OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Their Lp's have been characterized by the precision with which they were produced, but, as demonstrated by this show, this tempering effect was due entirely to their producer, Martin Rushent. On stage, their style could best be described as brutal, and the intricate keyboard work which highlights their two excellent Lp's were buried in the noise.

CONCEPTS

THE NEO-UNDERGROUND MOVEMENT

The underground is reborn. That is the reality expressed in a recent conversation with a retailer who operates a weather vain store. He sells lots of what radio programmers might call esoteric music. His reading of the current scene is valuable.

Through his eyes one sees a whole world of music enthusiasts who have developed their own communications network and a set of musical values which cannot be ignored.

Two kinds of people are involved. One kind is old hippies who, then as now, prefer outside music. They are the heart of the mass of imported record buyers who have made European recordings an inexorable part of the American scene. Electronic music is a central focus of these people.

The other element in this musical sub-culture is younger. These people have no connection to the past. Woodstock means nothing. The music associated with it is old fashioned to them in spite of its continued dominance in media.

These people are the new anti-establishmentarians. They are buying singles with picture sleeves and singles with "B" sides which are not on a given group's album. They are having fun collecting records, something that our generation has long since flushed.

Through magazines like Trouser Press, Bomp, Zip Zap, Slabh, and N. Y. Rocker the word gets out on up and coming releases and other obscurities. The reviewers in these publications are needed as a means to cut through the crap.

Things you should know:

- (1) The first Sex Pistols single is going for \$50 a copy.
- (2) The heir apparent to the Sex Pistols' throne is The Clash.
- (3) Color vinyl is over - as soon as the big companies jumped on it, it went out of style.

This kind of ground swell might be the basis for the next radio format.

- Bonnie Bramlett/MEMORIES/Capricorn CPN-0179 (Deke Richards has given back to Bonnie that raucous, rockin', gospel feeling which the old Bonnie & Delaney Lp's had. The choice of material is excellent, the presentation a little busy.)
- Tom Brash/PORTRAIT/ABC AB-1055 (Country touches, solid song selection and a funky rock rhythm combine to show Tom off in the best light. He has the earmarks of a strong club entertainer. Down home and nice.)
- J.T. Brown/WINDY CITY BOOGIE/Pearl PL-9 (J.T. Brown's music is a rambunctious kind of boogie blues. It is so urban that its rural roots are totally obscured. Much of it sounds like 1940's music which laid the foundation for the rock and roll music which emerged in the next decade. Distributed by Delmark.)
- Ron Carter/PEG LEG/Milestone M-9082 (Cozy. Ron's music is both thoughtful and soulful, a duality which many of his contemporary acoustic players cannot manage. The music is appealing though it does not invest itself with much intensity.)
- Johnny Cash/I WOULD LIKE TO SEE YOU AGAIN/Columbia KC 35313 (Johnny writes the same few songs over and over again. But, they are solid melodies which, by this time, hold a special place in the American litery. One more time.)
- DeGarmo & Key/THIS TIME THRU/Lion & Lamb LL 1037 (DeGarmo and Key aren't a unit. Key is a guitar folk rocker and DeGarmo is a Keith Emerson keyboardist. They fight it out throughout the record. The settings for each track, taken individually, are nice. Weaknesses are in the singing and in the Christian writing. The message gets in the way sometimes. Write: 9255 Sunset Blvd., Suite 519, Los Angeles, Ca. 90069.)
- Doctors of Madness/United Artists UA-LA 871-J2 (This Lp combines the two English Lp's which have been previously reviewed. Mystique surrounds Doctors of Madness. Names like Kid Strange and Urban Blitz must have made for a weird baptismal. Mr. Blitz plays the violin with the same audacity it took to take that nom de plume. In spite of some melodramatic arranging their music shows talent and freshness.)
- Flame/RCA AFL 1-2690 (Marge Raymond is faking a harsh voice mistakenly. She has a super set of pipes - as exemplified by "Shadow In The Night" - and she should value them. Real is better than artificial. The band delivers potent thrust behind her and the writing is O.K. too.)
- Richie Furay/DANCE A LITTLE LIGHT/Asylum AE-115 (Heavy handed orchestrations and built up backgrounds fail to completely overwhelm Furay's Lp because the beat and the guitars were not suppressed. Still, some excellent songs are not given the space to breathe and to express themselves. Each song was not given individual care within the total context. The result is more a forced flow production, than a free flow production. Toward the fringes.)
- Gale Force/TWC/Fantasy F-9551 (The Gale Brothers show talent as players and as writers but, they are unable to project an individual identity. They bleed in, in a world which requires standouts.)
- Steve Hackett/PLEASE DON'T TOUCH/Chrysalis CHR 1176 (Pretense is a crippling state of mind. Steve conjures up an extremely dense album when a few great songs were all that was needed. Layers of arranging ideas and melody ideas, ideas upon ideas make a decent album and a colossal effort feel cumbersome sometimes.)
- Eddie Hinton/VERY EXTREMELY DANGEROUS/Capricorn CPN-0204 (A raw Eddie Hinton belts out the traditional music upon which the entire rock 'n' roll tradition is built. His race record concedes nothing to modern arrangement styles and yet remains highly very extremely dangerous.)
- The Isley Brothers/SHOW DOWN/T-Neck JZ 34930 (Tightly wound and electrified, The Isley Brothers spin another funky web. When their songs are right, they invite you in. Whistle their funny suits.)
- Memphis Slim/U.S.A./Pearl PL-10 (For blues fans and those interested in the basis for much of what is progressive today, here is Memphis Slim. These obscure and previously unissued sides lay down some easy to digest urban blues. They are surprisingly well preserved. Distributed by Delmark Records.)
- John Miles/ZAPAGON/Arista AB 4176 (What you hear is craftsmanship. The first level is made of the neatly devised songs of Miles and Marshall. The second level is the precise presentation and production guided by Rupert Holmes. While there are no mistakes there is little in the way of spontaneous combustion.)
- Morningstar/Columbia JC 35316 (Heavily compressed, Morningstar's dynamic range is reduced to midrange exclusively. It'll make anything sound like an AM radio. The group's midwestern power band formula adds nothing new to the genre. It is based on adequate writing.)

- New Grass Revival/TOO LATE TO TURN BACK NOW/ Flying Fish FF 050 (Too Late is recorded live at a bluegrass festival at which New Grass must have turned some heads. Leaders in progressive bluegrass music, the band is not content with old formulations. Though they can handle them right well, they use tradition as a starting point.)
- Robert Nighthawk/BRICKS IN MY PILLOWS/Pearl PL-11 (If you have never heard Robert Nighthawk, this record will be a treat. People like B. B. King listened to his slide guitar playing. His singing can grab you too. Fine material makes him ripe for the likes of Leon Redbone. Distributed by Delmark Records.)
- Rainbow/LONG LIVE ROCK 'N' ROLL/Polydor PD 1-6143 (Compared to some new wave bands, Rainbow is rather musical. They used to be hard to take. Actually, the writing in this Lp fits their style very well. Further, as intense as the performance gets it never obliterates the music.)
- Ian Thomas Band/STILL HERE/Atlantic SD 19167 (A beautiful production yields a bright, sonically appealing album. Ian placed his easy songs in a clean musical context to match the sonics. Solid on all levels.)
- Various Artists/SOUNDTRACK - ROCKY HORROR PICTURE SHOW/Ode SP-77031 (This music was reviewed in the stage show album. It seems that the performances here are better - more secure. Still, it is fairly obvious that the music works better after you've seen the movie. Meat Loaf sings one song. The Lp is selling heavily in the U.S. underground scene.)
- Frank Wakefield & The Good Ol' Boys/BLUEGRASS/ Flying Fish FF 049 (The mountain feeling is recreated faithfully by Wakefield and crew. Pretty good songs form the basis for a pleasing backwoods set.)
- The Tim Weisberg Band/ROTATIONS/United Artists UA-LA 857-H (Johnny Sandlin puts a big, grooved rhythm, rather than the rock rhythm, behind the band. It takes you on a marvelous cruise but, it tends to overpower Tim's flute. That is the same problem most of Tim's Lp's have had. The tunes are pleasing.)
- Pete Warnick/DR. BANJO STEPS OUT/Flying Fish FF046 (Some pretty righteous picking and a phase shifter put Pete in a class by himself. Like a train winding around the bend Warnick's steadiness just keeps on coming. He takes the banjo beyond its normally narrow definition.)
- Mike Williams/FREE MAN HAPPY MAN/B. F. Deal BFD66 (Williams crosses the folk gamut from an out of style boonany sound to a favored country folk style. The more Texas influences him, the better off he'll be. Mike's writing is naturally rounded. Write: 608-B.W. North Loop, Austin, Tex. 78751.)
- The Writers/Columbia JC 35297 (Studio players who go for the big time, a foreground position, have consistently had weak names - The Section, Stuff, etc. - and weak songs. Here The Writers change nothing on the first count while they do show some ability in the second area. "Hey Babe" is quite a good song. Of course, all of these bands are noted for fine playing and The Writers stay with the best of them in that regard.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Eclipse/NIGHT & DAY/Casablanca NBLP 7097 (Half way between. Their own writing is less than captivating, it dominates a rock centered side two. Side one is disco flavored, featuring several former hit songs. They are not given new life. Eclipse is good at generating a mildly spacy ambience. They would do best going all the way into the disco field instead of hoping that everyone will love them.)
- Josh White, Jr./Vanguard VSD 79406 (Many mediocre Lp's are saved by a producer and a studio band. Here is one case in which the producer lost it. Decent songs, a decent singer and some fine players still result in an anemic performance. It sounds like lots of studio-time conserving first takes were used.)
- Woody/JUST FOR YOU BABE/Flickory HB-44009 (Look behind the ancient cover art. A few moments on side one are worth a listen. But after the third track things start to fade into mush. Side two is a total washout, weak songs and performances undo it.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Edwards & Ralph/Ariola America SW 50022 (Peter Yarrow's production is fast becoming synonymous with a folk-MOR sound. Pretty voices, bright guitars and abundant sweeteners demonstrate how much things stay the same in spite of change. Yarrow hears it one way.)
- David Fathead Newman/CONCRETE JUNGLE/Prestige P-10104 (Classy elevator jazz is what comes out of the end of Fathead Newman's horn. Pride in craftsmanship is deserved with credit to William Fischer's arranging and conducting.)

(These records which, in our opinion, deserve special mention because they come closest to perfecting their musical genre regardless of progressive radio application.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Al DiMeola/CASINO/Columbia JC 35277 (Though it is easy to get pulled in by the intimidating grade of musicianship, the tune is still the thing. Al keeps the fusion torch sparkling with uplifting melodies and with lots of rhythm movement.)

Les Dudek/GHOST TOWN PARADE/Columbia JC 35088 (He's got it going both ways, Les is a top notch guitarist at the same time that he possesses a super singing voice. He also is able to write a quality song. Wrongly, he likes to bury his voice in billowing production. "Central Park," "Gonna Move" and "Does Anybody Care" stand out.)

Brian Eno/BEFORE & AFTER SCIENCE/Island ILPS 9478 (Eno is a known eccentric. He comes inside enough to use the 3 minute song format while he infects the songs with his eccentricity. More than just good, each song becomes an adventure. Imaginuity.)

Jethro Tull/HEAVY HORSES/Chrysalis CHR 1175 (The rediscovered, resilient Tull sound of last album maintains itself in Heavy Horses. Ian's post-traditional rock seems to lean into the wind. That attack is the key to the delivery system. It helps fine tunes get a good ride.)

David Johansen/Blue Sky JZ 34926 (Crossing the Stones and new wave yields the current Johansen hybrid form. Though none of the songs which follow "Funky But Chic" get off the same way, the attitude of the whole album hits the mark. "Lonely Tenement" is special too.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Frankie Miller/DOUBLE TROUBLE/Chrysalis CHR 1174 (With Jack Douglas producing, Frankie's music hardens somewhat and he is pushed to sound Rod Stewartish. That is all fine because the underlying power of his songs guarantees success. Frankie Miller sings with an internalized rhythm and blues tradition to anchor his every inflection.)

Carly Simon/BOYS IN THE TREES/Elektra 6E-128 (A better collection of songs - when taken as a whole - than Carly usually delivers. Arif Mardin's production never falters, so except for some excess sweetening, the album comes off with an air of class. A notable attention to detail prevails.)

Ringo Starr/BAD BOY/Portrait JR 35378 (Such a good pop album. Bad Boy wraps around Ringo like a cellophane suit. The choice of material is central, while the arrangements surround and encase Ringo's basic singing voice. Vinnie Poncia's production is perfect for the occasion. Fun.)

U. K./Polydor PD 1-6146 (For a symphonic rock amalgome they are not overly pompous. Their tunes are the standard polyglots which we have heard before from these types. It is this band's robust playing which generates the dynamism. The list of bands from which Bruford, Wetton, Holdsworth and Jobson come is impressive.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Auracle/GLIDER/Chrysalis CHR 1172 (Auracle is a band of jazz and rock fusionists who take a little from the many who ran the gauntlet before. Some from Chase, Weather Report and 'Trane yields another thing. Produced by Teo Macero, who has worked with Miles for years, Auracle sounds whipped into shape. You may not whistle their tunes but, you will whistle their playmanship.)

Bobby Bare/BARE/Columbia KC 35314 (Though he has been around for years, Bobby is part of the new country spirit, the real country spirit. Many of the right names contributed to his new album, too. But, the biggest contribution is made by ten round, naturally honed songs, most written by Shel Silverstein.)

Dickey Betts & Great Southern/ATLANTA'S BURNING DOWN/Arista AB 4168 (The first Betts solo album hit a responsive chord because it rekindled the old Allman Bros. feeling. This album, while it is very nice, does not move with quite the same spark. That is not to say that it fails in any way.)
