RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

Reviewer's Reaction: Van Morrison's traveling soul review made a stop in Detroit last week. This long time Morrison fan found it a bit of a disappointment. While it was a treat to hear the great Morrison repertory and the new songs, the performances of some of the older songs like "Brown Eyed Girl" paled in comparison with earlier renditions. The major problem is that the band is not very interesting. Both Bobby Tench, the lead guitarist, and the keyboardist offered solos of little imagination. Morrison's soulful music demanded a horn section and the current aggregation doesn't include one. Van was in fine voice and the audience was greatly appreciative of the performance. Illinois Jacquet With Wild Bill Davis/Classic Jazz 112 (There is nothing obtuse about this be-bop. Jacquet comes straight at you and Bill Davis punches it up with staccato organ strokes. Easy.)

Kaptain Kool & The Kongs/Epic JE 35447 (Rock style pop music has a top 40 thread running through its entire fabric. From Saturday morning to vinyl Kaptain Kool & The Kongs are so clean.)

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

John Klemmer/SOLO SAXOPHONE - CRY/ABC AA-1106 (Being one of the most popular contemporary jazzmen, John is in a perfect position to show his audience the horizon. Since most musicians in this position would shrink from the risk Klemmer demonstrates both guts and artistic sincerity by doing this expansive solo saxophone Lp. A tune like "Happiness" reaches mind and body.)

Various Artists/NO NEW YORK/Antilles AN 7067 (Brian Eno has collected all of the New York City extremes. He brings them together here. Contortions, Teenage Jesus & The Jerks, Mars and D.N.A. provide 16 tracks from the rock outside. Strangeness.)

Pinchas Zukerman - Claude Bolling/SUITE FOR VIOLIN & JAZZ PIANO/Columbia M-35128 (Classy from the start. As the album swings from violin to piano and back again moods undulate and the impression grows. A rewarding combination for both classicists and jazzers.)

Buzzcocks/LOVE BITES/United Artists UAG 30197 (An unrelenting guitar whine and an insistent throb define the Buzzcocks. Some of their music has been all power but this album finds some tunes to mention. Merit.)

Lol Creme & Kevin Godley/L/Mercury SRM 1-3752 (Preoccupied with technique, L is beautifully recorded and performed. However, the tunes are fragmented. They seem expedient when nothing else is. Zappa would never get trapped in this musical corner. The instrumental "Foreign Accent" is superior. Satisfactory.)

Albert Mangelsdorff - Jaco Pastorius - Alphonse Mouzon/TRILOQUE-LIVE!/MPS 5D.064D.60206 (Trilogue is a meeting of the three participants in the abstract. It demonstrates clearly their playing ability but it also shows that Mangelsdorff is not the most melodious player either. Merit.)

Alphonse Mouzon/IN SEARCH OF A DREAM/MPS 0068.192 (A very musical Alphonse Mouzon fusion group emerges from this recording. You forget that it is a drummer-lead band. Nice tunes and the aid of sidemen the quality of Phillip Catherine, Joachim Kuhn and Miroslav Vitous do it. Merit Plus.)

Rich Kids/GHOSTS OF PRINCES IN TOWERS/EMI EMC 3263 (Though they know how to change textures without changing context Rich Kids' songs seem monolithic. Mick Ronson's production is not as articulate as possible which contributes to the first problem. They get by with their newish wave thrust. Merit.)

Vivian Stanshall/SIR HENRY AT RAWLINSON END/Charisma CAS 1139 (Nuts. Stanshall's story has the sound of a classic tale, in reality it is quite another thing. Funny and bent and totally British. Special Programming.)

CONCEPTS

BORN AGAIN RADIO SYNDICATION

As program directors who move into new markets soon find out, if they hadn't already known it, a good radio station is tuned into its audience before its audience gets tuned into it.

The first thing this fish out of water attempts to do is find out what makes this new place tick. At the same time the generalities, those radio essentials which apply everywhere, must be put in place. By the time they are situated the new knowledge of the area can be applied to trim the programmatic antennae. How much does Springsteen get played vs. Nugent vs. Southern rock vs. Western soft rock?

One relatively new way to goose the general side of programming is to latch onto some syndicated programs. It is not that syndication is new, it is more a fact that syndication has gained new respectability.

In the olden days -- five years ago -- syndication was looked down upon largely because program people preferred home grown, localized special event programming. Also the syndicators weren't as skilled or ethical as they should have been. Soon, however, do-it-yourself concerts and such became too much of a hassle, especially in the face of easier, cheaper, bigger name syndications.

The syndicators could do it better and that was the key. As long as they were doing something a station could not do or could not do better they had a place. As long as the syndications do not work against local interests they contribute.

It looks like we have moved into the golden era of radio syndication.

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Jimmy Buffett/YOU HAD TO BE THERE/ABC AK-1008/2 (There is a sense with all live albums that you, in fact, had to be there. Here you can hear the excitement, but you can't feel it. A recording's missing presence is only part of it. Still, a strong sense of Buffett fun comes through. The virtual monologue on side three amplifies the point.)
- Cindy Bullens/DESIRE WIRE/United Artists UA LA 933-H (Energized by a hot recording and supported by just the right studio names, Cindy is a survivor. She survives an album filled with mediocre songs. Some good hooks do help it too and a tune like "High School History" shows depth and potential.)
- Guy Clarke/Warner Bros. BSK 3241 (Guy is one of those pedigree country-rockers who draws on his lineage for favored status. His music is the comfortable kind. It rests on journeyman songs and pickin' for flavor.)
- David Allan Coe/HUMAN EMOTIONS/Columbia KC 35135 (The tension which Coe projects into his music is his magic ingredient. You never quite know what he is going to do. Witness the open letter to his estranged wife on the album jacket. Side one is from before while side two is from after and it is the better of the two.)
- Gail Davies/Lifesong KZ35504 (Sandwiched between the country side of Linda and the folksy side of Loretta, Gail finds a place for herself. This easy flowing album gets a solid start with fine tunes, both original and chosen. Mellow enjoyment.)
- Dr. Hook/PLEASURE & PAIN/Capitol SW-11859 (The antics of early Dr. Hook are all but gone. Pleasure & Pain is mild mannered, content to gather good songs from a variety of sources. Side two seems to move better starting with J.J. Cale's rocker "Clyde.")
- Fortune/Warner Bros. BSK 3246 (Rock's answer to Charlie's Angels. Everybody is so pretty. Much of Fortune's music is not in sync with the cover. The mixed metaphor won't help them. Colleen Fortune, who does most of the lead singing, can push it. Their songs average out the album's impression.)
- Fresh/OMNIVERSE/Prodigal P7-10028 (Undoubtedly, their freshest album. Michael Nesmith's production enforces the support integrity with tight, though busy, rhythm tracks. Good songs, however, provide the area of greatest improvement. Fresh finds a real reason to be.)
- Steve Fromholz/JUS' PLAYIN' ALONG/Lone Star L-4601 (Texas country-folk singer Steve Fromholz has made a career out of the Lone Star State. His baritone is appealing and his writing good too, though not as robust as his voice.)
- Terry Garthwaite/HAND IN GLOVE/Fantasy F-3564 (Invoking memories of Sarah Vaughn, some Billie Holiday and some Peggy Lee, Terry's jazz singing is striking. The fully rich accompaniment contributes too. Only the material begs for more. Both sides start strongly.)
- P.T. Gazell/PACE YOURSELF/Sugar Hill SH-3703 (Instrumental country music with a harp lead is not in much demand but, for the folks who like it P.T. is a man to covet. His ability is flexible yet secure and his tone is pure. Write: Box 4040, Duke Station, Durham, N.C. 27706.)
- Kansas/TWO FOR THE SHOW/Kirshner PZ 2 35660 (Kansas is the U.S. version of E.L.P.'s orchestral rock format. They are somewhat less pompous while remaining, at least, as forceful. They tend to write more consistently strong material. This two record set attests to that.)
- Paul Kossoff/KOSS/DJM 2-300 (Previously reviewed as an import. This fine collection of tracks and tapes (3 of the 4 sides are previously unreleased) demonstrate what a top-notch guitarist Kossoff was. His tone was robust, his lines economical and original. Strong on history.)
- Matrix/WIZARD/Warner Bros. BSK 3260 (The Matrix update of the big band formulation is quite successful. They lean on the rhythm combo and write inventive ensemble parts which almost mask the horn section. Their tunes are more interesting for their avant slant than because of their whistleable melodies.)
- Dan McCafferty/A&M SP-4553 (Have you ever noticed that almost everyone who sings a Dylan song sings it with his peculiar phrasing. Which brings us to Dan's super song filled album. His choices are universally excellent while his performances are pretty good. They don't rethink the originals.)
- Jimmy Murphy/ELECTRICITY/Sugar Hill SH 3702 (Pure country-folk-blues sounds like an odd descriptive phrase but it pinpoints Jimmy Murphy's music. He and his accompanists command their music. Not much electricity here except that which is naturally generated. Write: Box 4040, Duke Station, Durham, N.C. 27706.)
- Poco/LEGEND/ABC AA-1099 (Legend is a very satisfying album. Though you may not be able to point out all of its greatness, its steadiness and its warmth count heavily. Nice tunes too.)
- Cliff Richard/GREEN LIGHT/Rocket BXL 1-2958 (Mild Cliff Richard rockin' makes few mistakes but, it rarely reaches out either. Green Light is a pleasant experience.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Sad Cafe/MISPLACED IDEALS/A&M SP-4737 (This U.S. release combines two previously reviewed imports. Both reviews noted the quality inherent in Sad Cafe presentation and hoped that the writing would catch up to the rest. As a hybrid this Lp takes advantage of the other albums' strong points.)
- Starz/COLISEUM ROCK/Capitol ST-11861 (The hard rock formula pushed to the wall. Lyrics like, "come on Teresa, let me into your outfit" speak to teen dreams while the power penetrates the sentiment. Tunes are not tread on, to Starz' credit.)
- Stillwater/I RESERVE THE RIGHT/Capricorn CPN 0210 (A strong performance and a combination of arranging styles calculated to weaken the limiting Southern rock image set the stage. Those twin guitars are hard to avoid. Songwriting is adequate but not more.)
- The Richard Sussman Quintet/FREE FALL/Inner City 1045 (Sparked by very pleasing tunes and guided by a thoughtful Sussman piano Free Fall lands right on the mark. An eloquent statement.)
- Tanya Tucker/T.N.T./MCA-3066 (The cover makes the point strongly. Tanya is her own woman now, no hedging. The music is percentage points milder than the cover message. Still, it does make the transition completely. Well chosen songs round it out.)
- Ultravox/SYSTEMS OF ROMANCE/Antilles AN-7069 (That strange bend in Ultravox music is in the way they arrange their music more than the way they write. The tunes are rather good and the presentation interesting, if weird.)
- Dave Valentin/LEGENDS/Arista GRP 5001 (A nice groove. Dave's studioized jazz is built on a solid flooring. Top rank N.Y. studio players give the tracks their grounding while Valentin lays in pleasing flute tunes. The Latin influence works to give Legends a needed heated undercurrent. Clean.)
- Joe Lee Wilson/WITHOUT A SONG/Inner City 1064 (A super voice and the right feeling is enough to sustain interest. However, some problems like enunciation ("Xcape") and the inability to control his lower register shouldn't be on this or any, record. Good but, not great jazz songs are a factor limiting Wilson's limitless potential.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Buck White & The Down Home Folks/POOR FOLKS PLEASURE/Sugar Hill SP-3705 (The mix submerges the rhythm section which, in return, tends to hollow out the music. Good songs work to come through. Nice vocal harmonies are the only other saviour. Country mellow. Write: Box 4040, Duke Station, Durham, N.C. 27706.)
- Taatum/Ovation OV 1735 (A dynamic vocal performance by three female lead singers cannot save these unspecial songs, especially the lyrics. Further, the vocals have to drag along a rhythm mix which reduces movement rather than creating it.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Angela Bofill/ANGIE/Arista GRP 5000 (Crossing all of the imaginary musical boundaries is the main accomplishment on Angela's album. It can go M.O.R., R&B, jazz and pop with equal ease. Beautiful production supports good, but not historic songs. Potential exudes from the record.)
- Johnny Cash/GONE GIRL/Columbia KC 35646 (A terrific Lp. Johnny doesn't often write or sing a bad song. As a performer he forces you to chose him because he makes everything he sings his own. Take "No Expectations," it sounds like it has always been a country song. It is pure Cash, take it or leave it.)
- Arnett Cobb/THE WILD MAN FROM TEXAS/Classic Jazz 102 (Though he may be a wild man, as the title states, Arnett's music is anything but wild. It is more clean and neat, more restrained than the title implies. A welcome respite.)
- Mani Dibango/AFROVISION/Island ILPS-4526 (Dibango's disco-jazz adds a sense of grace to both fields. Flowing rhythms and melodies are punctuated by vocal asides and fine solos. Afrovision stands by itself.)
- Kenny Drew Trio/DARK BEAUTY/Inner City 2016 (Kenny never moves to the outside, his music is mature and flawless. His choice of material is worthwhile too. Kenny leans into the tunes so that even the ballads seem to reach out for you.)
- Ted Dunbar/OPENING REMARKS/Xanadu 155 (Here is a pharmacist from Texas who plays a rather refined guitar. Ted's guitar is so tasty. He complements his own quality with the likes of Tommy Flanagan and Sam Jones. Smoothness is insured.)
- Wilton Felder/WE ALL HAVE A STAR/ABC AA-1109 (This Crusader's production balances on the R&B/jazz frontier. The songs tend to eliminate themselves from our consideration but, their instrumental portions tend to bring them back. Felder's abrasive saxophone tone is appealing.)

Charlie Ainley/BANG YOUR DOOR/Nemperor JZ 35648 (All of the instincts are right. Interesting, if sometimes choppy, arrangements and Charlie's singular voice require attention. They don't get lost in the mass. Though he reaches back to get inspiration from a rich musical past, Charlie comes across as an original.)

Elvin Bishop/HOG HEAVEN/Capricorn CPN 0215 (Driven by arrangements which are, at one time, deeply rooted yet creatively devised, Elvin delivers another top-flight album. Solid songs and a sense of fun contribute further. Feel good music.)

Eric Clapton/BACKLESS/RSO RS 1-3039 (Backless shouldn't be taken to mean spineless. This Clapton album is built on grit. It moves back to a very basic style. First rate music and second rate sonics fight it out. Lots of terrific songs.)

Bobby David/20th Century T-572 (A vocal timbre which makes Bobby sound like a hot, female rock singer is appealing. That appeal is added to by several better than average songs. A new artist to note.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Dire Straits/Warner Bros. BSK 3266 (Previously reviewed as an import. Imagine a smidgeon of Lou Reed and Dylan in the most alluring, light Southern rock musical setting. The tracks on this Lp are killers. A single weakness is in the vocal treatment.)

Lou Reed/LIVE - TAKE NO PRISONERS/Arista AL 8502 (As important as the music - the band is great - are the Reed monologues which approach Lennox Bruce. He's not particularly funny, but you get the same spike in your brain, for example, when he lays out the critics in "Walk On The Wild Side," that tells you that the truth was just spoken. Lou is lucid at home on the stage in New York City where they understand. Audition before airplay.)

Kate & Anna McGarrigle/PRONTO MONTO/Warner Bros. BSK 3248 (Kate brings humor and Anna brings grace to a high class duo. The McGarrigles draw from a broad musical heritage, and in doing so, act to raise the level of popular music. A lovely album.)

Pointer Sisters/ENERGY/Planet P-1 (Fully half of Richard Perry's success as a producer is his ability to put the right material with a given artist. As demonstrated here he places the Pointer Sisters back in the center of the action with these choices. Getting performances is the other half.)

Tom Waits/BLUE VALENTINE/Asylum 6E-162 (Every Tom Waits album creates one or two new classic renditions. A song like "Romeo Is Bleeding" is street-real Waits at his best. His unique talent reminds us all of what it's supposed to be like.)

MERIT ALBUMS

Aerosmith/LIVE BOOTLEG/Columbia PC 2 35564 (Through the blaze Aerosmith shows skill. Good songs get driven to extreme and still maintain their integrity. Hot.)

Bandit/PARTNERS IN CRIME/Ariola SW-50042 (A solid rock 'n' roll front first draws attention to this band. A few memorable songs help to make heroes of these villains. Not white collar, Bandit's action is strictly from the streets.)
