DX NEWS

FEBRUARY 27, 1935.

Well here it is time for us to begin work on this week's Bulletin and we find that we have a lot of fine news on hand which we hope will be of interest to all of our members.

To begin with we want to take this opportunity of welcoming Paul C. Downing, Jr. Delray Beach, Fla. as a new member in our club. We trust that he will find his membership in our club very beneficial to his DX activities.

March 8, 9 and 10 have been set aside by Ray Lewis, Vice Chairman of our Courtesy Programs Committee for another Gigantic series of broadcasts from Canada. This party is to be known as Canada On The Air. Thus far the response has been very good and we are taking this opportunity to advise you of the stations that have already consented to broadcast for our club during these broadcasts. We want to take this opportunity of thanking Ray for the fine work that he has done with this Party.

We are in receipt of a card from Mr. J. Radford, Mgr. of station CROW who informs us that their station will be on the air on Saturday, March 9 from 12 midnight until 12:30 A.M., E.S.T. dedicated to the DX listeners. This station operates on 600 kycs. and is one of the latest Canadian stations to take the air.

We have also received a card from A.M. Milligan, Mgr. of station GJCJ Calgary, Alta. who advises us that they will be glad to co-operate with us on any of the three mornings mentioned from 2:30 to 3:30 A.M., E.S.T. We are asking them for Sunday morning, March 10, this station as most of you know operates on 690 kycs.

We are also in receipt of a letter from CHAB 1200 kycs. Moose Jaw, Sask. who advise us that they will put on a DX program to be dedicated to the members of our club on Sunday morning, March 10 from 2:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T.

Perhaps the best news is in the form of a card received from CHCK 1310 kycs. Charlottetown, P.E.I. who advise us that they too will put on a DX program for the members of our club on Sunday morning, March 10 from 2:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. We know that this is very good news to many of our members for this station has not run a DX program for at least 3 or 4 years that ye editor can recall.

Continuing with the list of stations that will put on DXes during this Canadian Party, we find a letter from CKWX 1010 kycs. Vancouver, B. C. who will put on a DX program on Sunday morning, March 10 from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T.

Also on the 10th we will find station CHRG 580 kycs. Quebec, Que. who will be on the air for the members of our club from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T.

CJAT 910 kycs. Trail, B. C. have also written us to say that they too are interested in presenting a DX program for the members of our club on Sunday morning, March 10 from 3:00 to 4:00 A.M., E.S.T.

The last acceptance that we have on hand thus far comes from station OPCT 1450 kycs. Victoria, B. C. They too advise us that they will be on the air for the members of our club, on Sunday morning, March 10 from 5:00 to 6:00 A.M., E.S.T.

We hope to have some additional acceptances for next week's Bulletin. We therefore suggest that you watch next week's edition very closely. We might add that we are very proud of the acceptances thus far received and we want to take this opportunity to urge all of you to listen in to these stations and send in your reports, and thereby show the stations your appreciation for these fine programs which they are presenting in our honor.

We have been advised by station WNEL 1290 kycs. San Juan, P. R. that they too will present a program for the members of our club on Sunday morning, March 10 from 1:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. However according to our records they are not scheduled to run a DX program on that morning inasmuch as their programs are presented every other week which would schedule one for March 3 and one for the 17th, however we hope to hear from them in the near future and thereby straighten out the matter concerning this DX program. In the meanwhile we might suggest that you watch March 3 for they may take a notion to present it at that time and again it might be on the 17th.

We are in receipt of a letter from Mr. Dammon of radio station WBAA who advises us that their station owned by Purdue University of Lafayette, Ind. will present an "All Purdue Midnight Radio Party" which will take place on Saturday morning, March 16 from 1:00 to 3:00 A.M., E.S.T. We have written Mr. Dammon requesting him to dedicate a portion of this program to the members of our club.

We hope that all of you heard some of the fine programs which were presented for our club this past week end. On Saturday morning instead of running one hour as they had notified us, WRBL Columbus, Ga. ran the program through an extra hour and it certainly was a mighty fine one, in which they gave our club lots of publicity. We were not able to hear XEFJ in Monterrey who were to have also put on a program for our club on Saturday morning.

Sunday morning found many fine programs on the air for our club. The first of which was presented over station KFRU Columbia, Mo. Following their program we heard the fine program which WOS Jefferson City, Mo. put on for us and at 4:00 A.M., we listened to the fine program from WGBF and also the excellent two hour broadcast which began at that time for the members of our club over WTRC Elkhart, Ind. At 4:30 A.M., we were very pleasantly surprised to hear WKAQ San Juan, P. R. dedicating a portion of their big three hour program to the members of our club. We felt confident that they would not forget our club and kept a close watch on their station and we found that we were right for we felt that they would give us a portion of this broadcast.

Earl Roberts writes us that he has just received a letter from XBE Durango, Mexico in which they have asked our pardon for not having put on the scheduled DX program for the members of our club on Feb. 5. The reason for their not having put on this program certainly is a sad one, for Mr. Stevenson lost one of his parents at that time. Hence he was unable to give us the program that he had promised us. However he hastens to assure us that he will dedicate more programs to our club soon and that the first DX program for our club was a complete success, having received many reports from all over these United States and Canada.
