CONCEPTS

Verbal & Non Verbal Communications

Speaking out of both sides of its collective mouth the record industry is out to bite its own rear end.

This issue of Walrus contains reviews of 139 new releases. These are all records released in the last <u>two</u> weeks. Aside from shattering all records for output in a similar period in our eight year history, it also shatters any notion of common sense.

Forget about talking art. Plenty of good music is around. Let's just talk business.

An incessant whining has been heard from the record industry for several years now which decries tightening radio formats. First, it was the offenses of Top 40 radio and now it includes both pop and progressively pop radio. Where can we introduce a new artist?

The crying also notes the tightened venue situation. Fewer concert promoters will take chances on the unproven. There's no place for an artist to work.

Together the tightening radio scene combined with the tightening concert scene means new artists are being choked off. That's the argument.

Why then are we being saturated by infinitely more music than can be absorbed? Especially, in the light of the production costs. It's suicide.

To recoup the expenses the record industry is in the midst of raising prices to the customer again. The price rise is, as they say, to cover the skyrocketing production costs but, those costs are a result of overproduction. Too many albums are being made. At these production prices the industry cannot indulge itself as is. At these retail prices the audience cannot indulge itself either.

It doesn't take a PHD in Economics to see the output must slow down. Remember Life magazine.
