HARRY M GORDON-Erie Penna. Have been doing a little DX'ing here of late. Sunday morning Feb.18, the Cleveland boys and I had an old fashion DX party, heard a few stations, such as 2YA, KGU CJAT, by the way CJAT was running an R9 at peaks on that date, CJCA, CKWX KGHF, testing, CKMO, KRBL, WFMA and numerous of other stations were hrd, the party broke up at 4:00 AM, I stayed up untill 5:15 AM and listen to a few TP's, this was a fair morning for DX, but on the following morning DEC.19 found almost a prefect morning if we ever had one. YSS was logged for 45 minute's, too you members that missed him, here's a little secret "YSS" came in on 645kc., not 638kc., Here's a "Believe it or Not" 1YA was so strong this morning that they almost pushed YSS off the dial at time's. Here's a few TP's heard 2YA-570kc., 3WV(???) 580kc., 630-???.650kc 1YA., 680kc.,???, 720kc., 3YA., 760kc., (???) 790kc., 4YA., 840kc., 2YC., also TP's hrd on 1100, 1130, 870 and a weak signal on 850. All these stations have been heard all week. Its lokks like the TP season is here. So watch for them. Such stations as KGU and 2YA, 1YA are almost like 1000 watt West coasters. KGU was showing a good R7-8 signal the other AM.

HILDING GUSTAFSON-Rockford Ill. Have a little more DX to report. Aussie and Zedders DX is picking up and should be good from now untill warm weather sets in. Last Sunday FEB.18 was one of the best mornings for Aussie and Zedder DX that I have seen for a long time. Stations hrd with good loud speaker volumn were 1YA 4YA 2YC 4QN 2BL and 4RK and others which I may have tuned over. 4RK should be a good shot for DX now that XENT is off 910 kc.,. They pack a whollop and should land in many DXers log. Altogether I heard exactly 40 Aussies and Zedders on this morning. Some of the weaker ones hrd were 3TR 3UZ 4AY 4GR and one on 900 kc which I beleived was 7UV. There was also another weak station interffering with 7UV which may have been another Aussie. Mrs McNeil's two Sons Robert, age 16, and Ricahrd 15, take active parts in the Management of KGFX, Robert, a Junior in High School has done a good deal of announcing, while Richard, a Sophomore, is interested in Radio Engineering. The station is located in the McNeil Residence. Every sis hours they make Airway Weather Observations which is found useful also for the Radio. The present schedule of KGFX is from 9:30 AM to local sunset. Programs from KGFX include talks by State Officials from remote control studios in the Capital Building. Daily Band and Chorus Music from the High School Building, Associated Press News from the Daily Capitol Journal Office, Sunday Morning Services from Congregational Church; Junior League Baseball Games from the Field, including the State tournament--and a Daily routine of interesting programs.

- (1)-Only veries received for reception from midnight January 1, 1940 to Midnight 1, 1940 will be eligible.
- (2)-Only veries from SW-BCB and Amateur Fone (NO CW) will be counted in the contest. No Veries from the U.S.A. SWBCB or Ham Stations will be eligible.
- (3)-Point Rating will determine the Winner. Sponsors of the contest will act as judges. In case of dispute's the Board Of Directors will act as judge's, their word to be final.
- (4)-Only verifications direct from the stations themselves shall be counted in this contest. No monitored or "dime veries" shall be counted.
- (5)-Verifications may be called in at any time by the contest manager, but only in case of dispute by the contestants or doubt on the part of the manager.
- (6)-Prizes will be announced after the completion of the 1939 contest. In the case of any ties duplicate prizes will be awarded.
- (7)-Larry Lundberg will act as editor. List of veries received should be sent to him. No veries to be sent into the editor unless requested by the Editor.
- (8)-Points will be awarded according to Continents in the following manner.
 - (a) Africa and Asia (5 points each)
 - (b) Oceania and Europe (4 points each)
 - (c) South America. (3 points)
