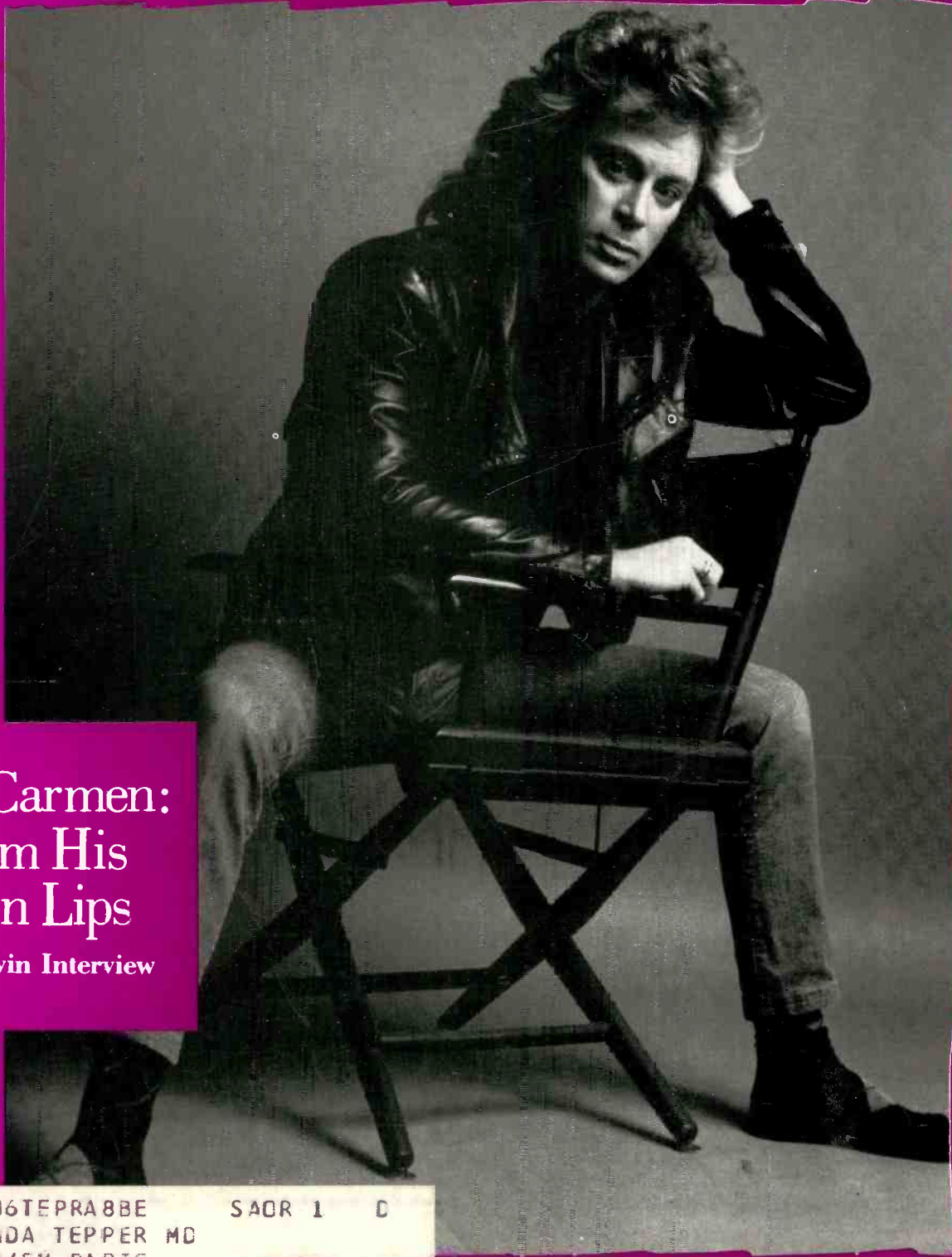

ANALYSIS

1985 is off to a helluva start musically. No one can complain about not having enough new product to choose from this week. About the only thing that remained unchanged was the "Power Trio", but the Top 40 got a noticeable face lift. FOREIGNER gains 20 percentage points in "Hit Factor", 75% to 95%. HENLEY headed Top 5, showing an 88% "Hit Factor", but the biggest increase goes to WHAM!, who took off like a rocket during the holiday break, going from an 18% to an 82% "Hit Factor". America's number one movie "Beverly Hills Cop" is helping turn "Neutron Dance" into a smash as well. Already top ten at WJZR, WALG, WKTU, WRKR, KSEZ, KDON, KPUR, WNPT, WBG, Q104, KHOP/FM, etc. There were a few programmers who registered some doubts about JOHN FOGERTY coming through in the 1980's. This most added record in our last issue of 1984 will go all the way with PD's amazed at the instant acceptance from older and younger demo's. GLENN FREY following hot on the heels of the POINTER SISTERS' success story. It took a month and a half, but our "Record To Watch" of November 30th, MIDNIGHT STAR's "Operator", debuts inside the Top 30. Big jumps at FM102 8-3, KKHR 22-13, WKZQ 22-15, PRO/FM 24-18, KSKD 34-24, Z93 29-21,

KRIO 22-13, KWES 13-5, WBTT 30-21, Z104, 14-9, KQXR 23-13, ZZ99 33-23, WBLU 32-13, WQTU 23-11. Early results on NEW EDITION's latest point to it outdoing "Cool It Now" by a big margin. Already logging 138 stations. KINKS debuts with 125 reports, and adds at 34 stations, including WKSQ, WPRO, KAFM, KKRC, KCNB, KTAM, KTAW, WHHY, WBBQ, KUBE, KRQ etc. The last "Record To Watch" of '84, JULIE BROWN's "Homecoming Queen" debuts at number two in Phoenix at KZZP and is also doing big things in Chicago. Added at WCIL-Carbondale, WDEK-DeKalb, and KNPA-Boise. Look out for a couple of Johns...this week's "Record To Watch", JOHN PARR, comes through with 28 adds for a total of 80 reports, but most important - a "Hit Factor" of 10% already! This one is right on the verge of taking off...big. Also JOHN HUNTER's "Tragedy" making a move with adds in Minneapolis WLOL, KRNA-Iowa City, KRQ-Tucson, WBEN/FM-Buffalo, KREO-Santa Rosa, KIST-Santa Barbara, and 25 more. JERMAINE STEWART's "The Word Is Out" building much like BILLY OCEAN did in the early going. MIAMI's I-95 charts it #20, with Y100 adding it as does CKLG-Vancouver and FM102-Sacramento. Moves 15-7 at KSTN, #14 at CKOC. Dave

Like quite a few people in our business today, Elvis became the single most important influence in directing my career towards music and radio. He literally changed my life.

George Klein, longtime Memphis radio personality, programmer and one of Elvis' closest friends, analyzed his amazing popularity on a recent edition of "Entertain-



ment Tonight." According to George, Elvis made such an incredible impact on our lives that today parents want their kids to experience and understand the power of Elvis Presley too. Once exposed to his music and talent, another generation of Elvis fans appear.

It's important on this occasion for all of us to remember that there is but one man who has sold over a billion records, one man who altered the course of musical history forever, one man who is *the originator* ... and all the rest imitators ... one man who personified "cool," and only one man who can be called the King of Rock 'n' Roll. ■

"Z" DAY

Up to now, I thought I'd heard everything.

But, today I heard about a "major market" station manager that got demoted to program director. And I heard about a "major market" jock that got fired because he slipped an album under the front door to a listener standing on the other side. It seems it was against "station policy." (Save the album kid, it will make a great collector's item.)

Radio is still a tee-shirt in an unemployment line. An ego smoking a cigar. An under-achiever failing up. A format living in fear. A senior citizen with a kindergarden mentality. A stranger dressed in black.

Radio is a "people" industry that is overly concerned with demographics, market share, statistics, theories, trends, gimmicky formats, and consultants. Management too often remembers yesterday's scars while making today's decisions. Radio remains an industry where mistakes are cloned.

Not all radio, thank God. I have known station managers who have been able to rise above the stagnant waters. M. E. "Dan" Danbom; Ralph Beaudin; Dick Penn; Ralph Barnes; and Chuck Knapp. They each share some strong and necessary attributes. First, they are very good listeners, and very good observers. All five are great motivators. They each set realistic goals, and then release the reins to allow the people involved to gallop forward. They are comfortable with themselves, and make others feel important. They are rare.

There are obviously more names to add to this list of "good guys," but I am certain their total would only fill a corner in the "eye" of the radio needle. I am not implying that the industry is

plagued with incompetent leadership; but perhaps the complexity of competing in today's markets points to a different method of leadership. Enter . . . THEORY Z.

"Theory Z" is a book by William Ouchi, a UCLA professor, which expounded on the Japanese management style. One of the points stressed in Theory Z is collective decision making. Team players. Theory Z also stresses a lifetime employment with a single employee (Think radio will ever buy that?) But, let's "Zero in" on collective decision making.

Picture this: Monday morning 8:00A.M. Seated around a conference table is station manager, the program director, the sales manager, the chief engineer, and the comptroller. This "management team" meets at least twice a week. Each shares an equal voice in all decision making. Station priorities are agreed upon. In time, each manager gains a broad knowledge of the workings of the station, and an insight into another's realm of expertise. By implementing the "team management" theory, each person sitting around that conference table can exercise their position as top management without the political pressures that dominate every corporate ladder. Five minds aiming towards one successful direction. Show me a consultant who can top that!

It is important however, that the member of the team whose title reads Station Manager not allow their ego to get in the way, or the management team will be reduced to a committee.

And nobody ever erected a statue to a committee. ■

MORE ON GETTING A JOB



As a postscript to the recent columns on Getting A Job, there was a fascinating article in the October 22 issue of Forbes magazine (page 220), called "The Anatomy Of A Want Ad". It details how an executive was selected for a family-owned greeting card company, "Pawprints", as the result of a want ad.

The crux of the article dealt with something more universal- how an applicant is selected from among those applying as "the" one. This seemed to have great relevance for radio folk too, so with the permission of Forbes, here are some excerpts from the article.

First, the want ad, as it appeared in the Wall Street Journal and the Boston Globe: "Pawprints: High growth, privately held greeting card publisher seeks dedicated, entrepreneurial, energetic and creative person with management experience for TOP MANAGEMENT POSITION. Resume to ..."

The ad drew 600 responses. When co-owner Marcia Tripp "turned to the stack of responses, she wasted no time. In fact, it usually took less than 90 seconds to pass or fail an applicant; and at that, only 16 made the second cut. 'I wanted someone smart, loyal, hardworking, and a leader. I didn't want a team player. I wanted a team captain--entrepreneurial, wanting to help us grow. Creative. Managerial. I wanted a person who had taken his knocks and knew how to manage people. The best

people see themselves as having these characteristics. "Yet many applicants were rejected out of hand, not for the lack of these qualities, but for much more mundane reasons. To wit: Sending a resume without a cover letter showing why the applicant wanted the job. 'Showed they were really interested, doesn't it?' Tripp asked sarcastically.

A badly photostatted resume.

A badly typed resume or letter--words misspelled, typos and messy erasures. 'Many people said they were good at a lot of things, typing not being one of them,' Tripp says. 'That's okay. But you would get it right, or have someone do it for you, if you cared.'

"Those simple errors probably knocked out 20% of the applicants. Others were clearly on fishing expeditions. 'It's like they were applying for every job opening they saw, without thinking about what was required,' Tripp says. For example, one applicant was controller for a Big Eight accounting firm. 'He wasn't a management person,' Tripp says.

"Similarly, letters that began with something like the following also got short shrift: 'The field of management has always interested me. At Pawprints I could learn firsthand.'

"Curiously, few people took the time to figure out anything about the company. For example, perhaps only one letter in fifty was addressed personally to Marcia Tripp. A quick call to the Pawprints switchboard would have yielded that information; at the minimum it would have avoided the mistake of a letter beginning 'Dear Sir'."

After getting it down to the final 16 applicants by these processes, Ms. Tripp got more specific in screening the applicants through personal interviews for the specific requirements of this job.

Notice any echoes in there of things brought up in the section of our "Get A Job" series that dealt with letters and resumes? If you've ever been in the position to receive or evaluate applications for a job, doesn't every sentence ring a bell? And in how many of those sentences were you wincing, recognizing a shortcoming you might have committed in a similar applicant situation?

After it was all over, Ms. Tripp said "she didn't find the process painful. 'What is most surprising,' she says, 'is that (of those who made it to the personal interview stage) the resume doesn't show the person.'"

And that suggests you should put a lot of thought and work into your resume and cover letter, when you send one, to make sure it does show you...because unless you're invited in for an interview (on the basis of what you've submitted) they'll never know you except through that application! ■

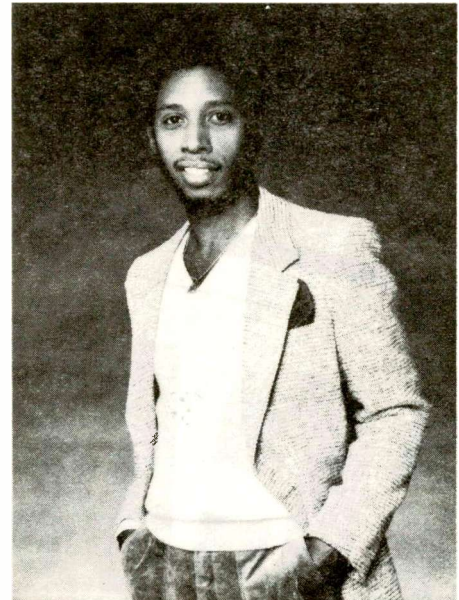

THE RETURN OF ERIC CARMEN



This week's **Gavin Interview** features singer, songwriter, producer, and multi-instrumentalist **Eric Carmen**. His visibility in American music has varied over the last 13 years. Best known for his number one classic "All By Myself" in 1975, Eric is also adored by rock'n'roll scholars as the leader of a pop cult band known as the **Raspberries**. Though the Raspberries garnered only one top five Top Forty single ("Go All The Way"), their musical ideals were way ahead of their time for 1972. Armed with a fresh early Beatlesque approach, they signaled an initial desire for American musicians to leave the bottom-heavy/solo-laden sounds of the Seventies for tighter and more disciplined waters. Prior to the release of his latest LP, simply titled **ERIC CARMEN**, his last musical contribution was as co-writer of **Mike Reno** and **Ann Wilson's** "Almost Paradise," love theme from the colossal movie *Footloose*.

KZ: Is the single a new song or is it something you've had for awhile?

EC: The single, "I Want To Hear It From Your Lips" is a reasonably new song. This album was recorded over a period of the last year. I actually started working on this album November of '83. The single was written with *Dean Pitchford* in about three minutes. (laughter) I met Dean when we worked on the *Footloose* project. I came out to Los Angeles (in October of 1983) . . . right about the time I was signing with Geffen Records. I got a call (from a friend) back in Ohio where I was still living. She said "We need you to come out and work on this love theme for this movie we're doing. We've had about five people working on it up to now and nobody has managed to do it yet. Would you like to try it?" Well, considering I've been waiting for somebody to ask me that for about fifteen years, I said, "Sure, I'd like to try it." So I got on a plane, met Dean on a Tuesday morning. We started writing "Almost Paradise" about noon and we were done at midnight. The next day it was in the film. After "Almost Paradise"

on our trip home from Paramount Studios, I asked Dean if he had anything else that might be of some use to me since I was about to embark on recording my album. About three days later, I got a call from him. He said, "I left something in the box at your hotel. See what you think." I went downstairs and opened up this envelope and on yellow lined paper there was this lyric for the song "I Want To Hear It From Your Lips." This sounds corny but it's true. I read it through one time and I heard the song in my head. I called Dean on the phone five minutes later and sang it to him on the phone. And lo and behold, the three minute wonder is the first single.

KZ: How did your association with Geffen Records start?

EC: I had met (A&R man) **John Kalodner** in New York a couple of years earlier. He had come out to Ohio and I played him some songs and I gave him a tape. There were a couple of different times in my career when I had been signed to a label when I had a big hit record but for one reason or another there did not seem to be any career development. I seemed to function in a

continual situation where people knew the songs that I had written or the records but they didn't know who Eric Carmen was. I was hoping that I could go someplace where they had the support that was necessary to establish a career as opposed to just another record.

KZ: I've been a fan of your music for a long time since the first Raspberries single "Go All The Way" in 1972. On the new album there's a song called "American As Apple Pie." It has one of my favorite Beach Boys licks from their tune "This Whole World." Was it intentional?

EC: (laughter) You mean the "Aww omm dot ditty?" The biggest problem is trying to figure out how to change it. We tried to sing "Aww um pop did it" or "Dot did it" because I don't want The Beach Boys to think I'm ripping them off. One little phrase in there. It's one of those things where there's just certain syllables that sing so perfectly in certain spots. My love of that band is prone to surface now and then. There's no way I can completely disguise it.

KZ: On your new album, you also use

producer **Bob Gaudio**. He used to be one of the *Four Seasons*.

EC: Bob Gaudio had impressed me greatly when he did "Hello Again" from **The Jazz Singer**." Neil's voice on that record was a good three times as loud as any normal lead vocal should be. One of the things I had going into this record was a couple of ballads that I thought were very important to this record. I wanted to make sure there was going to be a real good orchestral sound. I wanted to make sure the vocal would not get buried in the track. I wanted to be sure we got the ballads no matter what. I thought that with the rock'n'roll songs, I had a pretty good idea of how I could accomplish those in the studio. I didn't want the ballads to get lost. I thought Neil Diamond's "Hello Again" was a very good jumping off place for a producer to do "I'm Through With Love," "The Way We Used To Be," and "She Remembered."

KZ: You have pretty wide tastes in music.

EC: Having produced records myself, you begin to know how things were done in the studio when you listen to records on the radio. In all honesty, I don't own a ton of Neil Diamond records. I like a lot of stuff Neil does. But there are certain records I hear now and then on the radio that seem to jump out at you. To me, "Hello Again" was one of those records. Sometimes on that basis I would want to work with a certain producer. It's pretty much the same situation with **Don Gehman**. When I worked with Don it was almost entirely because of **John Cougar's** "The Authority Song." It was such a wonderful record! I thought whoever made that knows what they're doing. Even if John Cougar and I are significantly different artists. There's no reason why the guy who did this record couldn't do a proper job on "American As Apple Pie."

KZ: You haven't made a record in five years. Where have you been?

EC: (laughter) I was in Beachwood, Ohio, my hometown waiting for the right circumstances. The problem was the frustration of being 'typed' at a record label. In the Raspberries, when we started out there was a marketing campaign at Capitol Records. They took a look at us in 1972 and decided—Teen Band.

KZ: The Raspberries always had this real odd image. There was the image of a teen band, but all the music critics went crazy over them.

EC: Critics' darlings and a teen band. No self respecting seventeen or eighteen year old who bought an album wanted anything to do with us.

KZ: How did the whole thing start?

EC: The Raspberries were an outgrowth of two bands that existed prior in Cleveland, Ohio. One of them was called The Choir—that contained three members of the Raspberries other than myself. They were very impressive. They played all the songs that I loved by The Beatles, The Who, and The Byrds.

KZ: What was the basis on which the Raspberries were formed?

EC: Well The Choir had been playing in Cleveland and I had a group called **Cyrus Erie**. Towards the end of **Cyrus Erie** and The Choir, I got together with the drummer from The Choir and said give me a call. About three months later, we put the Raspberries together to be basically the reactionary group of Cleveland. By 1970, most bands were doing extended guitar solos and drum solos. Beards down to their waists. Hair down to their knees and torn up jeans onstage. In the interest of being different, the Raspberries just played our roots. Back to the Beatles, Stones, Little Richard, Chuck Berry, and Elvis. That's it. We had one song that had a solo over eight bars. Other than that, it was "Jailhouse Rock," "Long Tall Sally," and "Sweet Little Sixteen." Within about a month we were the top band in Ohio.

KZ: When did the Raspberries sign to Capitol?

EC: Demo tapes crossed the desk of **Jimmy Ienner**. He came into Ohio to see us. We were playing in a little bar at Kent State. When I think of all the things I did at that time, it's almost embarrassing. We went to meet Jimmy Ienner at the airport wearing matching suits. Burgundy suits and matching haircuts. (laughter) It was pretty riotous for 1970. We were offered a deal right away from Capitol Records—home of The Beatles and The Beach Boys. A dream come true. We did our first album and out came "Go All The Way."

KZ: Which was the Raspberries' big hit in 1972.

EC: I think it made it to number four or five. That was a pretty exciting situation for us. In those glorious days when you thought writing a good song and making a good record was going to get you a hit.

KZ: The monumental achievement of the first Raspberries album was that every "R" bin in the record stores stank like Raspberries for the next five years.

EC: That was pretty slick actually.

(laughter) I can't take any credit for that (scratch and sniff sticker on the front cover.) That was the Capitol Records marketing department. We did hear some great stories though. There was one about some woman in Toronto who apparently walked into a record store and passed out from the stench of all those albums.

KZ: You've worked with a long list of impressive engineers and producers—**Shelly Yakus, Jimmy Iovine, Kevin Beamish, Greg Ladanyi** and **Val Garay**.

EC: The way I look at it, making records is a continuing education on how to make records. Each person has their own little style and a certain kind of sound that they get. I've just been bound and determined to find out what all their tricks are. (laughter)

KZ: What eventually happened with the image of the Raspberries?

EC: When we signed with Capitol Records, we came out to Los Angeles in 1972 for the first time. We went to the Capitol Tower and they had interviews lined up for us. Boy, were we excited! Upstairs came Fave Magazine, Sixteen Magazine, Tiger Beat, Star Magazine. We thought 'gee, when does Rolling Stone Magazine come? How about Crawdaddy or Cream Magazine? They never showed up. I think Capitol took one look at us in 1972 and saw four guys reasonably clean cut with no moustaches and beards. They said 'Hmm who are these guys? They must be the Osmonds.' They decided right away that's how they were going to market us—to a teen audience. Of course, that line of thinking was the real kiss of death for any kind of credibility. It was just not cool to like the same kind of band your 13 year old sister liked.

KZ: When did your solo career begin?

EC: In 1974 I decided to go out and do it myself. I started writing things for a potential solo album. By the end of 1974, I was looking for a solo deal and lo and behold, Arista Records' **Clive Davis** got on a plane and came into Cleveland. I sat down at the piano and played him some songs like "All By Myself," "Never Gonna Fall In Love Again," and "That's Rock'n'Roll." He offered me a contract the next day.

KZ: I remember when "All By Myself" went number one in The Gavin Report. **Bill Gavin** remembers it as the song with the *Rachmaninoff* in it.

EC: That's true. It was very blatant. I wasn't trying to cover up the fact the verse was based on a theme from *Rachmaninoff's* Second Piano Concerto. That's probably my favorite piece of music in the world. When I was working on "All By Myself" it was a melody that was too beautiful to be ignored. Here's a way to bring classical music to an audience that perhaps never otherwise hears it. After it became known, everybody assumed it was the piano interlude in the middle. The only part that was taken from *Rachmaninoff* was the verse.

KZ: Where did your classical training come from?

EC: I started classical training when I was two and a half at the Cleveland Institute of Music. My family recognized

some kind of musical talent in me before I can remember. Basically I just wanted to play the piano. I took classical piano lessons at eleven for four and a half years prior to getting interested in rock'n'roll. Along the way I learned how to play the guitar, bass and drums. With the advent of portable keyboard instruments, it became more logical to use a classical basis for a song because you could actually recapture it live. So that crept back into my music. The solo album gave me an opportunity to break the Raspberries mold. Unfortunately I broke the mold too well. Now I think I've finally arrived at a label where they recognize the possibility of having an artist who can do more than one thing. That was something that was ultimately important to me. I have always dreamed of being somewhere where they would release an uptempo first single, a ballad second single and maybe an uptempo third single. As opposed to having a success with one thing and following it immediately with something that sounds as close to that first record as possible.

KZ: Let's talk about your second solo album, *Boats Against The Current*.

EC: That record was a real pivotal moment in my life. It was the first record that I had done without Jimmy Ienner. That album started out in London with my band, with Gus Dudgeon producing and then Gus left the project. I became the producer and had to finish the whole album myself. There were a lot of ups and downs on that album. Up until this new album, that was my favorite record

that I ever made.

KZ: How about the *Change Of Heart* album?

EC: I sat in the producer's chair for that album much more than the artist's chair. It had less of me personally than any other album I've done. There were a couple songs I really felt close to.

KZ: What do you think about radio these days? You've always rode the crest between Top 40, A/C, and Album Radio. But before then, there wasn't even any of those definitions.

EC: In terms of how radio relates to what I do, it's probably better for me right now than it's been for a long time. There was a time I could have had Top Forty hit records, but in general an Album station didn't really want to know. With the Raspberries, some brave AOR stations would play our stuff... **WNEW**-New York, **WMMS**-Cleveland. There were others too. Then after "All By Myself" there were a lot of people who said 'Oh here he is—the romantic balladeer.' What's interesting now, in some conversations with people who liked the Raspberries but were probably too young to do anything about it at the time, have now moved into positions in radio where they're able to say it was cool to have liked the Raspberries. For the first time it's now cool to have been the leader of that band. In terms of music in general, right around 1978 I thought the musical boundaries and parameters within which I could work to get a record played were very tight. In 1977-1978 the Disco thing was

happening. I remember thinking in 1978, if "Good Vibrations" came out today, I wonder if it would have gotten played. It's a pretty avant garde record. To me, the challenge of making records is breaking those rules. Making records that do not sound like every other record being made. Today, a whole lot of those parameters have once again been removed. I think "Good Vibrations" would have a much better chance of being a hit record today than it would have in 1977. I hear records on the radio that are very inspiring from the standpoint of going into the studio to take chances again and still thinking there's a possibility you might hear that record on a radio station. Records like "Owner Of A Lonely Heart" by **Yes**, "Shock The Monkey" by **Peter Dinklage**, "She Blinded Me With Science" by **Thomas Dolby**.

KZ: These are all records made during your absence from recording. Do you listen to the radio a lot?

EC: I get in my car and go through the dial. When I find something that sounds interesting, I stop. Those were the things I thought were interesting during that period of time. Here's a good example: "Girls With Guns" by **Tommy Shaw**. I think the fact that that record got played is encouraging. It's a very strange record from the concept of a hit record. Very eclectic drumming, very esoteric record for the Eighties. It would have been totally out of the question in 1978. It's wonderful to see that the parameters of making records have broadened again. ■

Centerfield/Big Train From Memphis-JOHN FOGERTY (Warner Bros.)
Everyday on the way to work, I pass the DUCKEE MARKET (pictured
on the cover of WILLIE & THE POORBOYS) and would think about
JOHN FOGERTY. Where had he gone? Quite literally, it turns out that
FOGERTY has traded his prosperous past for what he thought could
be an uncertain plunge into the future. Yet CENTERFIELD is an
enlightened burst back into the limelight of a business that sometimes
settles for the video vapid and the formula fed superficial in favor
of the matured and reasoned voice of true talent. The sheer gravel
and guts of FOGERTY's unintentional sense of Americana has been
sorely missed all across the radio/television dial. On first listen,
you'll notice CENTERFIELD is a vast emotional prairie ranging from
the innocent ("I Saw It On TV") to the bitter ("Zanz Can't Dance"
and "Mr. Greed") finally evolving into an honest sense of hopefulness
and renewal. As if the music on the LP isn't revealing enough, look
for part one of a two part interview with FOGERTY starting next
week.

American As Apple Pie/I Wanna Hear It From Your Lips/Maybe My
Baby/You Took Me All The Way/Spotlight/I'm Through With Love-
ERIC CARMEN (Geffen) ERIC CARMEN is inside and outside your
GAVIN this week. After five years sitting it out waiting for the
legal snarls to unravel, TOP FORTY adds are beginning to roll in
alongside the NEW YEAR. Conscious that he's been pegged as a
balladeer (which is only one facet of his abilities), CARMEN includes
songs that rock n roll much like his overlooked rocker LP, TONITE
YOU'RE MINE on Arista and his early work with the misunderstood
and miscast RASPBERRIES ("You Took Me All The Way"). Producers
BOB GAUDIO and DON GEHMAN (working separately) help thrust
a better-than-ever ERIC CARMEN headlong into the song-oriented
eighties. The music jumps up, lays down, slithers, and seduces.

At the risk of sounding as cutesy as all the other writers in this
business, I gotta say that the verdict is in. CARMEN is innocent
as a balladmaster and guilty of rockin' and rollin', and caught
red-handed talking about it on page 23.

The Crush/When We Ran/Living A Little/Laughing A Little/Zero
House-JOHN HIATT (Geffen) "When We Ran" is one of those
beautiful tunes that could be the envy of an ELTON or BILLY JOEL
minus the glitzy gloss. Producer NORBERT PUTNAM (bass player
on many Nashville sides including KRISTOFFERSON'S SILVER
TONGUED DEVIL) and his sidepeople (including the fine drummer
LARRY LONDIN) highlight and spotlight HIATT's talents as a song-
writer using a tinny mix with rhythms rooted in MEMPHIS GROUP
soul. This is the closest HIATT has come to reproducing a live
evening of his music. "The Crush" and "Zero House", after being
omitted off the last LP, survive the axe this time around. ALTER-
NATIVE stations should make a point of turning on the world to
JOHN HIATT. Let's sneak him in the back way.

Sooner Or Later/Separate Lives/Vulture Culture-ALAN PARSONS
PROJECT (Arista) Since I ROBOT, I've always had trouble writing
about any ALAN PARSONS LPs partially because I've never seen
him perform: live, partially because he can't be pinned down to any
one primary lead vocalist. Still, being distinguished by your
backing tracks and making a lucrative career out of that is indeed
a unique way of remaining a viable radio staple. Like both his most
memorable LP's (I ROBOT, PYRAMID, TURN OF A FRIENDLY CARD),
and his most forgettable (EVE and EYE IN THE SKY) VULTURE
CULTURE has its highs, lows, and tweeners. Ironically as the
PROJECTS get simpler (minus any linking identifiable total concept)
I have more trouble. Best bets include "Sooner Or Later" and
"Separate Lives".

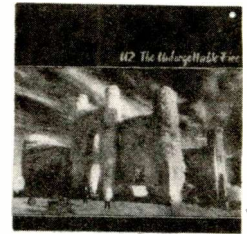

Welcome back from the holidays and to the second half of the 1980's. You may notice the absence of the numbers for last week and two weeks ago. We'll start with a clear slate because listing those numbers would be misleading with the two week lay-off.

REPLACEMENTS open the '85 season at the top - making them our first ever number one independant Alternative Action record. This is a significant feat considering the relatively limited promotion of the album.

LOS LOBOS and the SMITHS (12") are waiting in the wings looking towards the number one slot in the next few weeks. The SMITHS success as a single-only is unprecedented on this chart. Usually Alternative programmers don't get behind singles like this. Normally it takes the overall airplay of an entire album to move a record this high up the chart. But then the SMITHS aren't exactly your "normal" generic band either.

Our CERTIFIED record, BRONSKI BEAT, is taking advantage of the holiday lull in releases by quickly moving inside the top ten. Although it's very pop oriented don't let that scare you off. It's a quality record that deserves Alternative exposure.

ANALYSIS

Welcome back everyone who is back. Many of you who didn't call me this week I'm assuming froze your lists one more time. Be sure to call next week with those new lists so we can update our current chart information to reflect a more accurate summation of what the beginning of 1985 looks like. The biggest "Chartbusters" for the new year came from PHILIP BAILEY & PHIL COLLINS with their duet effort, and GEORGE BENSON with his "20/20". Although the BAILEY/COLLINS looked like it was destined to be a pop hit right from the beginning, R&B stations have picked up on the sound that sounded as though it might be too "rock 'n' roll" to fit the format. Debuting at #18 suggests that this theory was wrong. A young lady that we haven't heard from in a while, GWEN GUTHRIE, has made somewhat of a comeback with her "Love In Moderation" single, which debuts at #14 and becomes our "Certified" choice, along with JEFFREY OSBORNE, as predicted before the end of the year. Two ladies who started last fall off with a bang have returned for an encore: "Most Added" listings go to them - CHAKA KHAN, "This Is My Night", and TINA TURNER, "Private Dancer". No big

surprise on the "Pop Crossover" area, since the POINTER SISTERS have had nothing but crossover hits in quite a while, since they began their association with Richard Perry back in 1978. Getting to the new product, which most of you who called this week asked about: after CHAKA KHAN and TINA, ASHFORD & SIMPSON make a big return with "Outta The World", although "Solid" is looking big in the Top 40 department. Crossing over the other way are two rather unusual entries: WHAM!'s second single, featuring George Michael, looks hot enough to chart in the near future on our chart (it's already #7 on the Top 40 page) and SHEENA EASTON's "Sugar Walls", which bears a great resemblance to the PRINCE/TIME/VANITY sound, (as well it should, since the author of the tune is listed as 'Alexander Nevermind' who is rumored to be a pseudonym for Prince). EASTON enters our "Chartbound" category this week and in all probability will chart next week. THOMAS McCLARY looks like a winner this week and KURTIS BLOW's newest, "Basketball" gets stronger each week. New TIME single is "The Bird" and is getting lots of adds!

ERIC CARMEN-I Wanna Hear It From Your Lips

(Geffen) You can always count on Eric Carmen to make great records for radio. Together with ace producer Bob Gaudio, Eric makes a powerful comeback with a song that might as well be titled "Fire Pt. 2".

FRANKIE GOES TO HOLLYWOOD-Relax (Island)

Any song banned by the BBC is good enough for me. A humongous smash all over Europe, it was released in the U.S. last year but sadly got overlooked. This time around...watch out.

COMMODORES-Nightshift (Motown) Since the departure of Lionel Richie, The Commodores have scored with Top 40 radio as often as the Bears did against our 49ers.

But expect that to change with this tasty tribute to Marvin Gaye and Jackie Wilson. Veteran writer/producer Dennis Lambert pulls out all the stops and creates one of the best new records of the new year.

PAT BENATAR-Ooh Ooh Song (Chrysalis)

This 60's throwback is made for cruisin' on Friday and Saturday nights. Happy, upbeat, and a welcome change of pace that's a total delight.

THE HONEYDRIPPERS-Rockin' At Midnight

(EsParanza/Atlantic) No, this is not 1985's answer to "The Curly Shuffle". Actually this Roy Brown classic was originally called "Good Rockin' Tonight" and was one of Elvis Presley's early hits.

That fact alone should make it worthy of airplay and Plant and company do a version that would make The King proud.

JOURNEY-Only The Young (Geffen) An intense and powerful track that should more than help satisfy the demand for new product from their millions of fans. Song is featured in "Vision-quest"-a film scheduled to hit theatres next month. But expect it to kick in big ahead of the picture's release.JULIAN LENNON-Too Late For Goodbyes (Atlantic)

Everytime I turned around during the holidays, I was reading, hearing, or seeing something about Julian. All the press is much deserved and this newest single from "Valotte" showcases his musical versatility and remarkable skill as a pop songwriter.

BILLY JOEL-Keeping The Faith (Columbia)

Languishing in the past, Billy comes up with a lyrical gem that sounds even better now that it's been re-mixed from his "Innocent Man" LP. What a week for nostalgia!

"Centerfield" John Fogerty (Warner Bros.)

Pendleton sleeves rolled up beyond the elbows. Faded 501's and seasoned desert boots.

Fogerty is a creature of natural comfort - of tall trees sheltering forest floors from acid rains and Winnebagos. A chopper of wood for a log cabin fireplace. A painter of songs where earthtones dominate, where vintage is the feel and heritage the core. Fogerty's long overdue return after a ten year hiatus is not without its own acid bathing as he takes aim at Mr. Greed and a Mr. Zanz and the videocracy of Couch Potatoes. Fogerty's tenure as centerpiece for Creedence Clearwater Revival, one of the most prolific bands of the late sixties and early seventies, earned him the respect and admiration of that day's bluecollar rock fans and even if some of them are more into zero coupon bonds and BMW's there's a whole new cadre out there.

"Centerfield" is certainly capable of beginning it all again. THE OLD MAN DOWN THE ROAD, BIG TRAIN, I SAW IT ON T.V., CENTERFIELD.

"Eric Carmen" Eric Carmen (Geffen) The layoff

between LP's has proven worthwhile as he's built up both emotion and creative energy in the process. Ballads with a bite and rockers with ridges are the trademarks of his career and both are clearly evident here. See and read the Zimmerman interview inside.

Welcome Back Eric. I WANNA HEAR IT FROM YOUR LIPS, COME BACK TO MY LOVE, YOU TOOK ME ALL THE WAY, AMERICAN AS APPLE PIE.

20/20 - George Benson (Warner Bros.) Track for track this is by far his most consistent LP to date. It's his most commercial and consumable in terms of airplay -the kind of LP that can be milked for hit singles 'til the cows come home. But if we're gonna choose sides, let's give Side One a decided edge for airplay. NO ONE EMOTION, recalls the energy of FLASHDANCE. PLEASE DON'T WALK AWAY sounds like a TURN YOUR LOVE AROUND groove. I JUST WANT TO HANG AROUND (written by the Sembello Family) is full throat and harmonies. NOTHING'S GONNA CHANGE MY LOVE FOR YOU has lyric by Gerry Goffin and BEYOND THE SEA recalls the classic version by Bobby Darin. Side two leads with the first single, 20/20 and carry's the album to a wholly satisfying conclusion by dueting with Roberta Flack on YOU ARE THE LOVE OF MY LIFE.
