life isn't essy. There are few cases where a simple solution solves a problem. Last issue's Concepts dealt with the apparent bankruptcy of Top 40 radio. Audiences thifting, en masse, to the FM dial has caught Top 40 flatfooted, unable to adjust. Can you imagine that most Top 40 stations still don't know how to use albums effectively. Couldn't they see the switch to an album consciousness

The answer is that they could but, that their response to it was the wrong one, the only one they were conditioned to use. They were trapped in a shrinking playlist syndrone. Ever since Bill Drake's tight playlist concept was successful, in the mid-sixties, the single Top 40 response to a competitive threat has been the tightening of the playlist one more notch. That has been their response over and over again as FM radio, and all competitive pressures, have pushed in on them.

But, life isn't easy and the bubble finally burst. They had tightened up to the point of strangulation.

The lesson teaches how necessary it is to avoid the kind of rigidity in thinking which leaves only one response to all problems. Tightened playlists were a great innovation for Top 40 radio in the '60s and for progressive radio in the '70s. They helped, in both cases, to focus the sound of the formats, to make the respective formats better sources of communications.

However, just as too much medicine can kill a patient, so to can ever tightening playlists kill off radio. There has to be a balance.

Our real fear is about the future of album radio. We see Our real fear is about the future of album radio. We see evidence, in its beginning stages, of the same sort of rigidity developing that has been a factor in Top 40's difficulties. Lots of fine albums get little or no airtime while Xerox copy, 2nd and 3rd generation groups fill the air. For example, Lps like the current Lou Reed album or the Herb Alpert/Hugh Masekela album deserve more attention than they get. They are only examples among many.

We are not suggesting that these kinds of records should get equal play with the hits or that the hits are lesser musics. We are suggesting that there are 168 hours in a week and that that amount of time isn't compatible with rigid thinking in a music policy. We are suggesting that after a format has been tightened there is a point at which further tightened there is a point at which further tighening begins to work negatively.
