DX NEWS

JANUARY 9, 1935.

This week we have a lot of news for you which we hope will be of interest to all of you. However the most important of this news in our mind at present is the change in time of the WORK DX Club broadcasts.

You will recall that we told you when ye editor first got this series of broadcast under way that WORK would give us a night spot for this program just as soon as they went down on 1320 kycs. We have long been anticipating this opportunity of informing you of the night spot and we now have the good news for you. This weekly broadcast will take place Friday evenings from 7:45 to 8:00 P.M., E.S.T. at first, however we are of the opinion at present that we may be able to get an even later period in due time. We sincerely hope that we shall be able to reach many more of our members with this new change in time and we would appreciate having cards and letters from all of you sent to us in care of the WORK DX Club, York Broadcasting Co., York, Penna. We want your comments and suggestions on this broadcast in order that we may improve upon it and make it one of the best DX Club periods on the air, however this is only possible as long as we get your comments on it, so please don't fail us, let us hear from you regularly. We need your support in order to make this period grow, don't let it be said that you didn't do your duty. Don't forget, this broadcast takes place on 1320 kycs instead of 1000 kycs as heretofore.

The next important news that we have for you is in regards to those Mexican stations operating on 1210 kycs that had promised us to take part in our Mexican Nights party at a time that we could not clear their channel for them. We have received air-mail letters from XETH and XEFJ in regards to their broadcasts for our club. XETH says they will be on for us on Tuesday morning, January 15 from 2:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. instead of Sunday morning, January 13 as we told you last week. XETH is located in Puebla, Pbla. and will operate on 1210 kycs. XEFJ also says that they will be on for us on Tuesday morning, January 15 from 5:00 to 6:00 A.M., E.S.T. instead of Saturday morning, January 12 as we had notified you last week. XEFJ goes even further than that they plan to change their frequency to 1230 kycs for this broadcast, they are located in Monterrey, N. L. We know that this news will be welcome to all of you, for they will now be heard at a time that the channel will be cleared and thereby give you all an opportunity of hearing them.

More good news on those Mexican stations; Earl Roberts sends us word that he is in receipt of an air-mail letter from XENL, 1240 kycs. Leon, Guan. who state that they will be very pleased to dedicate a program to the members of our club on Sunday morning, January 13 from 1:00 to 2:00 A.M., E.S.T. Please note that this broadcast will take place on 1240 kycs and that XENL will use 500 watts power during this broadcast. We feel certain that you ought not have much trouble hearing this program for the members of our club.

We want to urge you all to send in your reports on these Mexican broadcasts to the stations participating in this party, for there are several Mexican stations participating that we do not believe ever ran DX programs before. Let's make a good impression on them all with a lot of fine reports on these broadcasts for our club. Remember that future DX programs may depend a lot upon the response that they get to this series of broadcasts.

Through the courtesy of the I.D.A. we are printing a list of the hours that the European stations come on the air in the early mornings. These are the usual daily schedules and all times are E.S.T.

We want to take this opportunity of thanking the stations that put on DX programs for the members of our club during the past week. We hope that most of you were able to find HIX who instead of operating on 1270 kycs. as they had notified us that they were going to, they used 575 kycs or thereabouts. They were well reported here in York and we are confident that many of you should have heard them. Perhaps some of you mistook them for TGW but we hope that this did not happen in many instances. We also want to thank WPAX for giving us additional time on their program for our members, they were scheduled to be on from 2:00 to 5:00 A.M., and we were greatly pleased to note that they were on at 1:00 A.M., at which time we began DXing on Tuesday morning.

Earl Roberts says that inasmuch as none of the boys reported hearing XEAO Mexicali, Mexico on January 2 at which time they had notified him that they would put on a DX program for the members of our club, that he is inclined to believe that they made an error in typing and that the date should have been January 12. We are accordingly listing XEAO on the 12th and we hope that this time you will have some luck in being able to hear their station.

On the 12th we also find that KPPC 1210 kycs. Pasadena, Calif. will conduct an all night broadcast from 3:00 to 6:00 A.M., E.S.T. This station seldom runs a DX program and we know that this will be welcome news to many of our members. They have promised to dedicate the period from 4:00 to 4:30 A.M., E.S.T. to the members of our club.

Also on the morning of the 12th we find that CMW 930 kycs. Havana, Cuba will be on the air for the members of our club with either Alec Kinghorn or Vincent Clarke at the mike, or possibly both. Let's all listen in and send CMW our reports for as you know they have been more or less disappointed with the response to Cuban DX programs this season.

On Tuesday morning, January 15 the members of our club are to be favored with a program from station WHEF 1500 kycs. Kosciusko, Miss. from 1:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. Ye editor was the lucky one in lining up this broadcast for our club.

We thought that WDAY Fargo, N. D. put on a test program the third Tuesday morning of each month, however this information must be wrong, at least for this month, for we are in receipt of a letter from WDAY informing us that their test will take place on Tuesday morning, January 22 from 1:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. They have also promised us that a portion of this broadcast will be dedicated to the members of our club. Let's listen in to these two last mentioned DXes and send in our reports as both stations say they will be very happy to receive reports.

On Friday evening, January 18, KGVG 1200 kycs. Missoula, Mont. will take the air at 11:00 P.M., E.S.T. and continue broadcasting until 5:00 A.M., on the morning of the 19th. This broadcast will be dedicated to NRC. CDXR and IDA. It was arranged by R. W. Schofield of that city.
