## "The Coin Machines Merry-Go-Round"

### BUREAU FOR JOBBER-DISTRIBUTOR RECOGNITION

One of the problems brought to the forefront of the industry in past weeks is the status of those firms who would like to be known as jobbers or distributors, especially in the post-war era. For many years this has been a catch-as-catch can proposition. Jobbers simply announced themselves as such. There was no method, nor precedent, and especially no bureau to grant such recognition. There was no way to ascertain the financial or business ability of such self announced firms to carry on as jobbers or distributors. There was no one to report on their reliability, the service, repair or general maintenance which could be expected, and no information as to general business practise and reputation.

Prior to the beginning of the post-war era, which is bound to find tumult and chaos as far as jobbers and distributors are concerned, it would prove to the good advantage of this industry to arrange for a bureau which would be in a position to give recognition to those men who desire to act as jobbers or distributors. This is considered to be mainly in the hands of the manufacturers. It is the belief of some of the men in this industry that this should become part of the work of the manufacturers organization. Yet, it is a well known fact that many times in the past manufacturers would appoint distributors who had very little, if any knowledge of this business. There was little or no questioning as to the reliability, general business practise, nor facilities to correctly service customers. It many times seemed in such appointments, that the most important consideration was the ability to put up the necessary money required for the initial order.

In this coming post-war era, when much new blood is expected to enter into this industry, and in view of the fact that the coming growth of this business should be on a much more sound and logical basis, firms that are chosen for the wholesale work of this trade, should only be such firms that are completely capable of such effort. In great measure the future growth of this industry will depend on these firms. It will be up to these firms to correctly introduce and carefully guide the newcomer as well as keep the older men happy.

The men who will enter into this business after the war, as well as those who have been in this industry for some time, will have greater confidence, and certainly more assurance in men who are recognized by some outstanding bureau. A bureau that will act in the complete and unselfish interest of this industry. To obtain the rank of jobber or distributor, the firm would have to prove to this bureau that it is financially capable of carrying on such work. It would have to, as has been the case in almost every other industry, show that it is in a position to completely service its accounts. That it has a proper contact force. That its service organization is well fitted for the task. The manufacturers could then depend on such a firm to act as a true jobber or distributor for good and logical business reasons.

In the automobile field a man must gain a certain financial status and business reputation as well as prove servicing and sales ability prior to the manufacturers even considering him for the rating of jobber or distributor. To be a distributor or jobber in almost every other field requires much business acumen as well as financial stability and complete servicing requirements. This coin operated machines industry can also make the status of jobber or distributor just as outstanding. The manufacturers themselves seek only the best firms in the country to act in such capacity for them.

This does not mean that manufacturers should, in any fashion whatsoever, be obligated to accept only such firms as jobbers or distributors who are accepted and recognized by whatever bureau is created for this purpose. They can and should bring new men into this division of the industry constantly, and help them to gain such recognition. Once the fact became known to all new men, as well as to the older operators, that this or that man was recognized as a jobber or distributor by a bureau using high standards for such recognition, and therefore a man that could be depended upon, better business practise would be sure to result.

The Cash Box has been many times approached by manufacturers, and especially by many of the present revampers, regarding information as to who is and who is not a

jobber or distributor in this industry. The work of this publication carries it into these fields because no such recognition bureau exists. The Cash Box happens to be well acquainted with the greater majority of the outstanding jobbers and distributors and with a great many of the smaller firms, too. It has therefore helped along in this work in an effort to bring about recognition.

The establishment of a recognition bureau for jobbers and distributors is not too difficult a task. It requires someone to head it who has personal knowledge of the majority of the firms now engaged in this industry. It requires a man with good, common sense. Such items as financial status, experience, former business record, reputation, sales force, repair, service and general maintenance departments, territory covered, and a few more facts can be easily obtained. With this as a basis, as well as with the general information which can be obtained from the men in the territory where the firm seeking recognition is doing business, can help to instantly decide whether this firm should be granted recognition publicly as a jobber or distributor.

Naturally, if a firm is already recognized by certain leading manufacturers as a jobber or distributor, then even this procedure is simplified. Such firms can have their present identity more firmly established for the benefit of all concerned with this industry by offering full information to any bureau created for that purpose. It would mean that every operator would know who were the officially and publicly recognized jobbers and distributors in his territory. What lines they handle. Their former reputation, reliability, service factors, etc., etc. There is no doubt that a report from such a bureau to any questioning operator, or any other interested person, would prove of great benefit and value to the jobber or distributor.

This work would have to be done in completely unselfish and unbiased fashion. It would require that no one firm be favored over another, regardless of financial status, friendship, or any other factors. It would have to be a simple and direct and unbiased presentation to the trade of those firms recognized as jobbers and distributors once they meet the basic requirements. Others who would, from time to time, also desire such recognition, would have to be granted this opportunity without being forced thru a lot of red tape. Furthermore, whatever standard is decided upon for this recognition, should be made public so that all would respect the position of jobber or distributor when recognized.

Because this industry is fast moving, and because of this is many times extremely neglectful of its own good business needs, The Cash Box offers this proposal to the industry now, prior to the finish of the war, so that such a bureau can be created to help benefit this entire business. Such a recognition bureau has been many times in the past demanded by jobbers and distributors themselves. This led to the creation of national organizations in former years, such as the NADA (National Automatic Distributors Association) and smaller, local groups, such as the AJA (Automatic Jobbers Association) of New York City.

These organizations all tended to one principle. To gain proper recognition from the manufacturers for their members as jobbers and distributors and also attempted to bring this fact to the attention of the operators. Insignias were created which appeared on letterheads and in the ads of these firms. When new firms were proposed for membership they were investigated to a certain extent. The organizations of this kind had the opportunity of making their division of this industry outstanding. Their principles were good. They missed the train simply because they did not employ the proper prominent help that was necessary to continue them forward.

Regardless of whatever organizations will again be created in this division of the field, it is well to remember that the most important requisite for jobber and distributor recognition is in the hands of these firms already recognized in such capacity and respected by the industry. These firms can make their division of this industry truly outstanding. If they do not create such a bureau, their division of this industry will again lapse into a catch-as-catch-can development without the respect and consideration they deserve. The time to act is now. It is further well to remember that such outstanding and recognized firms can also forever end the argument as to who is and who is not an operator. This always has been important. It will be more important than ever in the post-war era.

## LOWEST EBB REACHED

It is extremely interesting at this time to realize that this industry has reached its lowest possible ebb, as far as membership is concerned. Each and every week more and more manpower has been leaving this business. Leaders in the field report that they are now working with skeleton crews. Many firms are even dependent on mechanics who help them with repairs during the evening. Some report that they haven't even this sort of help left.

This lack of manpower was the reason for a very great majority cutting their routes down to absolute minimum. Firms that formerly operated anywhere from 100 to 1,000 machines of all types in their territories, now operate only from 10% to 30% of

that number. Most of these have sold off routes of outlying equipment. Some have pulled in equipment and sold it piecemeal. The industry long ago realized that every three phonos have become two and now even this figure is being challenged. Some of the leading music men are of the belief that only 50% of the number of phonos known to have been in operation during the pre-war era are now in existence.

At the same time more and more men have gradually been forced out of this business for one reason or another. The armed forces have taken the majority of these men. Some of these cut down routes proved unprofitable and the men quit. Others have entered into war industries. Some have gone into outside businesses which seem to them better able to carry on for the duration. In almost every case these men are still keeping in touch with the coin machines industry and intend, as soon as possible to re-enter this field. The belief is general that there aren't 3,000 men left in the coin machines industry acting as jobbers, distributors or owners of real operations, thruout the nation.

The probably upsetting to some, this figure is not alarming, considering what has happened to many other industries. It proves that this industry will survive this severe war period. It also means that the path for future growth is more wide open than ever before in the history of this trade. It also means that a tremendous number of locations are available thruout the country. This nucleus of coinmen who outlast this war, will be the backbone for the greatest growth this industry has ever known.

The fact that this industry is now believed to be at its lowest ebb, as far as its membership is concerned, does not mean that its purchasing power has disappeared in the same proportion. The best firms are left, and these always were the largest purchasers. This is instantly noted these days when a new revamp is introduced. Orders come pouring in at a rapid and even surprising rate. Even tho this field is now down to its absolute basic backbone, it can rapidly recover. The industry is not hurt. This is a purge. The weaker sisters were rapidly wiped out in this purge and others whose hearts were not completely in this business have also gone by the wayside. The men who outlast this war period are therefore assured of better future growth. This is an opportunity to eliminate many of the old and questionable pre-war policies and revive and re-establish this business on a finer basis than ever before.

The Cash Box has seen some fantastic figures published about this industry. If they were published in an attempt to impress outsiders, then most certainly this was extremely foolhardy, especially in view of the fact that all that was necessary to obtain these figures was to plunk down a quarter on a newstand. The fact remains that travelers who have visited noted coin machines centers are amazed at the fewer men they find engaged in this business. Yet these same men, when questioned regarding their own territories, also agree to a large loss of membership.

Now is the time for this industry to start with better plans for the future. Now is the time, while this industry is at this low ebb, and is therefore highly concentrated, more easily approachable, and can be reached faster for agreement purposes. Now is the time to institute many of the ideas that have already been proposed by The Cash Box for the general betterment of all this industry. As for example, the plan to create a bureau for jobber and distributor recognition. And why not, at the same time, also create a bureau, or organization, or whatever is preferred, that would also recognize all legitimate operators? Recognizing operators would eliminate location owners getting equipment directly which simply kills off some good operator and winds up with everyone losing. The upstanding and honorable and hard working operator deserves this break. A jobber and distributor bureau should make this their first big job.

## CABARET TAX ZOOMS PHONO DEMAND

A great many operators were at first somewhat upset over the announced 30% cabaret tax, just passed by Congress. Now these same men realize that the effect of this tax will be to triple and even quadruple the demand for automatic phonos from all types of former cabaret locations. There is no doubt that the smaller spots will immediately give up their dance floors and entertainment and turn to the automatic phonograph. The Treasury Department clears such spots, using automatic phonographs, from the 30% luxury tax category and from being classified as a "cabaret". By eliminating the dance floor and entertainment that is not instrumental the cabaret owner returns to the status of a restaurant or tavern.

The Treasury Department in its interpretation of what constitutes a "cabaret" states, "A roof garden or cabaret shall include any room in any hotel, restaurant, hall or other public place where music or dancing privileges or any other entertainment, EXCEPT instrument or MECHANICAL MUSIC ALONE, is afforded the patrons in connection with the serving of food, refreshments or merchandise.

This interpretation assures the industry that the demand will be so heavy for automatic phonos that it will never be filled until production starts up once again. In the meantime this is the opportunity that many phono operators awaited. They will benefit their average collections by obtaining locations which were formerly unapproachable. Many plan to string wall and bar boxes from mechanisms nearby into such spots, if they cannot obtain phonos, and as long as some cable is possible to obtain. The demand for phonos for such spots is already making itself felt.

# "Talking Out Loud"

## SAN FRANCISCO'S JUKE BOX ORDINANCE SHELVED

E. Geo. Bennett of M. A. Pollard and Company, San Francisco, sends in a clipping from the San Francisco Call-Bulletin which should warm the hearts of all phono men. The headline: "'Juke Box' Ordinance Shelved by 6 to 4 Vote". The story: "Following two hours of bitter debate, the Board of Supervisors today was on record with a decisive six to four vote defeat of the controversial 'juke box' ordinance which would have heavily upped taxes while delegating license control to police, assertedly as a measure to halt rising juvenile delinquency.

"At the same time District Attorneys Edmund G. Brown and George R. Reilly of the State Board of Equalization informed some supervisors better lighting of taverns should be enforced to reduce factors contributing to delinquency.

"The proposal was bitterly attacked by Attorneys Leo H. Shapiro, Harrison Call and Jake Ehrlich as a move to 'legislate small business men out of business', and to place owners of establishments in which 'juke boxes' were operated 'at the absolute mercy of one man'.

"The measure, offered by Police Chief Charles W. Dullea, admittedly was merely a method of forcing tavern owners to aid in policing partially lighted taverns thru fear of losing licenses to operate the musical devices which help draw trade.

"Police, a representative of the Commodore Sloat Mother's Club and others favoring the measure all admitted that the electrical musical devices of themselves did not in any way contribute to delinquency."

*(After reading this item over carefully, The Cash Box calls the attention of the trade to its everlasting battle over juvenile delinquency. Many articles have already been published in The Cash Box concerning this evil. The very last paragraph of this newspaper report clears the phonos from any contribution, of themselves, to juvenile delinquency. The attorneys defending the case are well known to the trade. They should be commended for the job they did. Once again The Cash Box takes the opportunity to warn the trade that it should carefully watch out for anything which may in any fashion involve coin operated equipment in this juvenile delinquency problem. Carelessness of location owners is no excuse. Rather than tolerate this, the coinman should pull his machine, before such carelessness can close an entire territory.)*

## FISH STORY

Elmer Marino who operates a few Photomatics in some of the New York City arcades, we learned the other night, is also in the wholesale fish business. As yet we haven't been able to tie up fish and Photomatics. Maybe we're slowing down.

## THE GUESSERS

The guessers started guessing the day that The Cash Box "Spring Special Issue" appeared on the finish of the European war. Beginning with Tuesday morning many returns were received. ## ASCAP'S "MUSIC IN INDUSTRY"

Extremely interesting to all music machines men, especially those who plan for post-war factory operations, are Ascap's three booklets entitled, "Music in Industry". These were written for the American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers by R. L. Cardinell of Stevens Institute of Technology who is at present engaged with the War Production Board. Ascap considers him the outstanding authority in the United States on this subject.

Booklet No. 1 is devoted to, "The Nature and Development of Work Music". No. 2 is about "Selection of Equipment", and No. 3 is on "Principles of Programming". Each one gives an extremely interesting viewpoint on factory music. These are being mailed to all industrial firms now using music to help stimulate their employees to greater production effort.

Ascap advertises in newspapers and suggests that the industrialist get copies of these three booklets. They also inform him at the bottom of their ad, in small, italicized type, that at present they will only charge him \$1.00 per year for the privilege of playing their music, but after the war they will go further into this matter with him. Be that as it may. We all know that Ascip also has intentions regarding the coin operated music machines field, too. They have lost once. But, being persistent, they are still at it. And one of these days, hope to get every phono in the nation to pay them a yearly fee.

Interesting to coinmen is the subject on "automatic record changers" as discussed by Mr. Cardinell on Page 8 of Booklet No. 2. Here he "strongly" advises against the use of automatic record changers "although they look very pretty in pictures." He claims that there hasn't been an automatic record changer made that can handle a record as delicately as a pair of human hands. He also tells a story about how careless one operator became. It seems that this careless operator placed the "Star Spangled Banner" on one program and during a visit by military officials at one plant the workers and all present were forced to spring to their feet and stand at attention while the national anthem was playing.

There's a lot of information in these booklets. There is no doubt that the average music man in this industry will enjoy reading them. After all, the factory field promises to be outstanding for coin operated equipment of some special type yet to be developed. Therefore any study of this field, and especially a study like that of the noted Mr. Cardinell's, should be in the hands of every operator.

## VIRGINIA'S "HOUSE BILL NO. 48"

We have before us a copy of the State of Virginia's "House Bill No. 48" wherein, it seems, an exceptionally thoro study of coin operated machines of all types was made and license taxes applied. (The copy of this Bill was sent to us by Frank E. Page of Roanoke Vending Machine Exchange, Roanoke, Va.)

In the first place any firm engaged in the sale or operation of coin operated machines of any kind shall pay an occupational license tax of \$1,000.00 annually, in addition to all machine taxes. Furthermore, the operator must post a bond with the State Tax Commissioner to insure the proper payment of taxes. Any coin operated machine (with certain types and the pay telephone excepted) shall pay \$25.00 per year license. Music machines are to pay \$5.00 per year license. Soft drink, agricultural products or cigar vendors pay \$3.00 per year. Candy machines operated in theatres pay \$5.00 per year, operated anywhere else but in theatres, candy machines pay \$10.00 per year. Cigarette machines, where a retailer's tobacco license has already been obtained, pay \$3.00 per year, and also pay 13c for each \$100.00 gross sales they do. Weighing scales, peanut, chewing gum and postage stamp machines pay \$1.00 per year. Miniature pool tables with 5c chutes or larger pay \$10.00 per year. Parcel checking machines pay 15c per year for each individual unit. 1c amusement machines pay \$2.00 per year.

*(The Cash Box has written to Virginia's leading coinmen but hasn't as yet heard just what action has been taken in regard to this Bill. As soon as we hear we shall be happy to pass on this information.)*

## BOSTON DEPT. STORE THANKS COINMAN

In this letter Frank Early of Gilchrist's Sales Promotion Division writes, "Thank you for helping us to put this drive over."

Ed. Ravreby of Owl Mint postscrips the Gilchrist letter with the following, "Their RCA service unit could not understand it." ("It" meaning the Panoram.) According to the letter Owl Mint received from them, Gilchrist's men called the Panoram, "a simulated Television set."

## WAR DEPT. OKAYS NCMA'S CARTOON

Henry W. Seiden, of Albany, N. Y., who was chosen Temporary Chairman of the National Coin Machine Assn. at the Second Wartime Conference, writes to advise that the War Dept. okayed the cartoon which members of this organization are sending broadcast thruout all industry.

The Adjutant General's Office of the War Department writes Henry, "The two cartoons which you sent to this office have been approved. I think they are very appropriate particularly the one emphasizing the use of V-Mail as this fits in with our national V-Mail campaign which is being carried out at this time."

*(When Henry visited the offices of The Cash Box he explained that all coinmen are being urged to get this cartoon placed in prominent locations thruout their cities. He also reported that many leading banks, department stores, post offices, etc., had already agreed to prominently display NCM's cartoon.)*






