock, who asked not to be identified, says, "I get virtually no response from programmers" when she sends them T&Rs. "Only one returned my call and actually gave me some feedback and advice, although he had recently filled the position that I was applying for. Another programmer sent me a form letter acknowledging receipt of my package. One other passed my tape on to another PD, but that's it for all the 30 or more tapes I've sent out over the past two months."

"I really believe that programmers just want to hire their own people—either air talent they have worked with before and know or someone who has been brought to them by a colleague," says this DJ. "When you see postings for jobs on the Internet or in trades, those programmers probably already have someone in mind, but they have to post it as a courtesy."

SEEING IMPROVEMENT

A few programmers say the talent pool of female jocks is actually getting better, not worse.

"Yes, it's more difficult to find women broadcasters than men, but frankly, I feel the situation is improving each year," says country KNIX Phoenix VP/general program manager Larry Daniels. "For many years, women have been put in less-than-creative on-air roles that have held them back. That is changing, I believe. I'm beginning to hear very talented women who are becoming outstanding personalities whether the lead in a two-person team or solo. I honestly believe that in the next few years, several women will become big radio stars and that alone will influence others to want to follow. In the past, women have had few female radio personalities to learn from and be inspired by."

"I have a daughter, Kris Dossey, who is on the air in Savannah, Ga., honing her skills," Daniels continues. "I regularly talk with many other female personalities who are starting to make names for themselves, especially in country. There are some really good personalities out there. You just have to look harder to find them."

Did The Chart Change? Or Attitudes?

WKFR Kalamazoo, Mich., PD Dr. Dave Michaels noticed it while pulling up the top 200 Broadcast Data Systems titles online: a greater proliferation of R&B crossovers—"Monifah, Tatyana Ali, Lauren Hill, Mya, and so on." In trying to decide how applicable those records were to his station, he asked where those songs were getting played—at a wide variety of reporters or at a relatively small number of rhythmic stations that are "giving [those songs] a ton of spins."

The answer to Michaels' question is that it's a product of the changing nature of the chart panel—there are indeed more stations that emphasize rhythmic titles—but there's also been a gradual shift in the format's attitude toward R&B crossovers that goes beyond a handful of stations.

Over the past year, we've seen the emergence of the mainstream top 40 station with an R&B lean, something that had been in relatively short supply in recent years, much to the discouragement of those of us who grew up with CKLW Detroit or WPGC Washington, D.C., in the '70s—stations that clearly weren't R&B outlets but still played the R&B hits before the rest of the country. There are more of those stations these days, and they got here in different ways.

WROX Norfolk, Va., like other Bill Thorman stations, was aggressive on R&B crossovers from the start. So was Jerry Clifton's KXME Honolulu. (Its sister station, KPTY Phoenix, has backed away from some R&B records but will pound the ones it does play.) KQMQ Honolulu and KHTS San Diego came from the rhythmic side; they added rock titles but never stopped being aggressive on R&B hits. Several of consultant Dan Vallie's recent sign-ons have been, from their inception, particularly quick to embrace hit R&B titles, but it's become even more noticeable since the pop/dance records that were those stations' initial calling cards became harder to find. And a few stations, most noticeably WSNX Grand Rapids, Mich., and KRQQ Tucson, Ariz., have evolved further toward the rhythmic top 40 side over the past six months, to the point where some people feel they belong on the rhythmic chart.

Add these stations together, and it's suddenly possible for a "Make It Hot" or "Daydreamin'" to achieve a much earlier quorum on the mainstream Impact page of Airplay Monitor. These songs are still proven hits at rhythmic top 40 and R&B radio by the time they get there, but it's not like 1995, when Montell Jordan might start

being played at mainstream top 40 only after multiple weeks atop both the rhythmic top 40 and Hot 100 charts.

That said, many R&B crossovers are also playing on stations that wouldn't have dealt with them a year ago (or would have found them later or dayparted them more heavily). Even with its strength in call-out, "Are You That Somebody?" seems like it would have once been a stretch for WNCI Columbus, Ohio; WRVW Nashville; WLSS Baton Rouge, La.; WJBQ Portland, Maine; or KMXV Kansas City.

We've discussed at length before how the prevailing attitude changed. PDs who were willing to acknowledge "Gettin' Jiggy Wit It" or "Mo Money Mo Problems" noticed that their adults didn't flee screaming, and that opened the door for other titles. Additionally, pop/dance records were suddenly in short supply, which left PDs with the choice of acknowledging R&B crossovers or becoming modern ACs. Now, we have to consider the possibility that because it's a little easier for R&B crossovers to chart, those songs are on the agenda for other PDs sooner. Although I've yet to meet the PD who acknowledges being driven by national chart numbers, it's always been the contention of record reps that an R&B crossover doesn't have much chance with many PDs until it cracks the mainstream chart.

In a way, I hope that's not true. One kind of likes to think that PDs would find R&B hits by watching their R&B competition and the sales in their own marketplaces. The reason to play any record, regardless of genre, has never been because everybody else around the country is playing it. Then again, the resistance to R&B product that we've seen for the past few years should never really have happened in the first place. So it's just fine to see it reversed by any means necessary.

Even if the greater acceptance of R&B crossovers is chart-driven, that doesn't mean it's an optical illusion. If new reporters are affecting the chart, it's also the case that changes in the musical climate are affecting the new reporters. In 1995, most top 40 stations were typically early on adult-leaning pop records, resistant to R&B crossovers, very concerned with protecting the '80s franchise, and not inclined to pound any record too much. In 1998, when people aren't as haunted by the format's early '90s troubles, a new sign-on is as likely to sound more KHKS Dallas than the station described here. For many broadcasters, the top 40 paradigm has changed, and R&B crossovers have been only one beneficiary.






