OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

There's been a flurry of activity at 'BRU with Providence's pressure cooker weather increasing everyone's adrenalin flow these days. Most important around town was Newport Jazz '78 held during the weekend of the fourth, and WBRU's attempt to develop a National Broadcast Network for the Sunday show. Read more about this in Bill Dobson's comments in this issue. It's said that close only counts in horseshoes, but we did come very close and learned very much. We did find that with proper care, motivation and advance planning (it just can't happen in two weeks without divine intervention) activities like the National Newport Jazz '78 Network can become realities. The advent of new AT&T long-line service now makes large networks with good sound quality possible as never before. The future does indeed look good for these exciting activities and it deserves our serious attention. Please call Bill or myself and we'll tell you all about it. I was very pleased and impressed by the wonderful response we received from all the stations and most of the label people involved. Their advice and support was invaluable. Special thanks to Sam Kopper of Crab Louie/Starfleet Studios.

BACK TO THE LOCAL SCENE: Recent live broadcasts have featured area artists Steve Rizzo and Sammy Brown (check Country Paul's comments on Sammy Brown in the last issue); an undefeated softball squad; and a fine time at the fronton for our second WBRU Newport Jai Lai Night. (An unexpected 25 cent beer night the same evening added to the fun.) Records, T-shirts, and a guitar were waiting for those 'BRU listeners in attendance.

That's the scene; finally, check out the new David Gilmour album - fine LP.

Sunday night, July 2nd, three or four million people across the country missed their opportunity to hear a live simulcast of a superb jazz concert. They don't know how close they came. Unfortunately, time constraints, unreliable cost estimates from AT&T, and less significantly, problems with artist/label relationships finally broke the camel's back. The point, though, is that is WAS possible - a wild pipe dream can still become a reality in AOR radio. The only necessary ingredients are energy, determination, a GM willing to swallow an enormous phone bill and a good idea. Twenty radio stations, including some who normally play very little or no jazz, were willing to commit hours of their air time to the presence and future of jazz in AOR. It is clear that when we exert collective influence, record companies are

Willing to bend their business needs toward OUR collective needs and desires. All WEA stations, especially non-commercial stations, have parallel activities, needs and problems. Increased "openness" - exchange and communication - can only have a positive effect on both individual stations and the entire genre. WUSA and WEA have a long history of fruitful cooperation even though we compete for a position of our audiences. Unless folks start copyrights and promotional ideas, there's no reason not to share them with the AOR across the state or on the other coast. WUSA will give a record album to the first caller at (401) 772-9250 with an idea, a rare tape or just an interesting topic of conversation. Does it take THIS to tap our collective resources? Finally, WEA - Los Angeles is interested in putting together a similar network for music festivals on the West Coast.

Paul said, thanks to Sam Kopper of Crab Lark Studios, the Mancini Brothers, and all the folks I spoke with on the phone for your enthusiasm, support and cooperation. We came pretty close on very short notice to pulling it off. If we work together, next time it WILL happen.

CONCEPTS

THE LANGUAGE BARRIER GOES TO COURT

WBAL-FM took its first amendment fight to the Supreme Court and lost. The court ruled that George Carlin's "Seven Words" routine as played on the air at 2 o'clock in the afternoon was citable by the great white FCC.

On the negative side the ruling upholds the right of the FCC to impose itself, after the fact, in programmatic decisions. Though that seems to contradict the Radio Act's intentions, the framers of the Radio Act probably never thought anyone would have to make a decision about those seven words.

Meanwhile, on the more positive side the Commission was not absolute in its ruling on the use of any language. They seemed to make a point of stating that the time and the

situation were considerations in their thinking. They seemed to be saying that Carlin's routine, played at 2 PM, was a gratuitous use of obscene language. That late at night or in the context of something dramatic or poetic, like maybe a song, there might not be the same sanction on the use of some of the very same words.

That is an important distinction which has a bearing on very practical decision-making processes in everyday situations.

Still, in an increasingly complex world this ruling, like the Bakke case ruling, seems to go in both directions at once. On one hand, they say you can't say it, while you might be able to if its said in an appropriate situation.

Life isn't easy.

- The Sonny Stitt Quintet/Finite FIN 1978-1 (Mainstream jazz played by one of its luminaries has musical flow and a self-confidence which isn't found too often in nature. Sonny Stitt surely fits that description, he defines it. Easy.)
- Conway Twitty-Loretta Lynn/HONKY TONK HEROES/MCA 2372 (A strikingly consistent batch of tunes get an exuberant reading from Loretta and Conway. There is no pressure, they sound like they had fun making the record. And best of all, the arrangements are pure country without any of the excesses.)
- Various Artists/BLUE NOTE MEETS THE L. A. PHILHARMONIC/Blue Note BN-LA 870-H (Bobby Hutcherson fails to take the leadership of the orchestra. Carmen McRae fits comfortably in front of it but, is an MOR singer at this point. Finally, Earl Klugh gets overwhelmed by the orchestra's size, except in his solo number. The Lp is O.K. but the orchestra doesn't get used as anything more than sweetening machine. That tends to work against both the featured artists and the orchestra.)
- Venus & The Razorblades/SONGS FROM THE SUNSHINE JUNGLE/IMP 7004 (Professional character Kim Fowley has invented Venus & The Runaways, sorry, Venus & The Razorblades. If you read all of the jazz that comes with the Lp you'll find a line which places the band's music accurately, "they do respect both Patti Smith and The Ramones." Well it's not as good as either reference and theirs is a question of believability. Imitation punk is pop.)

- Hamiet Bluiett/ORCHESTRA, DUO & SEPTET/Chiaroscuro CR 182 (In both the orchestra and the septet format Hamiet's music is turbulent. It swirls yet, follows a direct course which helps to keep it cogent. In contrast his duet with Don Pullen is a warm, even melancholy, excursion.)
- David Murray/LIVE/India Navigation Co. IN 1032 (David Murray's music is a good place to start investigating new music. He delivers an unmistakable avant jolt yet, he manages to do it with a sense of humor and without being heavy-handed. He moves you inside and outside.)
- The Revolutionary Ensemble/Inner City IC 3016 (Outside. The Revolutionary Ensemble's last Lp as a working group defines their name. They start playing beyond the melody. The listener is asked to accept their music, with the assumption that a tune was there. They can weave a spell.)

Although the first two sides were written by Mary Lou, the indelible mark of Cecil Taylor fills all four sides of this album. Ms. Williams properly calls Taylor the "Giant Of The Avant Garde." No one is in his league.)

- Shakin' Stevens/Track 2406 011 (As the 50's revival continues in England it gets no small advance from Shakin' Stevens who is the 50's. Vital, powerhouse remakes of classic songs will stimulate the juices of old rock and roll hands. Merit Plus.)
- Turning Point/SILENT PROMISE/Gull GULP 1027 (There are vast numbers of jazz groups, even whole schools, which have so involved themselves with the philosophy of what they are doing that their focus is totally inward. Their joy is derived from the skill and the ideas which they try, not from the music itself. That is the outward slant about which a group like Turning Point seems less concerned. Merit.)
- Various Artists/AKRON COMPILATION/Stiff GET 3
(From this record you might get the impression that there exists a vital music scene isolated in the backstreets of Akron, Ohio. If you can judge by one or two tunes there is some talent stuck in these tire tracks. Merit.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- The Brothers Johnson/BLAM!/A&M SP-4714 (They do the same thing everyone else does but, they usually do it better. Hotter funk, purer melodies and creative arrangements make the combo of the Brothers and Quincy Jones remarkable. Go Blam! the quality of the songs isn't as consistently high as on previous Lps, although the other elements remain steady.)
- Bill Champlin/SINGLE/Epic-Full Moon JK 33367 (The vast majority of the material which Bill Champlin has sung throughout his career has been second rate. Single is no exception. Likewise, Bill has always worked in an exuberant musical environment. Single doesn't change that either. The performance is top notch.)
- Chilliwack/LIGHTS FROM THE VALLEY/Mushroom: MMS 5011 (Acoustic guitars and vocal harmonies spread a veil of warmth over rumbly Chilliwack songs. Few groups have made as much good music for as long as a little public acclaim. Consistent.)
- Contraband/NOTHING TO HIDE/Portrait JB 35450 (When it is all stretched out Contraband is a journeyman rock band, but not more. They work in an old style with Owen Orford's near-scream vocals coming from behind the fuzz rhythm. It's the Black Oak type formula reworked.)
- Eric Dolphy/THE BERLIN CONCERTS/Inner City 3017 (When Dolphy plays the music reaches a higher melodic state as it strikes a contemporary chord. The players with him are solid support but, no competition. Recorded 17 years ago, the music still has a bite to it.)
- Dennis Doyle/CHANTELEER/Reynard #1001 (Wisely Dennis' homegrown doesn't try to get too fancy. It stays within proper dimensions. His folk and folk-rock music is pleasing. It is based on decent Doyle songs and a forthright presentation of them. Write: Box 143, Tualatin, Oregon 97062.)
- Michael Johnson/THE...ALBUM/EMI America SW-17002 (A crystalline production searches for the sweet side of recorded perfection. Johnson's voice is worth the attention. He sometimes sounds like a vocal improvement on James Taylor. Michael goes outside for material, leaning heavily on Bill LaBounty. Material is the area where questions can be raised. If looking for outside songs the whole world is available so why are 3 or 4 of the songs included here less than world class quality?)
- Key Largo/SANER DAYS/Mercury SRM 1-3726 (Almost all of their tempos are down. So that decent Key Largo songs tend to drag especially without more creative arrangements. There is no contrast, nothing in the support and nothing in the texture. Blah but competent.)
- Bonnie Dobson/WILD AND RECLUSE/Epic JC 35254 (Joel Dorn tries to make arty albums. This one has Dorn earmarks throughout it - something jazzy, something serene, something old and something pretty. His use of the orchestra isn't too offensive in what is truly an easy listening record. Whether it is a radio record is another question. Bonnie's voice is beautiful, especially in "Lucky Suite.")
- Kenny Loggins/NIGHTWATCH/Columbia JC 35387 (The voice of Kenny Loggins is a rare moment. However, the songs he is pushing through it are not as weighty. Even with arranging details by Bob James they don't have the sound of eternity.)
- Wilbert Liggins/SUNNY SIDE UP/Columbia-Tappan Zoo JC 35365 (This formula is so smoothly executed. The N.Y. studio regulars lay down a rock solid cradle and Wilbert lays his mellow guitar stroke right in it. It is perfect but creates new space. Instead it exists in the same time and space as many other things. Not a xerox copy or a clone, this is both original and non-original at the same time. It's science fiction.)
- Joanne MacCall/United Artists UA-LA 878-B (Here we have quite a good voice in an as yet unresolved musical setting. Joanne is given little of the stylistic underpinning which could take her voice and make out of it an indelible, individual sound. Her songs are O.K. "Ain't About To Love You" approaches that higher level.)
- Randy Meisner/Asylum GS-140 (A startling mix places Randy's voice behind the work. This concave mix, which should have been convex, robs presence from the lp. The high point is an exercise choir of material and the presentation of it. Mixed emotions.)
- Navarro/STRAIGHT TO THE HEART/Capitol SW-11784 (Navarro is a band with a comfortable west coast type mellow rock'n'roll feel and a good name. Their tunes are listenable but not soul stirrers. John Palladino's production sense is felt.)
- Karl Ratzer/N SEARCH OF THE GHOST/Vanguard VSD 79407 (Ratzer is a new name in jazz guitar circles and he is a name to note. He is disciplined, possessed of a good ear and fond of rhythm movement. Nothing here is mind wrenching but N Search is a very impressive first album. Karl goes both ways, acoustic and electric.)
- Thin Lizzy/LIVE & DANGEROUS/Warner Bros. 2BS 3213 (In live context Thin Lizzy is an interesting blend of street rock and the older blazing hard rock form. With or without the thunder, Phil's songs can reach top notch. The recording quality, if graded for clarity, is a 5 on a scale of 1 to 10.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Trickster/Jet JZ 35478 (A very upbeat, sometimes preheated Trickster attacks the pop-rock medium. They bring together lots of ideas from elsewhere as they try to live up to the quality of their name.)
- Various Artists/CALIFORNIA JAM 2/Columbia FCG 35389 (Rather good recording clarity marks this two record documentation of the second California Jam concert. Only side 2 is musically muddled, the other sides are surprisingly entertaining.)
- Various Artists/MONTEUX SUMMIT VOL. 2/Columbia JC 35090 (The liner notes mention the schism between acoustic jazzers and electric jazzers implying that the differences were resolved, at least, for this recording. Not really. There are both kinds of tracks on the album and for the fractionalized audience a few sides for each camp. Side 3 is the hottest.)
- Vasant Rai/AUTUMN SONG/Vanguard VSD-79414 (The idea of integrating Eastern and Western music isn't new. However, Vasant Rai gives the exchange a new delicacy. His melody lines are subtly lovely, "Bhairvi" develops into a powerful jazz statement.)
- Wilding-Bonus/PLEASURE SIGNALS/Vista DMP 7003 (Terrific rhythm enhanced by a full dynamic range recording propels these Pleasure Signals. Melody isn't given the same priority yet, there are still some interesting things going on to keep your attention.)
- Zion Mountain Folk/GRASS ROOTS MUSIC/Light HS-5745 (Bluegrass for the Lord. Zion Mountain Folk's pick pleasing tunes which happen to look ahead. The important point is that the music works on its own, with or without The Message.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Joanne Brackeen/TRING-A-LING/Choice CBS 1016 (It is easy to understand why an old bo-bopper still plays be-bop years later. It is less easy to understand why a young talent is playing in a style which has already made its statement. As good as Joanne is she is not going to advance Caper Peabson.)
- Cockrell & Santos/NEW BEGINNINGS/A&M SP 4712 (It's only the pop arrangement garnishes which keep Bud and Patti out of the rock mainstream. The idea of a male/female duet isn't explored enough these days. Good pop-rock.)
- Mattias Cole/LIVE/Capitol SBEL-11799 (The album doesn't win any awards for presence and it should not have been a two record set. Still, tucked inside are tracks of some interest - they rock. Listen to sides three and four to find the meat.)
- Buddy DeFranco/WATERBED/Choice CBS 1016 (Poor Buddy is one of the best players on an instrument which needs a comeback. The clarinet sounds old fashioned and with the accordion accompaniment it gets close to a wedding reception.)
- Bunky Green/VIBRONS/Vanguard VSD-79413 (On the very first track "Alone Again Naturally" Bunky shows us the distance which he can cover. We have to wait for the middle of the second side to hear it again. More hot sauce.)
- Johnny Hodges/AT THE SPORTPALAST, BERLIN/Pahin 2620-102 (Hodges has assembled a small big band in what might be called an Ellingtonfest. Much of the music is 40 years old and jumps along to the delight of this German audience. Still it's a less intense rebirth.)
- Carl Jackson/OLD FRIENDS/Capitol ST-11760 (Alternating between quality country picking and lush folk-MOR, Carl projects a dipole image. The majority says he wants to be a pop artist. The tunes are O.K.)
- J.J. Johnson & Nat Adderley/THE YOKOHAMA CONCERT Pablo 2630 109 (The union of J.J. and Nat makes for pleasing harmonies. Their mainstream thrust is easy to absorb anyhow but, the trombone-trumpet duo adds to the enjoyment.)
- Lori Lieberman/LETTING GO/Millemium MNLB 8005 (Undoubtedly Lori's best album. Grafted and musical it places her at the forefront of hip-MOR songstresses - Helen Schneider, June Oliver, etc. A position she should have been in years ago.)
- Eather Phillips/ALL ABOUT/Mercury SRM 1-3375 (Every Eather Phillips lp tries to make her a contemporary artist. Producer after producer takes the shot almost always working against a great natural blues talent. If the backup followed her instincts art would be preserved.)
- Candi Staton/HOUSE OF LOVE/Warner Bros. BSK 3207 (House Of Love shows us an organic rhythm and blues singer who is adaptable enough to work in several music settings. On side two the feeling plays more toward Candi Staton's real style. She is a potential powerhouse who is now firmly leashed.)

Cobham, Khan, Johnson, Scott/
ALIVEMUTHERFORYA/Columbia JC 35349 (It sounds like this amalgome jelled into a group. The feel and the performance are exhilarating. They take good tunes and launch them. What would they have done with great material?)

Larry Coryell & The Eleventh House/AT
MONTREUX/Vanguard VSD 79410 (The people at Montreux seem electrified by the power of fusion music. In a program dominated by the mainstream, fusion can do wonders. This band did showcase Coryell in a most flattering way. Playmanship is above average throughout, material is good too.)

Peter Gabriel/Atlantic SD 19181 (A dense Gabriel album shows lots of originality without sacrificing musicality. Robert Fripp, no doubt, is an influence on the Lp's outcome. This Lp requires the listener to work to get to all its charms.)

Lost Gonzo Band/SIGNS OF LIFE/Capitol SW-11788 (In a quiet way, Lost Gonzo Band applies its flowing, country influenced rockin' to a full complement of easily digested tunes. Ironically, they seem to be one of the few bands which isn't lost at all. They are worth the finding this time around.)

Professor Longhair/LIVE ON THE QUEEN MARY/Harvest SW-11790 (When the genuine rock stars, like Paul & Linda, have a party they invite genuine musicians to play. So this is Professor Longhair's first live album and in it you can hear the roots of much of what we hold sacred. Jerry Wexler would call this Lp a fine example of "antiquarian music.")

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Roger C. Reale & Rue Morgue/RADIO-ACTIVE/Big Sound BSLP-028 (When it's real you know it immediately. Reale is real. If "Pain Killer" and "Please Believe Me" don't get to you maybe one of the blazers will. Either way, Roger C. strikes a hot iron.)

MERIT ALBUMS

ARC/Lifesong JZ 35413 (If you were looking for outside material, which was a smart thing to do, why go to John Palumbo who is an unproven writer, formerly with Crack the Sky. With all of the movement Terence Murogue's production wand was able to get into these songs, struggle is the only clear message which emerges from the core of this album. It feels more like construction and less like music. Passable because of its workmanship only.)

Asleep At The Wheel/COLLISION COURSE/Capitol SW-11726 (The move to include the original swing music (i. e. "One O'Clock Jump") into The Wheel's Texas swing repertoire is a touch of class. On the contrary "Pine Grove Blues" is a harsh jolt. Collision Course is a good name for an album which is a little lumpy as the band tries to fight its way out of the box it's in.)

Gato Barbieri/TROPICO/A&M SP 4710 (Though the orchestrations are, at times, a bit overwhelming the voicings of Barbieri are loud and clear. The union with producer David Rubinson seems a natural one. Rubinson finds "Poinciana" and "Bolero" and sends "Latin Lady" into the stratosphere with the addition of Santana's hair-raising guitar.)

Gary Bartz/LOVE AFFAIR/Capitol SW-11789 (Truly fusion music, Gary pulls together a funky-jazzy-R&B-disco feel. The album moves toward the upbeat with very pleasing tunes into which Bartz' solos rest easily.)

Bitter Blood Street Theatre/Vetco 701 (Reminiscent of the semi-disciplined days of hippies, San Francisco and the underground, Bitter Blood Street Theatre plays rhythmically excited tunes which aren't too bad, at times even very good. But, the whole homegrown project needs to be harnessed, directed and formed. There's talent in them there grooves. Write: 5825 Vine St., Cincinnati, Ohio 45216.)

Dollar Brand/THE JOURNEY/Chiaroscuro CR 187 (Dollar Brand is a most underrated jazzman. He is the melodic world champion among both avantists and traditionalists. That is proven again with "Sister Rosie" which opens the Lp. The second piece is a very long, outside piece which keeps up his membership in Club Obscurity. Side 2 holds another lovely tune called "Hajj" which should have been half its length.)
