



Earlier in the year, Motown filed a lawsuit charging MCA with failure to perform its contractual obligations for distribution and Pop radio promotion. MCA later countersued.

•Busby stated he "very much regretted that the relationship between Motown and MCA had reached this point."

•According to an MCA Music Entertainment spokesperson: "It would be inappropriate to comment on matters before the Motown operating committee. However, MCA's position is that we have a long-term agreement with Motown that extends years beyond September 8 and we intend to vigorously enforce all of MCA's rights under that agreement."

•Whatever the outcome of these actions, please rest assured of one fact: A lot of lawyers will make a lot of money off this one.

BMG had offered the 10 million buyers of the group's CDs, tapes, albums or singles between \$1 and \$3 in discounts on any future label purchases. Judge **Thomas O'Brien** rejected the proposal, believing it was not right that people who were victims of a scam had to go out and buy another recording to receive compensation. It doesn't take that good a crystal ball to see that **Metallica**'s new Elektra release is headed straight to the top of the charts, challenging labelmate and current #1 **Natalie Cole**. This week, with less than 10% of accounts reporting sales for the Mondayreleased project, the self-titled album debuts at #38 on the HITS Top 50 Albums chart. We're talking sales bonanza.



AN EXCLUSIVE HITS INTERVIEW WITH LARRY MARTINO BY CONNIE BREEZE

This radio veteran began his broadcasting career at the Lyndon State campus station in Lyndonville, Vermont, before seguing to Colorado, where he worked in Gunnison and Pueblo. His first PD gig was at 96KISS in Nashville, then he programmed Q94 in Bakers-field, California, before coming to KGGI in Riverside as PD in July, 1988. Three years later, he's OM, just hired new PD Bob West and had a sensational book. The guy's entitled to stop and smell the roses ---even if all he wants to do is k about Bob — but an III 18 wind that blows no good in the form of HITS' radio jezebel Connie "Francis" Breeze was enough to send him scurrying for the air freshener.

You recently hired Bob West as PD, but the station was doing quite well even before he arrived. What prompted the move?

This is pretty much the same staff I inherited when I first came here three years ago. In a town where we don't have much direct Top 40 competition, people tend to get complacent. Although we get some competition from the L.A. stations, we've been #1 here for awhile now. I think the station needed a shot in the arm, and Bob West has definitely done that.

Bob does a midday shift and you do afternoons. Isn't it unusual for both a station's PD and OM to be on-air? We're in a recession now, as you know.

I was an off-air PD until we hired Bob, and then I went back on to do a shift for budgetary reasons. In order to hire someone like Bob — and pay him what he's worth — I had to make some adjustments. The other side of that is, because of Bob, the staff has a new vision and a new energy.

Bob is known as a creative programmer and a real motivator. You've given him a real opportunity to do both here.

Bob is an extremely talented programmer. I knew he was available and, in fact, had plans to move back to town. He was an interim PD here awhile back. He was raised in Ontario, so he knows this Hispanic market like nobody else. I kept that in mind when, at the beginning of the year, our ratings started to slip, and the staff started to drag. I had done all I could to motivate them, and it wasn't working. It got to the point where





I had to re-evaluate my strengths and weaknesses. I realized I had to make a change. My own staff was calling me Mr. Anal Retentive... to my face! During the interview with Bob, it became overwhelmingly obvious he was the answer to our creative problems. Of course, I had some problems letting go of some of my power, but Bob is a much more talented programmer than I am, so I feel much better about it.

"My own staff was calling me Mr. Anal Retentive... to my face!" The combination of a left brain and right brain person can be pretty volatile. But, for us, it works! Just look at our last book. We've doubled our numbers. We went from 4.9 to 8.7 25-54. It's the highest rating the station has ever had. The key is to have an appreciation for the other's talents and differences. Those numbers are pretty amazing considering you compete against L.A. stations.

But KGGI has a hometown relationship to its listeners the L.A. stations can't match. Obviously, that's why we're #1. The L.A. stations come out here once in a great while, but they really don't call the Inland Empire home.

Of course, just because a song works in L.A. doesn't mean it will work in Riverside.

That's right. We really service an audience that we feel is ignored in L.A. adult Hispanics. Also, Bob's doing an oldies show at neen that is just exploding. What's your goal now that you've done so well in your first book under a new PD? We've never cone that well twice in a row, so that's our next project. We want double digits all the way across the board. In our opinion, KFI had some numbers that were too high here. They shouldn't have numbers like that with our audience. IF I can accomplish that, and keep some sort of rein on Bob, I'll be happy. I mean, you should see this guy. Every week, management says, "Help! He's going crazy!" And I say, "Don't worry. I've got him under control." But, he really is going crazy!



When A&M CEO and Prez Al Cafaro announced the deal with Jimmy Jam and Terry Lewis to form their new label, Perspective Records, he spoke about the pair's "rare combination of [being] successful businessmen and artists." Forming Flyte Time Productions in Minneapolis in the mid-'70s on top of their impressive roles in the seminal group the Time, Jam & Lewis have indeed proven themselves to be two of the most prolific, talented and profitable young entrepreneurs in the business, with over 50 Top Ten Black singles, 20 Top Ten Pop singles and more than 30 gold and platinum records to their credit. The list of writing and producing awards is endless but perhaps two of the most telling honors they've received recently reflect just what they are all about. The two were given the Heritage Award at the NAACP's 1990 Image Awards and were named National Entrepreneurs of the Year by Inc. magazine. Perspective's historic and superb first release, "Sounds of Blackness: the evolution of gospel," by Sounds of Blackness, offers a significant insight into Jimmy and Terry's vision. Jam and a very quiet Lewis sat down at the Chaplin Lot for a tête-atête with HIT's own souiman-on-ice, "Don't Play With My Joe-Joe" Medwick.

What does it mean to have your own label?

Jimmy Jam: Personally, it gives us the opportunity to work with acts that maybe another label wouldn't work with. It gives us a chance to expand our creative scope. It's a move to give all the writers and producers we have on staff an opportunity to do the same thing - to go out and find things that they like. Our operating style could be called the family style. I like to say, we don't have good people behind us, we have good people right with us. We're not a big company, but many of our philosophies are shared by A&M, which is one of the reasons that we're here. It's a smaller operation and everybody knows what everyone is doing. That's the way we like it. What have you learned from your experience with Flyte Time that has helped you launch and operate Perspective?

Jimmy: We were fortunate in that we started out as artists and entrepreneurs because no one would hire us, so we had to make our own work. We would go out, rent a place to play and send out flyers. We basically had to be businessmen early in our careers. That taught us music and business go together. This is a learning experience for us because running a label is a little bit. different than just handing the projects in and forgetting about them. Now, we see the project though the process of selecting album covers. videos, directors... every aspect of the marketing. We couldn't have better people help us than Jerry Moss and Herb Alpert. In many ways, we see parallels between their relationship and mine and Terry's. Your first release, "Sounds of Blackness: the

evolution of gospel," is such an ambitious and beautiful project, one that reflects your promise of presenting a wide range of music.

Jimmy: The Sounds of Blackness has been part of our growing up. We always heard them, but were never really in the position to do anything for them. They did a show a few years ago which was basically a celebration of Martin Luther King's life. We decided right then that we wanted to work with them, so we got in contact with the group and started talking about doing an album and

relationship and mine and Terry's."

placing it somewhere. When our label deal came through, it just made sense that this would be our first act, because it does really show what the label is about.

What advantages and disadvantages are there to keeping the operation in Minneapolis? Jimmy: To us, there are no drawbacks. With the modem age of technology, FAX machines and jet airplanes, we really feel close to both coasts. It's played an important role because being in a creative business, wherever you are happy is where you're going to create. Minneapolis has been home for us for a long time. We're happy there. It's nice being away from the hoopla of New York and L.A. We're kind of isolated up there and we like it. Will running a label in any way hinder your prolific writing and production output? Jimmy: Hopefully, it's not going to get in our way.

One of the reasons we waited so long to do a label deal was we decided we were not ready to cope with the day-to-day running of a record company. We felt we still had some growing to do we just wanted to write songs and produce. Even when the A&M deal came up, we still really were not ready to do it. Herb told us, "Do what you want to do, and when you're ready, we're ready." We do realize there will be a little less writing and production time but we're at the point now where we're willing to give a little bit of that up to help bring along some other new writers and producers and just watch over what they are doing. Because that's the future. We were fortunate in our careers that we had a guy named Prince who said, "Hey, watch what I do, here's the way to do it." Now, we are in a position to do that for other people.

I think we can definitely play an important part in history, just from the point of being black entrepreneurs - just as Motown did it, just as Philly International did it. Those are great history lessons to look to for inspiration and knowledge. Hopefully, what we're doing and what La & Face, Teddy Riley, Russell Simmons and Clarence Avant are doing represent the latest examples of that tradition. I think it's important that the way the deals are structured now, we actually own equity in our music. We are happy to be part of that now our job is to make it work. For us, all that really means is doing what we've always done ---writing and producing the songs - except now, we are really, truly a part of what we do. So you can make some money while you're at it. Terry Lewis: [Laughs.] And mo' money and mo'
