With unit sales down, several labels are continuing belt-tightening measures as the country becomes further entrenched in an economic recession.


Latest news comes from Atlantic, which continues to restructure and streamline in the face of declining consumer spending. An undisclosed number of staffers were laid off last week.

Nirvana #1

Stop the presses, folks!!! If someone told you four weeks ago that the #1 album in the country would soon be DGC's **Nirvana**, chances are you'd bet the farm against it.

Pay up losers. The public has spoken. This week, the project soars to the top of the HITS Top 50 Albums chart.

HUGE sales have accompanied massive Post Modern radio and MTV exposure to make this one unstoppable. And the single is just going to Top 40 *this week*.

Can you say, "Guns N' Roses Part II?" Stay tuned folks, this one is gone.

Will all the Top 40 stations in America that *didn't* add the **Michael Jackson** record please raise your hand.

Just as we thought.

Breaking all previous add records, "Black Or White" swept across the country like wildfire, with Top 40 stations checking in like clockwork.

According to Epic's Sr. VP of Promotion Polly Anthony: "Jackson's run for the 1988 Democratic presidential nomination obviously cemented his image in the minds of programmers. It's hard to believe he didn't beat Dukakis." Thanks Pol.

Oh yeah, there's other Jackson information — Andrew Jackson was the 7th U.S. President, serving from 1829-37. He was born in 1767 and died in 1845. Thank you.

Brits With Attitude

N.W.A.'s "Efilzaggin" album has been declared not obscene by British magistrates in a historic court case which marked the first time a record has been seized by police under the U.K.'s Obscene Publications Act. Records will be in shops this week.

Nearly 25,000 copies of the album, released in the U.K. by Island Records, were seized by Scotland Yard's Obscene Publications Squad on June 4 from the label's distributor, PolyGram Record Operations, a day after the record's release. The impounded albums were returned and will be distributed to retail outlets.

Said Island Managing Director Marc Marot: "This court decision vindicates the position the company has taken regarding this record. We thought it would be difficult for the court to define the difference between what they found offensive and what could be proved to be corrupting."



On the new song "Rebirth," Chuck D. of Public Enemy proclaims, "I don't claim to be a preacher/Not paid to be a teacher/But I'm grown/I try to be a leader to the bone." And he is — by teaching, preaching, observing, commenting and rousing a little bit of rabble. This has been Public Enemy's code since 1987, trying to make the world a little better with its message while at the same time, the former Carlton Ridenhour and his mates craft an arresting sonic attack that advances the art of rap with each new release. The latest is "Apocalypse '91: The Empire Strikes Black," a collection of songs that continues P.E.'s study of the African-American situation in the U.S. and exhortations to their community to take the lead in improving its lot. It's a heavy agenda, but as he finished taping a week's worth of "Yo! MTV Raps" segments, the be-hatted Mr. D. was more than happy to dump some of it on HITS' own hat-man, Detroit Tiger Lily Gary "Tell A" Graff.

Compared to "Fear of a Black Planet," "Apocalypse '91" came out with a relative lack of furor.

Yeah, without all the bullshit. Of course, I don't ask for the bullshit; the bullshit just pops up. I'm just making sure we get the job done. But you gotta understand, sometimes the bullshit's supposed to pop up.


Does it surprise you controversy seems to dog Public Enemy?

No. I'm gonna deal with some things that people don't want me to deal with. My whole point is, if it's controversial to some, then maybe it should be controversial. I'm not going along with the fuckin' flow; I've never claimed to do that. Besides, it's usually not something in the record that's controversial. It's usually something around it — other people not really understanding rap and what we're talking about.

Most of the songs on the new album deal with the problems of the black community and how it can be the cause of some of those problems. That's dangerous territory. Listen, I live in my community. I see it being fucked up — fucked up by genocide and fucked up by the white man and his ways. There's a lot of us that are agents to that genocidal task. You hear people talking about who's selling out in music. They talk about M.C. Hammer when you've got real sell-outs living down the block selling out lives. Music's not all that important; we don't need to worry about who's selling music, who's not selling music. Music is a business. We need to learn some

We talk about the difference between what's real and what's bullshit. Bullshit is worrying about Hammer or Vanilla Ice, but allowing drug dealers to stand on your corner. Jealousy and envy are traits of genocide — we tend to be jealous and envious when we need to spend our time in other areas. The point is, it's safe to talk about those other things instead of doing something to improve your community. We've got too many adolescents over 18... we've got to get serious about business and responsibility and not fun and

real shit before we worry about the bullshit.

games. I mean, we're talking black-on-black crime, about taking brothers out. Why aren't you going to the White House and doing that shit? You're doing what those motherfuckers want you to do.

That kind of talk is precisely what scares white people about Public Enemy. Is there a peaceable solution here?

It ain't peace now. In my neighborhood, there ain't no peace.

Are people listening?

Some will listen, some won't, but those that listen will see they can guide their lives. The ones that won't listen won't better themselves

— they'll always be crying and screaming. Is Chuck D. and Public Enemy out to save the world?

I'm a grown goddamn man. I shouldn't feel I have to save the world. But I can't sit on my goddamn ass and do nothing. Those mother-fuckers who are into destruction need to be eliminated.

The white man puts black entertainers and athletes up on a pedestal. They don't put black doctors and lawyers up there, they don't put up black guys taking out their garbage, or the teenager working at McDonald's.

Everyone thinks you've got to make a lot of

money. My point is, making a whole lot of money quick don't mean nothing if you don't know what to do with it. If you can't take care of 50 of your brothers, what good is it?

Public Enemy's goal was to raise 5,000 potential black leaders. Now we need more. We need leaders who are responsible, who know business, who are ready to take responsibility for other people and for their community. Making you a man doesn't mean knocking somebody out and somebody up—you've got to take control.

The theme of this album is "Return to the Hard." Many people think hard-core means knocking somebody out or doing a drive-by. C'mon, man... hard means living your life. There are a lot of brothers out there whose lives are harder than them. I tell the brothers, "Look, if you can handle your life, that'll make you hard. If you can't handle your life, how can you think you're hard?" Handling your life is what makes you a man. It's hard to do— it means you're able to buck the fuckin' odds and are able to take care of many people by being constructive and not destructive. Is music a more effective forum for this message than politics?

Music just happens to be the thing I've studied for 15 years. In the music business, the black man is trying to snatch it back from the white guys, who have their hands in my pocket.

Black people have been doing jazz and blues and singing and dancing for years. Can you imagine if Jackie Wilson owned a share of Elvis? He would've been big business! The record company deals in sales — we deal in royalties. You try to get as much as you can by releasing records and doing TV and radio and anything else that lets you push the business. But most of the money doesn't come back to you.

Many rap acts are leading through example by starting their own business organizations. In our business structure, we have 45 to 50 people. Hammer takes care of a lot of people. If you can't build a structure that people can support themselves and their families from, what's the purpose?

That's where pro athletes have a problem. They make so much money, but ten athletes can't get together and build a business that their peers can work for. People like John Salley, Craig Hodges, Rick Mahorn are conscientious people, trying to network and help their brothers out. But can you imagine if 75 NBA ballplayers got together and decided to invest in businesses that supply the black community with its needs?

One, two or three guys can't do it alone. There has to be a whole collection of them saying, "Yo, man, this is what we're gonna do — we're gonna snatch this business away." Here we are buying Japanese cars

and working for Japanese companies. Why aren't we buying things from ourselves?
You're talking about creating a self-sufficient subculture.

This is the '90s. Welcome to the terrordome. It's the decade where we've got to think about doing and getting the job done instead of saying the only way out is working for the white man and his structure. We need to work for us. There's nothing threatening about that.

People are ignorant. I definitely don't have time to pay attention to ignorant people, especially those who aren't black. When I say ignorant, it doesn't mean stupid; it means you ignore certain facts you don't know. You need to sit down and learn better.

Do you ever get frustrated?

I didn't put the system here. I can only do my job and try to make a change, but at the same time, you can't get frustrated. God put you here only for a short time, even if you live to 100. I didn't create none of this. You just try to put your best foot forward. I don't want to sound like a fuckin' little girl. I'm a grown man. How did you hook up with Anthrax for the new version of "Bring the Noise" and the tour? Back in '87, I checked out this guy in one of the English papers and he was wearing a Public Enemy shirt at the Monsters of Rock concert overseas. It was [Anthrax's] Scott [lan], and it turned out they liked our music. So we mentioned them in "Bring the Noise,"

and throughout the years we kept saying we've got to hook up. Last year, they said they wanted to cover "Bring the Noise." I thought it would be redundant, but they kept pushing us... and it turned out to be good. I like it very much, and I dig the fuck out of the video.

Many people ask us why we get down with a rock group. We weren't trying to be ground-breaking or anything like that. If you know anything about real hip-hop, back in 1980, the only thing you could find with a beat was rock music — Billy Squier, Leslie West, Aerosmith. That's why Run-DMC did their thing with Aerosmith.

Do you want to be recognized by the rock world?

I really don't give a fuck. See, number one, it's important that I'm doing rap and that rap fans like it. I guess it's icing on the cake if the rock community respects what I'm doing for rap. I know what I'm doing in rap music. I've been an advocate for rap for a long time. When we first came out, I would not allow anyone to call rap computerized bullshit. I stand for rap's existence. I'm not here to ride on it for bullshit reasons. I'm here to stand and protect it. I have respect for M.C. Breed out of Flint, Michigan, just like I do for DLC from Texas, Too Short from Oakland and Def Jef from L.A. There's rap all over the world, and I think that's fantastic. Hip-hop should have no boundaries. *

Rick Cummings is the group PD for Emmis Broadcasting. He originally launched Power106 on the air in Los Angeles with an out-of-work programmer he literally grabbed off the beach named Joel Salkowitz. In the past five years, he has successfully turned around the fortunes of such stations as Hot97, WLOL and WAVA. With Jeff Wyatt's resignation from Power 106, Rick arrived in La La to search for a new P.D. Turns out he liked it so much, he's staying! Which suits HITS' own Gold Gym graduate and sometime beach bunny Connie "Ocean" Breeze just fine.

CUMMINGS AT YA!

You are pretty accessible for such an important broadcasting executive.

I like this job, and am not only enthusiastic about L.A., but I figure I'm going to need all the friends I can get!

That's pretty ironic considering you're the guy that leaked both Michael and Jermaine Jackson's records.

I'd like to tell you it was all planned, but it wasn't. I got a call from someone who knew where to get a hold of Jermaine's tape and wanted to know whether I was interested. I wasn't sure until I had the tape sent to our GM Doyle Rose's house, who said it was pretty interesting.

On my way to Doyle's house, I found out the Michael Jackson track had been leaked to Hot97 in New York, so I had Joel [Salkowitz] send it to me. And while Joel has been blamed for all of this, it was really me. He sent it because I asked him to. The only thing we're guilty of is being more resourceful than anyone else in town. Some people didn't see it that way, though. We received a cease-and-desist on Sunday, and promised Epic we'd stay off it until somebody else played it. KIIS put it on Monday, and so we started airing it again, also. What can I say? We got a great deal of publicity and ended up in the eye of the storm! Michael wasn't the significant part of all this. It was putting on the Jermaine record and having people comment on it.

There was concern at Arista that they would be perceived as having leaked this record to steal some of Michael's thunder.

The label did not send me the record. I honestly don't know where the record came from. Arista wasn't even aware of the bootlegged version. I went to great lengths to make sure I'd never really know where the record came from. I had the tape sent to someone else's house and the package it came in destroyed.

Why did you let Power106 slip so far in the ratings before you took action?

We hung on to something that worked so

well for so long, that we just didn't realize when it stopped working. When it was painfully obvious the Latin thing wasn't happening, we tried pushing house music on our listeners, but that didn't work, either. We have to play what our listeners want to hear, and balance the station's flow around that. Urban ballads work really well. Hip-hop is still really big. We've stayed away from Richard Marx and Genesis. The only exceptions we've made were for Extreme and Aaron Neville because we felt they gave us some real good relief, and the response was good. But, when they're gone, they're gone. They don't go into recurrent.

How are you going about remotivating the staff?

It's hard. Start-ups are easy. Everyone starts with a common vision. These people have been here five or six years, and some have suffered morale-wise because ratings have been down so much. Putting myself into their place, I can understand. It's hard to have fun when the ratings are not good. Jay Thomas has been the driving force in help-

ing us start over. He has re-committed to us, and is doing no TV until next September. In return, we are committing more resources and staff to him. Jay is a real power hitter, but no one has been throwing him softballs. Jay's been in my office every day for two months telling me our trends were going to go up, and they did!

Tell us about Michelle Mercer, your MD. There were a few people surprised when I took this job, but not as many as when I hired Michelle. She was my assistant in Indianapolis. She gives me what I don't know. A perfect example is "O.P.P." Two months ago, I didn't hear this record, but Michelle did because she's on the streets. I know damn well that I'm too old, too lazy and too white to be on the streets looking for music. Of all the people I've worked with over the past four or five years, she is the person I have ultimate confidence in. She just gets it!

Why did you decide to take on day-to-day duties here at Power106?


I came right away to interview PDs. I'd worked out such a plan to rebuild Power, I didn't want to spend all my time and energy convincing someone else I was right. When I decided I wanted to do this myself, I floated the notion past Doyle and corporate, and when I wasn't laughed out of the room, I thought I might be on to something!

What is your vision for Power?

To get into the mid-fours by next summer. We want to be a cutting-edge dance station, but we also need to get back some of the things we lost — being first on some of the music, having a #1 morning show and doing all the things that make a radio station great.

Can you beat KIIS?

Yes. There is plenty of room for us to co-exist. It seems they know their strength is in adults, and we've never been anything but a 12-24 station. We just want to be a really good, dominating 12-24 radio station.

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





How does it feel to have the British press calling you the greatest thing since sliced bread?

It's not so much people calling us the greatest — it's more a case of people coming to see us play live and getting their rocks off. I guess. I'm still really asleep. You'll have to excuse me.

What time is it there?

I don't know. I was up most of the night. I haven't had much sleep.

From the video for "Movin' On Up," you look to be in great shape.
I can't stop moving when I hear the

music. I love food and sleep. It's just sometimes you feel immortal and think you can stay up forever, but it's just not true. I nearly collapsed the other night, though. I'd been up for three-and-a-half days without sleep. I made it on-stage and played the show, but I don't think I played as good as I could've.

You sample Peter Fonda from the '60s biker movie "The Wild Angels" at the beginning of "Loaded." Does what he says sum up your philosophy of life? Yeah. The guy goes, "Just what is it you

wanna do?" and Fonda says, "You

wanna get loaded? Wanna have a party? Wanna have a good time?" It's pretty self-explanatory.

I read the band likes to do drugs

before going on-stage and that live performances sometimes degenerate into Replacements-style cover shows. No, no, no. I'll tell you one thing. I never forget the words to our songs. One reason we do cover versions is we just enjoy playing music. Sometimes I'll start singing, like say, "The Dark End of the Street" or "Bring It On Home to Me" or Coltrane's "Love Supreme" or Zeppelin's "Whole Lotta Love" and the band'll just start playing behind me. You don't have to be loaded to enjoy playing other people's songs. This is a great band in that respect. We can play virtually anything.

What is the live show like?

It's quite glammy and gospel, with a lot of different vibes to it. We use electric guitars, intergalactic synthesizer noises, deep soul blues vocals, beautiful blues acoustic guitars, fantastic electric piano, horn sections, live drums and drum machines.

How did you hook up with Denise Johnson, who sings lead on "Don't Fight It, Feel It" and background on most of the other tracks on the album? We heard her on some dance records and thought she had a great voice. She sings on a lot of records in England. People don't actually know it's her singing except fanatics. She improvises

Bobby Gillespie, has one of those soft, breathy voices which wows the ladies, but — at 5 a.m. Champaign, Illinois time — was hardly enough to keep HITS' insomniac and Village People fan club president Jill "Went Up The Hill To Fetch A Pail of Water" awake for the durati....Zzzzzz.

great vocals with a gospel feel.

What does soul music mean to you? Soul music is music that moves me emotionally and makes me want to dance. I would say that somebody like Alex Chilton is soul music. "Been Caught Stealin" by Jane's Addiction is a soulful song.

You used to be the drummer for Jesus & Mary Chain. I can even hear some of that band's influence in the ballad "Damaged."

Not at all. It's more a case of both bands being highly influenced by Kris

Kristofferson than anything else — more even than the Velvet Underground!

Why did you start a rock & roll band in the first place?

To try to transcend our surroundings. In England, most young people don't really have much prospects for a fulfilling life at all and they resent it. I'm sure it's the same in America. Kids are just fuckin' bored. There are very, very few good rock records coming out right now. Most of what passes for rock & roll these days just doesn't have that raw, teenage feel.
