DX NEWS

JANUARY 23, 1935.

We are all ready to start on this week's Bulletin with a lot of news which we feel confident will be of interest to all of our members. First of all however, we want to say that this past Sunday morning surely was one of the finest DX mornings that we have experienced this season and we hope you were all on the job and took advantage of the fine reception which was available on that morning.

We also want to call your attention to three surprise DX dedications that we heard for our club on Sunday morning. The first was from WNEL in San Juan, P. R. We certainly do hope that many of you heard this excellent program which WNEL put on for us. The second of the dedications took place over CMOA in Havana, Cuba. This station presented an unusually fine program for the members of our club and we hope that those of you who heard it sent in your reports to CMOA. The third was the mention our club got during a program from KIDW LaMar, Colorado. Incidentally we heard the announcer state that from this past Sunday morning on KIDW was to be on the air every Sunday morning at 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. and would remain on for either a half hour or an hour. Here is the opportunity for those of you that have not yet heard KIDW to tune in on Sunday mornings and here they are. We were also very much pleased to hear KABN Aberdeen, S. D. who really came in here in fine style. They were testing equipment and conducting a frequency check with Chicago.

Our Singleton and Eliminator Report arrived about two hours after we had last week's Bulletin in the mail, we are therefore including this report with this week's Bulletin.

Ray Lewis and Ed Hatch have both written us to the effect that they have received word from CJCB, Sidney, Nova Scotia that they will run two test programs on Sunday morning, January 27 from 2:00 to 2:45 and from 4:00 to 4:30 A.M., E.S.T. They also say that there is a very strong possibility that they will repeat the test on the morning of February 3 if weather conditions are against them in their test on the morning of the 27th.

KFRO in Longview, Texas have sent C. G. Huber our Adv. Chairman a verification of his report of reception of their station and the contents of the letter are very interesting, hence we are accordingly going to reprint those parts which we feel will be of interest to you. We might mention that Mr. Huber has asked them to give us a program on Saturday morning, February 9 from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. If a station verifies a thank you card it would not be fair to count three points, as request for verification was not made.
