RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

It's good to be back on these pink pages...I think I've said that before. It was 1971 after the now cliché "FM" staff walk-out/lock-out at WLIR. This time 2000 miles to the west...Denver, Co. After a stint with AOR leader KBPI, I signed Stallion to a 2 record deal with Casablanca. Spent 2 years working label liaison and artist development with Homeflow Management. Radio guys all over the country asked "Do you miss radio?" Actually, I was more involved with radio, talking more radio, check out facilities, spending more time with radio people, than I would have had I been at a station. So back in radio is a bit of a misnomer but this time an AM facility with a wealth of free form and progressive history. One of the West's legendary AOR outlets, with all that as a background, we're taking KEML into the 80's with a direction that will hold onto a sense of the old and maintain a clear mainstream AOR feel. With a strong AM signal we're going after some very traditional AM territory (i.e. AM and PM drives.) We all have 10 years of Album Radio under our belts and the challenge of making AOR work on the AM is perhaps the most exciting media challenge yet. AOR's time has come on the AM Radio! Larry Bruce (M.D.) has been in Denver since 1973 and participated in KBPI's incredible AOR numbers in 1976. Larry has also been at KKFM in Colorado Springs, KBCO in Boulder, and was P.D. at KUAD in Windsor, Colorado. Joel Moss, Production/News Director was part of the original staff at WLIR with myself, Mike Harrison, Pete Laison and Don K. Reed. Joel became program director at WLIR in 1976. He has also been associated with WPLJ in New York and WCOZ, Boston. Other staff members include, Scotty James who has been here at KEML for years. Dave Hohn from KTOQ, Rapid City, and Ira Gordon from KAZY, Denver.

- Dexter Gordon Quartet/MANHATTAN SYMPHONIE/Columbia JC 35608 (Everything about Dexter Gordon is classy. His personal manner and his music all reflect a man of some distinction. Manhattan Symphonie, with liner notes by Pete Hamill strikes that note again. Top-drawer.)
- The Great Jazz Trio/AT THE VILLAGE VANGUARD/Inner City IC 6013 (Sonic superiority elevates this LP before the music is even considered. You can feel the bass drum. The trio consists of Tony Williams, Ron Carter and Hank Jones. Their ability matches the sonic quality to produce a very pleasing set.)
- Tom T. Hall/PLACES I'VE DONE TIME/RCA APL 1-3018 (Tom's country moves in and out of the hip shadows. It has to do with the production approach a given LP will take. This one is organic country music, unaffected and pure. Fine writing throughout.)
- Clifford Jordan/INWARD FIRE/Muse MF 5128 (One of the elements which separates the contributors from the followers in music is individuality. The music of Clifford Jordan, though traditionally based, has a bend in it which distinguishes him from the rest. Top-notch traditional jazz.)
- Houston Person/THE NEARNESS OF YOU/Muse MR 5178 (The tunes are fat and the feel easily digested. Houston Person has the lounge band formulation down pat. Mild wannered.)
- Dave Pike/ON A GENTLE NOTE/Muse MR 5168 (On A Gentle Note is what it says it is. Pike's easy groove insures that by its light vibraphonic spray. Swingin'.)
- Rainbow featuring Will Boulware/CRYSTAL GREEN/Inner City IC 6001 (With tracks laid down by the N.Y. studio connection - Gadd, Gale, Dupree, McDonald and Brecker - you are guaranteed consistency and near-perfection. However, the LP doesn't sound like a unit playing. Instead it sounds like nice riffs on top of rhythm.)
- Tom Scott/INTIMATE STRANGERS/Columbia JC 35557 (Tom never comes to grips with the natural dichotomy he sets up in his title Intimate Strangers. His music is so cool, so restrained that it shows little sense of intimacy. Its aloofness tends to keep strangers strangers. Good but benign melodies work in the same direction.)
- Woody Shaw/LITTLE RED'S FANTASY/Muse MR 5103 (Both Woody and Frank Strozier on saxophone step out at times. But, their rhythm section maintains a low-profile and by doing so hold the soloists in a time capsule. It's a question of style not quality.)
- Woody Shaw/STEPPING STONES/Columbia JC 35560 (The same soloing with an updated rhythm approach would launch Woody. By today's standards the music sounds out of balance with the rhythm so suppressed. Therein lies the dilemma for tradition jazz in the 70's.)
- Joe Sun/OLD FLAMES/Ovation OV-1734 (Much of the normal Nashville overproduction is shed to permit Joe Sun every opportunity to shine. His rooted country music shares common elements with rock and folk music. It adds lots of good songs too.)

- Cass/ECLIPSE/ASH SP-2033 (Part of the LP is instrumental - a beautiful tune called "Earthly Mother" comes from that part - part is sung in French and part is sung in English. Their songs, in English or French, are not as good as their playing at any point. Merit.)
- Dr. Feelgood/PRIVATE PRACTICE/United Artists UAG 30184 (Resilient rock 'n' roll underscores this Dr. Feelgood LP. The band fades in and out of being really good. It's dependent on how strong their material is. They can deliver. Merit.)
- Eloy/LIVE/Harvest 164-32934/35 (Majestic play in a space-rock setting requires broad stroke soloing. Subtly is not appropriate. The mixed French-German accent on the English lyrics is strange. Their lyrics aren't nearly as important sounding as their music. Big and musical. Merit.)
- Grobschnitt/SOLAR MUSIC-LIVE/Brain 0060.139 (Long rock instrumentals demonstrate Grobschnitt's authority over the medium. Fluid play, especially behind the soaring guitar solo, is worth the admission price. Side-long pieces don't speak well for their editing ability. Merit.)
- Maneige/SUPREMACY/Polydor 2424 176 (Topnotch performances spark the instrumental work of Maneige. There is a delicacy built into their rock formulation. It sets up an interesting contrast. Good, but not inspired tunes. Merit.)
- Klaus Schulze/K/Brain 0080.023 (Emensely talented electronician, Klaus Schulze does everything in this two-record set. He builds a majesty in space and recreates standard classic music. He is a master musician and a master craftsman, an unusual combination. The 21st century of music. Special Programming.)
- Solid Senders/Virgin V2105 (Ex-Feelgood Wilko Johnson fronts the Solid Senders. That telegraphs their rock 'n' roll essence. Their performance is spirited though muffled by the sonics. A bonus live album is included. The playing is a little looser, but the sound mask still covers the music. Merit.)
- Alan Stivell/UN DEWEZH 'BARZH' GER/Polydor 2424 178 (A folk musician of unknown origin. Stivell's music incorporates everything from bagpipes to sitar though it is based on guitar. Music is very pleasing yet obscured by the language barrier. Special Programming.)

CONCEPTS

GREAT BALLADS OF THE WESTERN WORLD

Linda Ronstadt's breathless reading of Smokey Robinson's "Oh Baby Baby" brings shivers while it sparks a thought about how difficult it is to sing a ballad. In fact, the ability to write as well as perform a ballad may be the separating line distinguishing the men from the boys or, in Linda's case, the women from the girls.

In ballad writing, the melody has to hold together and create interest even in the verse. You can't get away with just writing a good hook. Unevenness is so much more obvious. The slower tempo demands more detail. Further, the pace demands a lyric which stands extra scrutiny.

Once the perfect ballad is constructed, the singing of it requires equal attention to detail. In Linda's case you could go to school on every nuance of her reading of the above mentioned song.

Think of it, our really great singers like Rod Stewart, Van Morrison, Bruce Springsteen, Joni Mitchell and even Mick Jagger can deliver a ballad directly to the cortex of your brain. Do not pass go.

That there are so few truly great ballads testifies for their difficulty. That great ballads tend to have a longer shelf life than medium or up-tempo things testifies for their enduring power.

Listen for the slow songs, that's where the talents reside.

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Carl Perkins/Ol' BLUE SUEDE'S BACK/Jet KZ 33604 (For so long now Carl has been part of the country music in-group, playing with Johnny Cash and such, that it's hard to remember the time when he was a rebel. A rock and roll rebel no less. These performances prove beyond doubt that he still has a true affinity for essential music.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Bell & James/A & H SP-4778 (Their sonic quality is impressive. All other elements, performance, arrangements and songs are good but, not filled with points of distinction. The feel is the thing.)

Brian Cadd/YESTERDAY DREAMS/Capitol TW-11661 (The best songs crowd up at the front of each side as Cadd takes out a piece of mainstream rock. A product of the present Brian flashes few cues to his musical heritage. Solid production throughout.)

Crack the Sky/LIVE 507/Lifesong JE 15675 (Fleamy play is the core of Crack. Their music is so dense that the recording process loses lots of it, especially in "Furf City." Still, their dynamic performance is made obvious.)

The Dodgers/LIVE ON THE BEACH/Polydor EP 1-6174 (The Beatles-like Dodgers are very appealing in spite of their imitativeness. It is amazing that that influence is still so powerful. These Dodgers may not win the series either, but they are contenders.)

Duke Deluxe/DON'T HIND ROCKIN' FORTNITE/ACA APL 1-3025 (Previously reviewed as an import. Most of side one and a few tracks on side two are reissues from the two Deluxe albums. But for fans of the band which evolved into the Tyla Gang, The Motors and The Ramour several unissued live tracks are included to up the ante.)

Flint/Columbia JC 31574 (Flint turns the pop rock formulation into a brush fire with a bright performance of quite respectable songs. They do nothing to advance the form but, they do burn it on its core.)

Fotomaker/VII-A-VII/Atlantic ED 1920H (Song after Fotomaker song, Fotomaker bellows rock confidence. They command the medium. When they connect with songs like "Just For You" or "Make It Look Like An Accident" they become more than just a good band and they go beyond album filler.)

Elton John/A SINGLE MAN/ACA 3065 (The focus and energy that Elton used to generate is diffused these days. A track may be a cute pop piece, a spongy rocker or an MORish ballad. Songs like "Georgia" and "Big Big" recall the potent artist inside the shell.)

Johnny's Dance Band/LIVE WOUNDS.../Windsong BXL 1-3711 (A neat improvement over their first album brings Johnny's Dance Band into clearer focus. Snappy play is their forte and it is exhibited here. New levels of material quality are reached too.)

Curtis Jones/LOMESOME BEDROOM BLUES/Delmark DE-605 (Piano blues somehow is more sophisticated than guitar blues. Curtis is a country boy from Texas and urban intensity isn't injected into his style. His piano moans while his tenor voice cries.)

Paul Konta/DANCING IN THE AISLES/Dance JET 7018 (A unique vocal sound and good piano songs speak well for Konta. The piano is important here because it is hard to imagine Paul's tunes being written on any other instrument. Solid.)

Ted Nugent/WARRIOR WARRIORS/Epic EX 35551 (As Warrior Warriors blues by Nugent's control of his power is obvious. Good songs provide a solid basis for the control and the Ep's cocky success. "Good Friends & A Bottle Of Wine" stands out.)

Outlaws/PLAYIN' TO WIN/Arista AR 4205 (Harmonized and typotized by the Outlaws' smooth presentation. All of their songs are easy on the ears but most are done in the same vein. Some variety would spice it.)

Payas/Epic JE 3549 (Child-mannered, blue-eyed soul gives Payas an appealing place to start. Give the same neighborhood as Steely Dan. Their good songs aren't quite good enough for such a lazier fairer approach. It seems as if they needed to be more aggressive. D.F. ANYHOW.)

John Payne/SHOCKED SYSTEMS/Lifesong JE 15503 (Lots of surprises. No Crack the Sky. Payne writes round songs as differentiated from the Yes-like furious Crack tends to do. Here they are set in a meticulously presented musical setting. We might quibble with some of "The Lushness" but, that doesn't alter overall positiveness. A few very strong songs like "Madness..." and "I Lean On You" lead the way.)

Gordon Payne/AM SP-4725 (The presence, as producer, of J.U. Gale ensures that Oklahoma Funk will fill Gordon's album. It does. Rhythmic movement is the story. It keeps the performance interesting even though the tempos and attitudes change very infrequently.)

Shawn Phillips/TRANSCENDENCE/ACA APL 1-102H (It is hard to have patience with Shawn's darkly mental lawns. He's like a depressing Amavour. Due to Michael Kamen's arranging some texture gets injected into the Ep. That adds tenille strength. Go for the up-tempo tunes.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

Terry Reid/ROQUE WAVE/Capitol SW-11857 (It is always good to have Terry back strokin'. He is a force for the good in rock music, he responds to his musical past. Reid's voice instantly reaches for the top of its range. Rip-roarin'.)

Sony Rhodes/I DON'T WANT MY BLUES COLORED BRIGHT/Advent 2608 (Few men his age, early 40's, are pure bluesmen. Sony Rhodes is as pure as he can be. The feeling is urban, post-war. The emotions are real city frustrations. Write: Box 431, La Habra, Ca. 90631.)

Rush/HEMISPHERES/Mercury SRM 1-3743 (Hemispheres continues the hard, teen-type Rush rock. However, this is a very well constructed album. No loose ends are left as its controlled power is uniformly applied. The writing is decent too.)

Steeleye Span/LIVE AT LAST/Chrysalis CHR-1199 (Steeleye Span has made some fine albums during its run but, as a band they really were something else on stage. They brought antiquarian music to life in a world of computers and S.S.T.'s. So it is quite appropriate to end the run with this live album. Good show.)

Richard Terrance/ANYTHING'S POSSIBLE/Capitol SW-11860 (Fun music. Terrance doesn't have much flair, but, he has his finger on a rollicking rock 'n' roll feel. Joined with his easy tunes, Richard makes anything seem truly possible. "Anything's Possible" is a super song.)

Tyla Gang/WOODSTOCK/Essexley JES-0059 (When Sean Tyla hits the time just right the band accelerates. Meanwhile, Bruce Irvine is capable of taking it home alone with his fine guitar stroke. It can be a strong combination. Excellent rhythm helps too. Songs like "Oakland Red", "It's gonna Rain" and "Suicide Jockey" strike gold.)

Michael Urbaniak/COSTUME/Marlin 2221 (Urbaniak has more lives than the proverbial nine-lived cat. Here a powerful, almost overwhelming, funky rhythm track dominates. Michael's soaring violin often gets submerged in it. He's like a featured soloist. Some of side 2 gets closer to the essential Urbaniak.)

Kidie "Cleanhead" Vinson/TA CLEAN MACHINE/Muse MR 5116 (A richly baroque blues feel pervades Vinson's jazz-blues mix. His music sits at the core of post-WWII music. Almost all of modern music evolves from his cross-current style.)

Wishbone Ash/NO SMOKE WITHOUT FIRE/ACA 3060 (Derek Launson's production helps Wishbone Ash into shape. Their recording sound is possibly the best they've had. Their performances are solid too. Average songwriting keeps them in place.)

John Paul Young/LOVE IS IN THE AIR/Scotti Bros. SB 7101 (Wedded between pure pop and hip John Paul gains credibility with a fine voice and some good songs. Both opening tracks are produced for pop ears. More restraint is used afterward.)

ENTISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive rock consideration.)

Tilt/MUSIC/Parachute REP 3008 (Strong voices lead the way for Tilt. But, various writing and an anemic performance combine to bump them too hard. Softened hard rock has a tough time.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

The Rusty Alexander 7/JUMENTO/Pablo 2310 826 (On Jumento Rusty does a very nice thing with rhythm. He brings into the tunes a touch of Jamaica, and the Dominican Republic. Spicy jazz result.)

Sobby Bary/HELENN WHEREVER I FALL/Columbia KC 35645 (Watch the bouncing producer. Those songs produced by Kyle Lehning tend to be augmented with sweeteners while those done by Steve Cichon tend to be less affected. Sobby Bary is one of the real country artists.)

Ed Bruce/COMETS & DREAMERS/Epic KE 35541 (A classic country ballad, Ed Bruce tells his tales with a rare sense of sincerity. Side one tends to get pop production gloss but, the real artistry is unimpeded on much of side two.)

Richie Cole/ALTO MADNESS/Muse MR 5155 (Super tunes played through Richie's hard alto wins praise. This Ep shows a young traditionalist in top form. Cole does stand out of the pack just as the liner notes suggest.)

Jessi Colter/THAT'S THE WAY A COWBOY ROCKS & ROLLS/Capitol ST-11863 (A creative choice of material brings Jessi's easy country flow into range. The arrangements are very standard however. They don't offer the best possible support for the music.)

Kiki Dee/STAY WITH ME/Rocket BXL 1-3011 (Kiki Dee has been a promising rock singer for years. Here she really leaves that potential behind to become quite a good pop singer. Bill Schnee's production is lovely.)

MOVE IT ON OVER/Rounder 3024

(For those who look for special things in life, George Thorogood & The Destroyers can fill the order. George isn't a great singer, he gets by. But, he is a classic guitar destroyer and The Destroyers provide bedrock support. Side two weakens somewhat but it works its way back to strength by its middle.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Joan Armatrading/TO THE LIMIT/A&M

SP-4732 (Unique talent deserves reward. Joan has a special sound in her voice and a special twist in her writing. She has also been blessed with super accompaniment too. It is all here "bottom to the top.")

Dollar Brand/SOWETO/Chiaroscuro

CR-2012 (Dollar Brand brings a powerfully strong sense of melody to the undulating rhythms he manages. Though he works with very long tunes, it is surprising that he gets relatively little acclaim, especially in jazz circles. Not since Bob Timmons and earlier Horace Silver has jazz had an artist with as unified a rhythm/melody style.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Can/OUT OF REACH/Peter's International
PLD 9024 (Previously reviewed as an import. The instrumental, space rock of Can is always powerful but rarely is it out of reach. In their music one finds an unusual creative flair. On this Lp the muddy sonics work negatively, yet Can shows a good sense of the song format.)

Captain Beefheart & The Magic Band/
SHINY BEAST/Warner Bros. BSK 3256 (More like a hairy beast the Captain stalks this record. He is not a pop artist. There is nothing like him - not even in the avant garde. Vague resemblances to Zappa, Waits and Patti Smith might be in order. There is no claim here that everything on Shiny Beast works but Don Van Vliet's oddball rhythms click enough to invite the crazies in. It's important that Don is recording again.)

Firefall/ELAN/Atlantic SD 19183

(Always Eagles influenced, Firefall hardens their sound to texturize a few tracks. It works but, anything would with a lot of good songs from which to choose. Consistent.)

FM/BLACK NOISE/Visa 7007 (Put FM in a class with Yes and Emerson, Lake & Palmer. But, to their credit, note that FM solves two of the problems of Yes and E.L. & P. They are musical and they are not pompous. Very good songs are elevated by terrific soloing. FM is a better signal.)

Steve Forbert/ALIVE ON ARRIVAL/

Nemperor JZ 35538 (Though he may be a throw back as a performer, Steve Forbert is a writer's writer. That makes his folk-based music rather universal. Steeped in the Dylan tradition he is not a mere mirror image.)

Lindisfarne/BACK AND FOURTH/Atco

SD 38-108 (Previously reviewed as an import. Gus Dudgeon puts lots of movement in the rejuvenated folk-rock of Lindisfarne. A few top-notch songs and a chrysaline presentation are all anyone can ask.)

Tracy Nelson/DOIN' IT MY WAY/Audio

Directions AD 101 (It rarely happens that a true artistic-technical symphonic is developed. Doin' It My Way captures one of the finest singers we have, Tracy Nelson, singing terrific songs on a direct-to-disc recording. A special treat results. Write: 1035 Draughton Ave., Nashville, Tenn. 37204.)
