Enough already. another Time Warner-distributed hip-hop act, Oakland rapper 2Pac, and his label, Interscope/Atlantic/AG, are being sued and charged with being responsible for the shooting of a Texas police officer.

Confessed killer Ronald Howard was allegedly listening to a tape of the group's album, "2PACalypse Now," while driving through Jackson County Texas in a stolen vehicle. When Howard was pulled over by patrolman Bill Davidson on suspicion of a traffic violation, he shot him in the neck. The officer died three days later. Police say a copy of "2PACalypse Now" was found in the tape deck of the vehicle.

The suit, filed on behalf of Davidson's family, seeks financial damages from 2Pac (Tupac Amaru Shakur) as well as Interscope, East West Records. Atlantic and Time Warner. Attorney James W. Cole says his clients not only wish for the financial remuneration, but "want to stop Time Warner from publishing this kind of music." Time Warner lawyer R. James George Jr. insists there is no evidence to support Cole's claims.

#### Quick Silas Is Golden At MCA

The Most Added singles of the week at Top 40 radio are #1 Trey Lorenz (Epic), #2 Eric Clapton (Reprise), #3 Peter Gabriel (Geffen), #4 TLC (LaFace/Arista) and #5 Rembrandts (Atco/EW/AG). Marky Mark (Interscope/AG) is back and scoring big out-of-the-box. MCA Records executive Louil "The Sounds of" Silas Jr., who has been instrumental in the success of such label artists as Bobby Brown, Bell Biv Devoe and Jody Watley as well as nurturing the career of producers L.A. Reid and Babyface, has been

rewarded with his own custom label, Silas Records, it was announced by MCA Music Entertainment Group Chairman Al "Do" Teller.

The new label will be distributed by MCA, where Silas has been Executive Vice President, A&R/Artist Dev-

elopment, Black Music Division. The first release on Silas Records will be the debut album from singer/songwriter Chanté Moore, "Precious."

Commented Teller: "It has been gratifying to watch Louil's growth during the years. When he started here, he was barely 5' 5" and now he's over 6 feet tall! It is only fitting his ability to identify talent, his extraordinary rapport with artists and his intuitive understanding of the artist development process will now translate to his own label."

Added Silas: "It has been my dream to have my own label and be able to see the artist development process through from start to finish. This progression is even more meaningful because I'll still be part of MCA Records, where I'll be working closely with Al, Richard Palmese, Ernie Singleton and the rest of the MCA team." #### Geffen/DGC Promo Teams Combined

Constructing what he calls a "dream staff," Geffen/DGC President Ed Rosenblatt announced the combination of the Geffen and DGC promotion staffs under the leadership of Bill Bennett, previously DGC promo topper and now General Manager of the combined staff.

According to the company, the move was "triggered by the retirement of Geffen promo head Al Coury" last week.

"The result will give us a larger promotion staff to work each release than any of our competing companies," said Rosenblatt, who added that the current release schedule "didn't warrant maintaining two separate promotion departments."

According to the label topper, "The new force will total more staffers on both a national and regional level than either had separately. Each person will have the luxury of a significantly smaller territory to work. The numbers and quality of the people will give us a stronger and more powerful department, a real dream team."

Among those handling national duties under Bennett
— Steve Leavitt and George

#### Wildmon Tamed

Chalk up one for the forces of free speech. Rev. Donald Wildmon failed in his attempt to prevent the release of "Damned In The U.S.A.," a British-made documentary about the censorship battles surrounding federal grants for artists supported by the National Endowment for the Arts.

An Aberdeen, Mississippi judge rejected Wildmon's claim that producers Paul Yule and Jonathan Stack violated his contract with them. The film, which includes Wildmon and the artists debating whether federal money should go for art depicting explicit sexual imagery, will be screened October 15 in Los Angeles.

"This just goes to show Wildmon's type of intimidation doesn't work," said Yule. "Maybe the tide for censorship has turned." The filmmakers have filed a \$3 million countersuit in New York asking for damages incurred because of the delay in being able to screen the movie in the States.



THE RAMONES are back, climbing up the alternative chart and selling records and tour dates!



"We are not ashamed to ask for what we want. when we want it." boasts Left Eye, the rapper in TLC, the red-hot. colorful Atlantabased hip-hop trio who have stormed the charts. The message of their debut single, "Ain't 2 Proud 2 Beg," comes through loud and clear. propelling the newcomers to the top of the pop heap. T-Boz, Left Eye and Chilli have brashly exploded upon the music world with their debut album. "Ooooooohhh... On The TLC Tip," produced by Atlanta's music maestros L.A. Reid and Babyface for their brand-new LaFace Records label. The album tastefully blends the best of rap, funk and R&B as TLC mix their funloving humor with straight-up, inyour-face messages about safe sex. The TLC gals got together with HITS' own Gallic rap expert, Pascale "On The French Tip" Lanfranchi, for some girl talk, as one and all donned giant condoms and dove into a vat of melted chocolate. Oooh la la!



Crystal didn't work out so we got Rozonda to replace her. We had to work something out so that the C would apply to Rozonda. We all adopted nicknames. TLC now stands for T-Boz, Left Eye and Chilli, but it also stands for the "Tit Less Crew." [LAUGHS.]

#### What's the most important quality a female artist must have to succeed in the '90s?

LEFT EYE: Probably being a role model. We feel there are no role models for girls right now... at least not for the type of girls who like to be like us. You don't have to wear tight clothes to get your point across.

#### Is hip-hop the voice of America today like rock & roll was in the '60s?

T-Boz: Yes, definitely, because it is the way for people to get their message across. Hiphop means more than just music to dance

to and a funky look. To us, hip-hop is the most efficient way to express one's opinion and make people aware of many important issues.

#### Safe sex is a recurrent subject on your album. Do you feel it is your responsibility as entertainers to discuss such an issue?

LEFT EYE: It was a conscious choice we made when we recorded the album. It is a cause we believe in and we do want our fans to know that safe sex is a very serious issue. We really don't feel it is our responsibility to discuss this issue, but we believe in using our talent to make people aware of it.

#### Who came up with the concept of wearing condoms on your clothes?

LEFT EYE: I did. One day, I ran back in the house to pick up something and I picked up a condom instead. I thought it would be really neat to put it on my clothes. That's how the whole thing started. Actually, we're making a fashion statement. We think it is easier for young people who are having sex to go to the store saying they're buying condoms to put on their clothes than it is to say they're buying condoms because they're about to have sex. It's crazy to think that many youngsters are too scared either to ask for condoms or talk about it. We want to eliminate the fear and the uncomfortable feeling many people have about condoms. If we wear condoms on our clothes, hopefully the kids will think that it is OK to use them. There is nothing to be afraid of or ashamed about.

#### On this first album, you were fortunate to work with L.A. & Babyface. What did you learn about producing?

CHILLI: We want to try to do our own stuff. We absolutely

equipment so we can make our own demos and present them to L.A. & Babyface. T-BOZ: Being that we are signed to their label and that we feel

T-BOZ: What we do is relate actual situations from a female's point of view. I think we have a variety of songs that the guys also can relate to; I'm sure they understand our message in "Ain't 2 Proud 2 Beg." The issues we touch upon are very real in today's society. If they want to put a label on us, they should call us realists.

LEFT EYE: We are here to say that we can do anything the guys can. To us, what really matters is how you can do the job. We didn't want to have just dance music on our album, We didn't want the public to take us for a joke, like we're just cute little girls running around with songs that somebody gave them. We want to make people think about the many issues we have to deal with, the problems of today's society.


#### TLC has been called a female version of BBD.

Chilli: I must say BBD started the trend with the baggy clothes. The difference between us is that our clothes are bright, we do not wear our pants inside out and we don't wear mismatched shoes. BBD's style is mental, while we call our style RBRF [pronounced Urbuf, stands for R&B, Rap and Funk].

#### Any upcoming projects?

LEFT EYE: We're going to do comedies, motion pictures and commercials. One of our goals is to have our own television cartoon, but not just any regular cartoon. We're going to have real fly animated characters... on the TLC tip!

**PolyGram Music Publishing Group** U.S.' CEO/President, Australian expatriate **Colin Cornish**, and his colleague, VP Creative **Mike Sandoval**, have one thing in common. They both started in the mailroom at a music publishing company and worked their way to the top. Cornish has been with PolyGram Publishing Company since 1988, based in Australia, before coming to America in January of this year. He had been with Chappell Music, PolyGram's former publishing company, since 1968, when it was first sold to Phillips. He rose to Managing Director at the pubbery and stayed there through its 1984 sale from PolyGram to a consortium headed by Freddie Bienstock, then left in 1988 when it was sold to Wamers.

Veteran publishing executive Mike Sandoval had been at Warner Chappell for close to 20 years, then was tapped by Cornish to join PolyGram Music as VP Creative last April. "No one else would hire him, so I did," jokes Colin. "Twenty years in the wilderness at Chappell deserves better."

The company has risen to the third-largest music publishing company in the world behind Warner-Chappell and EMI Music, with a catalogue which ranges from such chestnuts as "Smoke Gets In Your Eyes" and "Flying Down To Rio" up to the latest hits from U2, Billy Ray Cyrus, Pearl Jam, Sir Mix-A-Lot, the Beastie Boys, k.d. lang, Body Count and Bon Jovi. After unloading Chappell in 1984, PolyGram re-entered the publishing business in the U.K. in 1986 with the acquisition of the Dick James catalogue — which included several early Beatles tracks, as well as the Hollies, the Troggs and a number of other '60s bands — the Welk Music Group and Island Music. Two years later, Cornish was tapped to launch PolyGram's publishing company in Australia from his home base in Sydney. Since then, he has overseen an aggressive acquisition policy designed to build up PolyGram Music Publishing's presence around the world.

The company recently opened a brand-new American home office on the A&M lot in Los Angeles to go along with other U.S. divisions in New York (headed by VP Creative John Titta) and Nashville (manned by GM Doug Howard) and a smaller Canadian branch in Toronto (where manager John Redman holds forth). There, such valued PolyGram Music employees as Creative Director John Baldi, Director of Film & TV Paula Erickson and Film & TV Manager Danny Benair try to keep the key to the CD closet from HITS' resident song-plugger (and disc schnorrer) Roy "Joy Boy" Trakin. >>>>>>>

### What are your goals for the organization?

COLIN CORNISH: I want to make this the best music publishing company in America. I really do. The only way I can do that is to make sure we're involved in all sorts of music and get the best people — quality talent, quality writers, quality catalogues. That's the way to do it. There's no magicwand approach. I wish there was. It's as simple as putting good people with talent in positions where they can achieve results.

## If it's a record company's job to sell records, what does a publishing company actually do?

MIKE SANDOVAL: Our responsibility is to give the writers several areas of support, which include collaborations, production projects and, in most cases, in-depth marketing monies. Sometimes video and tour support is included.

#### How does the relationship work with PolyGram Records? Isn't publishing part of the deal when any of the PolyGram labels sign an act?

SANDOVAL: Most of the time, though, it works both ways these days. Sometimes we help bring acts to them.

CORNISH: Corporately and world-wide, we try to look after each other. Let's just say we can probably exert more influence on the record companies we're related to than others. Consequently, we can probably do more for the talent when we have that mutual involvement. That point should be underscored.

#### You inked American Music Club to a publishing deal, yet they signed a recording contract with Warners here in America and Virgin in the U.K.

CORNISH: When we got involved, the negotiations for the record deal had already begun. Obviously, that was one of the attractions to us... the fact that important companies like Warner and Virgin had seen fit to commit to them. We felt Mark Eitzel was a writer who is going to go somewhere. We've got to be able to work with all the record companies. But, where possible, we prefer working with companies within our own group.

## The publishing companies are getting very aggressive and competitive in signing new talent.

SANDOVAL: There's no question publishers have to get involved on an A&R level. It is part of our responsibilities to give the writers we represent a creative working bench to do all kinds of things, whether it's writing for soundtracks, finding them bands to produce, getting them a record deal or tracking down appropriate writing partners.

#### Placing songs in movies and commercials has become a huge part of the business.

CORNISH: We've got three people who do nothing else but pitch film and TV. The best thing about it is, directors, producers and music supervisors are looking for up-and-coming bands to put in their motion pictures. So groups

like the American Music Club, for example, will be naturals for film. SANDOVAL: We just signed the Outfield and we've already had a tremendous amount of film and TV synch use on the song "Winning It All," which is going to be their next single. We've already had two television uses, a film use

and a video use.

SANDOVAL: There's no doubt that publishers will become more and more active in discovering ways of breaking new talent aside from the radio.

CORNISH: We've just put together a package that lists songs in our catalogue, from 1900 through the present, with nine CDs included. We send it to film producers, commercial advertisers, etc., and the reaction has been fabulous.

There's a pretty large gap between the top two music publishing companies, Warner Chappell and EMI Music, and yourselves. CORNISH: Yes, but we're bridging that gap. When you consider that, internationally, we've just signed U2, INXS, the Beastie Boys, k.d. lang and Body Count, you can see how aggressive we are in building up our market share.

SANDOVAL: Not to mention Billy Ray Cyrus, Pearl Jam, Bon Jovi and Sir Mix-A-Lot.

CORNISH: PolyGram is into video, records, publishing, motion pictures and PolyGram Diversified Entertainment has further expanded the holdings in Broadway musicals and pay-per-view TV.

#### PolyGram has really been rejuvenated as a company.

CORNISH: I give full credit to Alain Levy. The internationalism he's instilled in his senior executives is fantastic. He just won't settle for not being the best all over the world. He's put the right people in place at the American record company. Between he and Eric Kronfeld, they've changed the whole face of the American PolyGram operation and have done a great job. Further, with David Hockman at the helm of PolyGram Music Publishing Worldwide, PolyGram continues to assert itself as the leading international publisher, as most

indicated by our recent growth. SANDOVAL: There's an overall cooperation now. You've got all these creative people in all of these key positions and everyone's helping one another win. From every aspect — film, music, publishing — they're all working together. CORNISH: There's no question now we're hot in a big way, and not just in records. In publishing as well as films, we're showing we can be as competitive as anyone.

## Where do you see music distribution going over the next decade?

SANDOVAL: I think it's just a matter of time before we're sitting at home in front of our terminals ordering up the records we want to listen to, either via the phone line or fiber optic cable. The problem is, how do you market and sell it? At some point, record stores will become obsolete. CORNISH: I think this is part of PolyGram's rationale behind going after publishing in such an aggressive way. Regardless of technology, if you own the rights to the master or to the composition, you're geared for anything. The future is there for you. It's like owning a piece of real estate.

## What is your attitude towards using rock music in commercials?

CORNISH: Much depends on the quality of the ad being put forward. I can understand why some songwriters and acts don't want to be involved in just any ad.

#### How about "I Still Haven't Found What I'm Looking For" as a Preparation H spot?

CORNISH: [Laughs.] You shoulda been a journalist!!! In my experience, commercials have never hurt the value of any song copyright. Take a song like Jim Webb's "Up, Up and Away." I've heard that song in many countries being used for commercials and you still hear it as a golden oldie on K-EARTH. Films are seen by people as a little less offensive. Today's movie directors have a keen ear for today and tomorrow's music. They want Pearl Jam in their films, knowing by the time the

movie's released, they could have a hot band on their soundtrack.

#### Will labels start their own soundtrack divisions in the future, as Epic has just done?

CORNISH: Now that PolyGram's heavily involved in the motion picture business with Working Title, Propaganda, A&M Films, Interscope, etc., we'll begin to do that more and more. The name of the game in the entertainment business is owning the rights, owning your backyard, not renting it. We want to be involved with people in the long haul. We're not

meetings with songwriters, helping set up collaborations, helping administrate the staff, keeping the film and TV department focused on various projects, going out, chasing bands. It's all the administrative and creative sides rolled into one.

#### In this post-rock era where most bands write their own material, do many artists still approach you looking for songs to cover?

SANDOVAL: We're still very much involved with that. We have had songs on albums by

a growing catalogue and copyrights that should be covered. So, when you finally give up being a journalist — which may not be too far away — you can come and work for us.

SANDOVAL: Is that a job application in your pocket?

## Do either of you want to follow the lead of Charles Koppelman and go into the label side of the record business?

CORNISH: Any publisher who really has his heart in this business wants his acts to be successful and sell lots of records. I want my acts to happen and I'll bend over backwards to do whatever it takes. I'm not a frustrated head of a record company or an A&R man. I'm a creatively oriented businessman. And you can't run a business in this industry without being creative. I just want the talent I'm connected with developing to its fullest potential. That's why publishing is unlike any other business in the entertainment field. You can get involved with something at its very embryonic stage and watch it develop. And our part of it is to nurture that talent with whatever resources we can bring to it. It doesn't have the high profile or the big bucks that the record business has, but I find it's equally as interesting. I'm more than happy to do music publishing, and if I'm half as successful as Charles Koppelman, I consider myself a great success.◀

## How large is the sheet music aspect of the publishing business?

CORNISH: Right now, probably less than 10%. We lease our print rights to a print publishing company called Hal Leonard. I'm not saying the income is insignificant, but it's not growing very rapidly because technology is changing. People are buying videos, CD ROMS, computer software... everything but sheet music.

### What's a typical day like for Mike Sandoval?

SANDOVAL: I might be involved in going over a rough sketch of a negotiation with a lawyer. Then, there's a tremendous amount of



I've always found it somewhat curious that so many seem to equate on-air personality with wordiness. As I say this, I realize that I'm stepping into a minefield because I'm dealing in opinion and not hard fact. You may be perfectly at home with a jock who, in my opinion, just talks too much. (Howard Stern, anybody?) When I tune into a music station other than at morning drive time, it is to hear music and a little personality. One can say a lot in a few words. Keep it short and effective like a welldelivered karate punch. A certain East Coast radio friend told me it drives her nuts to hear lots of superfluous on-air chatter. For example, phrases like "Those were the sounds of ...," "The music of ...," "The name of the song is..." and "Hello, this is J.J."

are all redundant. Not to mention unnecessary connecting words between live events (spots, PSAs, etc.) such as, "Lemme tell ya about..." and "...and..." Listeners only know what you say and they hear. What you don't say ain't said, so it can't hang you. (Ed. note: Hunh?) When going from live event to live event, a modest change of attitude will indicate to a listener that you just changed subjects. Of course, the same rule of thumb could well apply to certain trade magazine columns, but that's another story. Hey, it's just one jerk's opinion... By the way, Chante Moore's debut single, "Love's Taken Over," by all indications, will be huge and Nona Gaye's "I'm Overjoyed" is one helluva debut. Later.

TIME FOR A **CUP OF JOE** AND A DOUGHNUT WITH WAILING **SOULS** BY SEAN O'NEILL

For singers Pipe and Bread, the creative mainstays of Wailing Souls, it's no problem, mon. They've seen

Il Over The World," the new album by Wailing Souls, is sure to shock some of the aroup's longtime fans. For even though Wailing Souls built an international following playing rock-solid roots regade, "All Over The World," as the title suggests, is an ambitious collection that takes its inspiration from a wide variety of sources. Roots reggae is well represented here, but so are gospel, rap, R&B and rock & roll. As Wailing

Souls' first record for a major label, and first for the new Sony-distributed Chaos imprint, there's an unusual amount of weight on "World."

tougher times. Brought up in Trenchtown, Jamaica, they came of age under the tutelage of the legendary reggae artist Joe Higgs, along with another of Higgs' students, the late Bob Marley. After serving an apprenticeship as backup singers for the Skatalites, they performed and recorded as the Renegades, Pipe & the Pipes, and the Classics before establishing themselves as Wailing Souls. A string of Jamaican hits soon followed, including such reggae classics as "Firehouse Rock" and "Bredda Gravalacious." They live in L.A. these days, a long way from their humble beginnings, so Pipe and Bread were taken particularly aback by the sight, sound and smell of **HITS'** own resident trench-dweller Sean "Uh" O'Neill.

Do you worry that some of your old fans will think the new album is too pop-oriented?

PIPE: Some people say, "Oh, him gone commercial." It's only because we want to reach a wider body of the people. So the people can really know what we say. When we were small, we were writing all different kinds of songs, but we didn't record those songs, 'cause we know that reggae is what is going on. BREAD: And that is natural from lamaica, our natural music. But music don't have no boundary. The roots, the reggae music, that's us. If you listen to the album, it's there also, but I mean, you have to improve. You have to be innovative in this business. You cannot be doing the same thing, like eating one food all your life. Too much of one thing is no good. What was Trenchtown like? PIPE: Trenchtown is a college, see. And it's also like a ghetto.

BREAD: Yeah, like a prison, too.

PIPE: It's one of the roughest places you can grow up as a youth. But at the same time, it's one of the nicest places you can grow up, because you get so much wisdom from the people. It's like, when we were growing up, you know, you have bad guys and you have

good guys. Well, the bad guys, they protected us, 'cause they loved to hear us sing, you know? Nobody couldn't do us nothing, 'cause they know that all we do is music. BREAD: And everybody loves music. Whether you're a good guy or a bad guy. PIPE: Music is the spirit of life.

You guys seem committed to Marley's idea of "One Love."

PIPE: We have to sing about love, because we see how beautiful the love is, and how great the love could be if people could just understand each other and come together. We know the depths. We are coming from the depths. BREAD: We come out and say,

"One Love," because we know what is going to happen without "One Love." Holocaust without "One Love."

PIPE: We can't have peace without love. Love comes first, and then everything comes after. Our mother is love, and love forever. All of us is a peer. You have man and woman; you have black, you have white. The father who creates us all is not partial. See it? I don't know about race. I don't know 'bout class nor creed. I don't know about all that. I know about people. And if you know the true love, boss, the true love is something that's forever. Happiness forever.


#### Why did you make this musical move toward the mainstream?

BREAD: We're just spreading out some more. Trying to improve the music, trying to make it better. Get more people coming after it. 'Cause as you know, people are hypocrites. They talk about wanting to hear roots reggae, but if you turn on the radio, you don't hear it! So what are musicians supposed to do? Die from hunger? Most reggae artists are just pure hustling. Live shows keep them going. They don't see royalties. Those are the type of things we want to turn around. That's why we have to get more commercial, so more people can hear what we are saying. Then they will hear the roots stuff, go to the stores and look for that. We will always be playing the roots stuff. We try to keep the type of fans that we have right now, but we also try to get new ones. You know what I mean? New converts. PIPE: I would like all the Wailing Souls fans that have been waiting for us such a long time to hear us on the road again. We are back, and we are back for good. And you can always look for the good music from us. And to our new fans: If you don't know, you will know. BREAD: Yeah. That is all we have to say, except for, as usual, one love, one heart. You know what I mean?

Suzanne Vega, "99.9 F" (A&M): When Suzanne went into the studio with Mitchell Froom, rumors of her "industrial" album ran fast-and-furious. What actually emerged was an amalgam of aspects of her artistic output, from "Small Blue Thing" to DNA to seeing Peter Gabriel in concert (polyr-

hythmic textures galore) to exploring all of these ideas with truly seasoned players. "In Liverpool" and "As Girls Go" is Vega at her most gifted, reminding me why I've always hoped she'd play me in the movie of my life. I'm not worthy.

Screaming Trees, "Sweet Oblivion" (Epic): The most appropriate critque for the Trees previous elpees is "Great, but does not work up to potential." Maybe they've overcome "fear of success," or perhaps Mark Lanegan is finally comfortable in his role as a frontman - whatever the psychological victories



have been, it all reverberates through "Sweet Oblivion." Drummer Barrett Martin and the towering Conner brothers provide a "post-SST, yeah we live in Seattle" superstructure for Lanegan's both ferocious and contemplative lyrics. A triumph.



Shriekback, "Sacred City" (World Domination): In the early eighties, founding members Barry Andrews and Dave Allen honed from their jaw-dropping pedigrees a type of creativity that shines the pages of Post Modern with a glow that has lasted. "Sacred City" picks up that sneaky, sexy magical

wand and conducts music of symphonic complexity as of yet unheard in the nineties. "Signs" and "Hymn" are Melody and Lyric sashaying down the altar of a rhythmic wedding, while "Below" and "3AM" aurally depict their titles. (MC)

David J, "Urban Urbane" (MCA): David J, who we initially learned about through Bauhaus, and who still remains to anchor PoMo faves Love and Rockets, is one who's able to successfully wear a lot of hats. On his fifth solo work, David doesn't cease to tint every dark shade in that gothic-coloured



musical rainbow (a la New Order/Killing Joke), while giving the album a good dose of his own pizazz and upbeat personality. Enlisting Max Eider (Jazz Butcher) and Sonic Boom (ex-Spacemen 3) on guitars, "Some Big City" is the urban send-off for this roadtrip through America. (Meredith Chinn)



## RERAP

Lots of stores around the country have opened at midnight to sell Springsteen, Michael Jackson or Guns 'N Roses, but none to our knowledge have opened up at 12 a.m. to sell Mojo Nixon. Until this Monday, of course, when Repo Records in Charlotte, NC, will open to sell "Horny Holidays," Nixon's new Xmas album. "We're proud to have the world premiere of the new Mojo record," says Repo owner Jimmy Parker. "We only open at midnight for the big releases." The store will be advertising the opening with print ads and late-night television commercials. Nixon, who will be in concert in St. Louis that night, promises to call the store during the event. "We'll probably just bring a phone up on stage so all my Missouri fans can talk to my North Carolina fans," says Nixon. "I bet Bruce didn't call the stores that opened for him.".... Lots of response from indie store owners (as well as by NARM President Arnie Bernstein in the September issue of the org's newsletter) to the recent Rolling Stone article which insists that record stores are no longer visually exciting, don't stock breadth of product and have

uneducated employees. One retailer comments that because he isn't in a major metropolitan area he "can only get display material on certain artists that are available through my onestop. And if I don't send in pictures, they want me to pay for the posters!" Because he isn't a direct account, he says his calls to the regional branch of many labels and distribution companies go unheeded. even after he tells them he can't get material through the one-stop. Off The Record's Steve Hotchkiss believes "some of the points in the article were valid and some weren't." He points out that his store and many others offer a special order service and get many obscure titles for their customers in a matter of days. Another retailer says believes indie store employees do know their product and challenges music execs who think otherwise to "go to a bookstore and see how many of those salespeople have heard of Kurt Vonnegut or Philip Roth, let alone Tom Clancy or Ken Follett".... Meanwhile, lots of titles appearing higher on the charts at indie stores than at chains and mass merchants. Current releases by Ministry, Morrissev and Sonic Youth appeared in most indie Top 10s the week of release and still reside among the elite-selling titles. The soundtrack to "Singles" sold well out-of-the-box and continues to appear among the four or five best sellers in most indie outlets, and the Spin Doctors kicked in at indie retail at least three weeks prior to its current strong chart movement. Other titles which have shown continuously strong sales at indie retail include k.d. lang, Helmet, L7 and Suicidal Tendencies. And yes, these same stores are selling the new Eric Clapton, Bobby Brown, Garth Brooks and Warrant.
