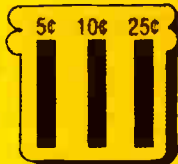

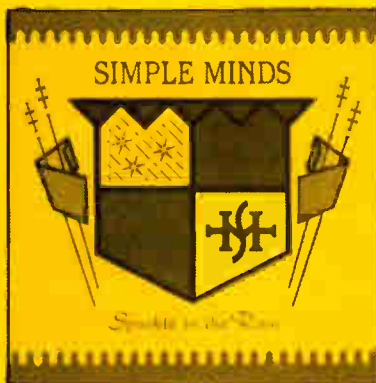

The next episode of I.R.S.'s **The Cutting Edge**, scheduled for 11:00PM (ET) on MTV, will feature a New Music Report chart countdown. You know we'll be watching. . .

CONGRATULATIONS to Meg Jones—she will take over I.R.S. College Promotion on March 1 in New York. Kim Buie is taking over for Meg at Enigma.

WE GOOFED: Don Dixon is co-producing the new R.E.M. album with Mitch Easter. Don is also working on the next X-Teens LP for Dolphin and is scheduled to work with **Color Me Gone** for A&M.

RECORD NEWS: The dB's are recording their third album (working title: **True Start**). It's their first for Bearsville/Warner Bros., and will feature a re-mixed version of "Amplifier." Producing will be Chris Butler, former leader of the **Waitresses**. . . **Chris Stamey** (a former dB) is on tour with a new band through mid-February, when he will take a break to record two new tracks with **Marshall Crenshaw** producing. . . The **Flestones** will be recording some tracks with **John Fred** (remember "Judy In Disguise"?) producing. . . A **Flock Of Seagulls** are recording with **Steve Lavelle** (**Julian Cope**, **Teardrop Explodes**) behind the board. . . **Roman Holliday** has dropped their horn players and are talking to **Dave Edmunds** about producing. . . **Hugh Masakela** has been signed to Jive. He's recording in Botswana. . . The **Jah Wobble/The Edge/Holgar Czukay** project **Snake Charmer** should be out shortly on Island. It's worth the wait. . . Island will also release **Paul Haig's** U.S. debut on their Antilles/Mango label. Musicians on the EP include members of the **Lounge Lizards**, **Rockers Revenge** and **Talking Heads**. Haig was in **Josef K.** on Postcard Records. . . **Andy Fraser**, an alumnus of **Free**, has been signed to Island. **Hugh Padgham** is producing. . . Antilles is releasing the soundtrack to the **Mel Brooks** film **To Be Or Not To Be**. Included will be Brooks' and **Anne Bancroft's** duet of "Sweet Georgia Brown"—in Polish. The have also released "To Be Or Not To Be (The Hitler Rap)" as a 12". It's expected to match the success of Brooks' previous rap, "It's Good To Be The King". . . Look out for **Made In France**, a compilation on Cachalot Records. Featured will be **Chagrin d'Amour**, **Les Civils**, **Kas Product**, **Bernard Lavilliers**, **Gerard Blanchard**, **Etienne Daho**, **Taxi-Girl**, **Charlelle Couture**, **Octobre**, **Sapho**, **Marc Seberg** and **Marquis de Sade**.

JACKPOT! SINGLES, TRACKS, ETC.

★ **THOMAS DOLBY "Hyperactive" (12")** (Capitol, 1750 N. Vine, Hollywood, CA 90028)—Mr. Eccentricity comes up with another quirky mini masterpiece. Between the dance and album mix everything's thrown in this danceable chef's salad—electronics, vocoder, trombone, flute, male/female duet harmonies courtesy of Dolby and Adele Bertei, chanting, acoustic guitar, moaning, scratching, heavy breathing and more. Whew! A sheer rollicking, soulful addiction.

★ **STEEL PULSE "Steppin' Out" (12")** (Elektra, 665 Fifth Avenue, New York, NY 10022)—Flash it, Dread! The Brit-reggae band from Birmingham has "stepped out" with yet another killer track—musically and lyrically. Ever political, ever Rasta, ever slick and musically polished, Steel Pulse states "Wisdom is respected, hatred is rejected." In addition to the album version (from the forthcoming **Earth Crisis** LP), an extended club mix is included here as well as an a capella rendition which is cool and deadly!! Already receiving urban contemporary radio play. So, step on it.

★ **ALARM "68 Guns" (12")** (I.R.S., c/o A&M, 595 Madison Ave., New York, NY 10022)—The Alarm's best track so far—bristling with power and enthusiasm, belted-out vocals and typically anthemic lyrics. An advance 12" from the upcoming **Declaration** LP.

AL DIMEOLA "Sequencer" (12") (Columbia, 51 W. 52nd St., New York, NY 10019)—This disc finds the master technician DiMeola teaming up with Jan Hammer and adding on a dub sequence mixed by Francois Kevorkian. DiMeola lays down a catchy, searing lead riff over some steady yet forceful electronic rhythms (provided by Hammer on the Linn Drum) to make his sound more accessible for urban contemp and ultimately AOR crossover.

SHRAPNEL "Didn't Know I Loved You (Till I Saw You Rock 'n' Roll)" (EP cut) (Elektra, 665 Fifth Ave., New York, NY 10022)—This cover of the Gary Glitter classic is no accident—Shrapnel plays power rock in a purely American manner, much the same way that Glitter did in an English style. "Didn't Know I Loved You" has much of the same crunchy appeal of Joan Jett's "Do You Want To Touch"—also a Glitter cover—it's even produced by Jett producers Ritchie Cordell and Glen Kolotkin. Worth noting: the rest of the EP is produced by Vince Ely (Psychedelic Furs).

POLICE "Wrapped Around Your Finger" (12") (A&M, 1416 N. LaBrea, Hollywood, CA 90028)—Not only noteworthy because of the featured track (one of the best on **Synchronicity**), this 12" also includes a live recording of "Wrapped" and the B-sides of two other singles: "Murder By Numbers" and "Someone To Talk To." All superb.

DAVY DMX "One For The Treble (Fresh)" (12") (Tuff City, c/o CBS, 51 W. 52nd St., New York, NY 10019)—"One for the treble/two for the bass/c'mon Davy D/Let's rock this place," sung by Davy's female back-up singers is one of the only vocal breaks on the record. This fact along with persistent funky bass lines makes the stripped down mix (*sans* heavy techno or repetitive rap choruses) all the more listenable and danceable. Davy D delivers some fresh scratch techniques as he stretches a vocal track around the scratch of a record, and in the final moments scratches a track of what appears to be engines revving and tires screeching. The instrumental mix is 1:48 of "bonus beats" for those needing the extra drumming to work into a mix of their own. The fire feeds the fire.

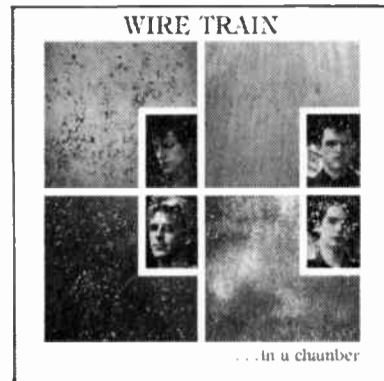

This issue's picks:

VISIBLE TARGETS (EP) (Park Avenue Records, P.O. Box 19296, Seattle, WA 98109/206-632-7816)—Visible Targets is three women musically set up around the steady percussion of Ron Simmons. Their guitar riffs sting, tingle, and slice throughout, without ever becoming overbearing. The Mick Ronson production is sharp edged in a pop/rock vein, especially standing out on "Autistic Savant" (look it up) and the white-reggae flavored "I Walk A Fine Line." Check out the vocal treatment on "Life In The Twilight Zone" which brings to mind the delicate vocals of Annie Haslam (Renaissance).

MISSION (Frantic Records, 12504 Killian Lane Bowie, MD 20715/301-254-8447)—A self produced 7-song EP from a four piece group that roughly mixes psychedelia and British invasion-era rock—all of which nicely complements lead guitarist David Cawkwell's obvious affection for raw power. The harmonies add a nice touch to "Dreaming," "The Girl Next Door" and the cover of the Monkees hit "Stepping Stone." This is a band with new material galore—it just needs production assistance to match the power and punch of their chops.

FACTUAL Faction 02 (EP) (Faction Records, 2806 Oakland Avenue, Nashville, TN 37212/615-297-8602)—The first few seconds of "Psychotic Romance," the lead track, sound like it could turn into U2's "New Years Day"—but it takes a different turn. It's melodic and danceable but mild with a high end synth that works from within (not overriding the structure of the tune). The track encompasses all of side one of this four song blue vinyl EP. "Wire and Chrome," with its electronic and human drums under a neat guitar run, distinguishes this band's sound from most robot rock. Also, the vocals are passionate and expressive. Factual continues to surprise the people of Nashville and beyond.

Video Views

★ Jackpot! ★

BILL NELSON "Flaming Desire" (Portrait-Epic) directed by Bill Nelson—With all the attributes of a Deborah Turbeville photograph in motion, "Flaming Desire" is the most evocative b/w music video this reviewer has seen. Bill Nelson pictorializes the range of human emotions and he actively seeks them out—the crystalline coldness of masks and giant ice sculptures, and the fire of lanterns and a flaming flower. A blazing key penetrating a lock—the only stock phallic image in the v/c—ushers in a whole series of obstructing windows and doors (one marked "no smoking," no less!), and Nelson alternates between use of high contrast and muted footage to reflect physically the separating/conjoining elements. Consummation via a merging within the mask, the orange neon outline of the rose, and the woman's explosion in light, like a bird fluttering aside the solar plexus, are all ingenious, gorgeous images. The clip's visual lyricality behaves in counterpoint to audio's insistent, desperate repetitions of the 2-syllable title words. How many 2-year-old songs come out of the vinyl woodwork wearing gossamer clothes like these?

BETTE MIDLER/MICK JAGGER "Beast Of Burden" (Atlantic) directed by Allan Arkush—Tabloid headlines/pix and the swish orchestration heard decades ago in Hollywood blockbusters intro this *splendid* v/c. Snappy dialogue has allowed for Bette's talking romance-breaker Mick into letting her perform his former hit, which gets a volatile, seductive delivery within a scope of stunning production values. Excepting Michael Jackson's lower limbs, which seem to possess their own birthright, Jagger and Midler arguably have the only rock 'n' roll legs that could possibly rival each other. Their gam games make for Jagger scampering daintily around the furniture like some stereotypically brutalized secretary, while Midler pursues him with all the finesse of a construction worker. Her heat is nevertheless contagious: Mick's glands getting activated is sure to become one of music video's priceless moments. The couple, borne to each other on the shoulders of their fans—Midler's entourage is appropriately enough a group of revolutionaries—resembles gamecocks at the height of the fight. No, nothing professes like professionalism: they are *hot*.

EURHYTHMICS "Here Comes The Rain Again" (RCA) directed by Annie Lennox and Dave Stewart—The Eurythmics' strength in creating instantly memorable melodies and hooks lets their videos wash down with a rare effortlessness. This v/c abounds in mournful scenic splendor that reflects audio's insistent ache—squid ink ocean, smoky grey/lavender wave crests, stone, Orkney Island cliffs—and Annie Lennox herself. The exceptional Lennox, who looks like a white nightshirted Bergman heroine lost within a candle-lit de La Tour painting, gazes like the Virgin, pouts and cocks her head like Magdalene and walks on water like The Capricorn. Voyeur Dave Stewart has his eye on her throughout the clip, and at the aerially shot reunion finale for Lennox's presumable dive into his perma blue-black.

RE-FLEX "The Politics Of Dancing" (Capitol) directed by Peter Sinclair—An aging hippie figure, the guru DJ of the new wave tempo is being pursued by the forces of regression. In the end, via a rhythmic strip-down of make-up, the DJ is revealed to be none other than Re-Flex's lead singer Baxter. This *concept* of movement is central to the clip, as the staff's literally escaping from the studio in time has guaranteed the continued transmission of dance signals. The abandoned wood anatomy figures, whose purpose is to simulate real-life movement, ingeniously evoke the dancing soul only temporarily out of its body.

PRETENDERS "Middle Of The Road" (Sire) directed by Danny Kleinman—In this performance dramatization, the Pretenders follow on stage a band having the prescience to yell something about "a hard time coming," and wind up in the middle of a violent political rally which causes the authorities to stop their gig. The fact the Pretenders were not inciters only underscores how audio's form—a not totally unviolent demand for the privilege of being a post-30 MOR—equals content of video as the demonstrators, perhaps posing as the iconoclasts of the psyche, answer a resounding no. Chrissie Hynde, in her sequined party hat, severe jacket and leather pants, behaves like her coldblooded performance self. But as always, she never fails to ration out the radiance.

ABC "That Was Then But This Is Now" (Mercury-PG) directed by Rupert Styles—What's significant is not the political overtones, aerial views of planes, or the floor-lit stage to mimic a landing strip, but rather that Martin Fry has begun looking and moving like "street." Mirabile dictu.

JOHN LENNON "Nobody Told Me" (Polydor-PG) edited by Michael Bencivenga, Michael Ehrman and Michael Duffield—Although lyrics were meant to convey those what-is-the-world-coming-to days, Yoko Ono's inclusion amidst the historical footage of Lennon's rapture in his family life lets the words also evoke the possibility of life's holding succulence around the corner. Video is grainy, but John would have undoubtedly opted for verite anyhow.

VARIOUS ARTISTS Black Star Liner: Reggae From Africa (Heartbeat Records, One Camp Street, Cambridge, MA 02140)—Although not brand new, this compilation of reggae from Africa is worth "crucial" attention as it bridges a lot of gaps at once. Reggae music is big in Africa, and African music is becoming of great interest in the US. This LP assembles recordings by African musicians from Nigeria, Liberia and Sierra Leone. Reggae that emanates from African nations carries a special cultural and political significance; the Rastafari emphasis on repatriation is reinforced by the African musicians in the "homeland" of Zion. This is the first in a projected series of albums. Stand out cuts include: **Sonny Olosum's** two cuts "Third World" and "Fire In Soweto," **Sabanah's** "Carry On" and **Matta Fahnbulleh's** "Kokoloko."

Ah-So-Me Chat

Roots. I hope you've all caught the February issue of *Musician* magazine which includes **Roger Steffens'** article on reggae music 1984-style. It's encouraging to see a publication as noted as *Musician* featuring a 7-page spread on reggae music. . . Congratulations to **UB40** who's single "Red, Red Wine" debuted at #83 on the Billboard Top 100 (January 28, 1984) and is on the rise. . . The University of California Press has released the first two volumes out of a proposed ten on **Marcus Garvey** and the U.N.I.A. (Universal Negro Improvement) Papers. 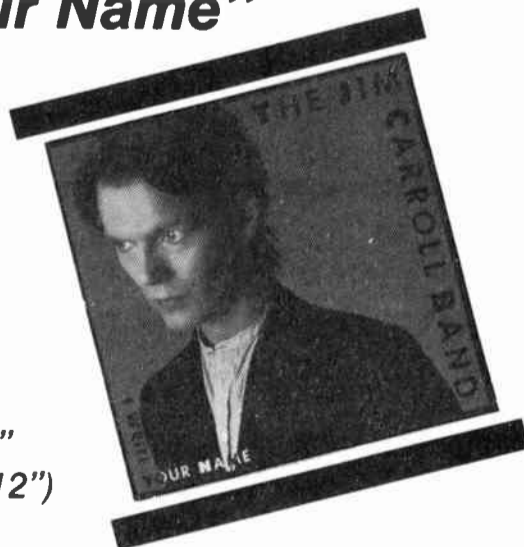

SIMPLE MINDS Sparkle In The Rain (A&M, 1416 N. LaBrea, Hollywood, CA 90028)—Simple Minds' 2nd A&M LP finds Steve Lillywhite producing and he has given them a grand sound to match their lyrical ambitions, quite like (perhaps too much like) his other recent outings with U2, Echo and Big Country. Overall, it helps Simple Minds sound more cohesive. . .the words and music forming a complete whole rather than two antagonistic elements as in the past. Commercially, it has greater potential than previous records—even without an obvious hit single. The best: "Street Hassle" (the Lou Reed track), "C" Moon Cry Like A Baby," "Waterfront," "Up On The Catwalk."

SOUNDTRACK Wild Style (Animal, c/o JEM, 3619 Kennedy Rd., South Plainfield, NJ 07080)—A soundtrack to the film produced by Charlie Ahearn about rap music and the hip-hop culture that grew out of the South Bronx in the late '70s. The scene could be a park or a playground—Wherever the DJs plug in, they scratch and spin/While the rappers grab a mike and do what they like/With a break dance or two from the Rock Steady Crew (often imitated, never duplicated)/The street starts cookin' and other people start lookin'. This record (overseen by Freddy Braithwaite [aka Fab Five Freddy] with assistance from Blondie's Chris Stein) includes rappin' by Busy Bee and Rubie Dee and features various scratch techniques. On "Wild Style Subway Rap #2" the "there ain't nuthin' to it/but to do it," pervasiveness shines with "Let your mind be pure/And free to create/Use the beat in your heart/And aim to be great." One of the featured crews, Double Trouble (of Funky Four +1 fame), tells their story with the confidence that's made them kings of the hill: "Through thick and thin/From beginning to end/The battle we lost/But the war we'll win." They have prevailed and so has the wild style. See the movie for a closer look at the Graffiti, the Dancing, and the streets, but play the record for the real thing. It may even tempt you to "Rock The House" with some scratch of your own.

VARIOUS ARTISTS Hell Comes To Your House Part II (Bemisbrain, c/o Enigma, 20445 Gramercy Place, P.O. Box 2696, Torrance, CA 90509)—The state-of-the-art California rock scene ain't punk after all! Despite the cover art, this LP is full of bright rock 'n' roll, tinged at times with country, funk and punk, in that order. Best of the lot: Blood On The Saddle's "I Wish I Was A Single Girl Again" (thrash with slow country vocals), Screamin' Sirens' "Your Good Girl's Gonna Go Bad" (wild party rock), the Joneses' "I'm Bad" (high energy country rock) and the Minutemen's "Corona" (a surprisingly light country love song—great guitars). There's lots of surprises on every track.

JOHN LENNON/YOKO ONO Milk And Honey (Polydor, 810 Seventh Ave., New York, NY 10019)—It's all too tempting to get overly philosophical about anything emanating from Lennon. Suffice it to say where *Double Fantasy* was obsessed with defining John and Yoko's interpersonal and family relationships as an abstract, somewhat isolated concept, *Milk And Honey* brings that description down to earth and tells the world about John and Yoko in day to day, real life. Where its predecessor was cerebral, *Milk And Honey* is visceral. It still asks the questions and thickly spreads on the affection, but it rocks. And it does so with a grittier street consciousness. John's tracks are all immediately likeable—rock's greatest voice shines in its strained perfection. And Yoko's ramblings are (with the exception of "You're The One," one of her best lyrical works ever) as always, omnipresent. Favorites: the rockers "I'm Stepping Out," "Nobody Told Me," "Borrowed Time" (a reggae-calypto ditty), "(Forgive Me) My Little Flower Princess" (a shuffle) and Yoko's sensual lament "Sleepless Night." The LP's showpiece is John's "Grow Old With Me," a consummate love song which, had he lived to supervise its production, could have been a classic on the level of "Imagine"—it's that sensational. Nevertheless, even in its present rough form (recorded only with piano and rhythm box) it's a gem—and a stark reminder of the musical void that's existed since John Lennon's death.

JAN GARBAREK GROUP Wayfarer (ECM, c/o Warner Bros., 3300 Warner Blvd., Burbank, CA 91510)—Garbarek's mystifying and soothing sax sets the tone by traversing and peering in and out like a man with a lantern leading an expedition. His band resembles Weather Report on "Gesture," with the rounded bass lines of Eberhard Weber and Garbarek's bittersweet wailing horn leading the way, then it suddenly veers away with a frenzied crescendo—uprooting the subtle beauty of the tune. Also give "Pendulum" a listen—it swings over a pit, suspending you by just a thread and never letting go until you gently land. Intimate music in the ECM tradition.

ROBERT HAZARD Wing Of Fire (RCA, 1133 Ave., Of The Americas, New York, NY 10036)—Hazard continues to develop as a songwriter (he wrote Cyndi Lauper's "Girls Just Want To Have Fu-un")—many of the tracks on *Wing Of Fire* are strikingly good and even follow a theme (a futuristic detective story a la *Blade Runner*). Producer David Kershenbaum has given him a solid modern rock sound, even more likeable than on his debut EP. The only problem here is that while much of the material is good, none is great, which means Hazard will have to keep looking for that breakthrough hit. The best of the bunch are "Fire On Fire," "She's Hot," "Hard Hearted" (might make for a nice dance mix) and "Melt Down."

"Synthesizer Man" is a bit trite, but the driving beat should find it a home in the clubs.

SPECIAL MENTION: KATE BUSH Lionheart (EMI, 6920 Sunset Blvd., Hollywood, CA 90028)—EMI blessed us with a treasure: the first U.S. release of the five year old *Lionheart* LP. The music on this, her second LP, is almost orchestral and the production is high-gloss, displaying many of the eccentricities of her later LPs. Bush is in as fine a voice as ever, effortlessly soaring above everything and hitting you squarely in the heart. "Symphony In Blue," "Hammer Horror," and "Fullhouse" make *Lionheart* worthy of renewed attention—Kate Bush deserves to be heard by all of America.
