Kiss is quite a phenomenon. They get very little radio support in either Top 40 or progressive radio and still, they sell millions of albums. That fact speaks for the power of concert appearances because it is through those appearances that the band has built an empire. But, Kiss is a phenomenon for another reason. That has to do with what may be the most structured and manipulative marketing campaign ever carved out. It is a battle plan designed to milk every possible dollar out of the band's audience. The latest tactic in the plan is the release of four solo LP's, one by each group member. Clever design is the highlight, but within the grand scheme they have made provision for some music. To the surprise of many, these albums are each decent in their own way. In fact they are more accessible to radio than those efforts made by the group.

Some big stars have released records in this the season of the big stars. Linda Ronstadt always issues a tasty album. This one has three or four bell ringers. While Phoebe Snow's album is also good, it is not produced to be the individual statement that Linda's is. It features a more standard New York studio session approach.

Chicago finally ran out of numbers and gave their new album a name. Everything else remains the same, tight playing and so-so songs. Then there are the Beach Boys. There is residual love for this band and everyone roots for them to do well, but their music is deteriorating into, what seems like, therapy sessions for Brian Wilson. Meanwhile, very quietly Ray Charles has released a second impressive album in a row.

This week there is also some avant art which requires mention because persons are not made of hits alone. Steve Reich is an avant garde classicist - which means that two hundred years from now he will be important and the above mentioned artists will have been long since forgotten. His long composition called "Music for 18 Musicians" is both inspired and beautiful. It is a slowly evolving, repetitious melody which grows audibly like time-lapse photography of a flower in bloom grows visually. Quite something.

P.D. Notebook

(by Eric Norberg, KEX-Portland)

The two programming matters the FCC seems most inclined to pass out big fines on are violations of the sponsor identification rule (which we looked at last week) and the lottery rule. In various locations around the country, lotteries of one sort or another (including prize drawings you have to pay to enter, door prizes inside concerts or other events for which admission is charged, and raffles) are legal, but the only lotteries which it's legal to promote on the air in any way are certain state lotteries specifically exempted by the FCC.

The three elements which define a lottery are "prize," "chance," and "consideration." Prize is pretty obvious; a contest you have to pay to enter in which there is no prize is certain to be fraudulent anyway! Chance means that skill is not the determining factor - and that not everyone wins. Here it starts getting tricky.

Suppose a local soccer team runs a series of ads to promote attendance at a game, indicating that at halftime there will be a goalkicking contest, in which each person kicking the ball into the goal from a certain point on the field wins a prize. Is that a lottery? Only those paying to get into the game could participate in the contest, but the team said it wasn't because skill in kicking the ball would determine who won a prize, thus eliminating the element of chance. But was it eliminated? This turned out still to be a lottery, because not everyone in the large crowd at the game would be able to participate...and there would be no auditions in ball-kicking to determine which of those who wanted to do it would be allowed to participate in the half-time promotion. Chance determined, at least partly, who was allowed to compete in a contest of skill...and if any element of chance is involved in determining who wins in a contest, the element of chance exists; and if prize and consideration are involved too, it's a lottery.

If the element of chance can get ambiguous, the element of consideration has been downright confusing, if not totally inconsistent. Has been; there's been a recent (rather unpublicised) change which helps clear the air somewhat, which we'll get to in a minute.

What consideration is, is paying to enter a contest. Buy the product and tear off the boxtop to enter; buy a ticket to enter; etc. Having to pay something to enter a drawing. That seems relatively straightforward (though it's amazing how often a spot will still get on the air in which those buying a car are then entered in a drawing for some valuable accessory, or those buying a pair of pants get to spin a wheel for the size of their discount, etc.)...but a decade ago the FCC ruled that having to pay anything to anybody to enter a contest was sufficient for "consideration". (Postage and the cost of a phone call have always been excluded, despite their cost, thus making radio station contests legal.) Thus paying at the gate to get into a county fair, where a free drawing was being held at one of the booths, constituted a lottery...and things like having to travel a considerable distance to enter a drawing became "consideration" too. That added enormous complexity to a matter in which having to buy a newspaper was consideration, but having to buy a postage stamp (even if it cost more) wasn't! (continued next week)
