DX NEWS

FEBRUARY 13, 1935.

Again we find that it is time for us to begin work on this week's Bulletin. We hope that you have all found DXing to have been fine over the past week end and that you were all able to add several fine new catches to your logs during that time.

First of all we have several more new members to welcome into our club, they are: Fred Sanders, 355 Ellis Ave., Peshtigo, Wis. and Serg. Juan Mora y Santa Maria, Secc. de Radio, Jefectura de Policia, Havana, Cuba. We hope that both of these gentlemen will find their memberships in our club very beneficial.

Howard Schlobohm our hard working CPCer from Brooklyn sends us word of several DXes that he has lined up for our club. However he is especially anxious for us to call to your attention the frequency check dedication which he has arranged for March 1 from WCAT 1200 kycs. Rapid City, S. D. from 3:50 to 4:10 A.M., E.S.T. You will all recall that during the latter part of December that Howard had arranged for a DX program from this station and that the results were very disappointing so far as the response to the program was concerned. It so happens that the morning of their program was very poor for radio reception and we believe that this was the cause for the poor response that we sent to WCAT on this program. Here is your opportunity to prove to WCAT that we can send in a lot of fine reports on any broadcast that they put on for our club. This is one of the few instances that we have had any unfavorable comment on programs put on for our club this season and we are very anxious to straighten ourselves out in the eyes of this station. Let's all listen in and send in our reports. Howard also advises us that WHDL 1420 kycs. Olean, N. Y. will put on a DX program for our club on Saturday morning, March 2 from 6:00 to 7:00 A.M., E.S.T. He further adds that he received a letter from WKAQ 1240 kycs. San Juan, P.R. telling him of their DX program for the 24th of this month from 2:00 to 5:00 A.M., E.S.T. He has written them requesting them to dedicate a portion of this program to the members of our club. Thanks for all of this news, Howard and we know that the members will all listen in and send their reports in to these stations.

Alec Kinghorn writes us to the effect that practically all of the stations in Havana will change frequency between now and March 1 and that they will also install crystals to properly control their new frequencies. He says he will send us a revised list just as soon as it is available to him.

Speaking of quick work, W3XBD owned and operated by the Bell Tel. Labs at Whippany, N. J. received a construction permit to erect an experimental station using 5 KW to transmit on 560, 900 and 1340 kycs. between the hours of 12 and 6 A.M. Last week, Joe Becker and Pat Reilley report having heard their station operating on 900 kycs several mornings. We think this is very fast work in view of the fact that they just received their CP a week or so ago.

Station XEU 1010 kycs. Veracruz, Mexico has been heard testing during the early AMs several times in the past week. We suggest you watch for this station, for they may continue to test throughout this coming week and those of you that have not as yet heard them can hear them if

D. members sends us word that she has heard a station using the call letters XELO between 650 and 670 kycs. and she says they gave their location as Piedras Negras, Mexico. We wonder whether this is the station that we heard several mornings last week around 660 kycs playing American Dance tunes and running after 2:00 A.M., E.S.T?

Earl Roberts sends us word that he has been advised that XEFJ, 1230 kycs. Monterrey, Mexico will present another DX program for the members of our club on either the 16th or 23rd of this month from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T. We shall list this tip in this week's DX calendar, although we are not certain that they will be on the 23rd, or the 16th, but we believe they will be on the 23rd, we therefore suggest you watch both dates for them.
