OLIVE JOHNSON-Watertown S.Dak. (FLASH:-KWAT-1210kc., Watertown S.Dak. will take the air February 10th., The 208 ft antenna vertic al is being erected. The old one was 70 feet. This is an Airport City so a beacon will be erected on the antenna, 250 watts with booster, -24 hour service, when needed; Same broadcasting and office rooms in the Midland Block. Congrats on KGFX DX, who sez we don't have Miracles ????. (Thanks Olive for the info, will drop a line befor long)

HILDING GUSTAFSON*Rockford Ill. New catches are:-TIGPH breaks thru around 9:00 PM here in the evenings. YVIRE hrd signing on at 4:35 AM CST Feb. 5th., LS11 hrd on their special but they were very weak., After listening to LS11 I tried for Aussies but they were unusuall weak, 2SM was about the best, and they weren't much good. But now I have ran that up to 662 stations heard, and I have also ran my total veries to 201. I hrd 36 new stations and received 25 new veries in Jan.and have hrd 6 new stations, and received 2 veries so far this month.
