INSIDE TOP 40 WITH DAVE SHOLIN

Top four slots are occupied by artists who have never had records in the top ten before. In fact many of the newer "unknowns" are causing much of the noise these days. INXS enters the top ten at WBEN, CHUM, KZZU, KS103, KCPX, KZZP, B-95, WQUT, WHHY, Q105, WANS, WBCY etc. PET SHOP BOYS primed to enter the top ten next week (a number of Urban programmers are playing the 12-inch in high rotation) as Hit Factor nearly doubles from 35% TO 66%! Moves 12-5 at 93Q, 10-1 KZZP, 19-10 KOZE, 12-5 KITS, 25-14 KYNO, 20-10 WZOK, 35-18 WLS, 11-3 I-95, etc.

VAN HALEN's best week assisted by the release of the album with phenomenal sales response. Top 20 at 5% of 239 stations reporting it this week, including I-100, WQID, Q104, B-94, Z100, WAAL, WSPK, WYTZ, KBEQ, KKYS, KZZK, AM106, etc. MIAMI SOUND MACHINE continues to debut in a number of markets pulling up to a respectable 21%

Hit Factor. Top 30 first week at WKYA, WNCI, KWSS, KKBG, KIMN, WJZQ, WYZZ, B-94, WQCR, PRO/FM, etc.

SEGER converting new airplay into some big chart gains at WKHI 30-25, WFBG 36-30, WCCC 27-23, WLS 26-15, KROC 31-24, B-96 25-20, KSYZ 31-24, KMJK 19-13, KRZQ 19-14, etc. OMD, with plenty of top ten activity on the West Coast, gets a boost from "Pretty In Pink" and adds at KHOP/FM, KRKE, KIVA, KSER, WXXQ, WRTB, WLKI, WKXX, B-97, WJZR, WTIC, etc.

Former Record To watch, NU SHOOZ, moves closer to Chartbound status with 21 adds. 12-inch sales are very strong in several key markets...charts 11-9 at Z100-New York, 11-7 WXKS-Boston, 22-14 WHTT-Boston, 14-9 KMAI-Honolulu, 10-7 KMEL-San Francisco, 11-9 KUBE-Seattle, etc. 21 adds also for CHERELLE & ALEXANDER O'NEAL. This former top 3 Urban smash moves 16-11 at WBBQ, 23-18 Q104, 17-12 KZZK,

21-11 KYNO; 8-4 KS103, 27-12 KDON, 6-3 KSAQ, 29-13 B-95, etc.

FEARGAL SHARKEY gets a boost with adds at KIIS/FM, KYMO and KGBS. Top ten in Canada at AM106, CHUM, CFTR, LG73, etc. SIMPLY RED doubles their airplay stats debuting at KMEL #23, KATD #29, WQLK #29, etc. Z104's Jonathan Little reports it's "the highest testing record of the last three years...94% positive".

FABULOUS THUNDERBIRDS quickly becoming a story. 27 adds, including WATT, KVIC, WBIZ, WWKZ, WRCK, KSWB, etc.



INXS-ful Breakthrough

When Top Forty acknowledged the "New Music" approach to hits in the eighties, INXS climbed right onboard. INXS began in 1979 when singer Michael Hutchence met the Farriss brothers — Tim (guitar), Andrew (keyboards) and Jon (drums) and their sax player friend Kirk Pengilly. Bassist Gary Beers, a pal of Hutchence, rounded out the lineup and it hasn't changed since. It was their quirky mix of dance, funk, and rock (along with three years of grueling American tours) that finally converted Top Forty and Album Radio programmers. Yet the imminent success of INXS hinged on the metamorphosis of frontman vocalist Hutchence. In their early U.S. support gigs with Adam Ant and The Go-Gos, he had a bit of a squirrely, punky presence. However, on their last American visit, Michael emerged as a dark haired version of David Lee Roth with the sexual persona to match. The girls in the audience responded in predictable fashion and "What You Need" lodged top five on the Gavin Top Forty chart and went top three in the Album Radio section. We spoke to guitarist Tim Farriss by phone as he was sunning himself in the Australian summer sun. Lead singer Hutchence is currently filming a movie, "Dogs In Space" with White City video director Richard Lowenstein. The rest of the group is completing a soundtrack single for still another Aussie movie production. After that, it's time for a bit of shark fishing (invitation respectfully declined, Tim), then another American tour.

KZ: How does INXS compare with past successful Australian bands?

TF: All the bands that came from Australia would do an American mix or were already playing music that would cater to American pre-eighties tastes. Sort of an American West Coast sound. People like Air Supply and Little River Band were really American influenced. We were more English influenced.

KZ: Has your American following created any backlashes in Australia?

TF: Our following in Australia has strengthened in some way. Particularly with the guys. Because we've remained living in Australia and we have kept coming back here, we haven't kissed (them) goodbye. People don't resent us for our success overseas. We're not coming back and talking with American accents.

KZ: How about what happened to Men At Work?

TF: We did a short part of their tour in '84, flying around in their private plane. Then we came home and they came home too about a month and a half later. They couldn't sell out a 2,000-seater here (in Australia). That was a bit of a tragedy. Luckily enough, that didn't seem to happen to us. I think it was because it took a long time for us to get popular, the same way it did in America — a lot of touring and playing.

KZ: So what are you doing now?

TF: Actually, we're in the studio at the moment. We're recording a single for an Australian movie, "Crocodile Dundee" with Paul Hogan. He's the guy (from the "visit

Australia" commercial). You know, "Shrimp on the barbie." We're producing this record ourselves.

KZ: Listen Like Thieves went gold here.

TF: We learned quite a lot from Chris Thomas (producer of Roxy Music, Pete Townshend, Elton, Sex Pistols). Maybe too much to work with him again. He told us we were a great live band and somehow we lost a lot of that on record. He told us to start thinking the same way in the studio as we do live. Perform the record rather than sit around artistically and iron over little bullshit parts. He throws a microphone in front of people and their amps and then he sits back and reads the paper.

KZ: The album sounds so live yet I heard it cost almost half a million dollars to make.

TF: Studio time, accommodations, wine, and beer. I guess it did cost about a half-million to make. Though the album was made very quickly, it was made over a long period of time. We usually had these studios decadently on lock-out.

KZ: What is your personal background? Were you guys students or workers?

TF: I was a bit of a Valentino at school. Kirk and I always played music throughout our school years together.

KZ: Was getting into music a life and death thing for you?

TF: It was a lifetime thing. All we did when we were kids was to see bands every weekend. That's what most kids do here.

KZ: What would you be doing now if INXS flopped?

TF: I'd still be writing music and playing it in one form or another. Perhaps I'd be the only white guy in a totally black band. That's kind of a fantasy of mine.

KZ: Looking back, how do you evaluate *The Swing LP*?

TF: We made that with a young whiz kid producer, Nick Launay. He started by getting Phil Collins all those great drum sounds. He was his pet engineer. You know those drum sounds you normally identify with Phil Collins? We went and recorded it in England. We rehearsed it there three weeks before we recorded it. We've always been funk-oriented, yet we've tried to mix it with other things. That album was a great album for us to experiment with the funk in different directions.

KZ: I think there's more of a kinship between American and Australians than British people sometimes.

TF: I definitely think so. Personally, I get sick and tired of defending Americans to the English all the time. Rock 'n' roll was invented in America, but I think the English have been the ones to instigate changes in it. Yet, to the English press, they love to criticize you if you're popular in the States. To me, what exactly are these people saying? Also, English people don't know any other way of talking besides as a complaint anyway. In England, you've either got to be Jesus and Mary Chain or Buck's Fizz (a plastic


type ABBA band).

KZ: Why has the line-up of INXS remained so constant?

TF: We were very young and we used to say things to each other like "Don't ever let a girlfriend get in between us and the band." We made a pact and it's grown into a way of life. On my birthday this year, it'll be nine years that we've been playing together.

KZ: Why did you wait until the third album (*Shabooh, Shoobah*) to gear towards the United States?

TF: We never thought pretentiously enough to venture outside of Australia just on the strength of our first two records. The first record was made on such a cheap budget. It was recorded midnight to dawn, after gigs. We were angry about things because we were living on social security. It wasn't until we got with a producer we really respected on the third album that we even thought about going overseas. Just before we made that album, we sent Andrew, Michael, and Kirk off overseas to visit a whole lot of producers in England and America. They had a copy of "The One Thing" video. We had done that one track and nothing else. All the producers were very impressed and said they couldn't improve on that. When they came back, we thought, "Great, let's stick with this producer (Mark Opitz). After (*Shabooh, Shoobah*) we had an offer to tour America. That's what

started our interests. “The One Thing” was some form of a Top Forty hit.

KZ: We saw you opening for Adam Ant.

TF: That was it.

KZ: Onstage, in the early days, you seemed more democratic. (Lead singer) Michael’s image has changed over the last few years.

TF: That’s true. In the very beginning, we were too democratic. No one was game enough to try and take on real roles. The third album was the turning point for the band. We really worked on the cover ourselves. The film clip of “The One Thing” was all us and an old school friend who made the video with us directing. Since then, being the front man has gotten through to Michael. He really revels in it now. Before, he’d shelter

among the band a lot more. To the viewing public now, everyone has got their roles.

KZ: Now you see kids screaming.

TF: In ’84 and ’85, we had a large teenage audience. That had something to do with the bands we toured with. We were still young. On the last tour, a lot of those kids have grown. We’re attracting a much broader audience now. In some parts of the US, the males way outnumber the females. That’s been the process of the new album too — being a lot more down to earth. We’ve tried as hard as we can to make all our videos performance videos.

KZ: What are some of your favorite new Australian bands? You were the guy that turned us on to Midnight Oil.

TF: One band I really love is Gang A Jang. There’s a band called the Models [just released domestically on Geffen]. They’re right in place and quite pop. I think the Divinyls are fantastic. Their new record is so good. Another band is I’m Talking. The Go-Betweens. Mental As Anything is on their way. They need a lot of familiarity with their audience. A band like Mental As Anything would be advised to tour America nonstop to build up that familiarity.

KZ: How was working with Nile Rodgers on “The Original Sin”?

TF: It was right when we were listening to everything Nile Rodgers had ever done. We were over-the-top fans. He just waltzed in backstage in Toronto. He introduced himself and I didn’t believe him.

KZ: How long did it take you to make the record with him?

TF: Three days. It started out as a jam. It was the second runthrough of the song. We did the song and continued jamming because we thought he was still getting


levels. He was talking to us while we were recording it through the headphones saying, “Yeah, it’s great! Yeah! Boom! Oh yeah!” We all thought it was really funny. He called us into the booth and said, “We’ve got it!” We recut the vocals and added sax. Dave Spinner (from David Bowie’s “Let’s Dance” album) and Darryl Hall sang back-ups.

KZ: What do you like most and least about being a hit act?

TF: The thing I like most about it is making music and playing live. I love what I do. The only thing I don’t like about it is being away from my family so much.

KZ: So with a Top Ten single, “What You Need,” I guess it takes the pressure off things.

TF: We don’t want to just be around overnight or for a little while. INXS is here to stay. ■



ON MANAGEMENT

CATCH SOMEONE IN THE ACT

Get out of your office!!!

Did you ever read the book called *The One Minute Manager*? Management isn't so straightforward and simple that it can be done in a minute, but I want to credit that book with an expression that well illustrates a very powerful message: Effective managers catch their people in the act of doing something right.

When we think about the idea of "catching someone doing something," don't we usually think of catching them doing something wrong? And don't we get the idea that as managers, we better spend our time reviewing their memos, their decisions, their conclusions, the computations, and their behaviors with one thought in mind: Catch them in the act of being wrong. Oh, I'm sure our reasons are very benign. We just want to help, or we just want to make sure that errors don't slip by us.

I'm not denying that it's important to correct people's mistakes, and it's important not to let errors go by. But let me ask you this: How receptive are you to a boss who never notices all the correct and good things you do (which is about 99% of the time) but only notices the things you might screw up on once in a while. Whether your boss attacks you like Attila the Hun or whether he criticizes you "nicely" is not the issue I am addressing. The point is that 99% of the time you're doing your job well, but he never notices that, and he never says anything about that. So how do you feel when you see

him coming down the hall heading straight for you? Do you say to yourself: "Oh, boy, I'm sure he's going to compliment me for something?" Right.

Now you may say: "Why should I notice the good things? That's what people are getting paid for." My answer to that is twofold: One, your question is logical but people's reactions are psycho-logical, which means they want and need those positive strokes. Secondly, I urge you to enter 1986, because the way to motivate people nowadays is not through methods that worked in 1946.

Your people are busting their tails trying to make you look good, and if you don't show them your constant appreciation of it, then why should they continue? The only thing that paycheck is going to do is simply insure they come to work, but if you want them to continue to put out that extra inch you're going to have to catch them doing it and reward them.

As I said, your people are doing so many things most of the time. Let them know it. Tell them individually; tell them in a group. Write them a note. Pencil in appreciative comments as you review their reports. Take them out to dinner. Give them tickets to a great show. Give them gifts. Budget permitting, selectively give bonuses. But don't just do those things. Tell them *why* you're doing those things: for staying late three nights in a row meeting that deadline, for making a new employee feel at home, for being extra sensitive to a tough customer, for getting that good deal with the vendor, for writing that good report, for learning how to use the word processor, for saying something witty or timely on the air, for recalculating those budget figures, for spotting an error and correcting it . . . The list is endless.

But on top of all that, the good managers are always walking around, staying in touch with their employees, noticing whenever they do something right, and complimenting and thanking them. You don't have to make a *big* deal out of thanking someone for staying late, for coming to work eight straight days, for writing a great promo piece, or for helping a co-worker turn out a better product. But *failure* to thank and recognize those behaviors is just poor management.

Catching people doing something right leads to other benefits as well. First, your really good employees don't want to be taken for granted. If you don't notice all the things they do to make you look good, they'll find some other employer who will. Secondly, by noticing the good things and rewarding people for them, you improve the probability that they (and others who learn about it) will continue to do those things. Thirdly, your people will be much more receptive to your criticisms of their work if they know that you're also on top of all the good things they do. Finally, you can give special rewards to really exceptional acts (like taking initiative to solve a chronic problem or to develop a more efficient way of doing something) and thereby raise the level of standards throughout the office.

Won't people get tired of all this praise and recognition? Trust me, they won't. As long as you're sincere, as long as you tell them specifically what the reward is for, they'll be glad you notice and care and they'll know you're not taking them for granted.

Get out of your office, prowl those halls, catch them in the act of doing something right, and pounce on them with a reward. You won't regret it. ■




As you know, the keynote speaker for the first annual Gavin Seminar a few weeks ago—and it was an inspired choice—was CBS TV and radio newsmen Charles Osgood. Although Osgood broadcasts the Sunday night CBS TV network newscast, he unabashedly prefers the radio, where he delivers newscasts on CBS radio and also writes and delivers light or thoughtful pieces, in prose or verse, in his daily network radio "Osgood File" feature.

He wrote a verse about his feelings about our medium, and whether you were there or not, I thought you might like to see it in print. It deals with his habit, at the end of his weekly TV newscast, of signing off "see you on the radio":

See you on the radio.
I say that every week.
A peculiar phrase, some people say,
for anyone to think.
I've got a piece of mail or two
up on my office shelf,
the phrase, they plainly say,
seems to contradict itself.

Dear Mr. Osgood, someone wrote,
that signoff is absurd;
radio is for the ear—
the song or spoken word.
The medium for seeing
is without a doubt TV;
we therefore call it video—
that's Latin for "I see."
So please don't say that anymore,
you really should know better.
(That's a gentle paraphrase of what
was in this viewer's letter.)

Dear Sir, I then wrote back to him,
and this is my reply,
I do believe that you are wrong,
and let me tell you why.
I've worked some years in radio,
and television too;
and though it's paradoxical,
it nonetheless is true
That radio is visual,
much more so than TV.
There's plenty of good reason
why that paradox should be.

You insist that on the radio,
there are no pictures there;
you say it's for the ear—
but I say "au contraire."
There are fascinating pictures
on the radio, you see,
that are far more picturesque
than any on TV.
No television set that's made,
no screen that you can find,
can compare with radio,
the theater of the mind . . .
where the pictures are so vivid,
so spectacular and real,
that there isn't any contest—
at least that's how I feel.
The colors are more colorful,
the reds and greens and blues
are more vivid, yet more subtle,
than televisions use.
The dimensions of the radio
are truly to be treasured:
Infinite—the size of screen,
diagonally measured.
The resolution so acute
TV cannot compare;
we can whisper in the listener's ear
and take him anywhere!

You tell me I cannot see
the audience I touch;
let me tell you now a secret.
My experience is such
that although the room I work in
may be very plain and small,
in a way that's quite miraculous
it isn't small at all.
I'm there, inside the radio,
the one beside the bed,
and that's me you hear when it goes off
—come on now, sleepyhead.


I can see you in the morning,
I can see you coast-to-coast . . .
as you sip your glass of orange juice
and bite into your toast.
I am with you as you brush your teeth,
and as you shave your face;
you may think you are alone,
but I am with you, everyplace!
And I see the lines of traffic

stretching endlessly for miles
not a hundred or a thousand miles,
but a million there must be;
and I'm riding along with them . . .
this is radio, you see.
And I'm on the Jersey Turnpike,
on the thoroughway, on the hutch,
on the Eisenhower Expressway,
helping people keep in touch.
And the California freeways,
and the Houston traffic funnel . . .
I may lose you for a little while
as you go through the tunnel.
Suddenly you're there again,
I'm here to tell,
to nobody's surprise,
because they know me very well.
My voice is with them everyday,
and when it disappears,
they know it comes right back again—
it's been that way for years.

I've been riding with them every day
for such a long long time,
they're willing to put up with me
when I resort to rhyme.
And that may be the ultimate
and quintessential test
that proves beyond the slightest doubt
that radio is best.
For friends will always stick with you
though your poems may not scan;
I'll see you on the radio—
I can, you see, I can!

That was but a small part of Charles
Osgood's talk, and I'll have a bit more
about it next week—in prose this time! ■



"Be Good To Yourself"—Journey (Columbia)

Lots of change with this new JOURNEY single hitting the streets and the airwaves. After his massive solo success, MR. PERRY aggressively took the helm. Hence JOURNEY is now a three person core, augmented by session players RANDY JACKSON and ex-CHERRY BOMB LARRIE LONDIN. "Be Good To Yourself" aptly defends both JRNY's Album Radio and Top Forty turf, no problem.

Virus —Laurie Anderson (Warner Bros.)

One of the true innovators of the airwaves, eyewaves, and brainwaves, LAURIE ANDERSON takes the cerebral, the everyday and the obvious, turning her performances into a most interesting and unique outlook on communication. LAURIE ANDERSON's biggest remaining challenge is to bridge the gap between the experience of her live presentation and appreciating her discs. Perceiving her strictly as a recording artist is like caging the songbird, however this NILE RODGERS production could give radio a viable reference point for her multi-media talents.

No One Is To Blame—Howard Jones (Elektra)

This song was originally written and conceived here in SAN FRANCISCO. It deals with the dilemma of being a married guy in a world of pretty women. Hence the line, "you can look at the menu but you just can't eat". It originally appeared on HOWARD JONES' last LP, but

has gained renewed notoriety since PHIL COLLINS shared space on the vocal track. It's indeed a luxury for an artist to have a song firmly resurrected from the past. This one may eclipse all his past hits.

Cocker—Joe Cocker (Capitol)

Over the years, JOE COCKER has weathered many a storm. His voice is the object of quiet affection many musicians and producers love having the opportunity to mold. On this LP alone, five producers get that chance with five different courses and coarses. COCKER is like the sandpaper display at the hardware store. Depending on what kind of finish the final process requires, ole JOE seems to have the necessary grain to perform. I like SHELTER ME/AtoZ/ and the ribald YOU CAN LEAVE YOUR HAT ON.

Modern Times—Latin Quarter (Arista)

Here's a unique arrangement, much like the early days of ELTON JOHN or PROCOL HARUM. LATIN QUARTER (named after the fashionable art district of Paris) has an arrangement where the band ships music to a lyricist who then adapts the songs to particular topics. "Modern Times" is about Uncle JOE McCARTHY. "No Ordinary" tells the story of soccer game massacres. "Truth About John" decries the exploitation of the late JOHN LENNON. The messages are the heavy aspects of the music, as LATIN QUARTER approaches things subtly and tastefully. This is intriguing music with an ear to the world.

The ROLLING STONES perform a DIRTY WORK assault on the Album Chart as one of the handful of people that debut the first week at Number One. Was BRUCE SPRINGSTEEN the last to pull such a stunt inside these pages? Last week's cover feature, THE FABULOUS THUNDERBIRDS were actually second in "airplay" right after the STONES. They remain underlined at #4 while JACKSON BROWNE and ROBERT PALMER stay ahead on rotation points. The Most Added race was confusing as hell due to some neglect when it comes to conversions. Please remember: GAVIN can accept up to two mentions of a record. One can be an add, and the other mention can be the highest rotation, i.e. an "add" and a "heavy" or an "add" and a "medium". That enables the act to receive add/airplay points or rotation points, which ever is higher. Records added in "light" need only be reported as an "add" since the points for both categories are the same...JOE JACKSON will definitely debut impressively next week. It gave VAN HALEN a run for its money for #2 Most Added. Young JULIAN LENNON technically debuts this week as an LP at #7, surprisingly passing VAN HALEN. Almost all the action is still on the single track "Stick Around", which explains its showing as fourth Most Added. Simply put, most people are viewing it as a twelve inch...PRETTY IN PINK should go Top Ten. It is JULIAN's



opposite, with action on four trax, depending on the demeanor of the station that's booming it.

DAVID BOWIE will change into an album next week, as the entire soundtrack hits the streets. It sounds as hip as the PRETTY IN PINK album as far as content goes. This so-called "wacky new music" has spread to film in a big way. And you thought it would just pass. Aren't you ashamed? There has been a bevy of METAL and HARD ROCK released that has an active core that has yet to be fully felt on especially this chart. I'm referring to records like the new JUDAS PRIEST, UFO, and a big part of the VAN HALEN. There is a strong core rock crowd no doubt heating up your phone lines. Tapping this audience is a touchy and controversial subject, even to mainstream rockin' Album Radio stations. It's a market by market decision, but something to definitely judge on one's own turf.





MODERN ENGLISH, GREEN ON RED, THE FABULOUS THUNDERBIRDS, and HUSKER DU were all caught up in traffic by records just outside the top ten. Watch for these albums to break loose next week.



COUNTRY SUMMARY

Some bigshake-ups in the chart this week. After looking like it had peaked last week, EARL THOMAS CONLEY does an about-face and breaks back into the Top Ten. The GAVIN Country Reviewing Committee's favorite cut off of HANK JR.'s album was "Ain't Misbehavin'", and it looks like it's also a favorite with Country listeners. DAWN GARRISON at KERR-Polson tells us that it's by far her most requested record, and it had some noteworthy jumps at WKAK (25-16); WPOC (19-11); KXKZ (25-8); KYCK (26-12); WCUB (26-17); WDMP (26-16); KIDN (35-23); KYYX (24-14). It looks like "Life's Highway" and "Mama's Never Seen Those Eyes" will both

have easy times reaching the Top Ten. Positive comments are still pouring in on the DWIGHT YOAKAM single. "SPRING BREAK"

SPRING IS TAKING SHAPE

The Spring fashion message is shaping up as spare and simple. Layering returns with a lean, clean perspective. Why we may even see the return of the Nehru jackets for women. Does this mean that music and radio are returning to the '70s look? No, not necessarily, but for those involved with black and urban music and radio there is a chance that the changing face of its music may have a direct effect on the format's ratings future.

Black music in Spring 1986 continues to be a true hybrid of all that is uniquely American. Take the case of the "Godfather" of Soul, James Brown's return to the top of the *pop* charts with "Living In America." From the gospel strains of old Baptist church songs to the jazz melodies of Atlantic Starr, they all set your heart, mind and feet in motion. However, although steeped in history, black music has continued to grow and evolve. New artists have arrived on the hit music fashion scene, shaping the sound of the music we hear today; new faces are occupying executive positions and making decisions that will have far-reaching effects on the music industry; and new ratings methodologies are being implemented by the rating services which are changing the way radio operates. So it becomes more obvious with each passing day that Spring is drawing nearer.

Also taking shape this spring is the continuing trend of black and urban radio's acceptance of new artists, which seems to indicate that black music audiences are welcoming the influx of a whole new generation of artists with open arms, while still enjoying the talents and contributions of veteran performers, often on the same label. This season 22-year-old Whitney Houston joined veteran platinum sister and labelmate Aretha

Franklin at the top of the charts, scoring a double for Arista. These are all encouraging signs for Spring and 1986.

BLACK RADIO AND THE QUARTERLY MEASUREMENT CHALLENGE

As we swing into Spring, the word seems to be out that certain formats are either doomed to failure or assured of success. It seems to me that black/urban radio may be one of the formats that can capitalize on the ever-growing popularity of its music and its artists. Added to this fact, as DST (Differential Survey Treatment) improves and it has, the share of listening obtained by black/urban/hispanic stations will rise. Every Spring there seems to be some slippage on the part of some non-ethically targeted stations. And for those stations with one eye on the actual audience levels, the results may seem somewhat illusory. Others may lose share points because mass-appeal stations like CHRs and ACs continue to do well. All of these stations have added lots of black and urban and crossover music to their spring menus. Color them "light browns" ... or desert sand.

AN EXPLOSION OF COLOR HIGHLIGHTS THE SEASON

Color is the big news of this spring scene as lush and energetic colors ranging from brightened neutrals and pastels to bold primaries, update the classic silhouettes that abound. And exciting new colors aren't just for the teens and sub-teens anymore. Everybody wants to be "hip" and "in!" Why even easy-listening, beautiful music stations have gone through a dramatic shakedown period. They have found that winning means keeping up. There's an awareness that old tricks won't work any longer. Research has shown repeatedly that today's "baby boomers" didn't grow up on cascading strings and instrumental background music. Even the terms "beautiful music" have been replaced by "easy listening" ... MOR or middle-of-the-road has all but disappeared from the format categories. A quick look at some of the artists now being brush-stroked on easy listening stations now includes Al Jarreau, Roberta Flack, Dionne Warwick, Luther Vandross, Lionel Richie and Quincy Jones. What research has also turned up was that there is an ever-growing resentment toward "covers." Cover versions of songs have been a fly in the "hip" musical fashion ointment since the Crew Cuts

covered "Sh-Boom" and Pat Boone covered Fats Domino. What this research also found was that there was a strong resentment when vocal cover versions were played instead of the originals, in order to broaden the base. The color of the artists not only doesn't matter as long as the material is strong, it's actually hip and in now to add some "color" to an otherwise bland format.

PLANT NOW FOR SUMMER BLOOMS

In order to reap what you sow, you've got to *plan before you plant!* Then you have to do all the things that a good radio "gardener" must to grow a great "crop." Winter weary spirits are banished as Spring unfolds hopefully with blossoming big ratings and anticipation of a bountiful Fall harvest. But wait, there's something missing in this mangled metaphor ... the tools of the trade! I mean it's great to talk about victories and winning, but even the most skilled among us must have the right tools. And proper tools must become a priority. In these times of mainstreaming and streamlining, monetary motivation is still a healthy stimulant. And lack of it changes the status and responsibility of programmers and music directors and air-talent. It is true that most programmers are more like businessmen today and more programmers by the year become qualified to be managers. But will programmers forget their old needs because of their new needs? And will management that has not experienced programming close their eyes to current needs?

It takes money to make money. To plant, seed and harvest a good crop takes adequate funding. Programming today must have parity in multimedia advertising. The stimulus to create impulse is the foundation to new cume ... the most important game for black and urban radio. Impressions must be made in every way possible, as *often* as possible. More than ever, winning involves *giving*. Someone once said to a farmer who had a successful crop that he "planted with love and harvested with the spirit of giving." In planting and programming, the tangible benefits of giving may be obvious, yet the intangible benefit will often outweigh them ... and that argues persuasively that the quality of one's *giving* — more than most of us realize, or would be willing to admit — affects the quality of one's *living* ... no matter what the season. Our character, ratings and garden all reflect the amount of weeding that was done during the growing season. Color it groovy. ■

Wisely, Boy George and Company have moved back to the sound that made them international superstars. Threads of the Motown fabric (especially Smokey) has become a staple of Culture Club, and on this gigantic British hit they maximize it to the fullest.

THE BLOW MONKEYS - Digging Your Scene (RCA)

If you're like me, you're saying to yourself... The Blow Monkeys? Don't let the name scare you off. This is a true breath of musical fresh air, slick, hip, and totally adult. Hearing records like this is the payoff for those whose job it is to listen to new product. Something this unique and commercial must not go unheard.

JOURNEY - Be Good To Yourself (Columbia)

Programmers and fans have been getting restless waiting for this release. Journey's new configuration, Perry, Cain and Schon let loose and do some serious rockin'. The entire project has been geared to radio with no video backup. Manager Herbie Herbert aptly described it as "R.O.R.... a radio oriented record"...and he's right.

HOWARD JONES - No One Is To Blame (Elektra)

One of music's finest young talents has truly come into his own as a writer and performer. Backed by Phil Collins, who also gets producer credit with partner Hugh Padgham, this spectacular effort is sure to drive the women wild.

ERASURE - Who Needs Love Like That (Sire/W.B.)

New band formed by Vince Clarke, one of the original members of Depeche Mode and the guy who also created Yaz with Alison Moyet. Alternative stations in some markets played it as an import and it caused a big buzz. Catchy enough to recommend it for pop play.

BOBBY BARTH - Don't Come To Me (Atco)

Somebody should tell the producers of "Miami Vice" about this song. Draws mental pictures that fit the slick pastels of the show. Lots of sax highlights the sensuality of this tune.

Rolling Stones "Dirty Work" (Rolling Stones/Col.)

When there's dirty work to be done, these blokes are usually first to volunteer. Somebody's gotta do it! The twins of glimmer aren't afraid to bring in ringers like producer Steve Lillywhite and guest vocalists Jimmy Cliff and Tom Waits. The resulting textures are raw, urban, crusty and angry. The drift is helter/skelter. The attitude is pyromaniacal, yet they don't burn any bridges. The boys arrive at 51 W.52nd St. via side streets, the rock 'n' roll alleys where we hear the musical equivalent of the business end of a switchblade. The words are tough, but for the most part within the guidelines of the Prudent Musical Revolution Committee. But unless you want Tipper Gore in your lobby, I'd avoid HAD IT WITH YOU at all cost. On the brighter side, ONE HIT TO THE BODY is about being knocked out by love. HARLEM SHUFFLE is a perfect soulful strut song and it gets Jagged to the max.

Joe Jackson "Big World" (A&M)

A continental kinda guy. Joe's taken up the role of tour guide, as he walks us through three sides of two-track cool pop. Jackson did this live in New York in the presence of a live, but hushed audience. The intention was to capture the tension of real time without the audio interference of yahoo's and the like. Side one shakes. Side two has a simpler, smokey blues feel. Side three may be the best side for lyric. Side four opens with a recording of a Lybian radar tracking station, followed by Tipper Gore's favorite sounds, followed by Oscar's tribute to Steven Spielberg and The Color Purple. But seriously folks...check out HOMETOWN, WILD WEST, RIGHT OR WRONG and SHANGHAI SKY as a representative sample of Joe Jackson's state of the art. Now Joe...About this video idea I've got...
