GOODIES FOR CHRISTMAS?

As the leaves start to fall an overview of the year's re-corded output starts to fall into place too. This year is not pleasant to contemplate. It is a year of mediocrity, a year of playing it safe. There is a sense in which the continuing perfection of the format of recording has reached new levels, but in doing so much of the sportaneity of mu-sic has been sacrificed. There has to be a trade-off.

It does not seem logical to assume that the artists aren't as good especially with so many of them around. So what are the factors at play.

A major factor is the perceived tightening at all radio formats. Record companies sensing the tightening in radio tighten their own A&R policies and guide their previously signed artists into a more saleable and/or playable mode. Tangent to that is the attempt to make the gamble - which every record is - a safer bet. That is done by hiring a known, successful producer who will deliver a proven product. Hence, the amazing rise of the independent producers. Always a part of the industry, they are now its subsurface insurance policy. subsurface insurance policy.

For insurance of their own the industry's turn to studio players with whom they are familiar. So, the same players end up on album after album. It's like a band with revolving front men. The big news in the studio world for this year is that Steve Gadd has done some sessions on the
