
Besides giving away the secret of "The Crying Game," this year's Oscar nominations in the music categories were.... well, they were nominations. In the Best Song category, noms went to "Beautiful Maria Of My Soul" from "The Mambo Kings";
"Friends Like Me" and
"Whole New World" from "Aladdin"; and "I Have Nothing" and "Run To You" from "The Bodyguard." Best Original Score nods went to "Aladdin," "Basic Instinct," "Chaplin," "Howard End" and "A River Runs Through It." A Lifetime Achievement Award in the Best Score category went to Geraldo Rivera for his masterful score of Margaret Trudeau.

What started at the AMA's, continued with the Inauguration and the Super Bowl and climaxed with a moonwalk with **Oprah** has resulted in a *very* resurgent "Dangerous" at retail. In the meantime, the single, "Heal The World," has picked up serious sales steam as well as a slew of major Top 40 adds, including Z100, Q105, WEGX, PRO-FM, WNCI, WXKS, WIOQ and others.

But the main story is "Dangerous." This week, the album jumps 35-15 on the HITS Top 50 Albums chart behind strong sales in *every* region of the country.

"Since the Oprah interview, sales have dramatically increased, with 'Dangerous' going 30-13 on our chart," said Strawberries' Michael Kaupp, who cited "the public's improved perception of MJ."

"It's just berserk! What more can I say?," screamed Larry Webb of Music City one-stop and the Cats retail chain. Naturally, Larry ended up saying more — "I'm seeing movement on the entire catalogue," he bellowed.

Meanwhile, ABC estimated that 90 million people watched at least part of the Michael/Oprah interview. In addition, one million of those people have attempted to buy the elephant man's bones. And who could blame them?

## **Buziak To Helm Sony's Tri-Star**

Sony Music has launched the TriStar Music Group and named industry veteran **Bob** "And Weave" **Buziak** President of the new label, reporting to Sony Music President **Thomas D. Mottola.** 

The TriStar Music Group will release and market repertoire from Sony Music International affiliates to the U.S. marketplace and will sign non-Sony foreign artists for release in the U.S. The label will be distributed through Hollis, Queens-based Relativity Entertainment Distribution, half of which is owned by Sony Music.

Commented Mottola: "The Tri-Star Music Group will broaden Sony Music's presence in the U.S. by providing an outlet for some of our international artists to receive their own special focus outside their home territories. And, more importantly, it will give Bob a chance to pile up some serious frequent flier miles."

Buziak was most recently President/COO of the Elektra-

distributed Chameleon label. Prior to that, he was President of RCA Records, where he signed such new acts as Love & Rockets, Cowboy Junkies, Michael Penn and Peter Murphy. He was also Arista's International and U.K. managing director and had his own management and production company.

Commented Buziak on the appointment: "The most im-

#### **Callout Discussed**

While we are always in support of the airing of active music — defined here as records that sell and those that receive phone response — there is also a place for the callout hit, which appeals to the audience that doesn't actively search out its music, but responds to it over a period of time. When these callout records are properly used by stations in their music mix, they help stations have an overall sound and feel that enables them to "flavor" in active smashes like Snow (EastWest/Atl G), Digable Planets (Pendulum/Elek), Silk (Elektra), Paperboy (NP/Isl/PLG), etc. The most successful programmers use callout on currents as simply a part of their evaluation mix, watching most closely for burnout on overplayed hits. It is, however, in the evaluation of recurrents to give a station the proper flow that separates "the men from the boys."

So, we spent some time checking with key information sources, and without giving away any trade secrets, have compiled the following list of a dozen guaranteed recurrent callout winners. While the individual songs will come as no startling revelation to PDs, this list should be interesting as a whole to all, and as new information to those outside radio circles.

## MAN

#### IN THE MIDDLE

an Diego-born basketball star Bill Walton is the stuff of legend. Recently elected to the Basketball Hall of Fame, Walton followed Lew Alcindor (Kareem Abdullabbar) at UCLA and re-

wrote the school's record books as a member of two NCAA championship teams, earning All-American honors all three years he played varsity ball, during which the team compiled a record of 86-4. The #1 draft choice of the Portland Trailblazers in '74, his professional career was stunted by frequent injuries, but he did manage to lead Portland to an NBA title in '77 and was the league's MVP the following year. As a member of the Boston Celtics' '85-'86 champions, he was

winner of the NBA's prestigious Sixth Man Award.

He also played with the San Diego/L.A. Clippers from '79-'85.

f Bill Walton was just the sum of his basketball accomplishments, he would still be pretty impressive, but he's so much more. Overcoming a childhood stutter, he has emerged as one of the leading analysts in the game as a TV color man for the Clippers, Dallas Mavericks and NBC's NBA coverage. He also conducts coaching clinics and basketball camps and appears in a very visible Reebok commercial that debuted during the



Super Bowl and features his one-time prodigy Shaquille O'Neal. lways a non-conformist, the once-pony-tailed Walton was a hippie among jocks in the NBA, a major rock & roll fan from way back and a renowned Deadhead. Bill has recently entered the music business with a new venture, Bill Walton's Rockin' Club Red Jukeboxes, CD-stocked jukeboxes targeted for bars and restaurants which debuts this month in the San Diego market. Later this year, he'll become a recording artist himself with the release of a double-CD/cassette instructional

hoop recording, "Men Are Made In The Paint"
(Issues Records), produced by Harvey Robert
Kubernik and featuring Doors' keyboardist (and
fellow Hall-of-Famer) Ray Manzarek as musical
director. Among those contributing liner notes are
such unlikely bedfellows as Jerry Garcia and Kevin
McHale. Additional projects from his ex-coaches
John Wooden and Jack Ramsay and legendary TV
broadcaster Charlie Jones will follow,

which he's co-produced with partner Kubernik.

alton took some time out from his hectic schedule to jam a few shots back in the face of his old pal, HITS' resident bard of the backcourts, Harvey "Above The Rim" Kubernik.

#### FIRST OF ALL, WHO'S GOING TO WIN THE NBA CHAMPIONSHIP THIS YEAR?

Every time you start thinking about somebody else winning it all, Michael Jordan steps up and has the kind of game he did against Portland the other day. When Michael plays like that, it's difficult to imagine anyone else winning. There are a number of other teams that have good solid chances. I like the Knicks and Cleveland in the East. Also, Charlotte and Orlando, but they may still be some players away.

In the West, the talk has been Phoenix all year. Never count Portland out, even though they've had a difficult year by their standards, but they've still got a tremendous amount of talent and depth. They've got the best defense in the West and they've got a chance to still make lots of noise. There is some thought Portland might have lost their window of opportunity to get their championship with this current team. Phoenix has had the best record in the league all season. In Charles Barkley, they have one of the best players in the NBA. When they have that, you've got a great chance. They've got tremendous talent at all positions although their weaknesses could be defense and rebounding, and possibly in their set offense. Those are three areas where you have to shine if you are going to win the NBA championship. The play-offs is not about race-horse basketball. It's slug-it-out half-court set offense. The teams are too good by the time you get to the very end. Utah, San Antonio and Seattle are three other teams with a legitimate chance.

#### HOW ABOUT THE L.A. CLIPPERS?

They sure have been enigmatic this year. Lots of expectations, a disappointing start and some of the new guys didn't show up in the best of shape. Stanley Roberts is a promising prospect, who is just starting to come around. When they play well, the Clippers can beat anybody. But it's a mystery as to what it is that makes them play well. I believe both the Clippers and Lakers will make the playoffs, though.

#### HOW ABOUT THE NCAA'S?

I picked Duke at the start of the season. I really like Bobby Hurley and coach Krzyzewski. The most fun and entertaining team in the ACC aside from Duke is Florida State. They have a lot of potential, one of the best coaches in basketball in Pat Kennedy and a truly brilliant non-statistical key in Charlie Ward. Indiana has a very solid team and Bobby Knight. Every five or six years, he wins a championship, which just goes to show you, coach Knight is into rock & roll and understands the notion of rhythm. When it's tournament time, the teams have to raise the level of their game. They have to value possession of the ball, which is why I don't like the way Michigan has played this year. You have to open it up and be more assertive, which is why I like Duke.

#### HOW DO YOU LIKE BEING A TV ANALYST?

It never gets boring. It's the same as being a player. It takes preparation. You gotta be ready. You can't be 15 minutes late. I am the first person in the arena, three hours before hand. I'm trying to become a total broadcaster. One thing I really like about this year's Clippers broadcasts is that I've been around a bit now and there's more a sense of a team. When you do every game with the same people, you anticipate what they're going to do. You get their timing and rhythm, so when I'm preparing, I think about what they will be doing and how to get them to set me up.

The play-by-play guy is like the playmaker. He's the [former UCLA All-American] Greg Lee, the Larry Bird. The color man, the analyst, is the finisher, the Kevin McHale.

#### YOU ARE NOT AFRAID TO SPEAK YOUR MIND AND CRITICIZE INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS.

When somebody throws a good pass, I'll say it. If someone isn't getting it done, I'll say it. I don't know any other way. I've always been taught to question authority, speak my mind and think for myself. If you look at my basketball career, you can say that I've had two main guys as my mentors, John Wooden and Jack Ramsay.

In the world of broadcasting, Charlie Jones is the guy I ask questions about technique and execution. He found me my first agent and also the speech therapist I worked with when I first started out. I also work with my producers as closely as possible. It's easy for me to be a critical broadcaster because I've been so criticized myself. When you're a top player, and you lose the game or a championship, you're a bum. But you learn to accept that.

What I've learned most from Charlie Jones is the ability to be calm on the inside while excited on the outside. Because you have to be.

I bring notes to the game. I'll come in with a stack of material two feet thick and whittle it down to five or six pages of one liners. I also love the telestrator. It's a fabulous tool that allows the fans to understand the game better. The key in viewing basketball is not to watch the ball, but the whole screen. That takes years of training.

#### OF ALL THE MAJOR SPORTS, BASKETBALL IS PERHAPS BEST SUITED TO THE $\ensuremath{\mathsf{TV}}$ SCREEN.

That's because it's on a small court, you can see the players and the goal at the same time and the ball is big. Also, the players don't wear hats or helmets. And the game is fast. The players are people you can relate to. Personalities like Magic Johnson and Larry Bird brought the players into a new era of media relations and carried the game to the next level because of their ability on the court. The players of tomorrow will even be better because of seeing Jordan, Magic, Bird and Isiah on TV. The real question is, will the players of tomorrow maintain the values and the work ethic that Magic, Bird, Isiah and Jordan have? Will they maintain the sense of responsibility toward the quality of this great game? Will they keep it moving in a positive direction rather than just being in it for the money and the hype?

#### HOW DO YOU FEEL ABOUT THE EVOLUTION OF THE NBA GAME INTO ONE OF INDIVIDUAL SKILLS RATHER THAN TEAM PLAY?

The teams that win championships play team basketball. The teams that don't, don't. There's nothing like being on a winning professional basketball team. It permeates every aspect of your life. You just have so much confidence, great feelings, respect and loyalty for your teammates and your team. Even on losing teams, you always believe that you are going to win. That's the only way to stay sharp, to keep it fun and exciting. But once you lose that belief that you're gonna win, it's time to either move on or quit.

#### HOW HAVE THE ENORMOUS SALARIES OF TODAY'S PROS IMPACTED THE GAME?

It's lowered the sense of urgency, the level of competition and made people friendlier to each other on the court. I'm a big believer in the other team being the enemy. Some people break their neck every game. Jordan is playing better than ever as he gets richer than ever.

#### WHAT DO YOU THINK OF SHAQUILLE O'NEAL?

[LSU coach] Dale Brown brought me down to the school a couple of years ago to work with Shaq as a consultant. I talked and worked with him on every aspect of his game. He was a great student. Attentive. He

hasn't exceeded my expectations, but I have pretty high expectations. This is a phenomenal talent and person. The world is his stage and it is up to him as to how far he'll take it. There's no limit. In the pros, they are letting him play more, whereas in college, he got in foul trouble. But every player, no matter how good they are, needs coaching to get better.

#### WHAT IS BILL WALTON'S ROCKIN' CLUB RED JUKEBOXES ABOUT?

We're leasing our jukeboxes to bars and interested individuals. Every place gets its own customized programming. We guarantee any CD stocked within four days after order. Because I live on the road, after a long hard day, I like to chill out at a bar over beer or a glass of wine. And, the problem for me is, in most of the bars, I don't like the music that's playing. So I said to myself, "I gotta get music into bars the people I know really like." This is our first month and we're based initially out of San Diego [Call 1-800-B WALTON for information]. My own jukebox is wired to my home stereo system, with Neil Young, Bob Dylan, the Rolling Stones and the Grateful Dead all plugged in.

#### WE KNOW YOU'RE A BIG MUSIC FAN. WHEN YOU WERE A MEMBER OF THE BOSTON CELTICS, DIDN'T YOU INTRODUCE SOME OF YOUR TEAMMATES TO THE DEAD?

The Celtics always teased me about being a Deadhead. Naturally, none of them had ever been to a Grateful Dead show. So one night, I took Kevin McHale and Larry Bird to a Dead gig in Boston for my birthday. Afterwards, some of the band and crew came over to one of the Celtics' practices. Mickey Hart even wears a Celtic warm-up jacket in the video of the Dead's "Touch Of Grey." Later in the season, the Dead were going to play outside Boston, and I talked to the guys and they made special arrangements so the team could be seated in an area near the stage for the show. Just about the whole Celtics team came, even Chief [Robert Parrish], but Danny Ainge's wife wouldn't let him come. There was a moment when Jerry Garcia looked over at Larry Bird and started to play, like "This is how we do it," and they went on to jam for four hours. It was a magic moment for me because the Grateful Dead have been such a huge part of my life for over 20 years, and I think my friends and teammates finally got it. When I played in Portland, I was friends with the son of the PA announcer at the Coliseum. I would bring Dead tapes and cassettes to be played before the game. When we came out for warm-ups, they'd play "Truckin." When I was in Boston, the organist at the Garden learned to play a bunch of Dead songs.

#### WHAT ARE SOME OF THE SIMILARITIES BETWEEN THE DEAD AND A BASKETBALL TEAM?

Creativity, team work, speed. You don't know what's gonna happen from one moment to the next. It's not scripted. The Grateful Dead are like a basketball team in that the guys who stir the drink are different every day and there's a tremendous inter-team competition. I've seen it be Bob Weir or Mickey Hart, Danny Ainge or Scott Wedman. Basketball teams play in many of the same arenas the Dead do. It's really fun when I go to a game now as an announcer and the security guards and ushers will stop me and say, "Bill what are you doing here? The Dead

aren't playing tonight."

#### HOW WOULD YOU COMPARE JERRY GARCIA AND LARRY BIRD?

Brilliance in performance is the main similarity. Commitment. Passion for work. Jerry Garcia is not one of those guys who sits around thinkin', "Gee... I just can't wait for this to be over." He just wants to work everyday. For people like Garcia and Bird, there's never enough. A lot of guys wish there were 82 games each season and some wish there were 50. Garcia and Bird both have the hunger, desire and creativity to never be satisfied. They always believe they can do better. The real beauty of Garcia and Bird is that when they see somebody else has gotten it done, they come back the next time better than ever. I just saw Jerry's first show after a long hiatus and, at 50, he is playing better than ever.

DOES THE INCREASING USE OF ROCK MUSIC DURING BASKETBALL GAMES AFFECT THE PLAYERS? Music has a big role in the game. It creates an atmosphere. When you pipe in that loud pounding bass drum and rock music, you're talkin', like Spinal Tap said, "To 11." Music gets the fans going and great home crowds help your performance. The crowd knows it has a role in helping the team win. You can't put a number on it. No matter how far you've gone, they can take you farther.

#### HOW DO YOU FEEL ABOUT BEING ELECTED TO THE BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME?

It's the ultimate honor any player can have. I always chose winning over statistics as goals. To be selected along with great players like Julius Erving is an honor. Years after your active career is over and you've fired up your last jumper, grabbed your last rebound, or made your last back-door pass, it says, "This guy was important... this guy could do it." I have to look back and give credit to the five people who shaped my career and are already in the Hall of Fame: John Wooden, Jack Ramsay, Lenny Wilkens, K.C. Jones and Red Auerbach. My game is the product of their teaching.

#### WHO'S ON YOUR ALL-TIME TEAM?

Bill Russell, McI Iale and Bird on the front line, Magic and Michael Jordan in the back court. On the team I would pick to beat 'em would be Wilt Chamberlain, Rick Barry, Elgin Baylor, Dennis Johnson and Isiah Thomas.

#### YOU WERE A BIG FAN OF BILL RUSSELL.


Bill Russell was always my favorite player growing up. My parents got me his book, "Go Up For Glory," 30 years ago and I still have the original copy. One of the first sports books I ever read. I admired his competitiveness and willingness to do whatever it took to win the game.

#### THE PORTLAND CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM YOU PLAYED ON REALLY WAS MORE THAN THE SUM OF ITS PARTS.

The beauty of that Portland team was that it was a team that was not only respected for its court accomplishments, but its style of play. That team came real close to fulfilling its coach, Jack Ramsay's vision of basketball. It wasn't the most physical of teams; it was a team that was based on speed. Yes, Maurice Lucas and I were aggressive front-court players, but the physical quality that set us a part was our team and individual speed. Lionel Hollins, Larry Steele, Bob Gross and Dave Twardzik could fly up

and down the court. Their anticipation and their playing off the strengths of Lucas and myself underneath the basket, defensively and offensively, made it a team that couldn't be beat.





## Afom TIME FOR SOME cober's and Mr. Pibb

#### with NED'S ATOMIC DUSTBIN by TOM LANHAM

IT'S A CHEMICAL THING.

When the five jittery Joes who

comprise Ned's Atomic Dustbin aet dose to each other on-stage, there's this unexplained explosion of kinetic kablooey, sort of like a pinball machine on permanent tilt. Voxmeister John rebounds off the sexual thud-thump of two — count em — two bassists, Alex and Mat, while guitarist Rat and drummer Dan plug any remaining gaps with a joyful rhythmic noise that never fails to set crowds on fire. Through their first two albums — the 300,000+ selling "God Fodder" and the flip new funkfest "Are You Normal?" the childhood pals who comprise Ned's, barely 21, are riding a dizzy rock rollercoaster around the world and having a ball.

RAT AND THE VAGUELY criminal-looking Dan are hanging around backstage on an umpteenth American assault, and they handle interviews — except for a few giggles, knowing winks and ribcage chickenwings — like old pros. The first order of business? Food, and they know exacty what to order. "Domino's!," the duo yells in unison to a road manager, who promply scurries off to a pay phone. "That pizza better be here in 30 minutes, too! We're timing it!" And who should show up, pie in hand, than HITS' own delivery boy,

#### What would the future have held for you if you hadn't formed Ned's?

Tom "The Piper's Son" Lanham.

RAT: University, probably. The thing is, we've never had proper jobs. I had one for four weeks, then I left it and went back to college. It started off with me trying to be something, but ended with me sweeping the factory floor. I thought, "Fuck that!" We all went to college without any intentions of finding a job at the end. Everyone just applied to get a grant, and you leave with a degree in drinking. In our case,

Ned was there waiting when we got out. Were you surprised by the success of

#### "God Fodder"?

DAN: When the success does happen, you don't notice it anyway because you're just rolling along, doing what you're doing. And



you don't really get the chance to sit down and realize, "Oh, we've sold 50,000 albums in this country, or whatever,"

#### At 21, not many people are sitting backstage in some foreign land, discussing their lives with journalists they've never met before.

RAT: In a way, we've been lucky, because we've been doing this since we were 17, and we were 18 when we started breaking in England, so we've really grown up as part of it. It was fucking hilarious when we were 17 or 18... we didn't have a clue. But since we've grown up with it, we've done nothing for three or four years apart from this. You just get used to it.

#### What was Japan like?

RAT: The first time was very freaky. The second time, it was a pain in the ass. The weird thing about the Japanese is that they won't leave you alone; they're always hanging around. It's fun, but at the same time it gets very embarrassing for us, because we haven't got a clue where to hide.

DAN: It's outrageous. You wouldn't believe it! When you leave the stage,

they cry. They go to the airport when you're going home and cry there, too. WE USUALLY END

RAT: They probably cry because we're so ugly. They're tears of

happiness because we're finally leaving. But since we've done all this

traveling, we have become world-wise. I can't imagine any of us getting a real job now. I don't know what the fuck I'd do. I'd probably go back to college again for another two years.

#### What makes something like "Legoland" or "Not Sleeping Around" a Ned's Atomic Dustbin song?

RAT: It was pointed out by our producer that — if the five of us play on it — it's always gonna be a Ned's song. And recording this time was much better than doing "God Fodder." There was a great deal of pressure, but we also had more time to experiment. We recorded

in some very nice places, like Rockfield, Chipping Norton, all over. DAN: "Not Sleeping Around" is really old, one of the first we wrote after "God Fodder." So it's an in-between song, which is why we

released it as the first single. I think the newer material is a lot better than our old stuff.

#### Just out of curiosity, how many different T-shirts have you guys come up with over the years? There was one great tour one which said, "If you missed Ned's, then you fucked up!"

DAN: It's a pretty good slogan. Like our album title, which was taken from a book Jonn and Mat saw in the psychology section of a bookshop. There was nothing on the spine, just the words "Are you normal?" We love slogans. We used "Be silent, consume, die" as a backdrop for the last English tour; we saw it written on a bridge wall somewhere in America. And there've been over 70 different T-shirts to date.

#### Some faves?

RAT: "We've talked about it - now let's fuck."

DAN: Yeah! That's a good one! We're also particularly fond of your Goobers, those peanuts in chocolate. We find them quite

amusing, like Mr. Pibb. Alex was getting some refreshments, and the first one he got was Goobers, and he needed something to swill 'em down with, so he bought a Mr. Pibb — that's so amusing.

#### Onstage, you've got such great chemistry. Do you hang around together offstage as well?

**DAN**: Where we live, there's nothing else you can really do.

RAT: Back home, we usually end up sitting in a local pub together night after night. Everybody's got to have a local, a pub where the barmaids know ya and the other drinkers know ya. And, no matter who you are, they still won't ever give you any free drinks.

I told them emphatically, "NO!," and Dave said, "Great, we'll expect 600 words on Roy's desk by Friday. Congratulations." The upside is I'll be seeing all of you at NARM and the downside is the only credit card they're trusting me with is from Chevron... I guess I'll start off with some major league retail butt kissing here... Steve Lerner of CD One-Stop informs me of an erroneous report by my predecessor, Mitch (a good friend and a very cool guy with some of the best Kings tickets you'll ever see). It was reported that, in order to take advantage of the CD One-Ston/Soundscan bonus promotion, an account had to buy \$100,000 worth of product from CD One-Stop. Steve says that no product whatsoever need necessarily be purchased from them (although there are incentives to do

Steve Libman of Atlanta's Nova Distributors says that their business is up 40% over last year, but declines to attribute it all to Justin's decline. Steve says that quality of product and a healthier economy have to be factored in as well. Justin's GM Bill Norman (formerly of BIB) stayed in Atlanta, going to One-Stop Record House. They have been focusing in recent years on their retail business (Sight & Sound and Peppermint), but with Bill coming in, they are now looking to revitalize the one-stop. At least one of Justin's sales reps has moved to Abbev Road's Atlanta office, and now rumor has it that Justin's warehouses have been purchased by Mike Goldwasser and Mike Parkerson of Starship Records/Record World. They reportedly need the space for their retail and rack-jobbing but will they also take a foray into the one-stop business? Says Libman, "We all go back a long way. Atlanta's a big town and there's plenty of room for everybody."... We hear that Sound Warehouse is going to pull all rental video product from stores located anywhere near corporate-owned Blockbuster video outlets. Stores that are near Blockbuster franchises (who own their own inventory) will not be affected... Well, if reaction at retail from the Super Bowl halftime show is any indicator, let's all brace ourselves for the Post-Oprah interview era of sales on "Dangerous"... And talking about a reaction record, Ron Simms at Abbey Road calls to scream "PAPERBOY DELIVERS!" Yo Ron, don't give up that high-fiber diet...






