## Note From Bill

*Bill's been on his trip of a lifetime for less than one week and we've already received his first diary notes. We share them with you now, knowing many of our readers enjoy Bill's notes.*

12/7 - 7PM. Arrived L.A. Airport, checked UTA (Air France), 10:25 flight for Papeete cancelled. "We'll put you up at a hotel. Stand by the door - look for mini-bus marked "Airport Hotel". I did - got aboard - found it was the "Skyway Airport Hotel". Got off - asked cab driver to take me to Airport Hotel. He said "No - I've been here an hour waiting for a fare, and your hotel is just outside the airport". Had to wait until another fare came along. Then we shared cab and he took me to my hotel. But it wasn't - it was the Century Airport Hotel - a real flea bag. Phones for cab. None came. Hailed one - (and in L.A. that's pure luck) went to Airport Hyatt. Paid for it myself.

12/8 - 6:30AM. Checked in at UTA - flight due out at 7:15AM. Took off 8AM. Seat partner Cole West (movie actor bound for shooting a film in the outback of Western Australia. Real name - Wesley Cordell Christenson.) Other seat partner a French woman from Toulouse, who speaks no English. I tried my high school French on her and was delighted when she understood.

Mr. Christenson knew everything about everything and everybody. He had been everywhere - almost - and knew the Pacific Islands intimately. He left no doubt that at age 66 he was still a real stud, having little interest in women near his own age.

He slept for a while during the movie - as did I - but his talk was at least as interesting as a novel, and it helped to pass the long 8 hour flight to Tahiti.

Previously I had gone into the men's room and shed my California clothes for tropical whites, a welcome relief - but a fearful crowding of my suitcase. Repacking is top priority. Scenery on Tahiti lovely but so far nothing superior to Hawaii. Perhaps Bora Bora?

## P.D. Notebook

(by Eric Norberg, KEX-Portland)

- The FCC's quota approach to public affairs and "other" programming often places unrealistic burdens on stations, and though the Commission places a premium on such programming run in the course of the regular broadcast week, it expects broadcasters to run at least the minimum amount of each category pledged in the license renewal application. Public affairs and features categorizable in the "other" category can very profitably be constructed in small capsules and run in high-listening times in stations of all formats - but small capsules don't fill the hours you committed. Most stations toss the remainder of their public service programming in odd hours on week-ends. Broadcasters tend to be defensive about this, but you should be aware that there can be very sound positive reasons for doing this.
- In the markets I am familiar with, experiments I have conducted have shown that audiences are uniquely receptive to such programs on - surprise - Sunday morning! However, I have found no indication that the same is true on Saturday or Sunday nights. The ratings should tell you if this pattern is the same in your market. There may actually be value to you in your market - in terms of audience size - in staying in service programs till fairly late Sunday morning; stations that get into music early in the morning sometimes show weakness till the midday period.
- No service programs will command an audience unless there is something of value and interest in them; however, some of them may pragmatically be sponsored religious programs or the like. In the discretionary programs, the stations that do best are the ones whose Program Directors have taken considerable pains to find the best shows. Though it's true that "documentaries" per se no longer can be classified as "public affairs" unless they deal with issues which rank in your community ascertaining of regional problems, it should come as no shock to you to discover that because such problems are on people's minds, an intelligent discussion of the problems can be interesting to your audience. Such programs need not originate locally to be topical and applicable; there are several fine ones distributed nationally.
- As for religious broadcasts, the most commonly available shows tend not to be of specific interest to the nonreligious. The most stimulating religious services often tend not to be offered to broadcasters - the ministers are less interested in raising money for worldwide ministries than in reaching members of their own congregation. They are often more than pleased to cooperate with a station that seeks them out with an offer of airtime, and will usually find the funds to cover all incidental line or tape charges to make use of sustaining airtime. This sort of program development is not as uncommon as you may think - among the successful stations! (Hint: Check out the churches with special appeal to college students.)
- All of this is nothing more nor less than the obvious (but often somewhat neglected) principle that all program elements should be maximized in appeal to your audience, as a matter of course. FCC commitments may be met without resorting to "throwaway" programs - with a little effort!
- By the way, though documentaries about music and entertainment are no longer classifiable as "public affairs", they certainly do qualify as "other" programming if they contain interviews and commentary, and the music is selected to complement the text; if you're logging such programs "E" instead of "O", you're definitely missing a bet. On the other hand, the FCC has decided that secular music played in a religious show is not classifiable as "religion" ("O"), and in programs which drop short religious thoughts into a secular DJ show setting, only the time spent in the religious thoughts can now be counted for "O" credit! This does not apply to hymns and religious songs, however. Nonetheless, stations which have been counting on these "religious" DJ shows to fulfill their "O" credit obligations now may have a more urgent reason to consider the form of program development just discussed than they may have believed!
