Harry Gordon is the first to claim points for NRC programs verified. Harry has veries from WJBO and WPAY, the latter verified twice. CMKE has just verified OM so add another 5 points. So that nets him 20 points. Remember that each program listed in the DX calendar with NRC in back of it is good for five points that you verify it. Also the regular periods of WPAY WJBO CJCJ and KSL count.
