# RADIO CITY

**S**moke is billowing out of an upper floor window as the men in their clean, Dallas fire machines speed to the hotel. It is a hotel stuffed with a radio programming convention. The slickered firemen hassle their way through the mob with extinguishers in hand. A half hour later they leave the scene after the blaze had been contained. No one hurt, no one had to be evacuated. In fact, no one evacuated themselves because this was a radio programming convention and a little fire was not about to disturb the convening that was going on in the lobby's pit. Everyone was there and it was intense. Not the fire, the convening.

That scene from a now famous Dallas R & R convention of several years ago represents the apex of the industry meeting routine. It was a zoo, but it had all of the ingredients for success. There are only two—one is social and the other is substance.

A couple of weeks ago, typical of the perplexities of these times, there were three conventions held in one six day period. None of them did it all, although it was the Abrams meetings which came the closest, especially on the content side of



the ledger. WSHE's **Neal Mirsky**, who only went to the Abrams meetings, explains his feeling that at other conventions "the one on one is the most valuable thing (offered) . . . When you put people up on a panel, in the spotlight, they feel this is their shot to impress everybody. Everyone seems to have a facade. Whereas when you get together in the room or in the hallways, the lobby, there's more general relating."

Neal expresses a theme heard over and over again by the Abrams people and by those unconnected. The social thing is good but the sessions suffer in the trade publication meetings. A reason for that weakness is articulated by panelist **Bob Coburn** (WMET, Chicago): "I had no contact with anyone before the panel . . . Nobody has a direction . . . It's kind of a wing it situation."

**Paul Kelly** (WQFM), who is just plain off of conventions, says, "They're really glorified parties . . . (One) particular convention had markets from #1 all the way to #200. What was a problem for the top 30 (market) wasn't a problem for the bottom 100 (markets)." He goes on to

identify more of his feelings: "Everybody was talking about what was wrong and nobody told anybody how to fix it . . . They were talking in generalities."

The man from Milwaukee doesn't even like the social aspect of conventioneering. He described a situation at a conclave where he spent two days just trying to get into a position to say hello to an old friend. For him it is frustration. "I just plain don't have the time. I have a station to run."

Some, like **Tack Hammer** (KQRS) "haven't gone to a trade sheet convention since the first R & R."

KMEL's **Bobby Cole** explains that, "If (he) was going to be away from the station, (he) could do more getting some other things done." Still, when he has gone to conventions he has liked the content side. He likes to "listen for someone to spark a thought." It's the social aspect which bothers him.

Memphis' **Tom Owens** (WZXR) notices that "you see the same people every year and every year they complain but they keep going." He isn't always complaining, however, he provides some insight into the problem too. People are going to



complain when, as he puts it, the sessions are "scattered and chaotic." Everything is too general. He's looking for some focus when he suggests that the topics should be more narrowly defined. "We have a problem here . . . for the next two hours address yourself to the problem." Here is where the Superstars' meetings seem to have the edge.

"It's no screwing around," **Dan Hayden** (WHCN) says. "We were down there and we worked real hard . . . there's talent development, promotion, state of radio, sales presentations, and there was one interesting idea where they had a board of general managers . . . that really does help."

If there is anything the Superstars' meetings seem to lack, it is on the social side.

One cannot help but come away from this series of conversations thinking that Lee Abrams could help by consulting publications on how to run a convention with substance and that there are lots of people who could help him run a convention with some fun in it. The same kind of fun that should be part of radio.

# ON THE WIRE

## NEW YORK AND LOS ANGELES

### LOS ANGELES

**KROQ & COLUMBIA IN TOMMY TUTONE TURMOIL:** Chuck Randall, KROQ's mid-day DJ, was threatened with an injunction by Columbia bigwigs after he played "Cheap Date," a track from the Bay Area band Tommy Tutone's debut. The problem? Apparently CBS staffers were bugged that Randall played the record two weeks prior to its official release. The practice of enjoining a station from playing an as-yet unreleased disc is usually reserved for heavyweights like Fleetwood Mac, Elvis Costello and the like, and Randall was riled: "When was the last time a record company asked a radio station not to play a new act?" The DJ couldn't believe the big to-do Columbia was making. "There were repercussions all the way to New York." But Randall went ahead and played the Tutone track again anyway. "Let 'em injunct me," he sneered defiantly.

**RONSTADT'S BAND STILL NAMELESS:** Waddy Wachtel, Dan Dugmore, Rick Marotta and Stanley Sheldon—L.A. kingpin sessioners and Ronstadt band alumni—have finished work on their Peter Asher-produced, all-digital disc for Mercury Records. The company's hoping for a May release but cover artwork has not been started since the foursome are still without a moniker. The group has gone through several choices (the Boys was one), but nothing's stuck. Meanwhile, Wachtel and Marotta have flown to Japan to back native superstar Goro Naguchi on his upcoming Oriental jaunt.

**WARNERS NABS A COUPLE:** Bugs Bunny's on the prowl again. This time the Burbank-based diskery has signed Anglo popsters 10CC for a long-term deal, and stolen from fellow WEA umbrella outfit Elektra, ex-Television frontman Tom Verlaine.

**IN OTHER SIGNING NEWS:** Keith Sykes (whose demos are getting heavy airplay on Chuck Randall's KROQ show) is reportedly being pursued by a swarm of companies. At the forefront are both wings of CBS—Columbia and Epic. Sykes' songs are rooted in an early rock (Sun Sessions-type) sound . . . Mercury has pacted Light of the World, a British R&B unit . . . Big Twist & The Mellow Fellows, a midwest blues combo, to Flying Fish Records . . . Another indie label, Waterhouse, has acquired Aztec Two Step. Their THE TIMES OF OUR LIVES is due soon . . . A reformed Humble Pie has been inked to Atco. The Pie's ON TO VICTORY just

shipped . . . Cris Rea to Columbia . . . I.R.S. has enlisted Santa Cruz's new wavers the Humans . . . Tonic K. has ankled Epic for Arista. His new LP: AMERIKA.

**SHORTS:** New Mercury act Van Wilks were known for most of their career (based in Texas) as the Fools. Unfortunately, EMI/America's the Fools beat them to the punch platter-wise . . . Waterhouse act the Lamont Cranston Band (named after crimebuster the Shadow) are set to open on Bonnie Raitt's upcoming tour . . . Welsh guitarist Deke Leonard (from Man) is playing on Walter Egan's new LP, which is being produced in L.A. by Earle Mankey . . . Bram Tchaikovsky's forthcoming Polydor LP was to be called THE RUSSIANS ARE COMING until someone at Polydor thought it might be too controversial considering all the anti-Soviet sentiment nowadays. Much to Bramski's chagrin the album is now called PRESSURE . . . Bob Dylan borrowed a harmonica from Mark Wenner of the Nighthawks blues band during recording sessions in Muscle Shoals. Dylan was in one studio, the Nighthawks, recording their Mercury debut, were in another. Word is that after Dylan espied Wenner's tattoo-covered body, he rushed over to a Muscle Shoals tattoo parlor to get his own flesh filled in. (A cross on his chest?)

**IN THE STUDIO:** Orleans are at Trident Sound with Brand X keyboardist Robin Lumley producing . . . Gary Myrick & The Figures at Wally Heider's with Tom Werman guiding their Epic effort . . . Rickie Lee Jones reteams with Lenny Waronker and Russ Titelman for a follow up to her Grammy winning first foray. They're at Warner's Amigo Studios . . . Jude Cole, Moon Martin's guitarist, is recording an album at Pasha Music House. Rob Grill is producing, John McVie from the Big Mac, Pink Floyd's Nick Mason and Little Feat's Kenny Gradney are all guesting . . . Ted Nugent in New York working on his next Epic LP. Lew Futterman and Cliff Davies co-producing . . . Peter Noone, toothy lead singer of Herman's Hermits, is in town cutting tracks. Some of Tom Petty's Heartbreakers are lending a hand there . . . Carolyne Mas at N.Y.'s Power Station with producer Steve Burgh, waxing her second collection for Mercury . . . Another Mercury group, Southside Johnny & Co., also completing their next record . . . Mike Chapman ensconced with his punky protege Shandi, recording her Dreamland/RSO debut.

**VINYL DECISIONS:** New

records include THE KLARK KENT KOLLECTION and the Cramps' SONGS THE LORD TAUGHT US, both from I.R.S. and both due in late April . . . From Warners: Stephen Bishop's label bow, RED CAB TO MANHATTAN, Emmylou Harris' all acoustic ROSES IN THE SNOW and Robin Lane & The Chartbusters' debut . . . Squeeze's ARGY BARGY should be out momentarily from A&M . . . Likewise for Boz Scaggs' MIDDLE MAN on Columbia . . . The Scorpions' ANIMAL MAGNETISM ships soon from Mercury.

**FILM CORNER:** The Band's Levon Helm makes a fine acting bow in the Loretta Lynn bio-pic COAL MINER'S DAUGHTER. Helm plays Loretta's dad. Band compatriot Robbie Robertson just completed his first film starrer in Carny, opposite Jodie Foster and Gary Busey . . . The gun-toting terror of rock, Ted Nugent, is also said to be preparing for a movie career. He wants to make Charles Bronson/Clint Eastwood-type blood-and-gutsers.

**ROCKIN' NEWLYWEDS:** (Slightly belated) congratulations are in order for Boomtown Rats' mini-bassist Pete Briquette and Adron's own songstress Jane Aire, who tied the nuptial knot recently in the groom's home town of Dublin—Ireland, of course. The wedding took place only days after a pair of sold out homecoming gigs by the Rats, which were nearly cancelled by local authorities scared of potential crowd violence. The shows did go on though, without incident, we're told. Other recently mated notables include Thin Lizzy's Phil Lynott and Lou Reed (No, not to each other!). Now if we could only get the three fun couples together for a round of The Newlywed Game....

**JOIN TOGETHER WITH THE BAND:** Recent recruits who have been drafted to fill holes in the ranks of bands left shorthanded in the wake of "musical and personal differences" include Jude Cole as new guitarist for the Records, Snowy White ditto for Thin Lizzy, and Mike Bailey (drums) and Russell Webb (bass) who become the new rhythm section for the Skids. Cole, an alumnus of the Moon Martin Band, joined the Records at Town House Studios in London in time to appear on their forthcoming LP, which Craig Leon is producing. He replaces Huw Gower. White joins Lizzy after stints with Pink Floyd and Peter Green. He'll replace Gary Moore. The


two new Skids join in time for the band's first U.S. tour, projected for late this spring.

**INFLATION FIGHTERS:** Angered by what they deemed was an outrageously expensive ticket price (ten bucks!!) for their recent show at the Hotel Diplomat here, the Specials took their case to the streets. The band had posters printed saying that 500 tickets were being held to be given away to people who called one of three numbers at a certain time. The numbers given were the office phones of the show's promoter, Ron Delsener, the band's record company prexy, Terry Ellis and their booking agent, Ian Copeland. Copeland explained later that the high charge was due to an extremely expensive rental fee on the hall.

**NEW DISCS ON THE WAY:** Epic will inaugurate their new 12" 4-track collector's disc series dubbed "New Discs" at the beginning of May with four releases: Cheap Trick, New Musik, Propaganda and The Continentals. The discs, which will list for \$3.98 and, in special cases (like Cheap Trick's) \$4.98 will be used both to introduce new groups at a more affordable price than an LP and to fuel collectors with previously unavailable and/or hard-to-get tracks by their faves. The Cheap Trick New Disc, for example, will contain a live version of "Daytripper," a rare B-side and two studio outtakes. More on this experiment as it unfolds.

**BITS AND PIECES:** Snips, whom many will remember as the voice of Sharks and later Baker-Gurvitz Army, has completed an LP in London, which he co-produced with ex-Rich Kid now Ultravox guitarist Midge Ure. Expect it here this summer.... Speaking of Rich Kids, bassist Glen Matlock, seen here with Iggy Pop last time around, has left the Ig and is in the process of forming a band with ex-TRB guitarist Danny Kustow.... And speaking of Ginger Baker (I was), he's got a new touring band called NRG (that's "energy," geddit?.... Blues revival could be the Next Big Thing in the UK (just as soon as the Soul revival—just getting underway—runs its course). Pioneering the trend will be aptly titled The Blues Band, an outfit currently getting raves which is made up of such veterans of the last British Blues boom as Paul Jones, Tom McGuinness and Huey Flint (all of whom once played with Manfred Mann).... Kevin Ayers is alive and living in New York and has a new LP due out soon. He's also got a band together for eventual U.S. work, we hear.... So upset are the Tourists with their British label, Logo, that they're moving (Continued on page 12)

CHART ANALYSIS  
BY GEORGE MEIER

Two stories come out of a close look at the Top 10 radio records this week. Happily, one of them is the tremendous enthusiasm for the current crop of albums. To make the point, note that 13 records have airplay percentages over .500. Just two weeks ago, there were only 9 records above .500. When you consider that many times we have had number 1 records which have operated in the lower .600's, this is a very encouraging and impressive circumstance.

The other notable pulse is the influence on the charts made by the South. There are several things going on there. Almost one year ago we were describing a shift in that region toward a Midwestern style. They have moved away from Southern rock toward hard rock and they have always been somewhat slower on new ideas than the two coasts. Hard rock and conservatism has always been the profile of the Midwest, now it is the profile of the South too.

- 1. There isn't a non-rock album among the top 7 Lps, even Linda Ronstadt and Billy Joel intensify this time, and it is the South which goes strongest for them all.
- 2. Also, it is notable that Marshall Tucker comes into the chart at the 16th position with merely moderate to heavy airplay in the South.
- 3. Meanwhile, where are The Pretenders, The Clash, Gary Numan and The Ramones weakest? In the South, of course.

In other radio regionals, it is the Northeast which bolsters Elvis Costello, The Clash, Warren Zevon and The Specials. Sue Saad and the Next get help out West and Rachel Sweet excels on both coasts.

On the retail side, the consistently powerful Pink Floyd shows no sign of diminishing. And Eagles won't go away in the South. Rush and Journey are significantly stronger in the Midwest and West while The Clash and Elvis Costello are stronger on the coasts.
