There are only three weeks more to go before coinmen from all over these United States will once again be greeting each other at the Hotel Morrison in Chicago on November 15, 16 and 17, 1943. #### "SUCKER?"

Many time in the past we have written regarding the misnomer, "sucker". This expression developed in this industry when it was very young. It happened to be a popular expression of the stage and traveled its application to many misnamed purposes and persons. It was taken up by a very few individuals who believed that because they tremendously overcharged newcomers to this industry, or who, meeting with men hidden in the small villages of the nation, were able to sell them at exorbitant prices called these men, "suckers". And bragged about the fact. To the dismay of these first, sharpshooting salesmen, these so-called, misnamed "suckers", in most cases, have risen to leadership in this industry whereas the salesmen who started them on the road have long ago disappeared. And to their sorrow.

For the record, then, there is no such person existant in this industry now or at anytime to come who can be termed a "sucker". And many that pays a high price for a machine today is most certainly not a "sucker". If he needs that machine, has the location that will amortize the cost, and still earn him a decent profit percentage on his original investment, then how in all the world of business economics can such a man be termed a "sucker"?

We believe that the time has arrived when those engaged in this industry should clean it of all misnomers of this type. We feel that most coinmen are earnest and sincere in their endeavor to raise the level of the business ethics of this industry. We also fully believe that they are all of one purpose - a better, cleaner business - one that they can own up to and be proud to be members of - for the sake of their families and their friends. Certainly, using such a word as "sucker" will not help to raise the level of this industry. In fact, it can only create suspicion and disdain on the part of any intelligent outsiders who may be planning to enter into this business. It surely will frighten them away from this industry if it does anything at all.

Every single member of this business has, by his own record, proven that there is no such thing as a "sucker" remaining in this industry - or anything that can even be so termed. Because a man may make a foolish purchase now and then, this isn't the word that will describe him. All other business men in all other industries make mistakes. But, thruout any industry no one challenges a man's intelligence and future desire to remain in business by terming him a "sucker".

If you believe that the man whom you have just started in this business is a "sucker" you still have much to learn. Not only will be find himself earning more than he ever did before with less work, but he's going to fall in with the spirit and the excitement and sportsmanship and action of this industry. And before long, as you already know, he becomes everyone's customer and not just your own. If you did use him for what you term a "sucker" then what have you accomplished for your own business betterment? You have only created another customer for one of your competitors and a only fool a man once. From then on, if you still believe you are fooling him, you're only kidding yourself. And can, instead, apply the same ugly misnomer to yourself

In other lines, too, such as candy, leather merchandise and novelties of all sorts, coinmen have proven themselves good outlets. But, whenever we discuss these new merchandise lines with these coinmen we find that their first and true love remains the coin operated machines business. And that they are eagerly waiting to get back into it bigger and better than ever before.

As one of these men wrote this past week, "We are doing a very nice job with our beer but we aren't letting go of our operation nor of our coin machine salesmen. We believe that when the war is over coin machines will once again be our exclusive business. Not that we don't like the other lines we have taken on, but somehow we just can't get as interested in them as we can in a coin machine. There isn't the excitement and especially not the profits in our outside lines. Give me a coin machine anytime."

"E" FLAG TO FLY OVER "BALLY" PLANT

The Army-Navy Award Flag, awarded for outstanding production of war materials will soon be hoisted over the home of "Bally" games and venders, according to announcement by George Moloney, Vice-President and General Manager of Lion Manufacturing Corporation, Chicago.

"Many of our friends", Moloney stated, "are unfamiliar with our corporation name, as distribution of "Bally" products was handled by our sales organization, Bally Manufacturing Company. However, the Lion plant in which "Bally" products were manufactured for years, and the old "Bally" organization is active in the production of war material. George Jenkins, for example, General Sales Manager of Bally Manufacturing Company, is now supervisor of a very important part of our total production. Herb Jones, "Bally" Advertising Manager, is acting as my assistant in the management of all Lion production. Our engineering and production staff, which produced "Bally" games in the past - - are now breaking records in production of war material".

Mr. Moloney stated that the letter informing Lion Manufacturing Corporation of the "E" Award had been received, and that the date of the Ceremony of Award would be announced later.
