





Crowes Won't Fly With ZZ

In the middle of a threenight stand in their hometown of Atlanta, **Def American**'s **Black Crowes** were tossed off the **ZZ Top** tour by **ZZ**'s management, **Lone Wolf**.


According to a statement from the management firm, "Lone Wolf Productions has determined that the Black Crowes are no longer an appropriate opening attraction for the ZZ Top 'Recycler' world tour. As a result, the group has been asked to leave the tour, effective immediately. The decision to go in another direction for an opener was based upon philosophical differences between the two bands."

Chris Robinson of the Crowes told a live radio audience on "Rockline" that the band was dropped because of on-stage comments about corporate sponsorship.

The ZZ Top tour is sponsored by Miller.

A subsequent release from the Crowes stated: "Problems began to develop a few weeks ago when ZZ Top's management told Chris Robinson to stop making references in his on stage dialogue to corporate sponsorship."

The recent proliferation of new labels had some industry skeptics wondering if there was enough room on the charts for all these upstarts. This week, three new kids — Interscope, Giant and Charisma — are serving notice they're real contenders.

Charisma cracks the Top Ten of the HITS Top 50 Albums chart for the first time with the skyrocketing Enigma. "MCMXC a.D." has already passed 560,000 units and moves 11-9 on the chart behind the smash Top Five single, "Sadeness."

Meanwhile, Giant scores its first #1 single with **Tara Kemp**, and is riding the "New Jack City" rocket as the soundtrack jumps to #19 on the Top 50 Albums chart. That project is closing in on **405,000** while still in its infancy. According to new Giant giant **Charlie Minor**: "See, they should a hired me earlier."

Final new kid at the top is Interscope, whose Gerardo has Rico Suaved his way into the Top Ten of the HITS Top 50 Singles chart and has pushed the album "Mo' Ritmo" past the 300,000 mark.

The Most Added singles of the week at Top 40 radio are #1 Mariah Carey (Columbia), #2 INXS (Atlantic), #3 Styx (A&M), #4 Sheena Easton (MCA) and #5 Celine Dion (Epic). Last week's Wildcard, Extreme (A&M) continues to perform incredibly well, while REM (WB) is spreading quickly behind their #1 album.

WILD CARD QUEENSRYCHE (EMI)

Credit the folks at MTV for the hammer on this ballad that is selling the hell out of the album and igniting the phones at Top 40s. It's dominating the secondaries with moves like 20-10 KATM, 19-15 93Q, 19-14 WCIL, 20-10 WNYP, 16-12 Z99, 23-17 KNIN and 11-7 WSKZ. It's breaking in the Northwest majors and spreading now to the Midwest biggies. All will fall on this future Classic Rock staple. Take it home, Jack!

Quick Minor Miracle At Giant

In a move that had as much element of surprise as a Billboard record review, Giant Records officially named Charlie Minor to the post of President. The announcement was made by Giant owner Irving Azoff who claimed that Minor was a "Rock and Roll Picasso" who has "the warmth, sensitivity and deep down human decency of Allen Grubman."

Minor was most recently Senior VP of Promotion at A&M, the place, second only to Le Dome, where he spent most of the last two decades. Besides being honored with numerous awards, Minor has the unique distinction of being the record executive, living or dead, to say "Hey Bud" more times than any other.

According to Minor, "It's always been a dream of mine to work with Irving Azoff, and my second family after A&M in the music industry has always been Warner Bros., especially Michael and

Mo Ostin. So if a man could ever have a dream come true, that's what happening right now."

Replied Azoff: "It's amaz-

ing how much smoke he can blow up people's asses in one paragraph, ain't it? That's my President!!!"

Big development out of last week's NARM has WEA President Henry Droz committed to a 5x11.5 non-jewelbox CD package called the ECO PAK. Four of the six manufacturers are reportedly in support of the less wasteful package, which has no jewelbox but instead sports a plastic tray in which the CD and notes are placed and sealed in shrinkwrap. The ECO PAK, developed by Warner subsidiary Ivy Hill, then folds into a jewelbox-like package after purchase. CEMA and PGD are still leaning towards a jewelbox-only alternative due to international concerns. Exec. VP Pam NARM Horovitz has gone on record in favor of the 5x11.5 package. Droz says the ECO PAK "would be available to share with the industry on a nonroyalty basis."



To call Warner Bros. Sr. VP of Black Music Promotion and Marketing Ray Harris a softspoken and sincerely nice guy would be an understatement. The New York-born-and-bred Harris has more friends and admirers in the business than JAMS' Graham Armstrong has gray hairs in his beard. Ray grew up in Harlem with music swirling all around him, a self-described "street corner kid" listening to all the great music of the time — Motown and doo-wop, pop and soul, Billy Stewart and Curtis Mayfield. That upbringing had a profound effect on his life and his decision to get into the music business for all the right reasons. His first gig was as an RCA Product Manager in New York. During his stint at the label, he rose to National Promotion Manager for R&B, then Director of Black Music Marketing and ultimately Division VP. At RCA, he had the freedom to sign acts, establish budgets and hire personnel. He came west in 1982 to take over as President of Solar for three years, then set up his own production company, managing several acts. He joined Warner Bros. in 1988 as Vice President of Promotion for Black Music, and took over his current position as Sr. VP of Black Music Promotion and Marketing almost a year ago. HITS' Joe "SloMo" Medwick who's been known to hang out on a few street corners himself (though it had nothing to do with music) - got the lowdown on the humble Harris... and the illustrious black mysic roster he oversees at Warners and Reprise.

Eight years ago, the two camps were not even talking to each other."

Were you in

any bands as a kid? That's funny. You're the first guy to ever ask me this question. I don't know if I want to tell you this story, but it's the truth. I've always wanted to sing, but I'm somewhat shy. There are many people who might disagree with that, but that's my perspective! When I was in junior high school, we used to put on talent shows and I had a few funny roles for which I had to sing. I really don't want to talk about this because I have some buddies that would love to hear this stuff. Oh, what the heck, I did Frank in "Annie Get Your Gun!" Go ahead. Insert laughter! But I was raised around music, the church and the whole family thing, which was great. Warner Bros. is currently blessed with an amazing number of genuine superstars like Miles, Quincy, Prince, Ray Charles and so on. How do you

to that next level? With any new artist, what you are trying to do is establish a base. I think the company has done a great job with Al B. Sure! His debut album was just shy of double platinum, which isn't bad for the first time out. His current album is now gold and continuing to sell. Look at Big Daddy Kane's third album, which is now close to gold, too. We're seeing a continual growth pattern for both these artists. There are a great many other acts that we feel comfortable about in the same way.

The thing I enjoy most about being at Warner Bros. is the artist roster — from a superstar perspective to an established artist perspective right through to the new signings. The first thing anyone will tell you if they know

anything about this company is, it is a tremendously A&Roriented organization with an incomparable roster. I feel it's a fabulous opportunity for me to be able to be a part of this in the marketing and promotion areas.

We have an enormous amount of talent on this label. As we sit, there's a Monie Love album that is happening and we're working a second Jasmine Guy single, both of which are exciting to watch develop. So, we have a host of things happening there.

How are you doing with some of the newer associated labels? Our association with Giant Records through Irving Azoff is kicking in fine fashion with Tara Kemp. Irving has put together a fine roster and also some great people to work with. They've just released the "New Jack City" soundtrack, which features singles by Christopher Williams, Ice T, Guy, Keith Sweat, Johnny Gill, Levert and more, I think it could be a monumental album. On the Reprise side, we've talked about Big Daddy Kane, but a group like Grammy winners Take 6 really prove that Warner Bros. is an artistoriented company.

Given the label's diverse roster, do you find yourself working

I think that's what makes people comfortable being here — be they new artists or established superstars — because we deal



Adult Pop records are being played on Quiet Storm formats, you realize that there's a great deal of homogenization going on. But it's all the same — music is music.

As rap becomes more mainstream, is it losing its edge? Rap is as diverse as hard rock, soft rock, jazz or whatever. All rap should not have to sound the same, just as all rock & roll doesn't sound the same. There's room for everything — those who like that hard, cutting-edge rap music and those who are into the more mainstream, melodic or radio-oriented kind Quincy Jones are. I think they should respect this music and listen to it and give it a chance. Don't say you don't like it — because this is part of your culture and your history and you cannot deny your history! At least be knowledgeable about it before you turn it off. I say that to my kids and I say that to radio also. I think those of us who work at record companies have an obligation to promote our history and legacy and those people who represent it. We can't afford to ignore those who came before us. Radio has an obligation to make sure this music is

to make sure that I'm suited up property! I've got to be sure I have all my linemen lined up and that's what a video is — it's part of the team that gives you additional ammunition. I've noticed that longform music videos are becoming much more important as far as our marketing plans go. I see that area of the business growing and growing.

What's the key to Warner Bros. and Reprise Records' tremendous success?

That's easy. It's definitely a combination of fine talent and a great management team. What

Kevin Tong, Product Coordinator; Tina Cope, Advertising Coordinator; C.C. Evans, Office Manager — they're all great! That pretty much rounds out the national Warner staff, with the addition of our two prime conationals — Hilda Williams on the east coost and Ted Astin on the west coast. On the Reprise side, you have a key person in David Linton, Director of Promotion Black Music, but all the people I've mentioned would be nothing without the dynamite field people we have out there on both the Warner and Reprise sides. They are the best, all of

Is it the same with jazz music? Of course. Miles is going to be Miles. We have a young man here named Mark Whitfield who's as traditional as any jazz player I've heard. He plays in the style. But there's always room for the people that do the more contemporary kind of jazz, too. Speaking of legends, Mavis Staples has done some great work on the "Graffiti Bridge" soundtrack. How do you go about turning on a new audience to someone like her? There are a great many Mavis Staples fans out there. If there's one thing that gets me emotionally charged up, it is when our youngsters don't know who people like Mavis Staples or Miles Davis or Ray Charles or

Do you think video could possibly supplant radio by providing that kind of information?

From a marketing perspective, I don't think there's anyone who'll deny that videos have helped record sales. Does MTV or BET help sell your records? Absolutely. It's an additional marketing tool — just as press, radio, touring or in-stores are. It's another avenue of exposure for the artist. But a record can still happen without a video. James Ingram just had a #1 record without one. Of course, it certainly helps. It's like if you tell me I'm going out there to play the San Francisco 49ers — well, I've got

can you say about Mo Ostin, Lenny Waronker and Russ Thyret other than that they are true professionals, and definite industry leaders? And then we have Benny Medina, VP of A&R, as true a talent as you can find. On the Warner Bros. side, we have Hank Spann, who is Vice President of Promotion — the man is a legend in his own time! Hank has a tremendous radio background and a great feel for the record business. Then we have Earl Jordan, our Vice President Black Music Sales for Warner Bros., who is a very intelligent and capable young man. Marylou Badeaux, our Director of Artist Relations Black Music, is also right up there. Gene Shelton, Director of Publicity Black Music; Pat Jones, Manager of Artist Relations;

While the picture at WEA and Warner/Reprise is pretty bright, the U.S. economy has been lackluster. What's your outlook for the music business?

I tend to think the entertainment industry will survive any serious economic downturn. When money is tight, you can't go out and spend \$25 on dinner and a movie, but you might be able to go out and buy a piece of music from your favorite artist and stay at home and listen to it with your family and friends. Music has always proven to be a saving grace in tough times.

And this is one of those times. Right, and I'm just happy to be part of a business that brings joy to people during these trying times. That makes me feel good.







Motorhead, "1916" (WTG/Epic): The title of this album refers to the number of Motorhead records these Gods of Grunge have recorded. Just kidding. Lemmy sums up the state of his band best in "I'm So Bad (Baby I Don't Care)": "Black-hearted to the bone/Older than the Rolling Stones/Been to

heaven, been to hell/Bought the farm and I won't sell" and "Ramones," a tribute to the other Masters of Fuzz. Bow before Motorhead at the altar of Post Modern and don't *ever* forget where your umlauts came from.

BoDeans, "Black And White" (Slash/Reprise): Since the early days of the "Da BoDeans," we've been captivated by the amazing harmonies of Sammy Llanas and Kurt Neumann. "Good Thing" opens with a "Badlands"-like intro and propells through 11 other songs that are inherently slices



of Americana. The bond between Kurt and Sammy is what differentiates the BoDeans from many other bands of their ilk. This is a partnership, not a clash of egos. The keyboards add friction to the guitar-driven mix on their best album to date.



Television, "The Blow Up: Roir Sessions" (Danceteria): This French import of the U.S. cassette-only release captures the fury and guitar explosion of Television live, at their peak. Here is 85 minutes of rock and roll history, from the opening chords of the 13th Floor Elevators' "Fire Engine" to the

only available version of "Satisfaction." Caveat emptor: the sound quality sucks, but the 15 minutes of heaven found on "Little Johnny Jewel" documents the most exciting time in music. And I stood up and fell into the arms of Venus de Milo.

Rocky and Bullwinkle, "Birth of Bullwinkle: Volume II" (Buena Vista): And now here's the cultural part of our program: Volume II of the six volume Bullwinkle video retrospective finds our pal Moose at the annual Frostbite Falls Flotilla Festival at Veronica Lake. After discovering the "Ruby Yacht (love that



band!) of Omar Khayyam, Rocky and Bullwinkle *liberally* use puns and the censors' distaste of violence to narrowly and heroically escape certain danger. This video also has a particularly hilarious 'Fractured Fairy Tale,' though this Dudley Do-Right is a bit tame. More PoMo than Morrissey.

While still a student in Amherst, Massachusetts, J. Mascis made an incredible discovery, unearthing the musical missing link between folk and grunge-rock. Dinosaur Jr. signed up with SST and it wasn't long before audiences and critics began digging their bones. "Green Mind" is the band's first furious footprint on Sire/WB, with Mascis having laid down nearly every track himself. Dinosaur Jr. continues to leave a big impression on old and new fans alike, but as the most laissez faire guitar godhead around, Mascis takes the band's growing stature in a slow, ambling stride. The reticent songwriter is still generally impervious to anything beyond the nearest television set, which one day he hopes will see him slashing away in a commercial for K2 skis. The slope-happy Mascis disclosed his thoughts on dinner with Liberace and his fledgling acting career to HITS' own purveyor of snow jobs, Joe "Ski Love" Jarrell.

What were you like as a kid?

I was kind of a weird, quiet kid. Actually, I was kind of normal up until junior high. I couldn't deal with the cool kids in school anymore. I just lost interest and started listening to Black Sabbath.

What inspired you to become a musician?

I knew I couldn't deal with getting a job so I thought I'd better find something else to do.

How did you come to pick your band name?

No reason, really. I just thought, "Oh, that sounds cool." If you could choose your next incarnation, what would you be?

Uh, maybe a cow. Just hang out, eat grass and be slaughtered. It'd be a good time. Although, if you're one of the cows up for slaughter, I guess it wouldn't be too good a time. The ones around [Amherst] are mostly dairy cows. They seem to have an alright life.

Did you enjoy being part of the Neil Young tribute record, "The Bridge"?

I like Neil. Everyone's always comparing us to Neil Young. But I didn't sing on it for that reason. This kid in the dorm, Artie, used to play guitar and sing some Neil Young and Dylan songs tryin' to see if girls would like him, but it didn't work out. So I thought he'd be the better man for the job.

What's your most bizarre groupie experience?

I got this one letter that was pretty weird. It was this big fourcolor poster collage of all these different pictures of me. It looked pretty professionally done and it came with this weird letter that said, "J., this is what I want to show you," and then a picture of this death-rock chick. She was staring at the ground. Kind of scary.

What's your most bizarre experience on tour?

One day I was hit by a car. Then we played and I ended up throwing my guitar into the audience as hard as I could and whacking this guy on the head. And then a deaf guy came up after the show and wanted me to sign his album. He had a Pink Floyd T-shirt on and he said, "Yeah, you guys are pretty good. I listen to your album so I can crank it up really loud and point my speakers at the floor. But I couldn't understand the lyrics because your hair was in front of your mouth." All in all, a weird day.

If you could have a dinner party with absolutely anyone, what guests would you choose?

Liberace would be cool. He seems like a swingin' guy. Sammy, Dean Martin. Let's see, some chicks would have to show up. Dolly Parton, Claudia Schiffer, Karen Allen would have to be there, definitely. Have you acted before?



Yeah, pretty much, but what can you do?


