(This is all the information we have at this time. Our Filing system is working out very well, we have a few stations with no information on. In the next issue we will have more dope. Ed)

Here's one urgent SOS-Answered:-4QS is listed at Dalby, Australia on 760 kc., according to Joe Lippincott's veri received from 4QG. Check Joe's LPO report.

JOE LIPPINCOTT-East Vassalboro Me. Despite any statements by the Montana

stations about not having my name, all three of them got my reports. And all three verified and in addition all three sent copper souvenirs. I sent a report on a reply card, with only initials on it, it must have been this card they read. I just received a veri from 4QG and on same card is schedule for 4QR 4QN 4RK and 4QS. This card was mailed 19 January 1940. 4QS is listed at DALBY and on 760 kc.,. I now have 3 veries of HOK covering two different dates.

AEAC was hrd on its regular freq of 980 with a DXers program at about 2:45 AM EST Sunday AM, and they claim that they will be on with such a program every Sunday at that time and will also make it worthwhile for DXers as they will send a DX bulletin. I hope they will do something as they ignored my last report of some time ago. SOS..Who played selection "The Chapel Bells are ringing" and then signed off on 1360 at 3:42 AM EST Sunday the 25th Feb...?.
