LOEW'S NEW STATE THEATER TO OPEN JULY 1

Best Building Will Be Ready for Occupancy May 1

Estimated Cost of Project Placed at \$5,000,000

New York, Jan. 10.—Marcus Loew's new State Theater building, at the corner of Broadway and Forty-sixth street, so well as the State Annex, will be ready for occupancy by May 1, it was announced today. The new State Theater, however, will not be opened next several months later, the estimate date being July 1. The entire project is estimated to have cost the Loew corporation \$5,000,000.

The office building program, certain dates in detail, in the tallest building on Broadway street of Forty-sixth street, it is by far the most imposing structure in the Times Square district. Building operations, which have been moving apace, are fast nearing completion. The Annex, which is six stories in height, will house the Loew looking office and the offices of the Loew agents.

This house, when opened, will be the only remainder theater in the Times Square area competing with the Palace.

BILLS REGULATING TICKET SPECULATORS A SURE GO

Senator Walton Takes Definite Steps To Introduce Two Measures Into New York State Legislature Within the Next Few Weeks

New York, Jan. 19.—(Special Bulletin) Sen. Charles Walton has taken the first definite step to introduce into the New York Legislature the two measures designed to regulate ticket speculators and to otherwise control prices on the part of peddling hawkers, known here as "flips." The bills, which were favorably quoted by the press legislative committee, it was said, will be brought forth upon the floor within the next few weeks.

In measure one bill would make it a misdemeanor for any person to stand on the sidewalk and offer tickets for sale to the owner of a theater at higher prices than the face value. It prohibits "express from selling tickets to or from any building, office, shop, booth, post office or to or from any apartment, whether, store, business, residence, or any building, office or other place, or to or from any person or at the place, by word of mouth, writing, or any other means, that are offered at other residences of the party and may be secured in any building, store, shop, booth, post office, or other place."

"By the terms of the other bill," says Walton, "a person who is offered a ticket, before or after it has been so advertised, is prohibited from selling tickets to a theater at a price above the lowest advertised price. This bill makes the following provision:

"The owner of a theater is prohibited from the purchase of any ticket at a price above the face value of the same.

"The person who is authorized to sell tickets at a price above the face value of the same shall be deemed to have sold the same at the face value of the same."

It is 15 Acts on the Opening Show Every Monday

NOTICE—On our opening show every Monday we will have from 10 to 15 acts from which we will select our regular week's program. Come early. You be the judge, help us select. Applaud acts you like. Performance at 2 p. m.

Is this enough to prove to Actors what Managers think of them? They are just cattle brought for the inspection of the multitude, or, like the gladiators in the Roman Coliseum, depend upon the fickle fancy of the crowd for the week's engagement, after having paid their own fares and expenses to Indianapolis.

If another example is wanted it is found in circulars distributed in Nashville, Tenn., in a column statement in a paper known as "Loew's Weekly" (the rival of Mr. Albee's "Vaudeville News"), which is described on its first page as "Issued Weekly Without Charge to Patrons of the Loew Chain of Theatres."

In this, and in advertisements in the Nashville papers, we find that at Loew's Vendome, for the period of from January 10 to 31, the public is invited to come 'round behind the stage and to see "the artists' dressing rooms" and "THE ARTISTS MAKING A QUICK CHANGE OF THEIR COSTUMES."

For fear the insinuation put in might be missed by the Nashville young men, Loew's Weekly says: "Next comes the visit to the artists' dressing rooms,

AND WE WON'T TELL YOU WHAT YOU WILL SEE THERE."

And to be sure that one should get what this means the article in "Loew's Weekly" says: "YOU WILL SEE SIGHTS THAT WILL HOLD YOU SPELLBOUND."

Every Vaudeville Actor and Actress knows what making quick changes means. For the purpose of making changes the less worn underneath the better. And this invitation to the town boys of Nashville to come 'round and see the women make their quick changes, and the further insinuation that "we won't tell you what you will see there," is about as low and depraved as advertisements can go.

Can there be anything more disgusting, more degrading, more obscene, more lowering than such an invitation as is contained in this advertisement?






