Holiday Spirit Drives Country Radio

Country stations from coast to coast are busy making the season brighter for their listeners. Here are just a few things stations have been doing.

- KFRG/Riverside got a winning bid of \$10,000 for an X-Box 360, with proceeds benefiting the "Spark of Love" toy drive for Southern California firefighters. The winning bidder returned the X-Box to the station, which donated it to the local Ronald McDonald House.

- KFKF/Kansas City's 2005 Toys for Tots Toy-a-Thon featured personality **Dan Holiday** once again home-staying on a rooftop. This year, though, he had some company from artist **Chely Wright**. The pair descended from a local Wal-Mart roof when the goal of 9,400 toys had been met. Wright then performed for about 400 donors. Subsequent donations have raised the total to more than 10,000 toys for the Marines' campaign. Holiday denies secretly wishing the goal had never been met.

- KASE/Austin teamed with an area dry cleaning chain to collect more than 30,000 coats during a Coats for Kids drive, which also included a competition among schools. The stores served as drop-off locations and cleaned the coats. The drive ended with a huge distribution day, when needy families brought their children to select coats.

- KKQB & KTHT/Houston held their second annual Cure Kids' Cancer radiothon to benefit Texas

- **Dec. 23:** R&R's final issue of 2005. The Country section will feature the format's first-quarter music releases.

- **Jan. 4, 2006:** The first R&R Country Hotfax will arrive that morning. We'll update all the news that took place over the holidays and highlight the singles going for adds on Jan. 9.

- **Jan. 6, 2006:** R&R's first issue of the new year, a news-only edition with no music information.

- **Jan. 9, 2006:** The first reporting day of the new year. Adds from Mediabase-monitored stations and reports from R&R Indicator stations will be taken from Thursday, Jan. 5, until Monday, Jan. 9 at 3pm ET. You'll get an R&R Country Hotfax on Jan. 10 with this music information.

WROO Heads To New Roost

Clear Channel/Jacksonville's Country and Alternative stations have swapped frequencies, with Country WROO heading from 107.3 to 93.3 and WPLA (The New Planet Radio) movin' on up to 107.3. CC/Jacksonville OM **Gail Austin** says of the flip, "WROO retains full market coverage and continues to serve our metro audience. No changes to format or staff."

The 107.3 signal is licensed to Jacksonville with 98kw at 991 ft. The 93.3 frequency is 50kw at 463 ft. and licensed to Callahan-Jacksonville. Callahan is to the north of Jacksonville.

The Jacksonville Country lineup now features WROO at 93.3, CC sister WQIK at 99.1 and WGNE at 99.9.

CBS Radio Talk WBZZ-AM/Tampa will return to its WQYK-AM call letters and begin simulcasting with Country clustermate WQYK-FM on Jan. 1.

Midas/Nashville Dir./National Promotion **Bob Reeves** recently set out to become the first promoter to ever visit every reporting PD in one — albeit rather major — trip. He intended to personally deliver invitations to Midas' launch celebration to each and every reporter, from border-to-border and coast-to-coast.

With the label's debut release set for mid-February, Reeves figured he had just short of 10 weeks to get the job done. Well, he got started a couple weeks ago in Portland, ME and ran through Boston and Springfield, MA; Providence; Hartford; Burlington, VT; and Albany, Syracuse, Rochester and Buffalo, NY before he began feeling ill. On a detour home to meet with his doctor, Reeves was diagnosed with a severe bout of diverticulitis. So much for the trip.

it's playing about 900 titles, "many of which are from country's heyday of the '90s and aren't on the radio in Denver." New calls will be KWLE.

Willie's music mix includes two currents, a new current and two hot recurrences an hour, in addition to country legends. Plus, there's one "reach" record an hour — a pop cut that's compatible with country. Garrison and CBS Radio/Denver VP/Programming Keith Abrams are looking for a PD and an entire airstaff.

Country is not new to Denver's 92.5 dial position. You may recall that "Big Dog" KZDG debuted in January 1993 and morphed into "Z92.5, the home of Denver's most country" in March 1995. It headed to the pound for good when it dropped Country in February 1996. Various upgrades over the last few years make it "a much better signal today than when it was 'The Dog,'" Garrison says. Willie is pointed directly at Jefferson-Pilot's KYGO, which has been No. 1 12+ the last three Arbitrons.

Sebastian Heads to Windy City: Cumulus co-Format Director/Country and WSM-FM (The Wolf)/Nashville PD **John Sebastian** was named PD of CBS Radio's WJMK (Jack FM)/Chicago. He starts Jan. 16, 2006. Sebastian joined WSM-FM in August 2004. His background includes programming stints at WLXX/Lexington, KY; Country KZLA/Los Angeles; CHRs KHJ/Los Angeles and KDWB/Minneapolis; Rock WCOZ/Boston and KISW/Seattle; and Smooth Jazz KTWV/Los Angeles. (RRCD, 12/14.)

Geoffries to Greenville: KSD-FM/St. Louis PD **Steve Geoffries** transferred to Clear Channel/Greenville, SC, where he will be OM for the cluster and PD of Classic Country-Country combo WESC & WSSL. He starts in early January and succeeds Scott Johnson, who exited in August. (RRCD, 12/14)

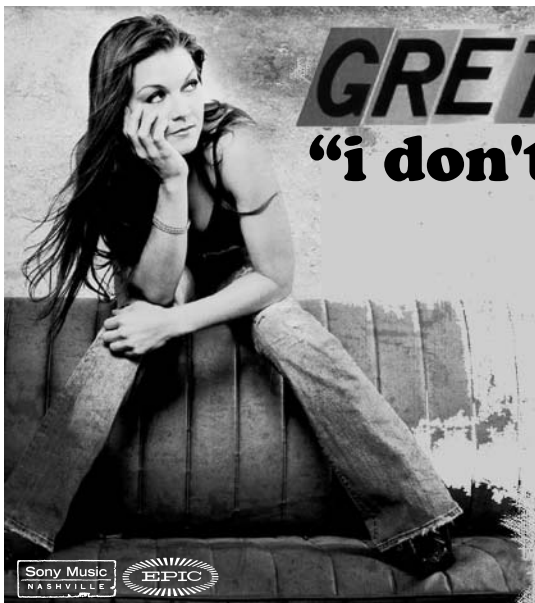

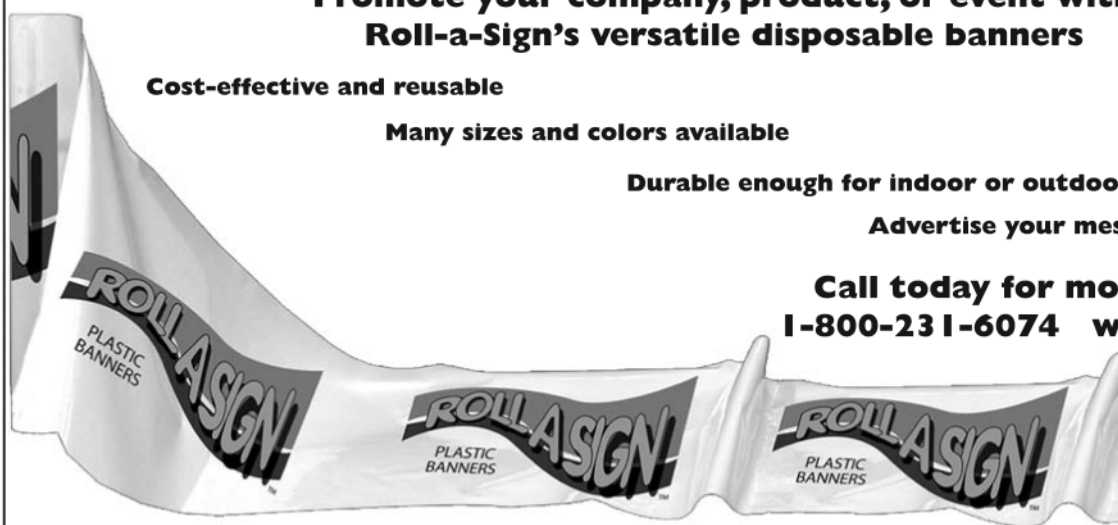
