So who is right and who is wrong. (According to this Central America information HJ2ABJ used to be in Santa Marta, Colombia. But is HJBJ and this old call the same station.) Now to that station on 1080kc., the same information from Central American report's this station VIA SW as in Bogota, Colombia. His call is HJBH. The old call was HJ3ABH on 4.90 Megs (SW). We cannot say which report is right, the above report or the report you will see on Page:3 (Top). If you mail is returned from one try the other.

TIPS AND LPO REPORTS

NOTE---Here's some information on them COLOMBIAN stations of the 4th of February:- Ray Edge says the NNRC carried the calls as HJBJ-1140 kc., located in Santa Marta Colombia S.A. Bob Potzum sends in this information that he and another chap heard this stations also, Bob hrd them on the BCB and the other chap on the SW, and both report that they are as follows:-HJBJ-1145kc., Santa Marta Colombia.. 1080kc., HJBH Barranquilla Colombia., HJLABA-1330kc., HJLABK-1310kc., both in Baranquilla Colombia. We will have a new Colombian list here in a next day or so and will check on this information. As there are several new stations coming on down that way one we know of is:-HJCI-1200kc., in Bogota Colombia..

Last week we had a EXCLUSIVE:-NRC SCOOP--On them five Texas stations well we were right in all but, one station, here's the official list:-KSAM-Huntsville Texas., KAND-Corsicana, Texas., KRBA-Lufkin, Texas., KTBC-Sustin Texas., NOTE PLEASE we had KDNT-where it should have been KNET-Palestine, Texas. According to the FCC bulletin this week we were right in that Scoop, these stations have orders of revocations of their licenses, effective February 24.1940. Applicants may request hearing within 15 days, in which case revocation orders will be stayed pending outcome of hearing.

--PREPARING FOR BROADCAST RELOCATIONS--

The Federal Communications Commission is considering the tentative re-allocation of broadcast bands in the U.S.A. to conform to the provisions of the N.A. Regional Broadcast Agreement, now ratified by Canada, Cuba Haiti and Mexico as well as by this country.

The treaty provides one year in which to make the prescribed changes in station assignments. By agreement, this time may be reduced. However it does not appear possible to effect such changes within the three-month period suggested by the Mexican Association of Broadcasters. The exact time when allocations will become effective will be determined by the Commission survey now under way, and to meet the convenience of all the North American countries involved so far as may be possible.

Until such time as the work is completed, the Commission cannot undertake to consider applications of changes in individual cases under the reallocation. The Commission will give due notice to all licensees when the general plan is determined.
