TIPS and LPO REPORTS

November 15 1941

HAROLD CRISWELL-LEWISBERRY PA I'm still around yet, haven't DXed much as I am working all night, 10 & 12 hrs and 5 & 6 nights a week. Meet with an accident a couple weeks ago, fortunately my left one. It is getting along OK. Am DXing now as I have lots of time. Got my hand badly cut. Reception has been terrible here. Veries rec this summer and fall are WKWK-WPAT-WCOP-WOCE-WWDC-KDTH-WABC-WJZM-WCED-WLAG. Reported all the Club specials I could. Didnt wake up in time for WGAA-couldnt hear KEVR and KGBS. Some of the stations gave us a fine send off. KHMO on check 11/5 for a new one, WWNY also a new one. WRRN testing the 7th, WJMA hasn't verified yet. I've missed plenty of the new ones, hope reception gets better soon. When I work 10 hrs and quit at 4:30 the 5 to 6 specials were made to order for me. Some of the NNRC specials were good, didnt hear CKUA-CHLN-CKCW-CHRC-CJCJ or CFRC. Heard CJIC-CKRN-CKNB-CKNA-CKCO on 1310 kcs very good. Glad to have a report Harold but am sorry it has to be an accident to you, Lets hear from you often.

MEL OLIVER-HOUSTON TEXAS Only veries rec this week are WABC-KCSJ-WAVE-WJZM-KHMO, will pick up as I have sent 10 reports in last 2 days. 11/6 Static severe, 3:05 WCBI testing; WLBJ-WGOV-WJZM-KLUF-WRBL on frequency checks. 11/11 Hrd the following freq cks KELD-WCMI-KXYZ-WTAQ-KGKL-WCOV-KRGV-KTOK-KGFF-KFVS-KOCY-KICA-KBTM in order hrd. Also KAVE on monthly DX program from 5 AM. 11/12 CBH s/o 3 AM; KLO & WHIS with fine DX programs from 304, for no clubs in particular; WBOW-WGIL-WCLO freq checks. Didnt catch any Canadian programs for NNRC, just couldnt hear them.

NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N M DX has been pretty good here lately. Have had a little more time to do some DXing. However, very few veries have petered in. Those include KTSA-KRLD & KSOO. New stations hrd here were KRNT-KGNO-WLB-KGKO-KMMJ-WTAX-WJZ-KFJI-WHBQ-KMLB-WLS-KGU-WWNY-KPFA-KWLC-WSLI-KINY-KFDA and KCMB. All these stations have been reported. However KGMB-KMLB & WSLI have been reported before with no success. Also hrd, but not reported, LYA-KHBC-KGBU; KGBU & KINY are my first Alaskan stations They came thru on this mornings FCC test programs. Only KINY was hrd well enough to report. TP reception has not been up to par the last 2 weeks. That is for the few mornings that I have been up. May have been some that I missed. The only news here is that our local KOB has changed freq and is now on 770 kcs. As far as reception around this locality the change is not too good for reception qualities. However dont know how this change may effect KOB's signals to the East. They now have WJZ to compete rather than WBZ. KOB's sign off time is rather early, being 11 PM MST or 1:00 AM EST, so that many eastern listeners will not be able to pull the 50 kw station thru. Still looking forward to sending my 1st report to a TP. Have hrd them for the 1st time in over 5 yrs. (Say Norm its not Mr Edge here, its either Ray or Pop) (Boys look KGBU-KINY, Yum-Yum)

BOB BREYMAIER-LAKEMOOD OHIO Here is my first report of this season. I reported to KPO-WKWK-WJLB-WEXL-WKW-KWK-WGN-WBIM-KDTH-YV4RA who have verified and WWNY-KFEL-WABY-WMFD-KELD-CFOS-CHLN-CJIC-CKRN-HJAR-XEJP who havnt as yet. The mystery station on 1153 kcs has been heard to announce as XEJP Mexico City. They announce the frequencies as 1150 but do not operate on that one. They seem to be on every morning and sign off at 4 AM. 10/29 logged 4QW & 4Q5. TP's fairly good that morning. 11/6 LRL R9 plus at 6:45 PM. At the same time YV5RQ-882 kcs was also R9 plus. OAX4A-854 kcs heard weakly. At sign off 11:30 PM TIPC 30DB above R9. HJAN good that evening and also in morning, being on until past 3:30. SW relay on; CMCK hrd well every morning. Also relayed on 8.7 meg. I finally received my HQ 120 after a 2 months wait.

JOE LIPPENCOTT-CELO N CAR. Sorry I cant be any help on TA's hrd this yr as I do not even have any way of listening to any kind of Radio here. Just waiting to get 110 DC currant as soon as I can get around to hitching up the Kohler motor. Even then I will have only a 5 tube set for DX and I imagine that wont amount to much. Wish I had something to use for DX. I think there is more than 2500 ft of solid cpooper wire to use for sky wires(dont tell Uncle Sam he might think I am hoarding it) so am going to see what a little wire and a little radio will do. Wish I knew Dave Thomas's antenna ideas. (Well Dave if you see this, Joe's address is Celso Community, Celso North Carolina) Well Joe you should do OK even with a small set as Jim Walker did OK with one-Ray

DAVID THOMAS-PROCTORVILLE OHIO Have not had set on for week-been busy in election,lodge and work. (Dave how did the election come out-sorry I couldnt send a few votes down to you) SPECIAL TIP within 2 weeks KEH will change from 1250 to 1420 kcs and use power of 1000 watts. Both English and Spanish will be used. Sked is daily 5:15 AM to 10 PM. On Sundays it is 5:30 AM till noon. REPORTS DESIRED on 1420. P.O. Box 147,Monterrey. Verie just received with this dope. (They also verified for your editor in 8 days) 11/11 CKUA & CHLN not hrd; CFGP questionable; CKNE fair and CJIC good; CKRN & CHLN fine with NNRC DK programs. Notice that last yrs FCC list still runs very close to form in 1941; 11/12 Station hrd behind WOL all morning,maybe CFRN or is it one in Mexico. If so Who? No sign of CHRC-CJCF or CFRC on NNRC DX. CKNX & CKCO on 1310 very good. WHIS on 3-4 with DX program; KLO-3-3:45 request DX program. Latest veries here,KGMB just out 21 days-exchange of post cards,thats service, XEH-KSKY-WGAA-WLAG and YV4RA. FCC tests again this AM was true to form but WSLs on 1490 kcs at 3 AM, rest the same. (Dave WSLs was on at 2:50 that AM-3:05)

Have reports out to all over and why dont WJMA & KEG answer? I sent my report to Monterrey over a month ago. XEMO also does not answer and CJRC sure should have by now. I agree with Carroll's poem. By the way Radex has a fb mag now hasnt it? I now have a VIC of 24 with all continents and have hrd 66 countries most of them on 2 tubes. I have had this Sky Chief only 2 months. LEN KRUSE-DUBUQUE IOWA The past several weeks DXing was only fair but but now old man winter is close by so reception promises to be quite favorable for yours truly. This is by the way my first report to the NRC and I hope to be a weekly reporter in these DX NEWS columns. Starting the DX hobby in February 1941 I have 561 stations logged on the BCB while I have 307 verified. On 10/22 hrd KWBW several hours in early AM broadcasting flood bulletins as their town was partially flooded. New stations logged 11/6 WJBY-WTMA-WCBI-WORD; 11/7 KWAT-WBOC & WRRN testing from 3:15 AM to 4:15 AM for equipment purposes. Among other new stations logged on 11/8 KOBH-WHLN-WGNC-WTOL-WKBZ-WBRW-WOLS-WJW-KSAM-WLAK-KBIX-WOMT-WHBU-WTAL-WMSD. Of the half dozen Canadian stations on the air on 11/11 dedicated to the NNRC I logged only one that being CJIC; It seems that these programs conflicted quite a bit with the regular FCC checks and thus is the excuse I will give for not logging more. New stations logged on 11/11 WAYX-WDNC-WPAY-WHIZ-WMFR-KAVE-KGKL-WCOV-KALB-WAJR. Veries WWSR-KMPC-KMBC-KSCJ-WJHO-WJHL cards, letters from CKTB-KFYO-KGIW-KROD-WJZM-WINN-KFUO-WMGA and WEVD. Starting 5 weeks after the opening date of the BCB contest, I'm going out to see just how I can rank among the outstanding "Night Owls". (Keep going Len and you will be up there)

HOWARD PERKINS-CLEVELAND OHIO Reports out to CFOS-WLAG-WINN-KFBI-KGGF-KGMB-XEG-XEAW-CMZ-HHW-on 1230 kc-XBDP-CMBC-CMCK and on SW TOWA-XEMW-ZNR. XEMW R9 plus here at 12:15 AM. CMJL Q5 R7-8 at 12:30 AM on 11/3; On 11/4 HHW Q3 R3-4 on 1230; WISR is like local here Q5 R9 in the afternoon, verified in 3 days. 11/5 Got WBIR & WGAC thru WEDC on freq test; WATL-WMOG WTMA-WCBI freq test on 11/6; Also on 11/5 WwNY for NRC Q5 R7-9 also KHL0 and WIZE on freq test. Received verie from PSH by registered mail, card and books on Brazil, took 7 months to reply to my report but well worth waiting for.

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N Y Well I nearly lost out on DXing, Sunday 11/10 a large truck ran off the road and burned in a high wind, house in extreme danger for 2 hrs, truck only 80 ft from the house. Well reports sent to WwNY special hrd Q4 R9 a fine program; 11/8 WwPC 4:45-5 on 1230 KV30-1240 5:25-5:40; KPFA-1240 5:55 drowned out by WCOU sign on; 11/10 KVOX-1340 4:20-4:35 Q4 R9; Veries rec CJCX(SW) card same as CJCB; KSCJ card verie one of the keenest I ever saw. Letters from WLAG & WGAA. Tnks for LRL QRA;

LEO HERZ-CHICAGO ILL Reports sent out to WALA-CFPL. XEAW not so loud since they use directional antenna. WALB and WwNY, this program was a swell one and signal good. Veries rather slow this season, only CFPL.

HERBERT CAMPBELL-ATHENS PA On 11/7 hrd WRRN test. Canadian NNRC specials hrd as follows, as of clear channels; CJIC (came on late) Q5 R9; CHLN fine program Q5 R8, QRM by WMFJ-KFAM-KCMC & KGFF; CKRN Q4 R7 QRM by WMFD WPAY and ?; CKNB Q4 R8 at 3:22; CKCO on 1310 kcs Q5 R abt million horse power; CKNX was on Q5 R8; Others not hrd, quite sure CFRC not on and if CKUA was on it was blocked by KMJ at Q2 R4. Condx fair bnt QRM high-12th

THOS E MORRISON-CLEVLAND OHIO I have been DXing about a year starting around Dec 1st 1940. Use a 5 tube Air Chief table model. Have logged 156 stations since Mar 29th 41. DX again poor all week and a noon sign has been giving me trouble with a capital T. CKRN-CKNB-CKCO-CHLN & CJIC 3:40-4:40AM hrd of the NNRC specials, others nil. I am writing a script for WWSR so ask all to listen and report. (What is it Lefty a Murder Mystery?)

TED NEIDER-SEA CLIFF N Y Since becoming a member of the NRC I hope to let the other members know I'm alive and have been burning the midnight oil during the past few weeks. So here is my first rpt on my DX activities from this neck of the woods. WNYF-1630 kcs is the Fire Dept, City of New York Radio Alarm station and can be hrd regular between mdt and 12:08 AM EST or later calling in Fire Boats from N Y Harbor, their card shows Fire Boat fighting fire in harbor and is a honey. CHSJ Q4 R5 over CKOC & WISN, s/o at 11 AM EST resume at 7:30 AM. KSD s/o 1:30 AM were Q5 R8 1:10-1:30 on Nov 8th.
