

As Sound Warehouse and Western Merchandisers ponder their options after being charged by the Dallas D.A.'s office with selling obscene materials, virtually every major retail chain is reeling from the implications of this clever new right-wing strategy. Dave Roy of Transworld reflected the frustrations of a lot of his fellow execs when he complained to HITS: "Maybe it's time this thing gets brought to a head—these little district attorneys are trying to make names for themselves. So maybe if it goes to the Supreme Court, it will force a decision and they'll shut these little guys down.

"I'm glad 2 Live Crew got picked up by Atlantic," Roy continued. "Now they have some muscle behind them."

Meanwhile, mum's still the word at Sound Warehouse, where "No comment" has become as pervasive as "yes" and "no." We have learned, however, that the chain has pulled "As Nasty As They Continued on page 14


Brodey's A Giant Livin' Large

Brodey added: "It's new, it's exciting, it's Irving!! (Ed. note: Where can we get one?) It's also the easiest decision I can remember ever making, except for the time I didn't take a phone call from Lenny

Beer. I'm also thrilled to be working with my old friends at WEA and Warner Bros. again. There is no doubt in my mind that Giant Records will prove to be uniquely prepared to meet head on — and ears on — the challenges that are certain to confront our industry in the '90s. Label Coalition Formed

Rock The Vote is the official name of the anti-censorship music industry coalition formed by Virgin Co-Managing Directors Jeff Ayeroff and Jordan Harris.

The organization, which is headquartered in Virgin's Beverly Hills offices, will have a small full-time staff and be jointly headed by Ayeroff's assistant, Beverly Lund, and political expert Jody Uttall (the wife of WB exec Jeff Gold).

Rock The Vote's primary focus will be to make use of the industry's sophisticated methods of reaching young people to sell them on the importance of their votes in turning the rising tide of right-wing fanaticism.

"The RIAA has been doing a very good job of working Washington, D.C.," Ayeroff commented, "but without the acknowledgment that what was going on was a sort of Abbott & Costello routine —

'Slowly I turned, step by step...' They're coming after us and cutting off a little piece at a time — they just clip a little off, clip a little off, clip a little more off. It's like a bad circumcision. And that's what's happening now.

"The image of a black man in the South being arrested by a policeman, being put in handcuffs for selling a record in 1990 — to me, that was obscene. And then, two days later, this Times-Mirror survey comes out that says that 62% of non-voters in the June primary were under 40. It's a joke. Politicians don't address kids, because they know kids don't vote."

According to Ayeroff, the two big issues of 1990 are fundamentally connected. "The environment is not just the air we breathe," he said, "it's the nature of the place in which we breathe that air. There's a lot that stinks in this country besides the ozone layer."

RANTING AND RAVING



Where Have All The DJ's Gone? As recently as ten or 15 years ago, American radio could boast of dozens, if not hundreds, of "name" radio personalities who were admired, looked up to, and who served as role models for young DJs on the way up. Today it seems like we have about five or six.

There's been a lot of complaining lately about the slim availability of qualified talent at all levels of the business. I've come to believe that this is due to a severe lack of training, along with a lack of qualified coaches to nurture the talent. It astounds, amazes and infuriates me to see the majority of jocks who make it as far as key Top Ten market gigs who've never been coached on the fundamentals.

Here are a few basics that every DJ can study and work on — every day of their lives. If you're a GM, make sure your PD knows this stuff and how to teach it. If you're a PD, you had better be able to teach and coach it. And if you're a jock, this is your life — know it and live it!

Preparation: You simply can't do your best work if you're not thoroughly prepared. You should be doing some sort of show-prep virtually 24 hours a day, as well as concentrated sessions before each shift. If you're not, you're getting beat by someone who is. Prepare — you can't beat it.

Confidence: One of the biggest mistakes I see DJs make is in their mental attitude — they're afraid to "fuck up." You can't do your best work if you are coming from a defensive posture! If you're afraid to make mistakes, I guarantee you that you will. If, however, you're prepared, and if you know in your heart that you're gonna

sound great when you open that mic, the worst you can possibly sound is real good. Being a DJ is 99% mental, and self-confidence will get you over the biggest hump.


Concentration: There's a reason your PD doesn't want you hangin' on the request line asking the groupies what they're wearing - it breaks your concentration! You need to be singularly focused on your show every second of your shift. That's what you're being paid to do! Personal calls, superfluous people in the studio, reading material, etc., all rob you of focus and concentration. Do whatever it takes to hone your concentration - Howard Stern meditates before each show, Shadow Steele dead-bolts the studio door. Bottom line, you can call your girlfriend after the shift. While you're working, think about work!

Execution: If you're prepared, confident and focused, then it's all a matter of simple execution. KNOW you're going to do when you open the mic, KNOW that it's gonna be good, CON-CENTRATE on it, and then (as Tom Peters and Nike succinctly put it), JUST DO IT! You can't execute well on a regular basis, though, if the first three building blocks aren't firmly in place. Being a DJ is a craft and an art. Work at your craft every day the art will follow.





# MARIAH CAREY'S ON

Looks can be deceiving. Classically trained by her vocal-coach mother, 20-year-old Mariah Carey has a rare seven-octave range (remember Minnie Riperton?) with a bottom end that can rattle your walls and a high end that can wake the dead. Two years ago, she was on the road singing back-up for Brenda K. Starr. Now she has her own debut LP and rising hit single in "Vision of Love," featuring a stellar production team (including Rhett Lawrence, Narada Michael Walden, Ric Wake, Chris Toland and la Carey herself) and an even more blinding array of guest performers (among them Vernon Reid, Nile Rodgers, Marcus Miller and Omar Hakim). But even with all that talent behind her, it's Carey's astonishingly versatile voice that's the star of the show. HITS' own multi-octave scream Perry Stern wheedled his way into the lady's presence for a few brief moments before being recognized as the pervert he is and thrown out the back door.

The last time we spoke you were taking a bath.

Yeah, well, you weren't supposed to know that.

#### The running water was the first hint.

[Laughing] I write in the tub and I read in the tub, so I figured I could do an interview there as well. I find it really relaxing. I was on the road doing a promotional tour. I went to nine or ten cities and performed with the legendary Richard Tee on piano and two background singers, no band. The routing was insane. We'd go from the West Coast to the East Coast to Minneapolis. All the climate changes were so intense and it sort of caught up with me. But I'm OK now.

#### What was it like doing Arsenio Hali's show?

I was really nervous. It hasn't been, like, "Wow! Everyone knows who I am now!" I went back to my hotel room and watched it by myself. In New York, some kids that I went to high school with were back from college and had a party to watch it, so that made me feel pretty good. The next day I flew to Detroit and sang "America The Beautiful" at the NBA finals and some 16 million people saw that. I wasn't nervous for that because I'd gotten through Arsenio. You're doing well in the pop

# and the black charts. Who do you see as your main audience?

Well, I'm mixed with a lot of different backgrounds, so I feel I'm accessible to both blacks and whites.

Is your father or mother



black? My father. For some reason i thought your father was Irish.

He's got a little bit of everything. He's part Spanish and West Indian and Indian. My mom's all Irish. My parents were divorced when I was three and I grew up with my mother. She was the major influence in my life.

How do you feel about seeing your records do well

#### on the black charts?

I think it's great seeing my music on any chart. It really makes me feel good to see my songs on the black charts because I'm really influenced by R&B music.

Do you think people who have only heard you are surprised when they see what you look like?

Well, sometimes. I did a song on my record called "You Need Me" and Vernon Reid from Living Colour played a solo on it. I walked into the studio after he'd been there playing it for a while. When I was introduced to him, he went, "You're Mariah!? You've got one of those big fat girl voices but you're a skinny girl!" That was kinda cute.

"I write in the tub and I read in the tub, so I figured I could do an interview there as well."

Did using a variety of producers help create the variety in the material?

I co-wrote all the songs and the first four — "Prisoner,"
"Someday," "Alone In Love" and "All In Your Mind" — were on that first demo, and they're pretty different from each other.

When was the last time you had a chance to write a song?

I wrote a song called "Love Takes Time" after the album had already been completed. I wrote it with Ben Margulies, my songwriting partner and we just threw it down on tape thinking it would be for my second album. I played it for Don Ienner, Tommy Mottola and Bobby Colomby after one of my shows and they all flipped out and said, "This is a #1 record — we've got to stop and put it on this album!" So they did. *

# ALITTLE BRIT

This 23-year-old sensation, who evokes classic soul crooners like Tammi Terrel and early Diana Ross, comes from Rochdale, an area north of London, where she says "the people are a lot more emotional because of the unemployment." Her stunning debut album, "Affection," sold more than 2 million copies worldwide within its first few weeks of release, pegged to the chart-topping single, "All Around The World." In person at Le Dome for the requisite record company power lunch, Lisa Stansfield's a real charmer, sort of a cross between Thompson Twin Alannah Currie and Tracey Ullman, with a bobbed nose and a distinctive beauty mark on her left cheek, but HITS' Roy Trakin was too busy scarfing Maryland crab cakes to notice or care.

#### How did you get that distinctive vocal style?

When I started singing, I was just this little parrot at first. All these hundreds of voices went inside, got mixed up and what came out was me. I've always wanted to be a singer. I've been singing since I was four years old. I made up my mind I wanted to do it professionally when I was 10 or 11.

# How do you explain the affinity the British have for American R&B?

The northern people are just so passionate. There's a lot of unemployment and not much money and, after all, soul music is passionate music.

The British tend to add a synthetic, modernistic layer to the music.

I think it's nice the way you can mix the two together, something really human with something technological. It makes it sound more convincing.

Can you believe how quickly this record has happened for you?

It's like an explosion, really.

Totally weird. Totally unreal. We've taken American music, put some of our personality into it, and sold it back to you. [Ed. note: So what else is new?]

Do you believe a white person singing black music, and vice versa, can be a means of bringing the races closer together?

I'd like to think so, but you'll always get people who'll say, why do black magazines cover white artists, or why does black radio play white artists? Or, she shouldn't be making black music. But that's their problem. Don't listen to the music if you don't like it. I mean, I am what I am. I don't mind what people say, really. They can badmouth you, but, at the end of the day, if you know it's all right, it doesn't really matter, does it? Personally, I'm a singer, y'know? And a songwriter. And I enjoy all the perks. So I'll take the flack, too.

What was the studio process like? Did you do a great many overdubs?

Most of the tracks were recorded in one or two takes... after a few drinks. They're quite spontaneous. If we tried to be too perfect, it wouldn't have worked, I don't think. You can't chop it up. It's organic

# AN IDAHO POTATO IN THE BIG APPLE

Have the music trends in N.Y.C. changed since you came to HOT 97?

In this format, music trends are constantly changing. It's always evolving. I wouldn't go so far as to say it's altered the sound of our station dramatically. We've experimented with different kinds of music within the dance genre. At certain times, we'll sound a bit more black-based, maybe heavier on the club stuff. It just depends on what's out there at any given time.

How do you see the market trend at the present time? I see a definite shift toward the acceptance of club records on our station. Snap, Black Box and Stevie V. are good examples of artists with tracks that have clearly come from the underground and are now mainstream hits at this station.

Do you think rap, house and world beat will be integral parts of Top 40 in the '90s?

I think they already are. You have a great many Top 40 programmers looking at this music from a totally different perspective, wondering exactly how to treat it. Our experience here has been, the sooner we get on these records and stay on top of them, the better off we'll be. We've tried to cover our bases by making sure the station plays those records. I truly believe the underground street stuff will eventually get on massappeal radio everywhere.

This music is here for the long haul. Compare the disco crash of the late '70s with the dance music that's currently prevailing. There are so many variations now — hip-hop, house, world beat — and the artists aren't limited like the Casablanca roster that basically comprised that era.

Idaho native Kevin McCabe studied broadcasting while attending school in Rockville, Maryland. His first radio gig was at WAVA when it was an album-rocker, manning the phones and doing research. He left to work at country outlets WVBK-AM and WPKX-FM in the D.C. area, then segued to WLND and WCXR. He was MD at Q107, also in Washington, D.C., for four months when the powers-that-be at Emmis asked him to work at HOT 97, which he's helped turn into New York City's most street-savvy Top 40.

How much time do you spend in the clubs and local stores looking for new records?

Not as much as I'd like because I have so much to do here in the office. I have to handle all the record company calls, balance music logs and attend meetings, which prevents me from being as active in the clubs and on the street as I'd like to be. I make it a point to get out during the week if there are special events. I'm al-

ways in the clubs on weekends. The best source for this kind of thing is not necessarily doing it yourself, but surrounding yourself with a group of people who can help you out. We have the best club jocks in America here. There are also a great many people who work in the stores as well as at the labels who are right on top of things. Those contacts help keep us on the cutting edge every week. What's currently the ratio of

major label to street and indie product on HOT 97?

I'd say about 40% of our 65 currents are from labels other than the majors. Approximately 40% of our music is totally exclusive in the market. We like to pave the way for the other stations in town to follow suit. Records can be played here without support from any other station in New York and we can break them wide open. How long after you start playing a record frequently is the effect felt at retail?

Anywhere from one to three weeks. I've seen records explode

off this radio station the weekend we add them. It can be as quick as that, but of course, sometimes it isn't. Black Box is one of those records that was added to the other Top 40s in town after we had been on it for quite some time because of the sales impact. What's the biggest difference between Emmis and CapCities? The most obvious difference is probably the role the two companies take in supporting their stations in the trenches. This station is one of the most active in New York in terms of promotions because Emmis allots the needed funds to make HOT 97 visible in the market. That's something they've founded their success on. This company is still a very young and active company, with people working for it that really love radio. Despite the talk that bankers have ruined radio, it's not true here. These are broadcasting professionals. And the company, as a whole, is always looking to expand. Just look at their acquisition of the Seattle Mariners. The

bottom line, though, is, at Emmis,

The action isn't limited to one area. One look at the lists of WEDR, WOWI, WZAK, WJHM, KMJQ, KMJM, and WHRK proves it.

W.T.G. seems to be going all out on this one, and prez Jerry Greenberg calls her "one of the most versatile, gifted young singers I've worked with since my days at Atlantic." (Ed. Note: original one Jer, but you forgot the word "special," or maybe you could have used "visionary.") This, coupled with the golden touch of Teddy, should make this one a done deal.

Once upon a time, a young girl worked very, very hard, every day, at perfecting her singing. Meanwhile, below the surface, hormones coursing through her body were turning her into a beeaauuteeefull woman. One day, without her knowledge, a demo tape made its way to the President of RCA Records, Bob Buziak, who signed her for a dance single but, after meeting our heroine in the flesh, decided a full-blown album was the way to go. "I believe she's a potential bust-through artist," said Bob, tugging on his double-breasted suit. "And we intend to milk this all the way." Stevie Wonder - whom she's known since she was a young girl because her father worked for him - jumped in to help, producing two tracks. In this way, boys and girls, Tyler Collins - a talented, sexy and genuine singer - came to make "Girls Nite Out," a wonderful album which is not only steaming up the charts, but also the glasses of our poor drooling HITS' correspondent, one H. (for Hee-Haw) Lee David.

#### Exactly how are you related to Phil Collins?

Phil Collins is my illegitimate father. He had a torrid affair in Rio de Janeiro 22 years ago and I'm the result of that.

#### Will you be suing him for support?

Yes I will. I definitely want some of his money.

#### What sorts of things would you and your girlfriend do on a typical "Girls Nite Out"?

The truth or the magazine version? The slutty HITS version, please. We would start out by blasting music and drinking wine.

#### Ripple? Thunderbird?

A little better, like Boone's Farm.

#### What was your favorite Boone's Farm flavor?

Raspberry, no? Actually strawberry. I'm a strawberry wine kind of girl. So we'd start off the evening blasting music, drinking and acting silly, putting make-up on each other.

#### Girls touching each other and putting on make-up? (Ed. note: Pant pant.).

Yes, basically. Nude young women drinking wine and touching each other. Then we'd take forever to find something to wear. Mix and match outfits. Then we'd get ready and feel cute and go to where we were going — to a party to wreak havoc, break hearts and tease men. We'd dance too.

#### as Stevie one day?

It's a drag right now, to be honest, because it's very lonely at this stage of the game. It's just me and my manager. I do the shows by myself because I don't have a band vet and I can't really afford one. Once I get on stage, I'm fine. I like the audience and I love to perform. But everything before that and after that is hard for me. I'm not a party animal - I won't go and hang out at a club or a bar afterwards, so I spend a lot of time in the hotel room and I get stir-crazy.

#### What do you do to pass the time?

Until recently, I watched a lot of TV, ordered a lot of food and got fat. I realized I couldn't do that anymore so my new thing now is to write. The musicians I work with give me tracks, which I take on the road and write to. I force myself to work out now in the room, which is something I didn't do before.

#### What's the sexiest thing about you?

Someone once said one of the most appealing things about me is the childlike quality of my personality. I don't go out of my way to be a sexy diva, so I thought that was neat. I'm trying to put off being an adult as long as possible. Does being attractive cause you problems in the record in-

dustry, like when you visit those

#### slimeballs up at HITS? "Phil Collins is my illegitimate father."

#### Do you have hearts on your bedpost the way bomber pilots show kills? (Ed. note: Wboa there, big guy!).

Yes I do. We'd collect the men. bring them back home and string 'em up. So I have a little chain of hearts. Then we'd usually go to some trashy food place and scarf majorly.

#### Your father worked for Stevie Wonder, How much contact did you have with him?

A lot, off and on. I would go to the studio sometimes with my father or on the road every now and then. That was the biggest kick for me. So I'd see Stevie Wonder in spurts. But then as I got older, my father kept me out of it.

Would you like to be as famous

#### How do other women treat you? I'm shy naturally, so it's not very

easy for me to talk to people and make friends. I was concerned that women may take that as being stuck-up and conceited. Usually, other women are very friendly and find me very approachable, so I haven't really had problems. There have been a couple of moments with women which have been kind of meow! But for the most part, everyone's been real receptive and accepting.





Neville Brothers, "Brother's Keeper" (A&M): With "Yellow Moon," the Neville Brothers earned recognition and accolades from every facet of the music community. "Brother's Keeper" is an even stronger record, with its unmistakeable New Orleans sinuous, sensual groove. The melding of Art, Charles,

Cyril, and Aaron's voices, coupled with their indivual musical gifts, attests that they are inspired by a force found in the greatest gospel music. The angels have showered us with an album that will be deemed a classic in years to come.

Heart Throbs, "Cleopatra Grip" (Elektra): After creating a furor on the British independent charts, the Heart Throbs have finally released their stateside debut. Fronted by sisters Rose and Rachel Carlotti, the Heart Throbs' lyrics reflect their intelligence and varied interests, which would seem to



contradict their seemingly accessible music. Listen closer there's a wall of white noise underneath. Listen to this with tongue planted firmly in cheek, especially "Dreaming," and "White Laughter."



Real Life, "Lifetime" (Long Run/Curb):Real Life, the Australian band who swept the PoMo airwaves with "Send Me An Angel," is back with "Lifetime," a percolating collection of songs for body and mind. "God Tonight," the first single, is already receiving massive airplay on PoMo

radio, and deservedly so. The band and producer Steve Hillage have crafted an album, drawing on influences from Ultravox to New Order, with other great songs such as: "Kiss The Ground," and "Push of Love. Play these. Thank you.

Various, "Pump Up The Volume, OST" (MCA): With a movie destined to be embraced by the college market, the corresponding soundtrack is designed for the PoMo audience. Everything on this record has either been recorded specifically for this project, or taken from an obscure b-side. Concrete Blon-



de's rendition of Leonard Cohen's "Everybody Knows" is breathtaking. Henry Rollins with the Bad Brains kick the living daylights out of the MC5's "Kick Out The Jams." Also brilliant are contributions from the Pixies, Soundgarden, and "Chagall Guevara."




### THE HORIZON

One of the most impressive rock albums of the season, Burning Tree's Epic debut, has finally hit the stores. Highlighted by the masterful guitar work of Marc Ford, this trio plays classic rock in the very best sense.... Speaking of classic rock, Jim Steinman, once the musical meat in Meatloaf is back and working under the band name Pandora's Box. Steinman's new project "The Original Sin," is full of his customary stylized drama and pomp, but he does it so well. It may seem too grand for U.S. radio, which is in dire need of a few such gestures. The track "It's All Coming Back To Me Now," with assistance from Todd Rundgren, is already a hit in the U.K., where they still understand grandeur on the radio. The album, on Virgin in the U.K., is still awaiting assignment here, although Epic may do it now that Richard Griffiths has moved over .... Seeing good bands for the first time is always a thrill; here are five worth catching; (1) Irish singer Brian Kennedy, opening for Suzanne Vega, displayed a compelling vocal and song style that earned him an encore; check out the single, "Captured" from his RCA debut, "The Great War of Words." (2) The Jody Grind proved live what they suggest on record - that they're stylish, full of promise and have a great singer in Kelly Hogan Murray. (3) The Blue Aeroplanes exceeded their record "Swagger," good tho' it is, while opening for the Church and on a sensational live set for Deirdre O'Donaghue's "S.N.A.P." show on KCRW. (4) Consolidated treated us to a serious slice of interactive agitprop punk-rap that was frequently riveting, articulate and aggressive, as is "Dysfunctional" and "This Is A Collective" on the group's Nettwerk/I.R.S. album. (5) Mancunian mayhem descended as Happy Mondays somehow transformed the Palladium into an ersatz Hacienda Club. The crowd was, needless to say, ecstatic.... Another multitalented Irishman, Andy White, an exquisite singer/songwriter, has an excellent new album, "Himself," on Cooking Vinyl and is opening for Hothouse Flowers. He did a set with John Wesley Harding at NMS .... A lot of people are also perking up their ears at the new Yo La Tengo album, "Fakebook," on Restless .... Adrian Sherwood posse member Gary Clail's On-U Sound LP, "End of the Century Party," features all the fearsome Tackhead members plus Keith Levene and Jah Wobble, among others, and sports lyrics to the left of k.d. lang: "Beef, how low can you go? Hear the cattle call. Death Row." A serious dance hit .... Human Drama have a cool new 12" single out on Triple X: "This Tangled Web" is an original from bandleader Johnny Indovina, and the flipside is a great take on Marianne Faithfull's "Times Square."... Also from XXX comes the Liquid Jesus live album, under the Koosh logo, indicating why this L.A. five-piece is one of the hottest rock prospects in the country right now. Expect a major label release before long.... And L.A.'s Christine in the Attic have a very impressive CD, available independently, and are getting radio adds for the smart Ken Scott production.... South African rhythm rockers the Kalahari Surfers may have the dance hit of the summer with "Bigger Than Jesus," a very smart politicized collage of Beatle phrases, particularly Lennon's, over a serious backbeat.... Women to watch: Sophie Hawkins, coming to Columbia; Amanda Kramer courted by Atlantic; and Kelly Willis with her pop-styled country album, "Well Travelled Love," out on MCA.

The band includes co-producer Eric Calvi. bassist Paul Powell, drummer Frank Tontoh and keyboardist Gary Sanctuary. but don't memorize their names, because Roddy'll probably have a whole new outfit next time.

"The Crying Scene" is a spirited pop-rock gem with a guitar solo that kicks and a chorus to die for. In a better world, it might be on every Top 40 station in the land.



While the label heads were swarming around Chris Whitley in New York last week, several A&* department heads were attempting to breach the security barricade outside Hollywood's China Club in order to check out Everything, with varying degrees of success. Examples: Charisma's Jeff Fenster, in from N.Y., battled furiously before being allowed to enter the packed club after flashing his business card: Interscope's Tom Whalley, whose company has no logo as yet, hence no business cards, knew he didn't have a prayer and split; MCA's Paul Atkinson, who must know the secret password, was immediately whisked through — now that was impressive. The fact that these VIPs

were willing to suffer the indignities of the club's infamous doormen attested to the degree of interest in this young but intriguing band, which combines the neo-soul of the Style Council with an element that's distinctly So-Cal. A bunch of the 15 or 20 A&R reps who made it inside were visibly going for Everything's sometimes ragged but fully engaging set. Singer/guitarist Cameron De Palma (yup, he's director Brian's nephew) doubled on sax, and turned in what hadda be the first kazoo solo in China Club history. (He tos-

sed it into the crowd at the end of the song: MCA's Kevin Coogan grabbed it.) After observing the set, Pro-Jam band leader Jim Ehinger incisively described Everything as "greater than the sum of its parts" — and they have a killer tune in "Top Of My Head." Manager Russell Pope affirms that he's been contacted by a number of labels, three or four of which are "extremely" interested.... Everything was followed by the rapidly maturing School of Fish, one of whose guitarists left a pointed nonverbal statement about the club in the backstage hallway before the band's encore. A bouncer who'd spotted him in the act made warlike gestures in front of the player when the Fish returned to the stage, and other bouncers were looming in the shadows. After he finished a screaming solo, the Schoolboy leaned his feedback-spewing guitar against the wall, sprinted across the stage, down the hall and out the back door, where he waved at a female passing in her car. The car door opened, he jumped in and they sped off into the night. It was the stuff rock legends are made of.... RCA's John Axelrod, who came to the show all decked out in his new Harvard Hillbilly getup (nice chin whiskers), has found a publisher for an essay he wrote on the rebirth of the blues — Fast Forward. Congrats. John sorry we couldn't use it.... Turns out I was one for two on those Enigma roster cuts. According to honcho Bill Hein, the label has re-signed Bardeux.... Former A&R rep DeeJay DeLorenzo. who may join Chameleon's promo dept., has started a Rock Bottom club to go with her indie label of the same name.... Charisma's Danny Goodwin, whose foot injury was more severe than we first realized, will be working at home for the next few weeks. And yes, he's already had his Harley fixed.

Enigma's energetic VP of Sales Jane Simon began her music business career in 1970 at what is now B96 in Chicago as a secretary for the news and program directors. She soon jumped ship to become news director at a small 10-watt station, which she thought was her opportunity "to be the Barbara Walters of the '80s." After budget cuts, Jane was back at BBN (B96), then headed for L.A. to do TV casting for CBS. She returned to Chicago once again a year later, working as a disc jockey for a suburban radio station. Her label life began with A&M in 1976 in Chicago. Two years later, A&M moved her back to L.A., where she eventually became West Coast Regional Sales Manager. Last month, she celebrated her first anniversary at Enigma. One of the few women in a male-dominated field, Simon took on HITS' own square peg in a round hole, Joe "Quack" Medwick.

#### Enigma is a label that started small but is on the way to becoming a major. What's that process like?

We have made an enormous amount of progress in the last year, starting with the development of field promotion, sales and marketing staffs, which Enigma never had before.

#### What's next?

We have to really tighten up all the various departments — publicity, marketing services, sales and promotion — to help execute and implement the vision that we have for our acts. We're going to add five more promotion people in the near future, so we need to get our internal systems together.

#### Enigma is an extremely streetoriented label. How do you manage to keep that up?

It has to do with the nature of the people that have worked here. There's a new culture developing at

Enigma — a sense of what's been great about the label in the past combined with the input of the new people that have been brought in. We've managed to merge the two together without losing sight of the street orientation the label was built on. I've brought in a Director of Alternative Retail Marketing, who focuses on those retail stores which feel immediate impact of sales not necessarily based on radio or video or touring, but on the music and the kind of customers they have. I'm also looking for someone to focus on hard rock and metal retail marketing, because that's another one of our strengths. We have some mainstream acts too, but our street-oriented label identity is based on our strength in the alternative and metal areas. We'll try to maintain that by working within CEMA's new structure and its branch marketing reps. You are one of the very few

### women to hold a VP of Sales position. Does it affect the way you do your job?

I don't perceive it to be a problem. I just try to do the best I can and hope that it works. Perhaps other people in the industry perceive it to be more of a problem than I do. I don't dwell on it, though. I'm proud

#### How do you go about breaking alternative bands at retail?



### RERAP

In a summer that hasn't exactly sizzled sales-wise up to now, soundtracks are showing some significant growth signs, and not just due to monsters like EMI's "Pretty Woman" or packages like "Ford Fairlane" and "Days Of Thunder." Also doing well at retail are specialized soundtrack labels like MCA-distributed Varese Sarabande. According to Joel Hoffner of MCA. Varese, which releases film music exclusively, has had "very nice" recent success with "Driving Miss Daisy," "Dead Poets" Society." "Back To The Future II," RoboCop II," "Gremlins II." "Total Recall." "Die Harder" and the label's latest releases, "Ghost" and the John Williams-scored "Presumed Innocent." More than one account is noticing a shift in the type of consumer who's buying this music. At Tower Records Columbus & Bay in San Francisco, Manager Bob Olsen explains: "Just as mainstream rock buyers are experimenting with international music, people are changing their habits. We're seeing new age, classical and jazz customers buying more soundtracks — basically because they need to listen to something different." Olsen, who reports that soundtrack



sales at his location are "5% of our business and growing,' cites Harry Connick Jr. as a prime example of an artist "launched by soundtrack success." At Wherehouse. Buyer Bob Bell explains that "How well the movie does at the box office is always a factor. 'Total Recall, for example, will sell so many units whether the music is exceptional or not." Bell also describes what he terms a "Somewhere In Time" syndrome: "People want to recapture the feeling of the movie; 'Ghost' is a perfect example of this kind of romantic fantasy experience." The sudden success of "Ghost" has caught some accounts offguard. At Tower Records 4th & Broadway N.Y. location. Soundtrack Buyer Mark Schwind admits that "We made a big mistake on 'Ghost' - it sold out much faster then we expected." Schwind, who also reports sales success with soundtracks from "Cinema Paradiso" and "The Cook, The Thief His Wife And Her Lover," as well as "anything by John Williams or Ennio Morricone," reserves the highest praise for the year's most talked-about TV program, "Twin Peaks": "We get at least 20 people a day asking for it. I expect it to be in our store's top 20 when it comes out, no problem."... Retailers are also predicting big things from PolyGram's Jon Bon Jovibuilt "Young Guns II" and Prince's "Graffiti Bridge" (although it's a stretch to describe either as a soundtrack), as well as music from Spike Lee's "Mo' Better Blues," which features Branford Marsalis and John Coltrane. An upcoming dark horse is Island's soundtrack for Dennis Hopper's "Hotspot," which teams such players as Miles Davis, Taj Mahal, Earl Palmer, Roy Rogers and John Lee Hooker.
